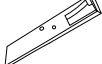
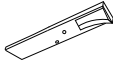
Assemble Front Legs

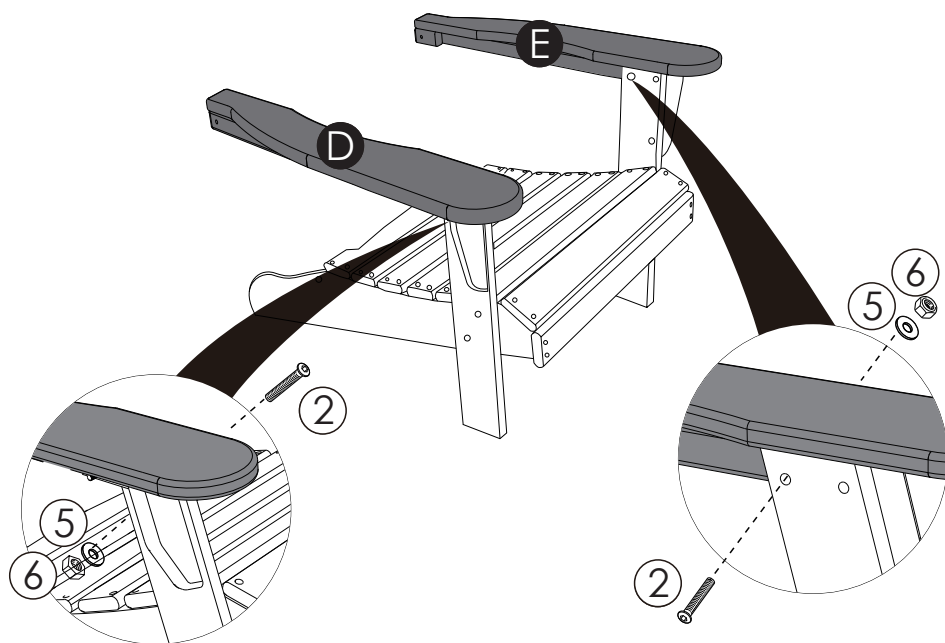

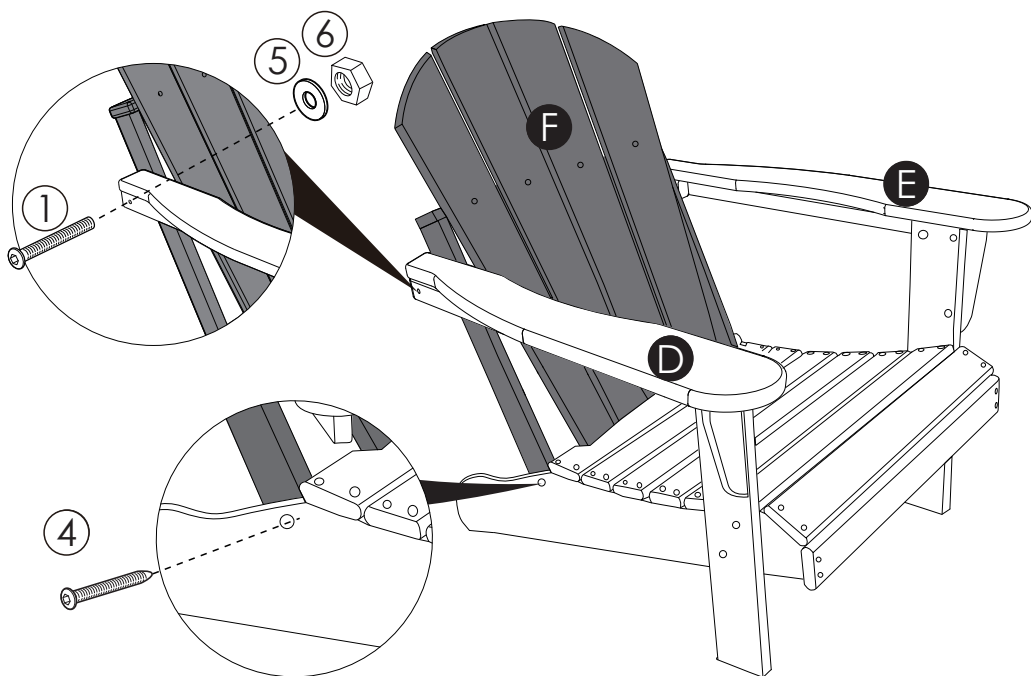

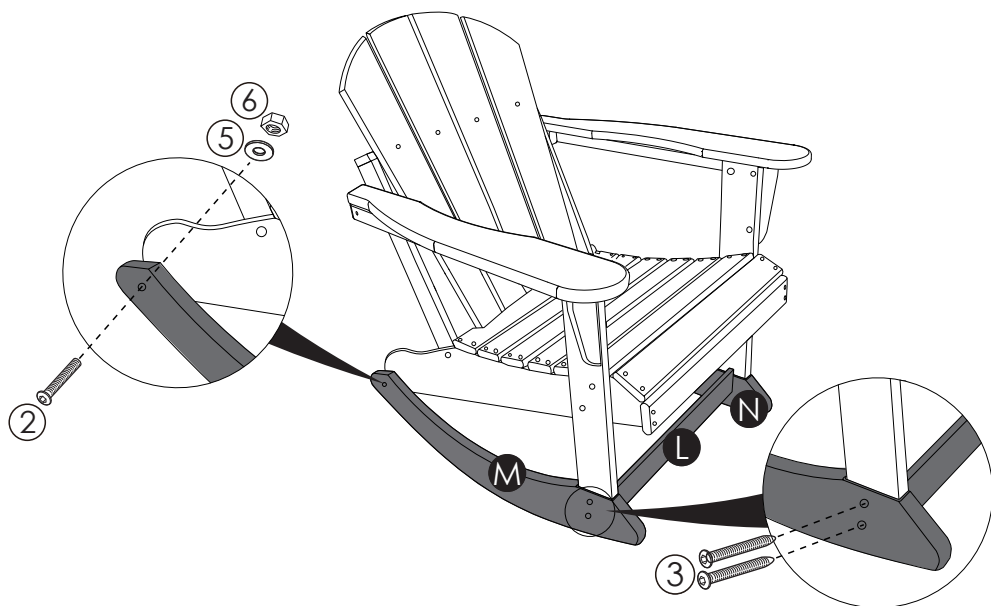
