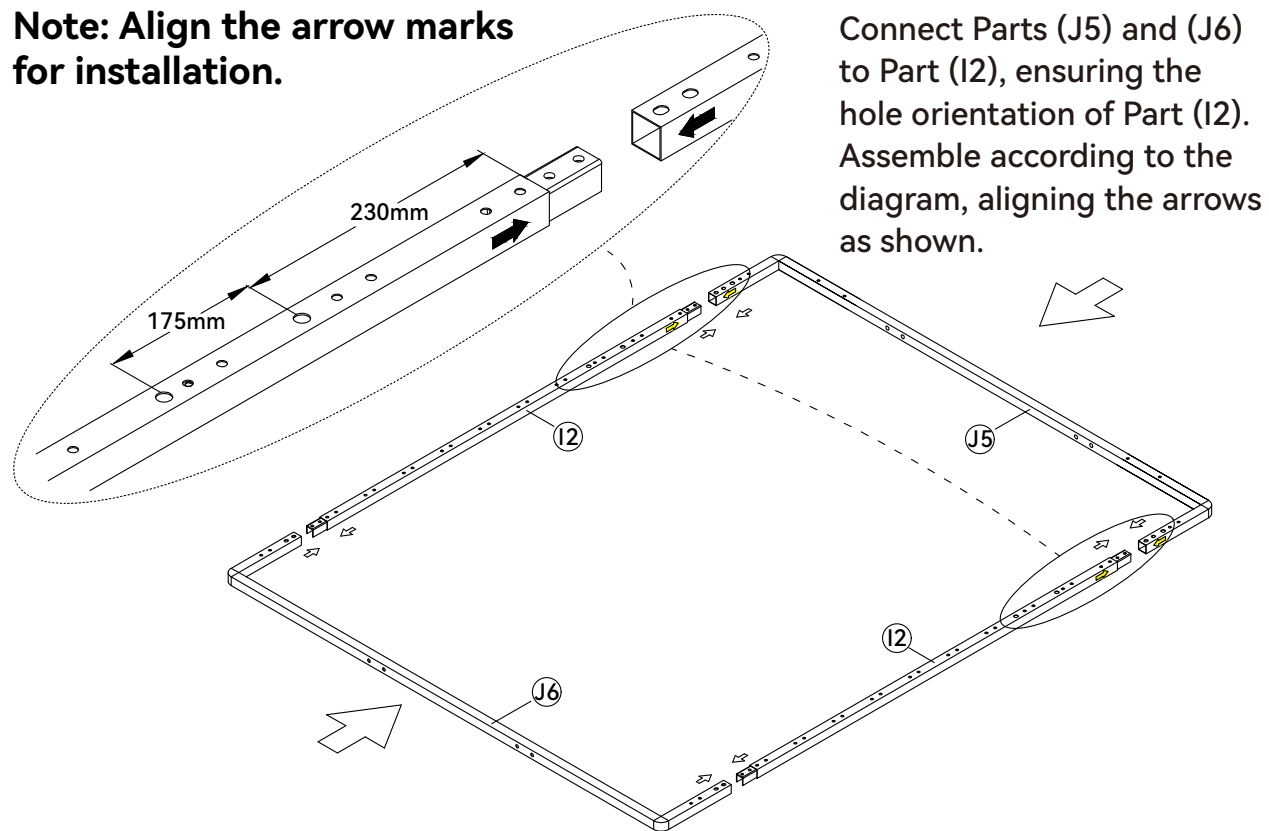


Connect Parts (O3) and (O4), and

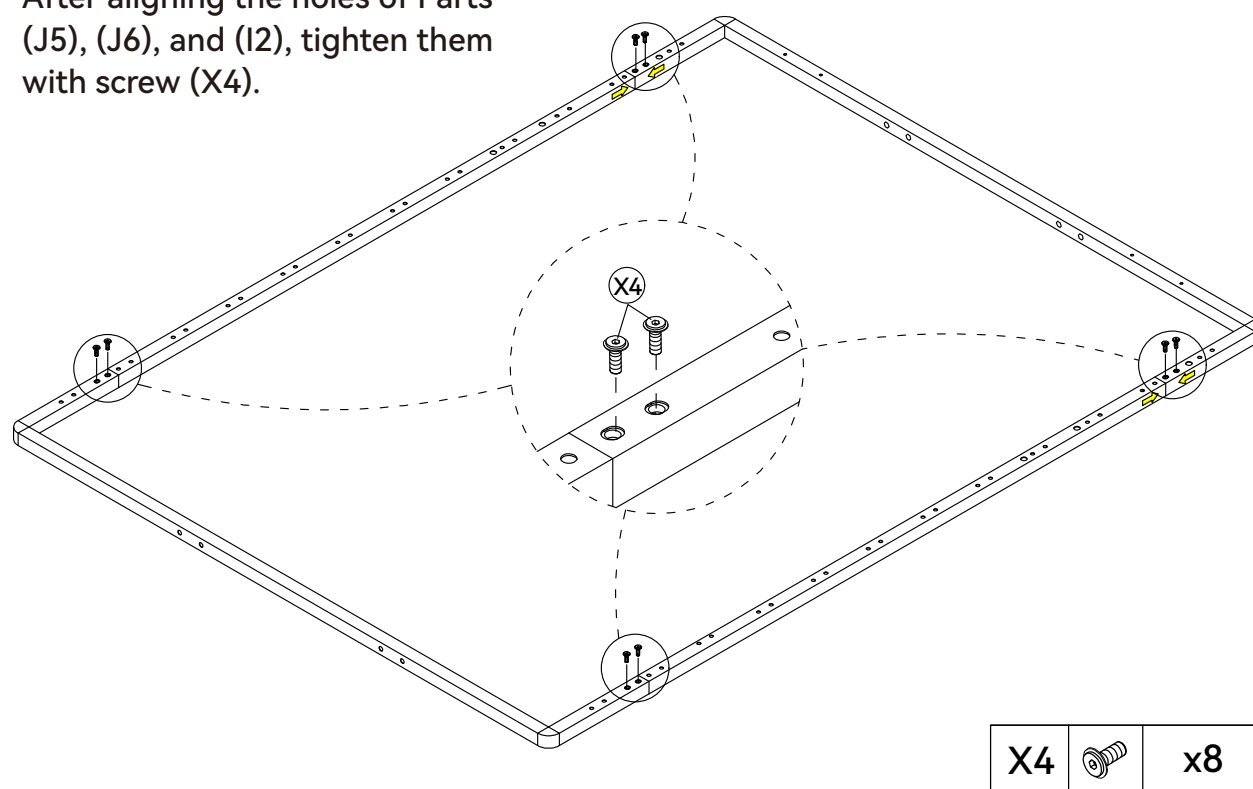

Note: Align the arrow marks for installation.



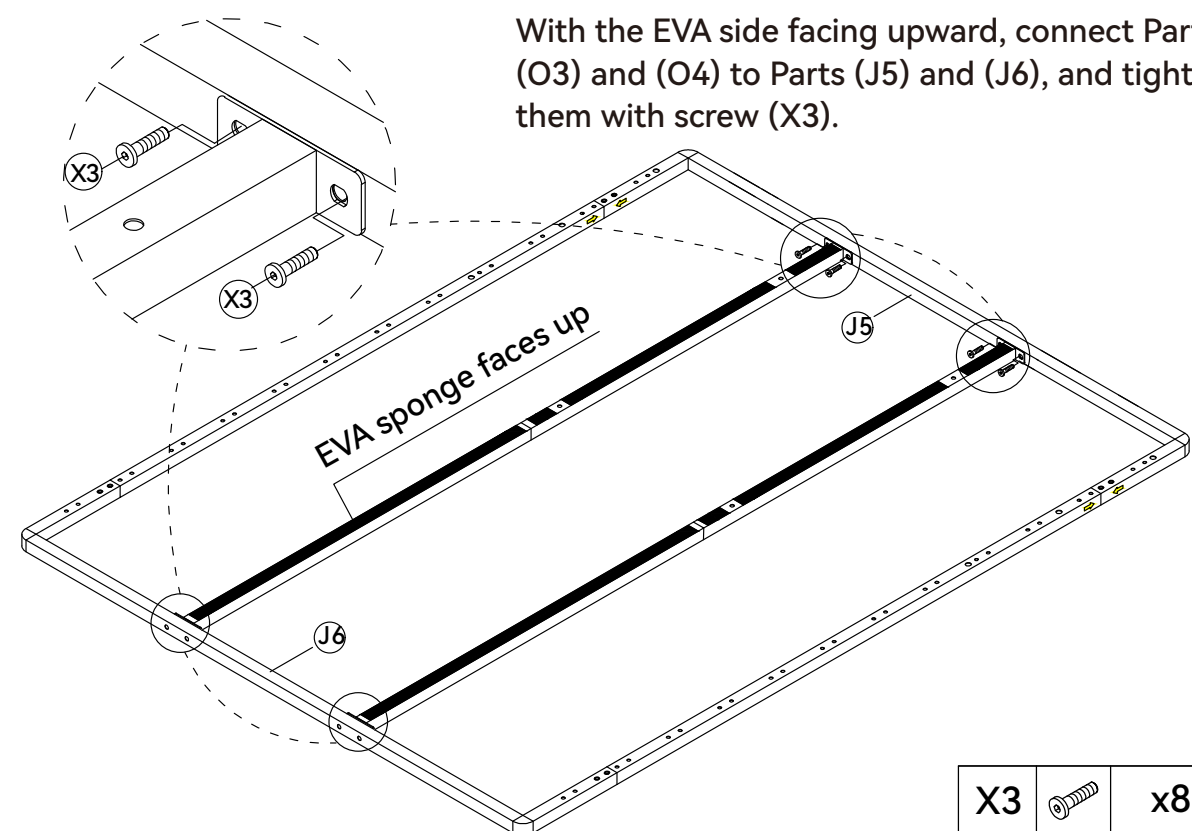

After aligning the holes of Parts (J5), (J6), and (I2), tighten them with screw (X4).



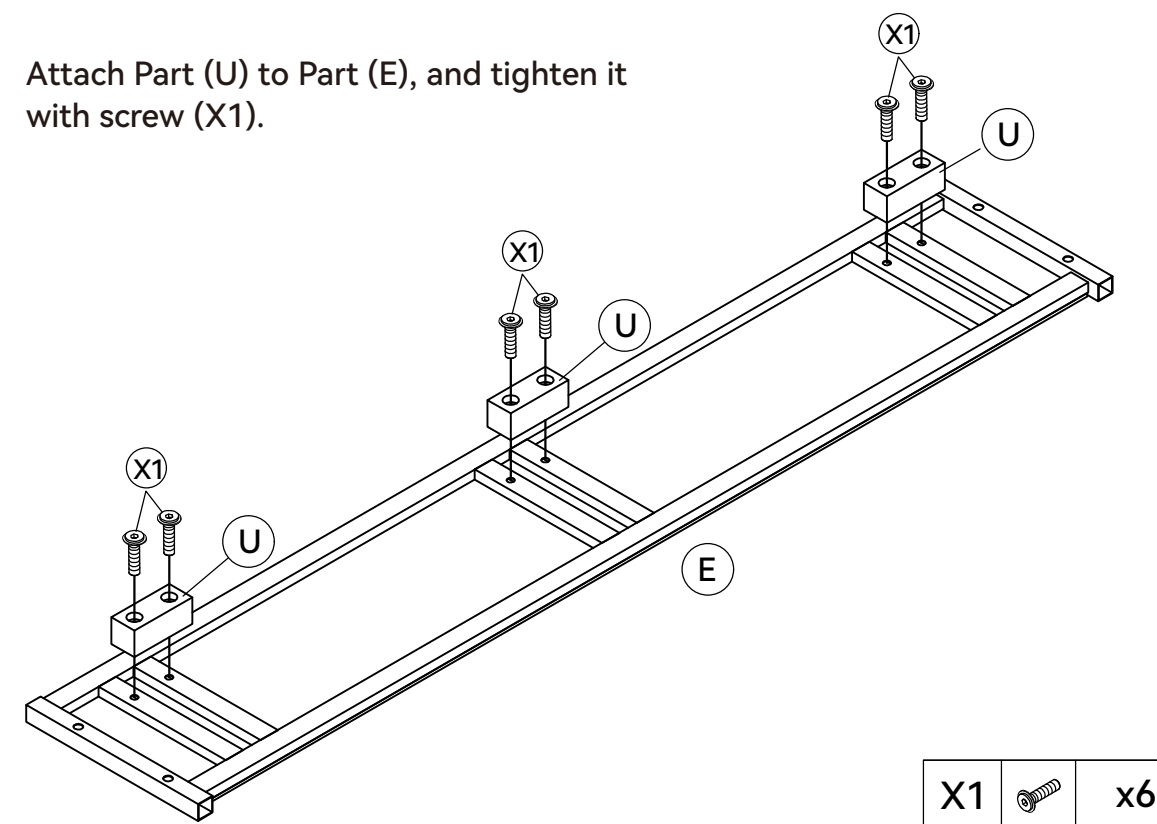

With the EVA side facing upward, connect Parts (O3) and (O4) to Parts (J5) and (J6), and tighten them with screw (X3).

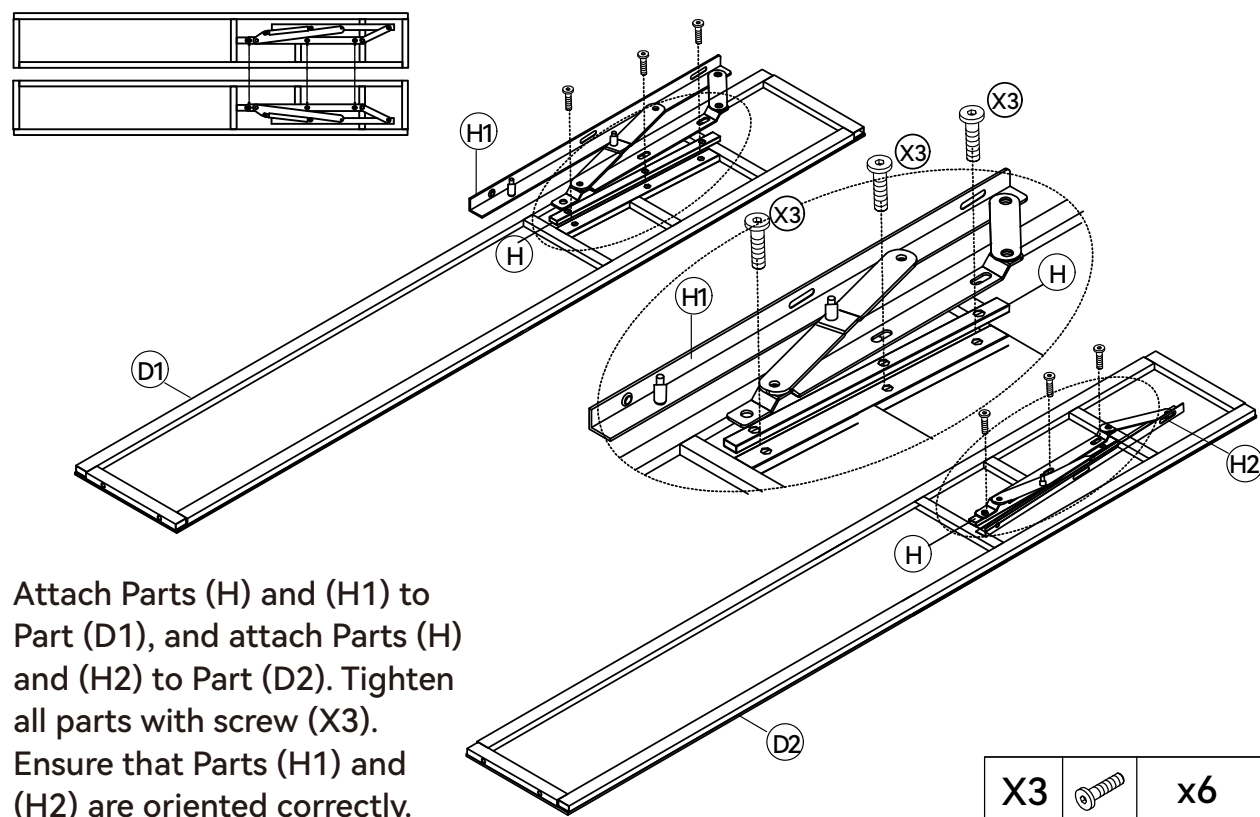

Attach Part (U) to Part (E), and tighten it with screw (X1).

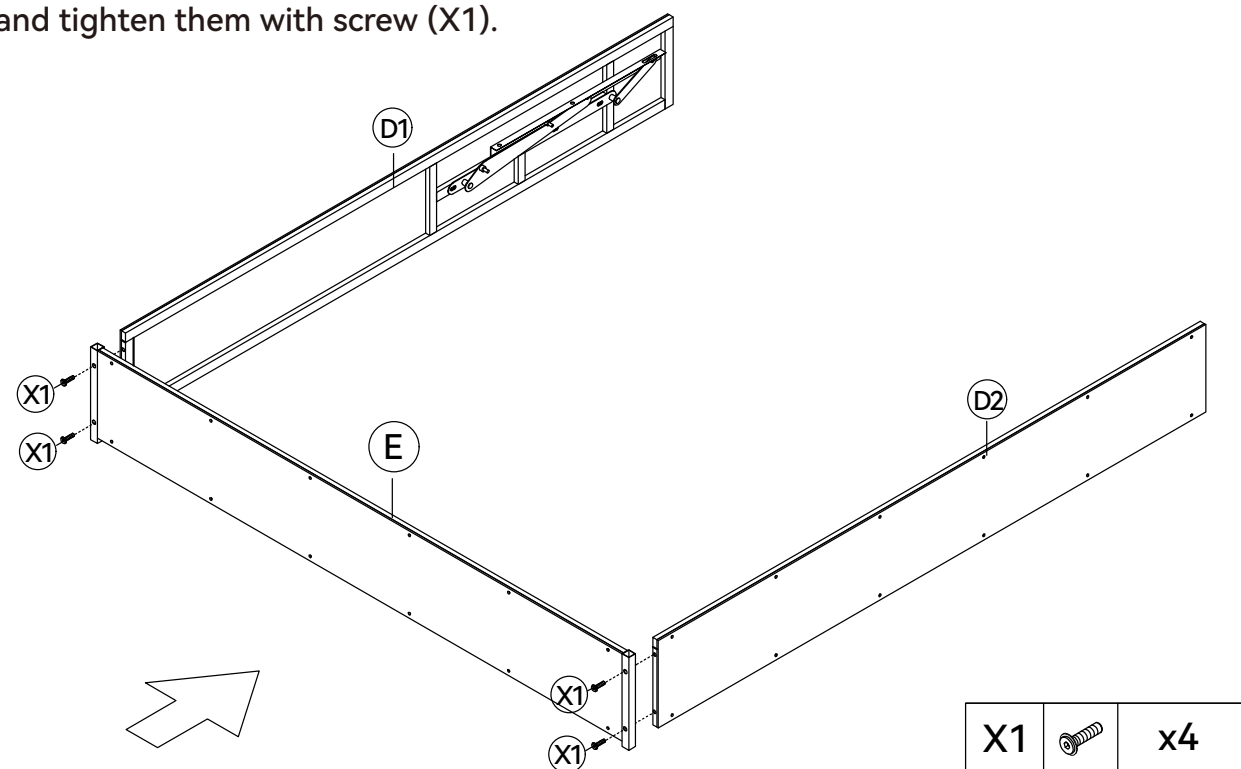

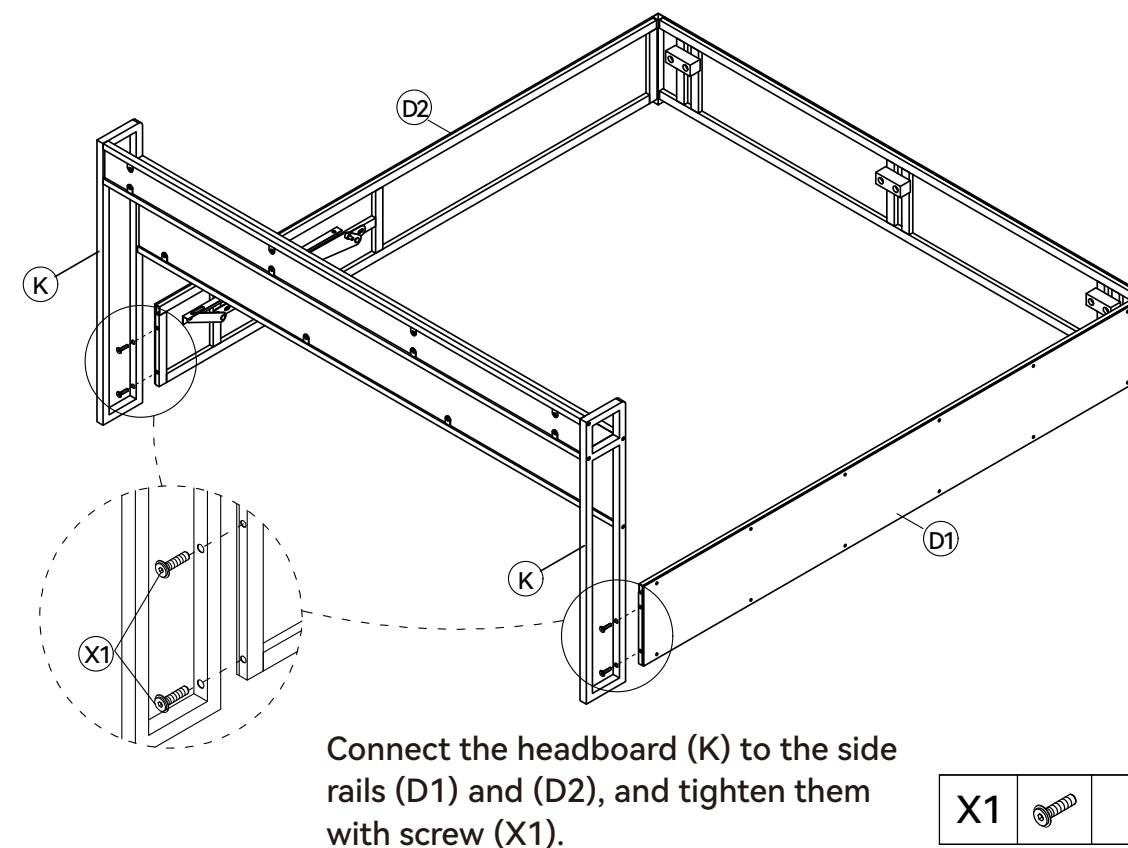

Connect Parts (D1) and (D2) to Part (E), and tighten them with screw (X1).

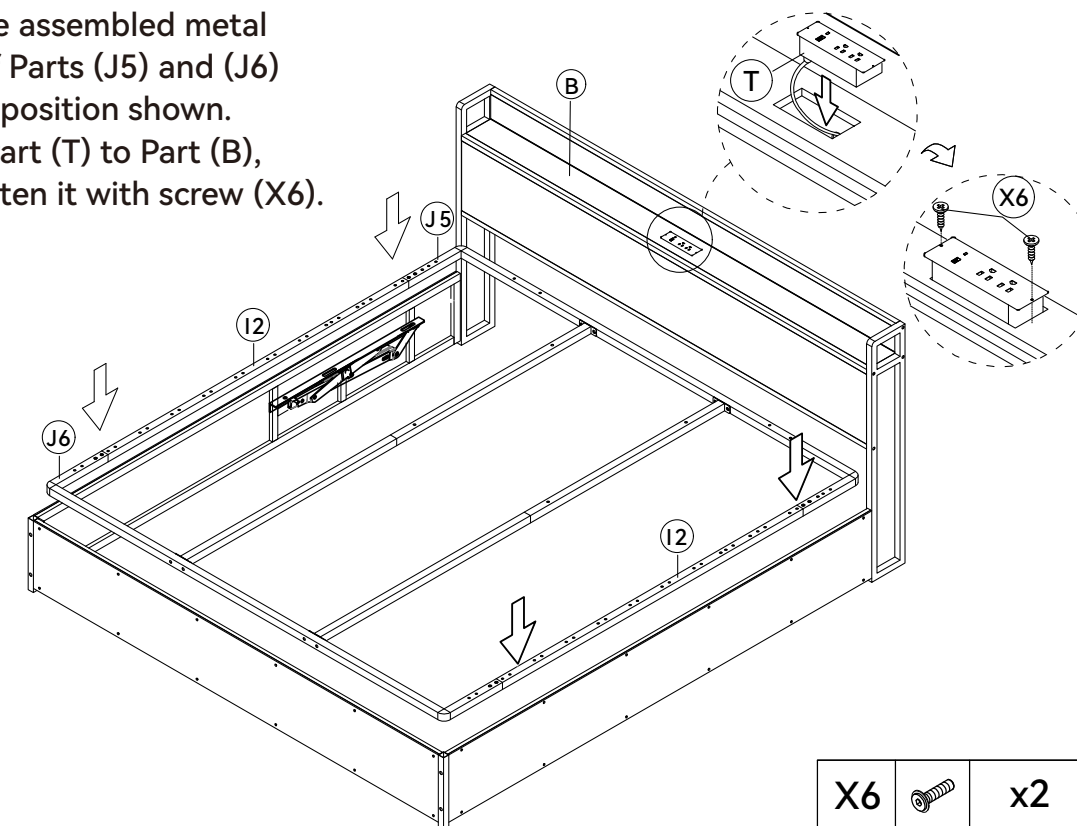

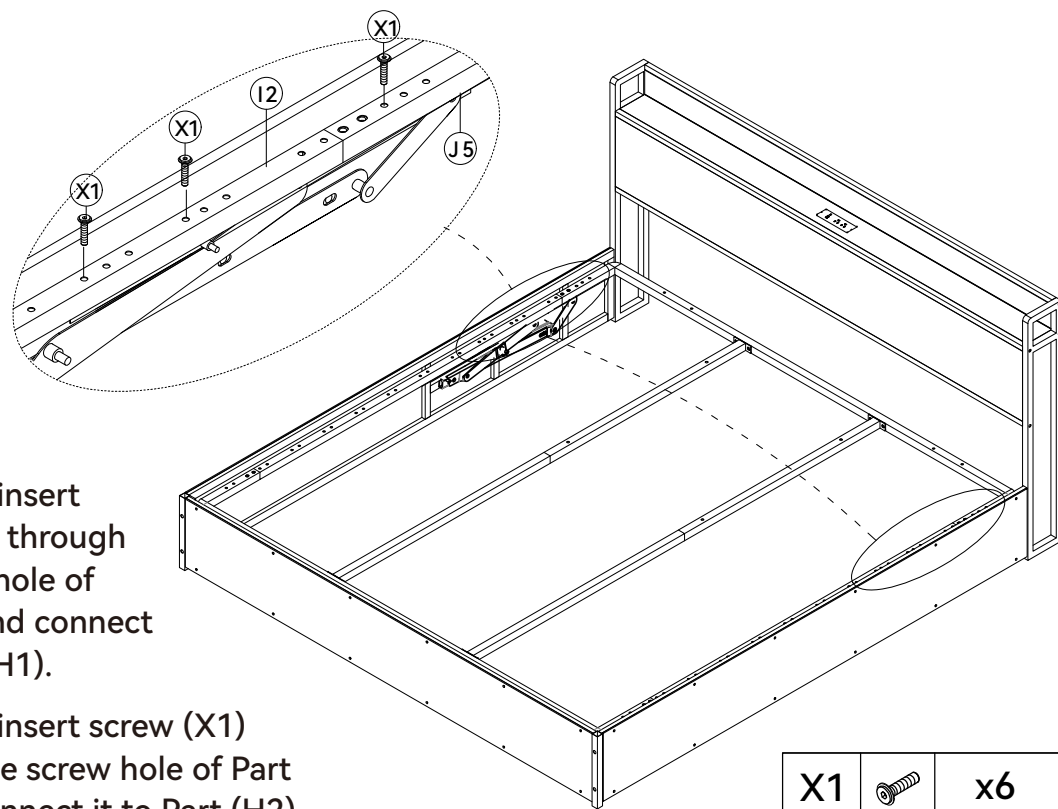

- Attach Part (T) to Part (B), and tighten it with screw (X6).



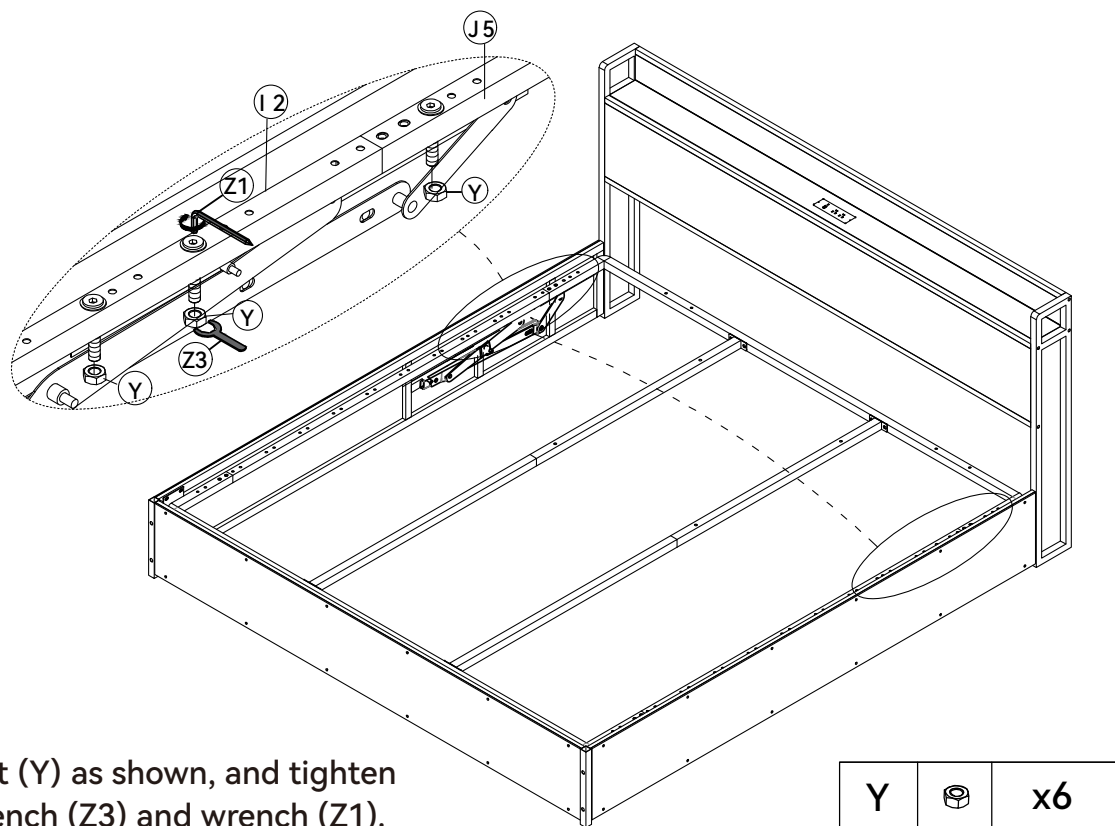

1. As shown, insert screw (X1) through the screw hole of Part (I2) and connect it to Part (H1).
2. As shown, insert screw (X1) through the screw hole of Part (I2) and connect it to Part (H2).



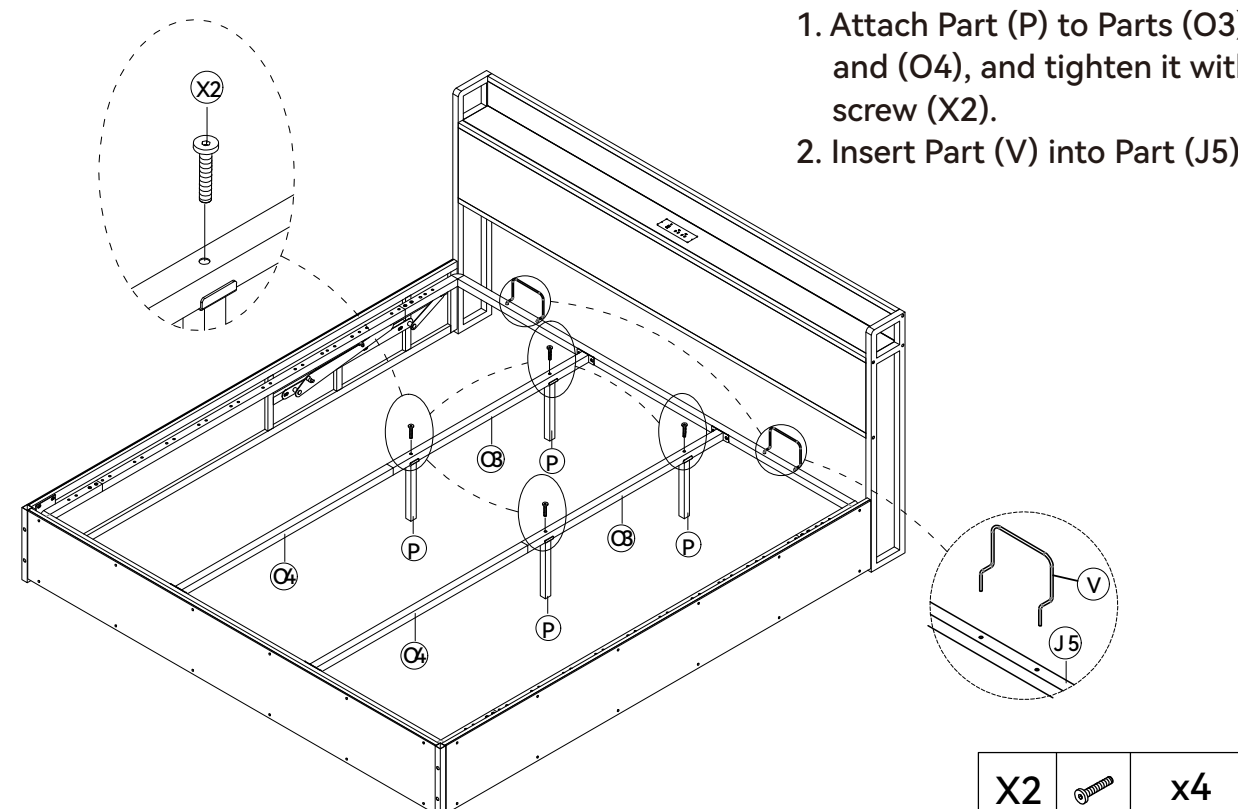

Install nut (Y) as shown, and tighten using wrench (Z3) and wrench (Z1).



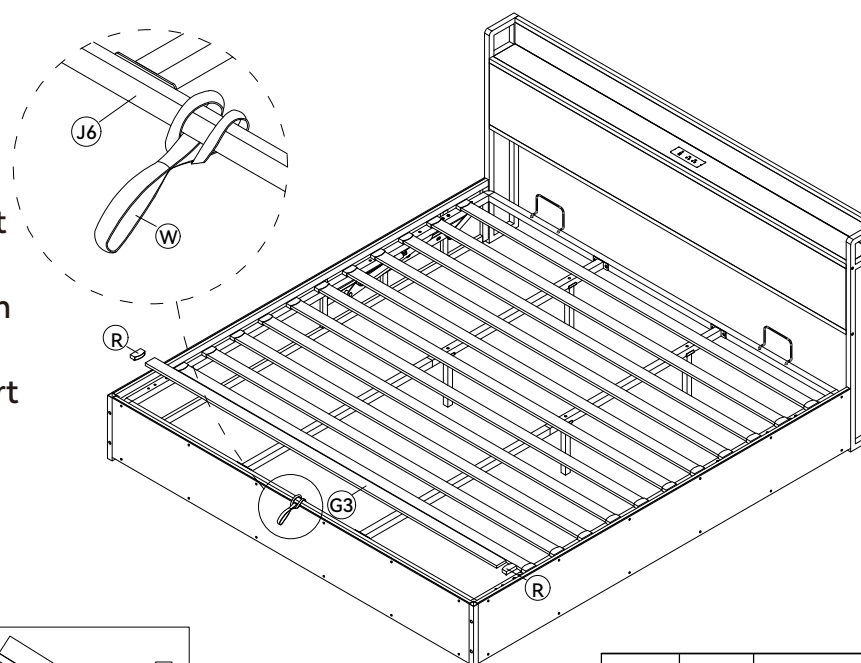
Step 17

1. Attach Part (P) to Parts (O3) and (O4), and tighten it with screw (X2).
2. Insert Part (V) into Part (J5).

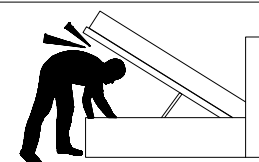
1. Connect Part (R) to Part (G3), and place the assembly in the position shown for installation.
2. Install Part (W) onto Part (J2) as illustrated.

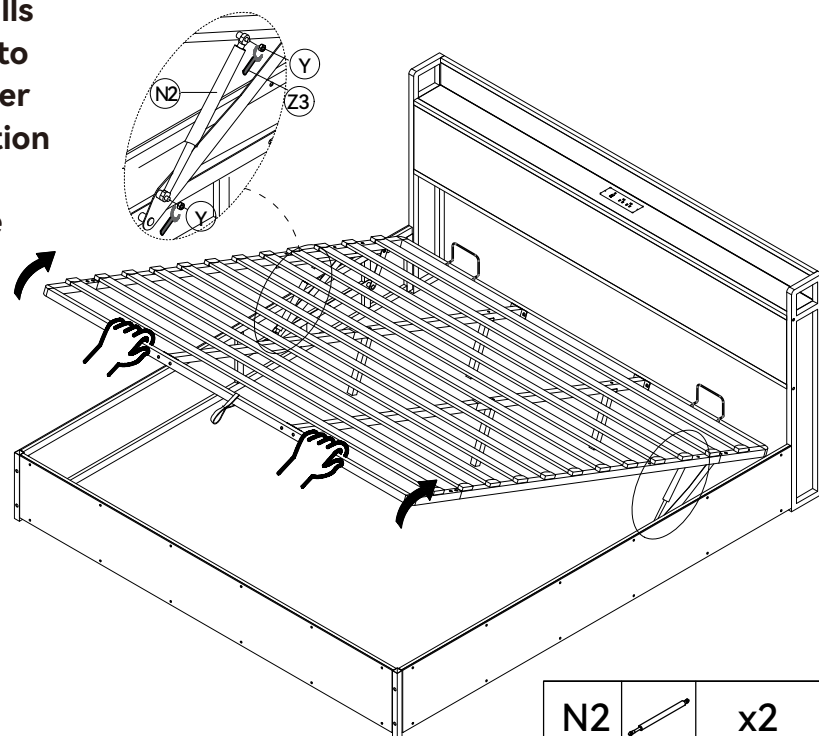

Tips: If only one person installs the Hydraulic rod, one hand to hold the I2 up and the another put the N2 on the right position as shown in the figure. After installing the N2, tighten the screws.

Two people are required. Lift the assembly to the indicated position, install Part (N2), and tighten nut (Y) using wrench (Z3).

Lock all the screws.

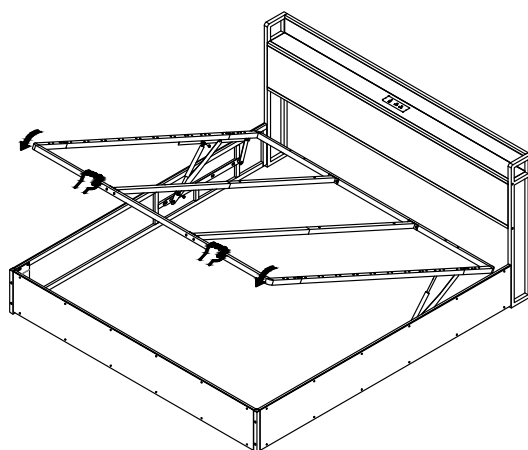

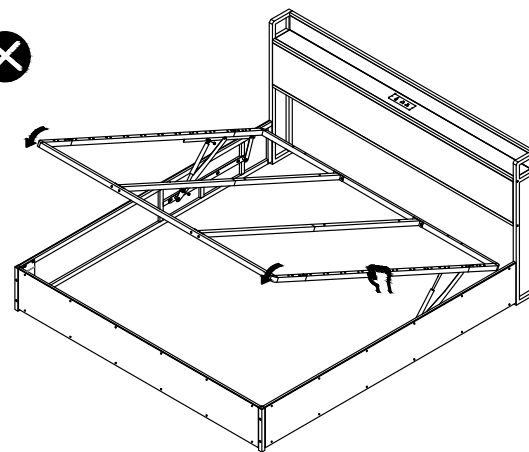

Note:

1. It requires extra force to push down when there is no mattress placed on it.
2. The hydraulic struts only function when mounted on the bed frame and cannot be actuated independently.



Operate from the foot of the bed



To avoid deformation of the metal frame, do not operate from the sides of the bed.
