

Solid Wood Dining Table Installation Guide

After opening the package, please find the following parts.



Adjustable
foot pad×4



Screw gasket×12

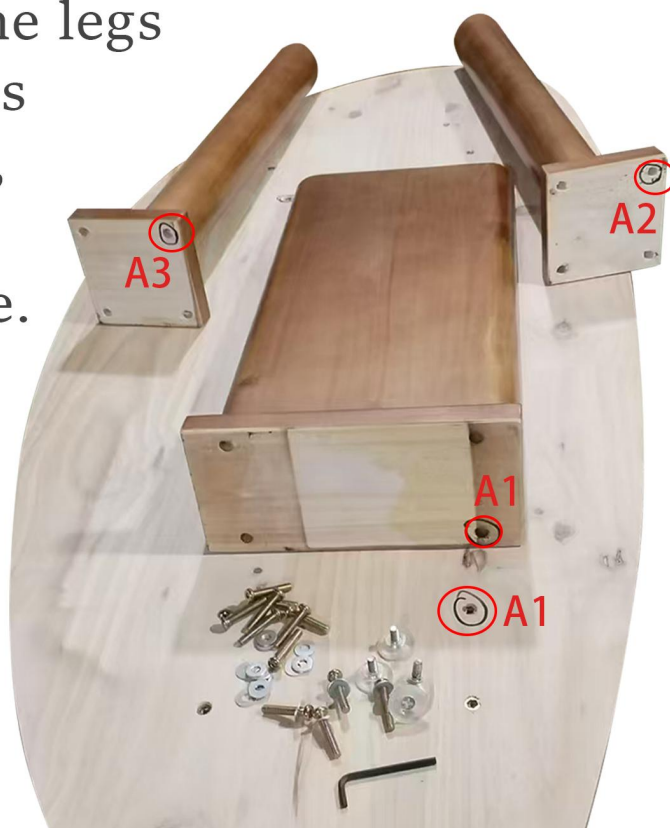


Screw×12

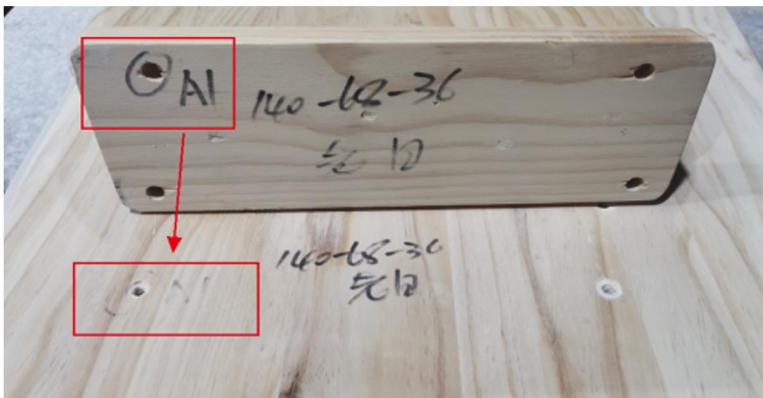


Hexagonal
wrench×1

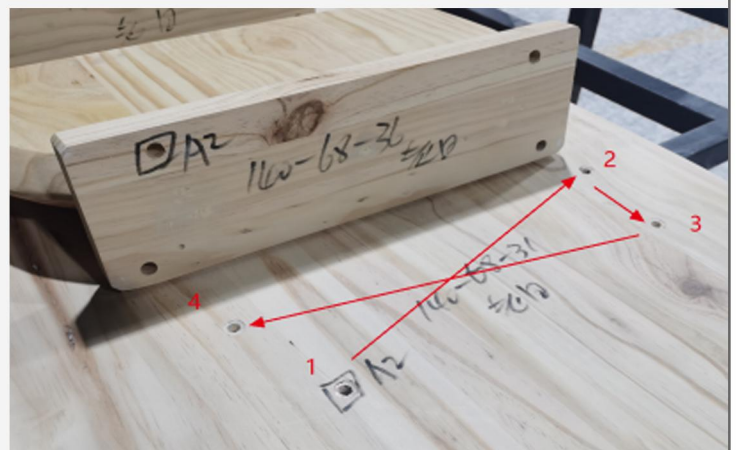
Each dining table base has 12 pre-drilled holes, with each side of the holes labeled as A1, A2, or A3. Correspondingly, the legs of the table also have holes labeled with A1, A2, or A3, which align with the hole positions on the table base. This ensures that the legs can be securely attached to the table base by



Align the pre-drilled holes on the legs, labeled with the corresponding numbers (A1, A2, or A3), with the identically numbered holes on the underside of the tabletop. Secure the legs to the table base by installing screws through these aligned holes, ensuring that A1 aligns with A1, A2 with A2, and A3 with A3. Refer to the following diagram for guidance.



Screw the screws into the reserved holes in the diagonal installation sequence.



Finally, screw the adjustable foot pads into the pre-drilled holes at the bottom of the wooden legs. Once installed, if the floor is uneven, simply adjust the foot pads to level the table and ensure its stability.
