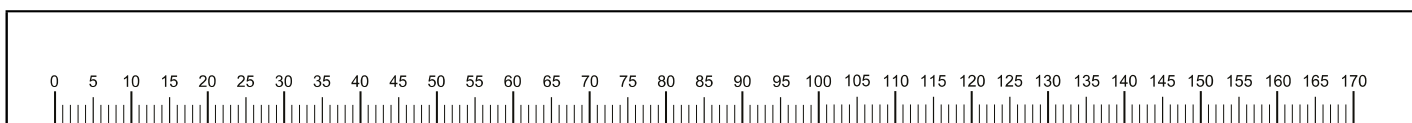

# Assembly Instructions

## Stage 1- Fitting the Unit

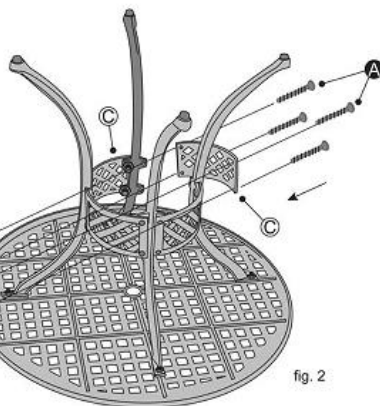
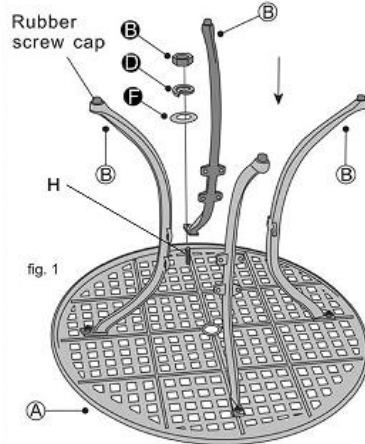
**NOTE:** It would be useful to ask someone to help you at this stage.

1. Fix the screw(H) on the table top.
2. Locate the Legs (B) onto the screw fitting on the base of Table Top (A).  
**See fig. 1.**

3. Use Nuts (B), Spring Washers (D) and Washers (F) to fix the Legs (B) onto the Table Top (A).  
**See fig. 1.**

4. Use Screws (A), Nuts (B), Spring Washers (D) and Washers (F) to fix Leg Supports (C) onto the Legs.  
**See fig. 2.**

5. The rubber screw caps at the bottom of the four legs can be adjusted, if necessary, to make the legs level with the ground.



## Stage 2 - Finishing the Unit

1. Carefully turn the unit upright. Then place the unit in the desired location.  
**See fig. 3.**

### Fitting

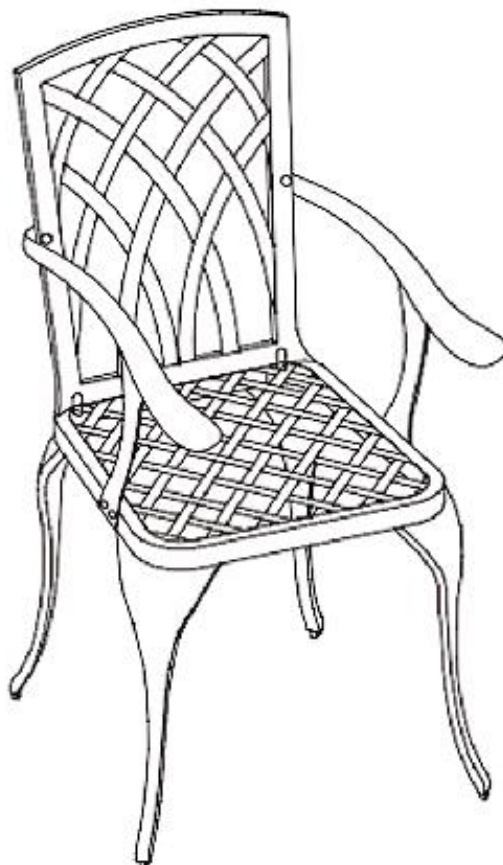
From time to time please ensure there are no loose screws on the product.

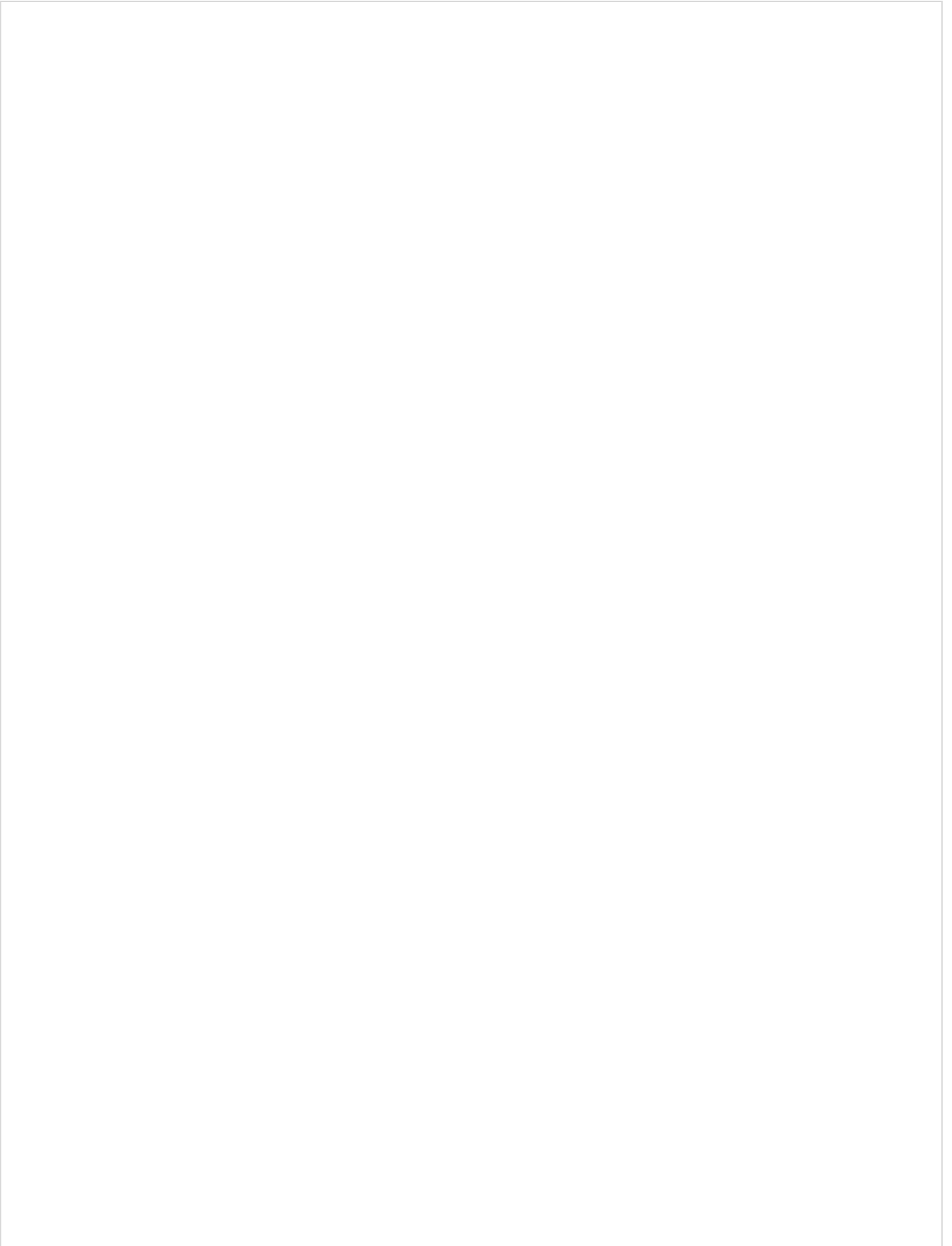

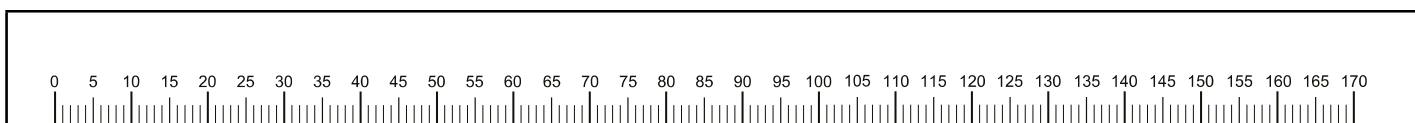

# Assembly Instructions

## 1

**Step 1:**  
Attach the front and back Legs ( C ) to the chair seat (B) using studs (N), washers and nuts (J,K,L). Do not tighten the nuts.

**Step2:**  
Attach the backrest (A) to the chair seat (B) using studs (N), washers and nuts (J,K,L). Do not over tighten.

**Step3:**  
Attach the right and left arm(D, E) using the bolts (F) and washers and nuts (G,H,I). Do not over tighten .

**Step4:**  
Attach the right and left arm(D, E) using the bolts (F) and washers ,nuts (G,H,I) . Do not over tighten.

**Step5:**  
Upon completion of full assembly and bolted up--all screws can be tightened down. Add the protect hats(M)
