Leaning Ladder Over-the-Toilet Storage Shelf

3-Tier Wood Bathroom Ladder Shelf — Espresso Finish
Assembly & Installation Guide

What's in the Box

- 2 side rails (ladder legs)
- 3 shelf boards — small (top), medium (middle), large (bottom)
- 2 connecting support rails
- 5 cam bolts (4 used to assemble the shelf, plus 1 spare)
- 1 Allen key (hex wrench) — the only tool you'll need



Lay all parts on a soft, flat surface (a blanket or cardboard works well) before you begin, and check the pieces above against your box before starting assembly.

Before You Begin

- Assembly takes about 15–20 minutes and is easiest with two people.
- Only the included Allen key is required — no drill or screwdriver needed.
- Tighten every bolt snugly, but avoid overtightening solid wood joints.
- Natural wood grain and stain color may vary slightly from the photos.

Assembly Steps

1

Position the connecting rails on the first side rail

Lay the first side rail flat on the floor. Fit the peg end of each of the two connecting rails into its matching hole along the rail — one near the top, one near the bottom.



2**Secure the connecting rails with cam bolts**

Insert the included Allen key into the cam bolt on the outside of the side rail and turn clockwise until each connecting rail is tightened snugly in place. This uses 2 of the 4 cam bolts (1 spare is included).

**3****Slide the shelf boards onto the rails in order**

With both connecting rails attached, slide the three notched shelf boards onto them in the correct order: narrowest at the top, largest at the bottom. Each notch should drop cleanly over the rail.

**4****Attach the second side rail to finish**

Lift the second side rail and align its holes with the free peg ends of the connecting rails, then press together. Tighten the remaining 2 cam bolts with the Allen key. Gently rock the frame to confirm every joint is tight and the unit feels sturdy.

Tip: Recheck all 4 bolts once more after the first week of use, as wood joints can settle slightly. Keep the spare bolt on hand in case one is ever needed.

**Placement & Styling**

Lean the assembled ladder shelf against the wall directly behind your toilet, resting the base flat on the floor and the top rail against the wall at a slight angle. Load the bottom shelf first to help stabilize the unit, then add towels, plants, or décor to the upper shelves.

Safety tip: For homes with children or pets, we recommend securing the top of the unit to the wall with an anti-tip strap (sold separately) for extra stability.

Care Instructions

Wipe with a dry or slightly damp soft cloth. Avoid soaking the wood or using abrasive cleaners, which can damage the stained finish. Keep the shelf away from direct, prolonged exposure to water to prevent warping.
