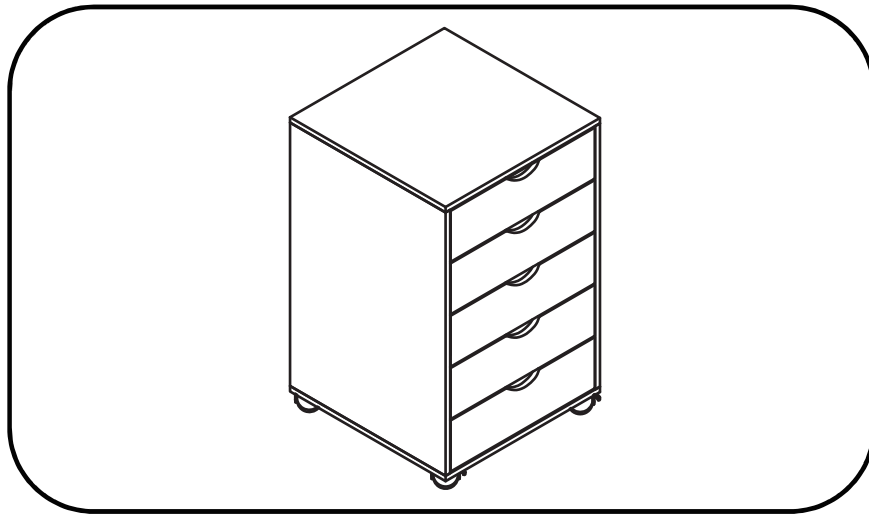


# 5 Drawers Cabinet



## Assembly Instructions

# WARNING CAUTION

## ADULT ASSEMBLY REQUIRED CHOKING HAZARD

- This product includes small parts, sharp points and sharp edges in its unassembled state. Keep unassembled parts away from children under 3 years of age, and animals.

## SAFETY WARNINGS

- Follow the information on the warnings appearing on table and on the carton. Do not remove warning label from cabinet.
- Do not allow children under 3 years of age to use the cabinet.
- Do not use substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.

## FURNITURE TIP-OVER HAZARD

### Children have died from furniture tip-over

To reduce the risk of furniture tip-over:

- ALWAYS install tip-over restraint especially if used by a wall or in the open.
- NEVER put a TV on this product
- NEVER allow children to stand, climb or hang on drawers, doors, or shelves.
- NEVER open more than one drawer at a time.
- ALWAYS place heaviest items in lowest drawers.



## PARENTAL SUPERVISION IS REQUIRED

- Parents or Guardians should supervise use under the intended age specifically regarding children that may have access to it and climb on the unit.
- Do not allow horseplay on, under, or behind the unit and prohibit jumping on the cabinet.
- If used improperly, your table may be pulled over or fall, creating risk of injury or damage. Children should not be permitted to climb or pull on the cabinet.

## USE, MAINTENANCE & ASSEMBLY

- Periodically check and ensure that the components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.
- Use on level surfaces only. Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damage to unit or floor.
- Do not use this item if any components are missing or damaged.
- Do not use substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.
- Only clean using damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- Check you have all components and tools listed on page 4
- Do not stand or put weight on this product during assembly, this could cause damage.
- Remove all hardware from the plastic bags and separate them into groups.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Certain assembly steps may be easier with 2 people.
- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.
- We do not recommend power screwdrivers. Only use hand screwdrivers to prevent damage to unit.
- Keep these instructions for future reference.

- TOUJOURS placer les choses les plus lourdes dans les tiroirs du bas.

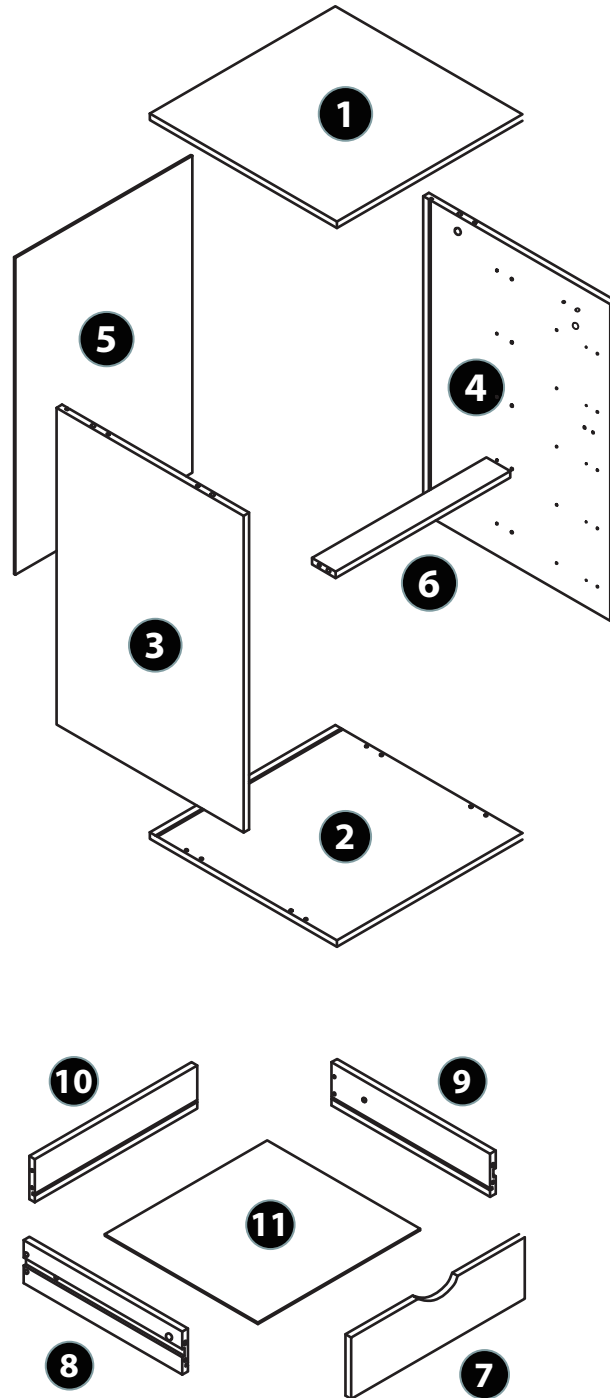
### Han muerto niños por el vuelco de muebles.

# ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

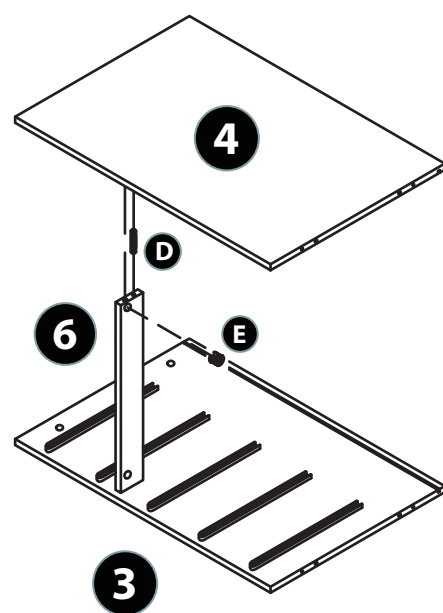
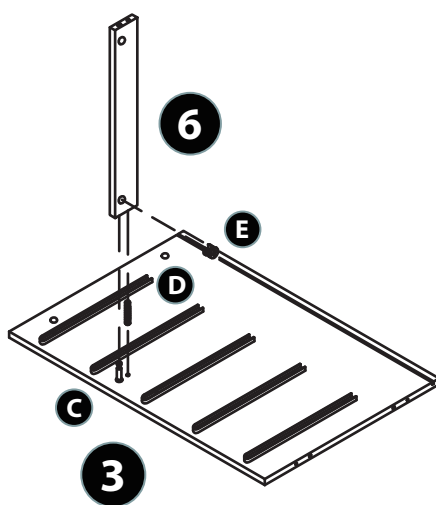

Select A×20, B×10 and 3×1, 4×1. Position 3 in the left, position 4 in the right. Insert A×5 into the one side of the B, and other A×5 into the other side of the B. Insert B×5 into the 3. Repeat the steps for the 4.

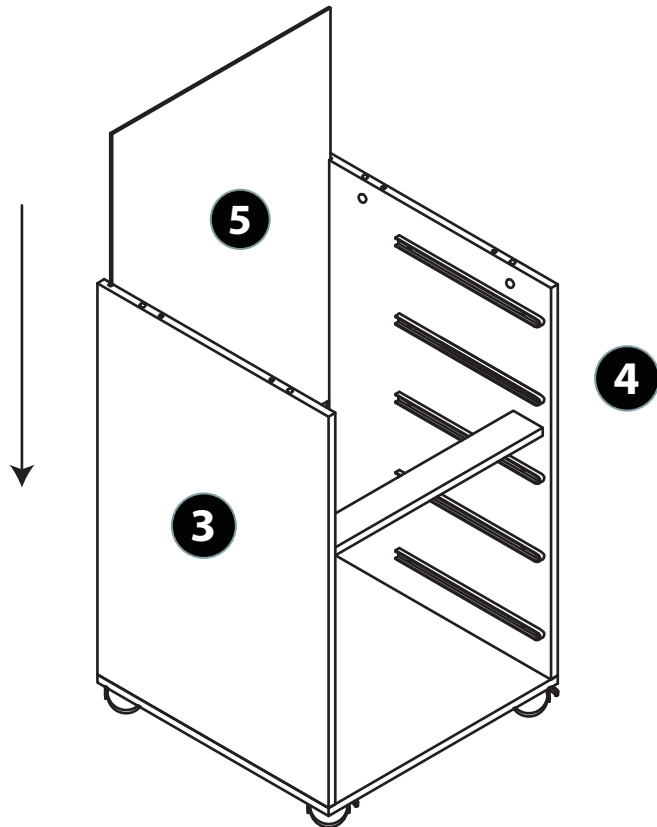
Insert C and D into the hole of the 3 into the 6. Insert E into one side of 6 into 3. Repeat D and E for the 6 and 4.



# ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

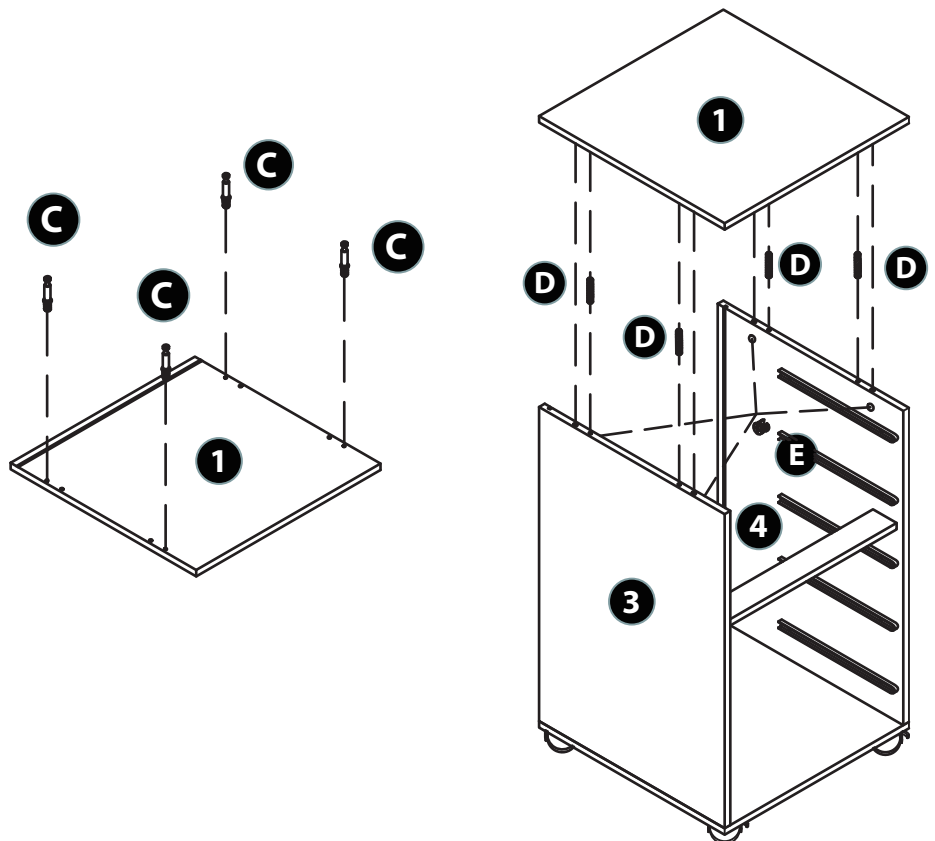

Stand up the 3 and the 4, put the wheels down to the bottom. Install the 5 along the grooves on both sides of the 3 and the 4.

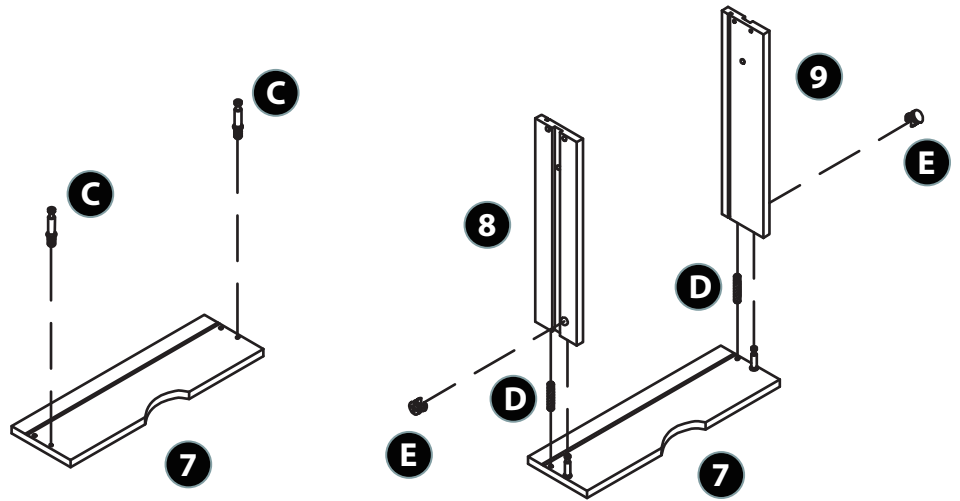
Select C×4, D×4, E×4. Insert C×4, D×4 into the 1 into the 3 and the 4 tightly. Insert E×2 into the top corners of the 3. Repeat the steps for the other E into the 4.



# ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

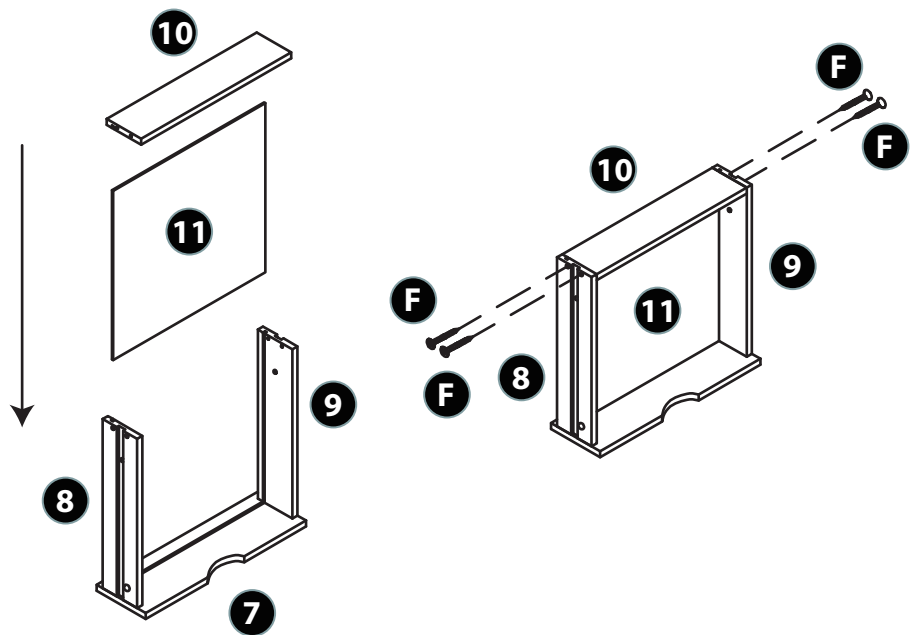

Insert Cx2, Dx2 into the 7 and the 8. Repeat the same steps for the 7 and the 9. Insert the E into the end of the 8. Repeat for the 9.

Select Fx 4. Install the 11 along the grooves on the both sides of the 8 and the 9. Install the 10 on the 8,9 and the 11. Insert the Fx2 into the 8 into the 10 to consolidation.



# ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Select 1x10, 8x5, 9x5. Insert 1 x2 into the two sides of the 8 and the 9. Repeat for other 8 and 9. The Drawer x5 are completed. Install the Drawers into the Drawer Table.
