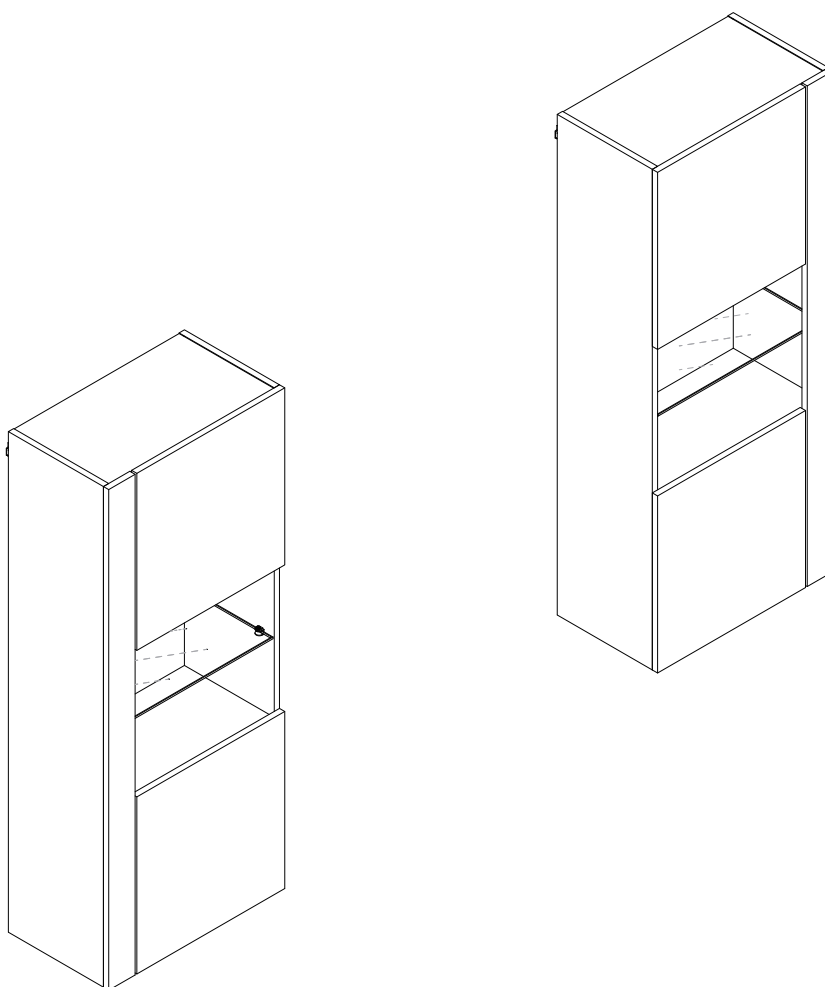

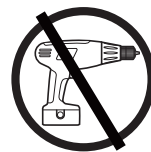


Safety and Care Advice

Important – Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

- During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



- To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your power drill is set on a low torque setting.

Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.
- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.

Handy Hints

- Assemble all parts and bolts loosely during assembly, only once the product is complete should you fully tighten the bolts
- Regularly check and ensure that all bolts and fittings are tightened properly.

WARNING

In order to help prevent overturning – please follow these instructions

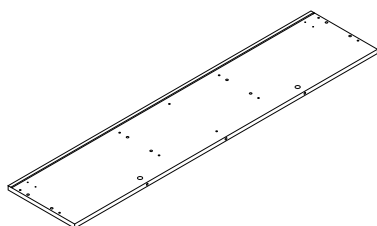
To help prevent product toppling over please follow the steps below:

- Must use the anti tip strap or wall fixing method provided (whichever applies).
- Do not allow children to climb or hang on the furniture.
- Do not place heavy items on top of the furniture, unless the furniture has been designed for this purpose
- Installation shall be carried out exactly according to the instructions - otherwise a safety risk can occur
- In order to prevent falling down this product must be used with the wall attachment device provided.

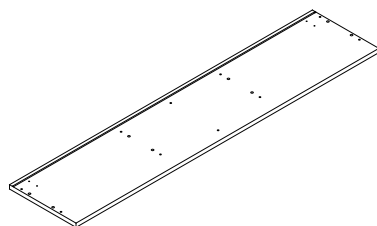
Please note that only the wall attachment device is provided. You will need to supply wall plugs and screws applicable for your wall type.

The screws length is measured from the head to the point (30mm screw shown).

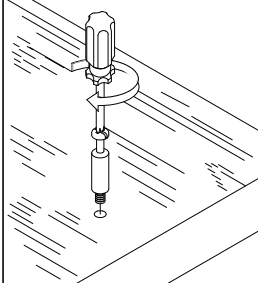
Using Camlocks

Step 1

Connect the male camlock as directed in the assembly instructions using a screwdriver.

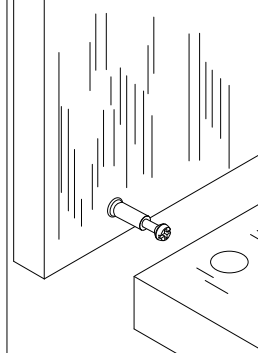

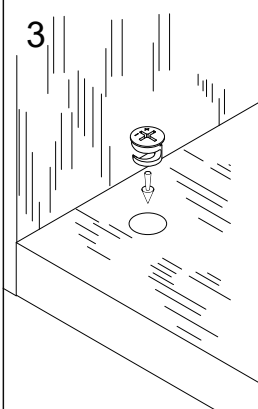


Step 3

Insert the female camlock as shown in the instructions.

Note: ensure that the arrow on the top of the camlock points towards the entry hole for the male camlock.

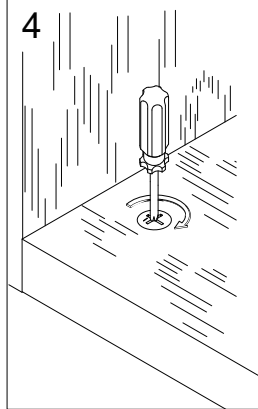
Step 4

Turn the female camlock clockwise with a screwdriver.

You should feel a click when the camlock is locked in place.

The joint is now secure.

Adjusting Hinges

Hinge adjustment:

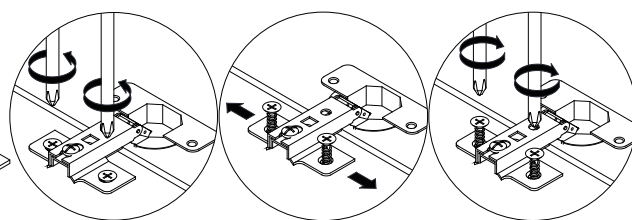
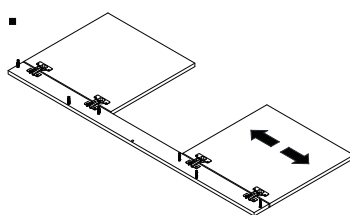
a: To move the top panel up or down, loosen screws shown and move top panel to suit

b: To move the top panel in or out, loosen screws shown and move top panel to suit.

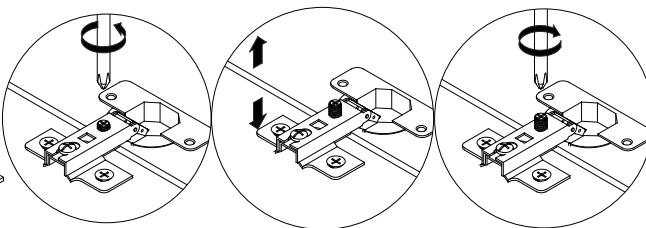
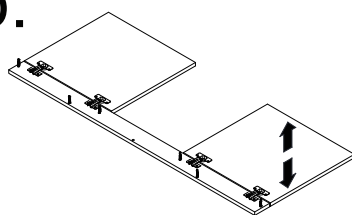

c: To move the top panel left or right, adjust screws shown.

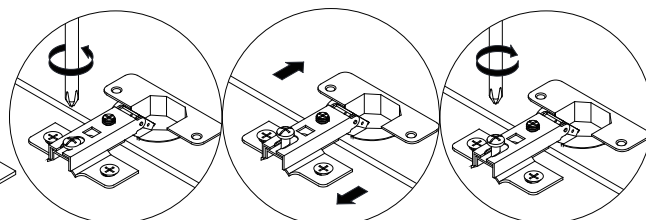
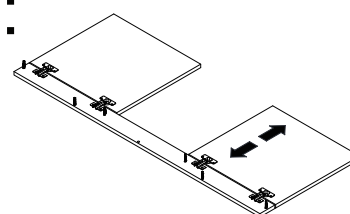

Step 1

CAM-LOCK

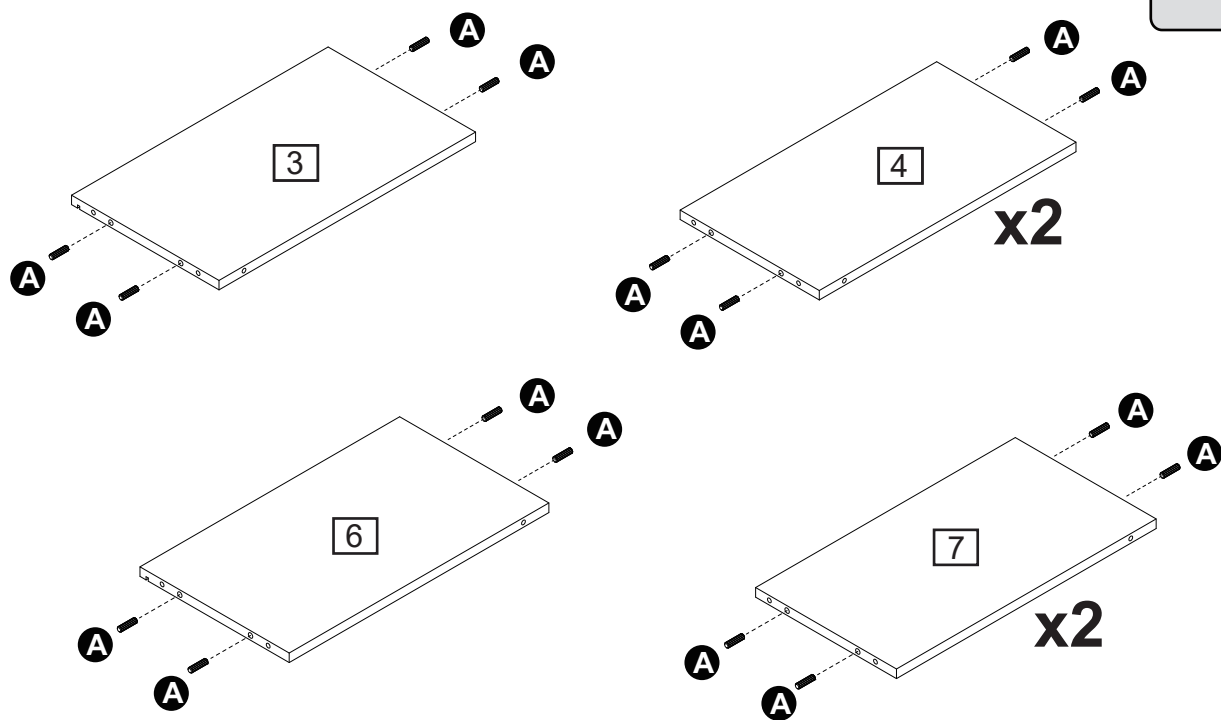
Tighten until shoulder is flush with panel. Do not overtighten or undertighten (see example below)



Insert wooden dowel (A) into part (1)
Attach cam bolt (B) to part (1, 2) with a screwdriver.

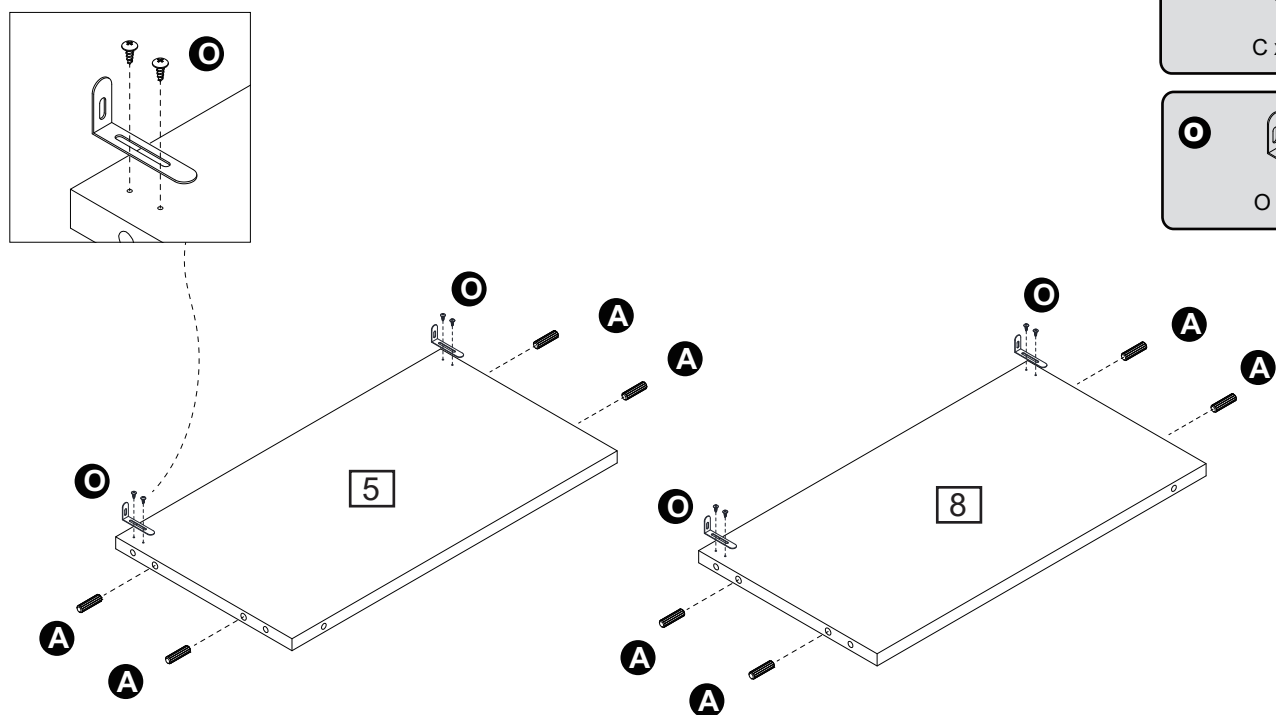

Insert wooden dowel (A) into part (3, 4, 6, 7).

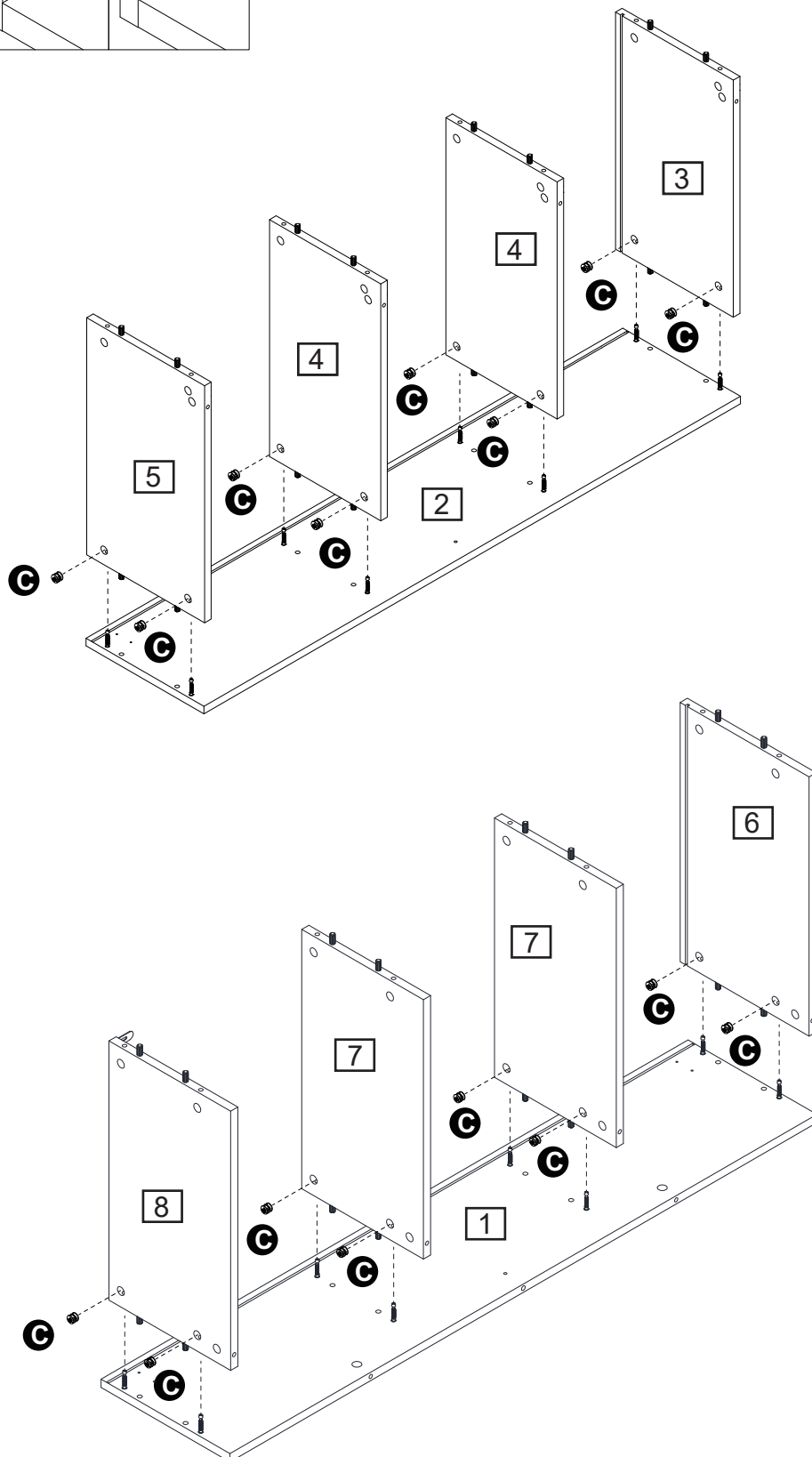
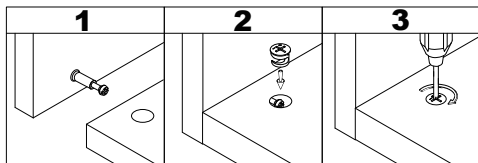

Insert wooden dowel (A) into part (5, 8).
Attach wall attach brackets (O) to part (5, 8).

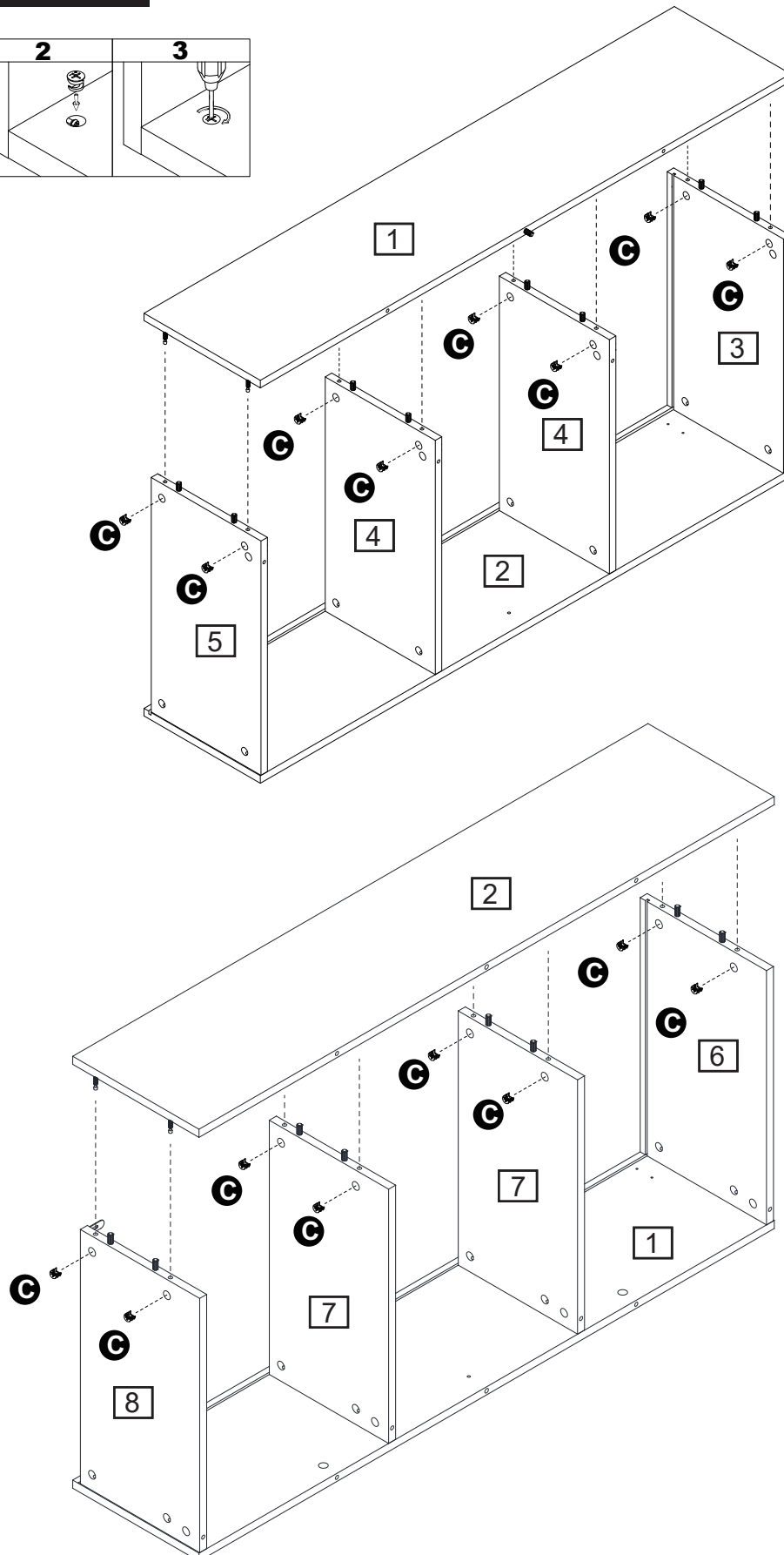
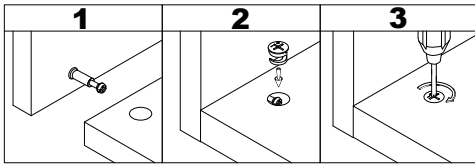

Attach part (3, 4, 5) to part (2), then insert and secure cam lock (C) to part (3, 4, 5) to lock them. Attach part (6, 7, 8) to part (1), then insert and secure cam lock (C) to part (6, 7, 8) to lock them.

Note: Hooks of Part(E) (F) stick out 2 cm(3/4")

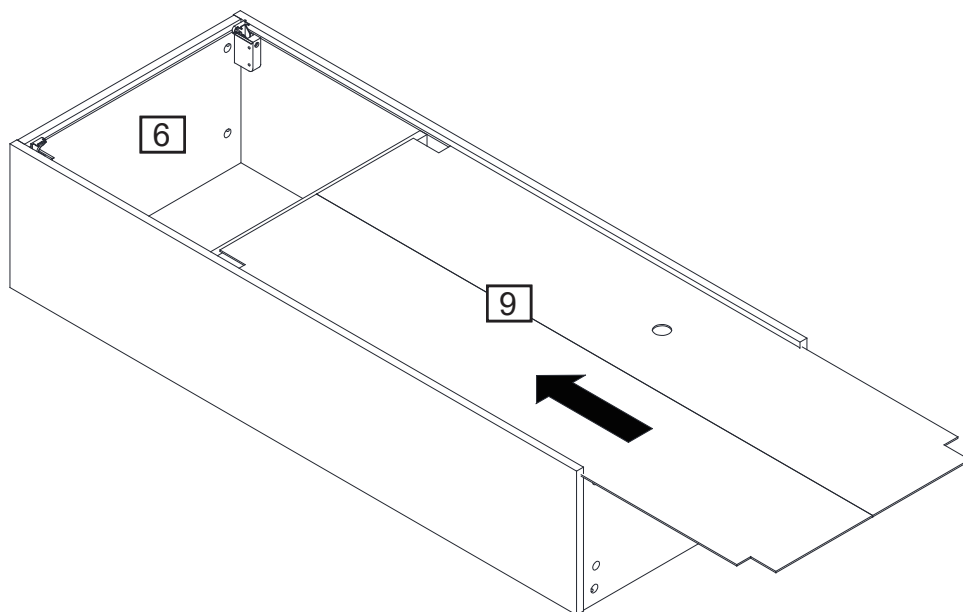
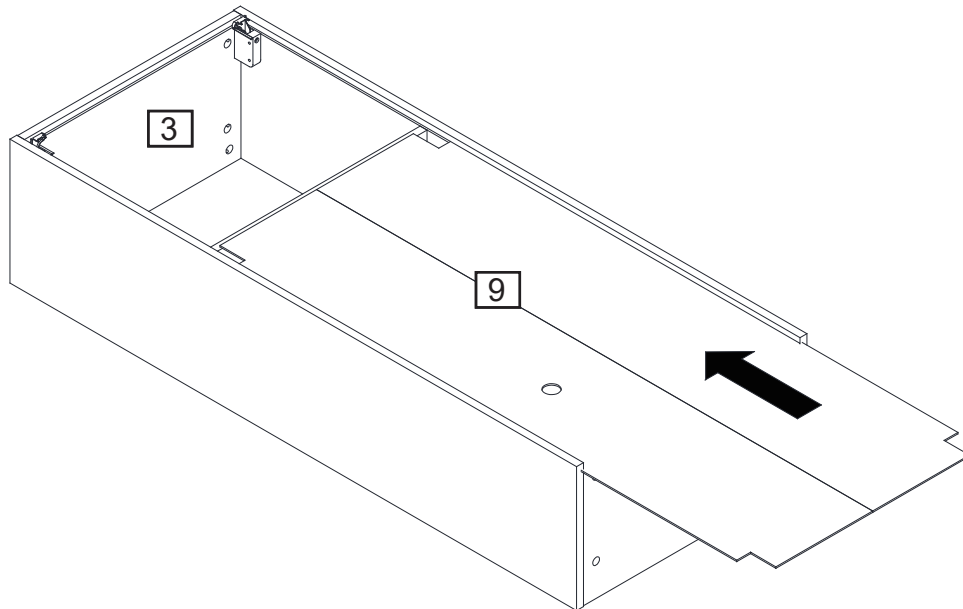


Locate part (3), and then use screw (D) to attach wall mounting bracket (E) to part (1), and wall mounting bracket (F) to part (2).

Secure back panels (9) to part (5, 8) using screw (N) with a screwdriver.**

Note: You may screw the glass shelf clamps to tightern them.

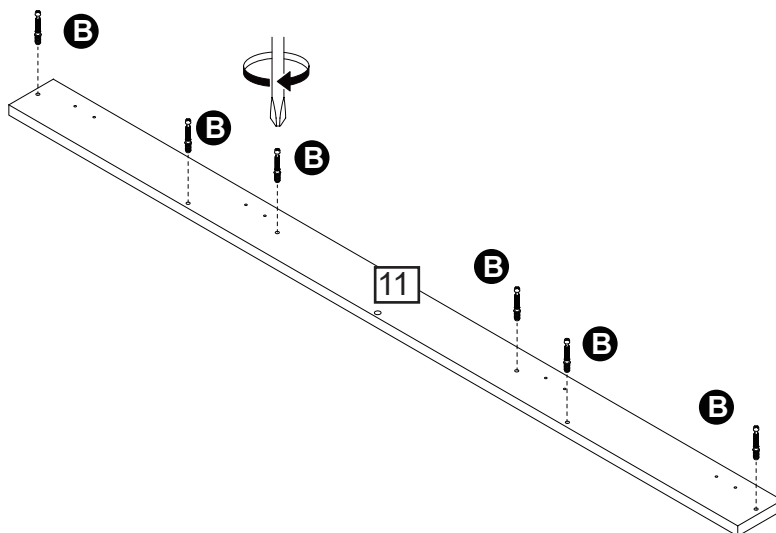
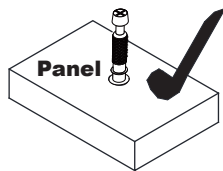
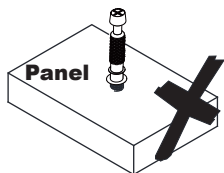
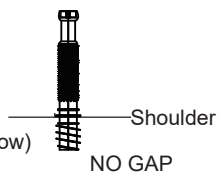
Get the power cables of the LED lights through the cable holes.

Use screws (I) to secure hinges (J) to doors (12), and then secure hinges (J) to part (11) with a screwdriver.

Attach part (11) to part (1, 3, 4, 5), then insert and secure cam lock (C) to part (1, 3, 4, 5) to lock them.

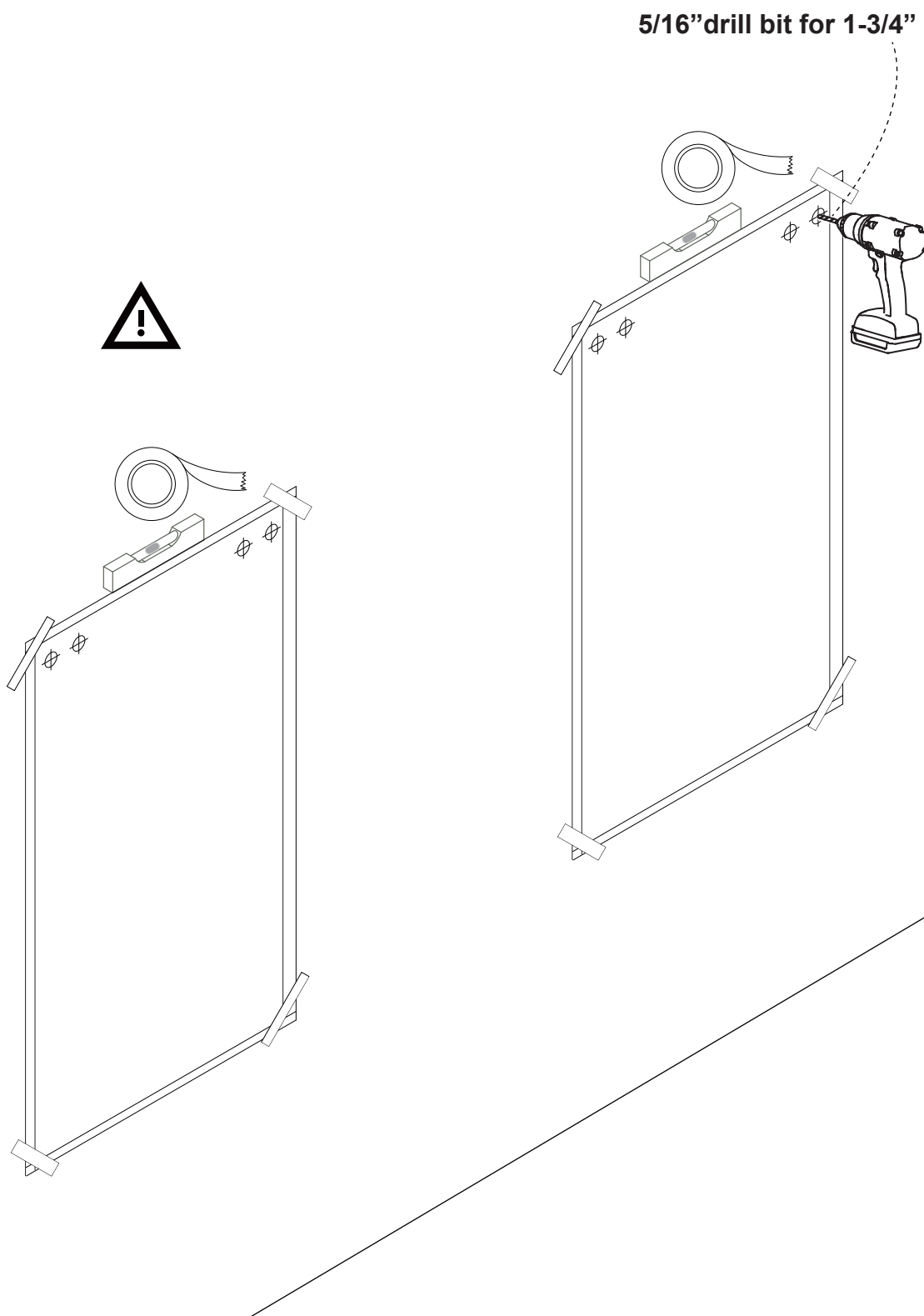
Attach part (11) to part (2, 6, 7, 8), then insert and secure cam lock (C) to part (2, 6, 7, 8) to lock them.

Attach door bumpers (K) to part(1, 2).

You may refer to page 4 about how to adjust hinge.

Step 15



Tape the cardboards to the wall where the storage cabinets will be mounted
Drill the hole on the target mark on the cardboards.

Note1: Use a level to make sure the cardboards are level.

Note2: Always ensure the wall to be drilled is free from hidden electrical wires, water and gas pipes.

Serious or fatal crushing injuries can occur from furniture falling down. The furniture must be used with the wall attachment device

Secure the wall attach brackets to the wall using screws (O).

A Guide to Wall Mounting & Fixings

Important note:

If plastic wall plugs (rawl plugs) are supplied with your product, e.g.:



- these are only suitable for use in masonry walls.

If you are in any doubt about the correct wall plugs for your wall, seek professional advice.

Failure of the product due to using the incorrect fixings is the responsibility of the installer.



Important: when drilling into walls always check that there are no hidden wires or pipes etc.

Make sure that the screws and wall plugs being used are suitable for **supporting your unit**. **Consult a qualified tradesperson if you are unsure.**

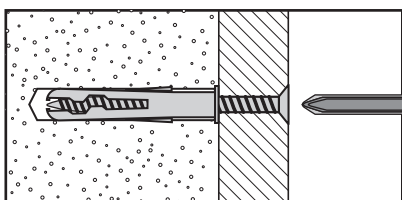
Hints:

- 1: General rule:  always use a larger screw and wall plug if you are not sure.
- 2: Ensure you use the recommended drill bit to match the wall plug and hole size.
- 3: Ensure you drill the hole horizontally; do not force the drill or enlarge the hole.
- 4: Take extra care when drilling high walls, ceilings and ceramic tiles. Ensure wall plugs are inserted beyond the thickness of the ceramic tiles to avoid the tiles splitting or cracking.
- 5: Ensure wall plugs are well fitted and are a tight fit in the drilled hole.

Types of walls

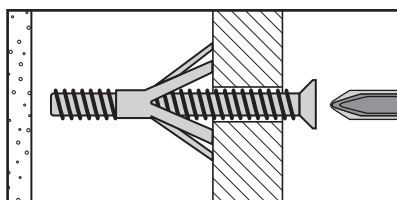
You can use one of the following types of wall plug if your walls are made of brick, breeze block, concrete, stone or wood.

No.1 "General Purpose" wall plug



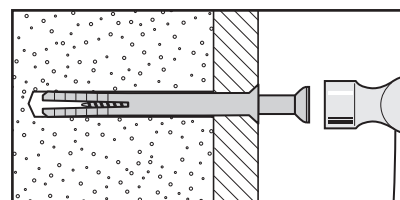
Generally aerated blocks should not be used to support heavy loads, use a specialist fitting in this case. For light loads, general purpose wall plugs can be used.

No.3 "Cavity Fixing" wall plug



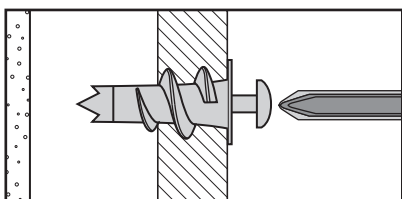
For use with plasterboard partitions or hollow wooden doors.

No.5 "Hammer Fixing" wall plug



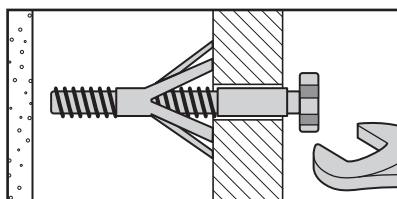
For use with walls stuck with plasterboard. The hammer fixing allows it to be fixed to the wall rather than the plasterboard. Always check the fixing is secure to the retaining wall.

No.2 "Plasterboard" wall plug



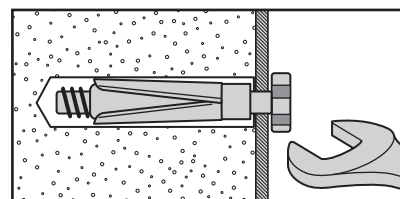
For use when attaching light loads onto plasterboard partitions.

No.4 "Cavity Fixing – Heavy Duty" wall plug



For use when fitting or supporting heavy loads such as shelving, wall cabinets and coat racks.

No.6 "Shield Anchor" wall plug – heavy loads



For use with heavier loads such as TV and HiFi speakers and satellite dishes etc.



Care & Maintenance

Safety: always check the fitting and location to ensure your safety in and around the home.

Fitting: from time to time check the fitting to ensure the wall plugs or screws do not become loose.
