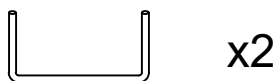
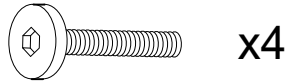
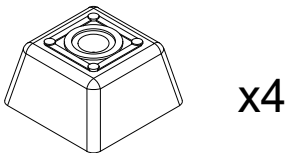
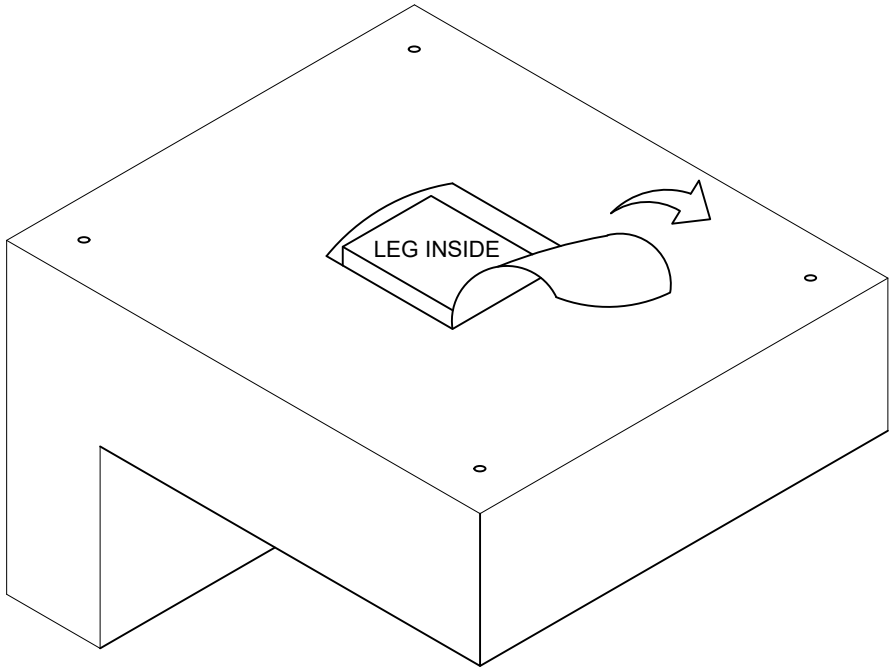
ARMLESS CHAIR
