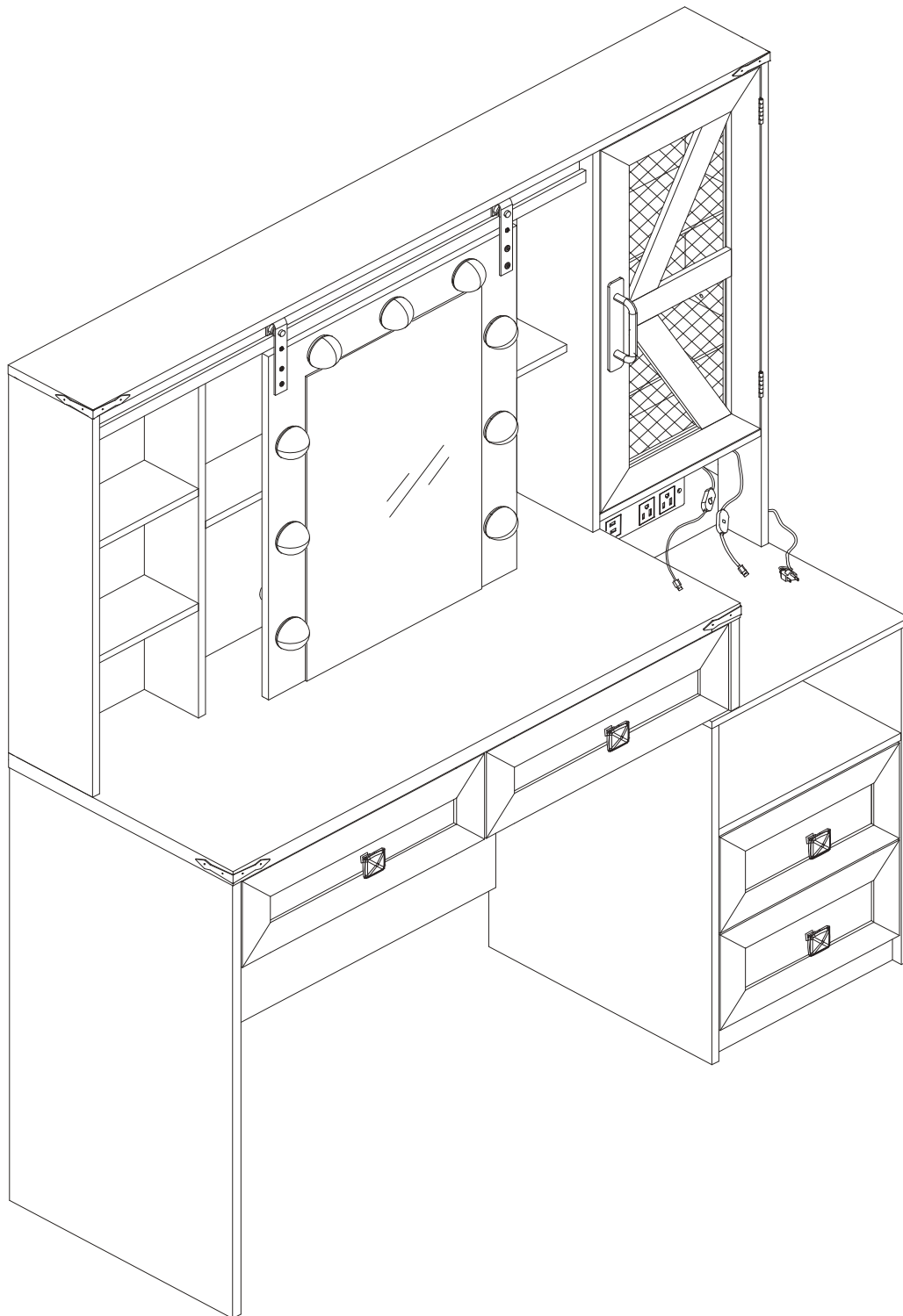


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION

I. Regarding Installation

●**Professional Installation Recommendation:** For large, modular, or wall-mounted furniture, we strongly recommend that you hire qualified professionals for installation. Self-installation may involve risks.

●**Self-Installation Liability:** If you choose to install the product yourself, it means that you confirm you have the corresponding installation capability and voluntarily assume all risks and responsibilities arising from improper installation, including personal injury and property damage. Improper installation includes, but is not limited to, damage to product components due to ignoring installation instructions during the installation process, loose, missing, or wrong installation of connectors, and obvious instability such as tilting and shaking due to improper placement after installation.

●**Follow Official Instructions:** Installation must strictly follow the steps in the Installation Manual and diagrams provided with the product. Do not rely on any installation guidance from unofficial channels. Our company shall not be responsible for any problems caused by failure to follow official instructions.

●**Safe Installation Environment:** Please carry out the installation in a spacious, bright, and well-ventilated environment and use appropriate tools. During installation, please keep children and pets away from the work area to prevent accidental ingestion of small parts or accidental injuries.

II. Regarding Usage

●**Weight Capacity Limit:** Please strictly comply with the maximum weight capacity limit indicated on the product. Overloading may cause structural damage, deformation, or overturning of the furniture, leading to serious accidents. Our company shall not be responsible for any consequences arising therefrom.

●**Wall Mounting (Mandatory Requirement):** To prevent furniture overturning accidents, especially when there are children at home, you must use the anti-tip devices provided in the product package to permanently connect and fix the furniture to a solid wall. If the fixing devices are damaged or substandard, please contact us immediately through the purchasing platform to obtain replacement parts.

Special Warning: The fixing method must fully comply with the requirements in the manual. Failure to fix as required may cause the furniture to overturn, resulting in serious injury or death. Our company shall not be responsible for any furniture overturning and all consequences caused by failure to perform wall mounting or improper fixing.

●**Regular Inspection and Maintenance:** It is recommended that you regularly (especially in the early stage of installation and after moving) inspect and tighten all connectors (screws, bolts, etc.) to ensure the structural stability of the furniture (see the maintenance method in the manual for details). Problems caused by neglect of inspection and maintenance are not covered by the warranty.

●**Proper Use and Placement:**

Place the furniture on a flat and solid floor.

Do not use the furniture for purposes other than its designed use (for example, standing on drawers or shelves, using a chair as a ladder, etc.).

Do not place heavy objects such as televisions or items that attract children on the upper part of the furniture.

Avoid placing the furniture in humid, sun-exposed, or extreme temperature environments to avoid affecting the product's service life or structural stability.

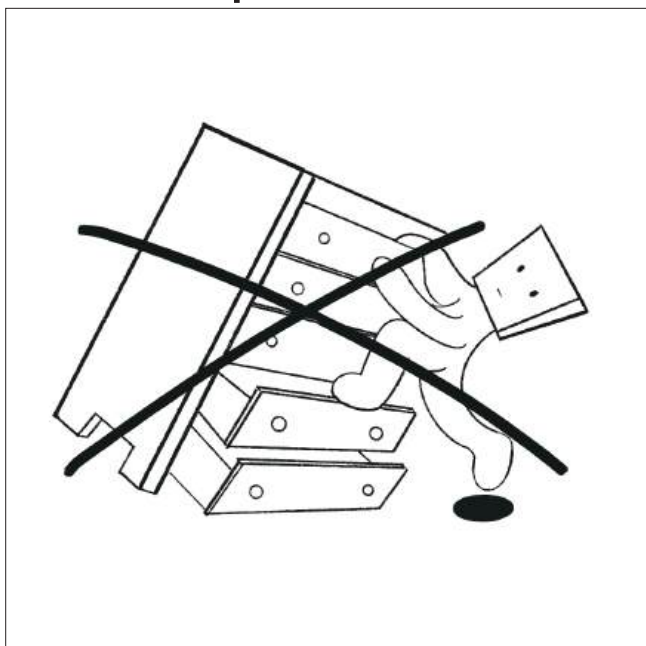


Electrical Safety Precautions

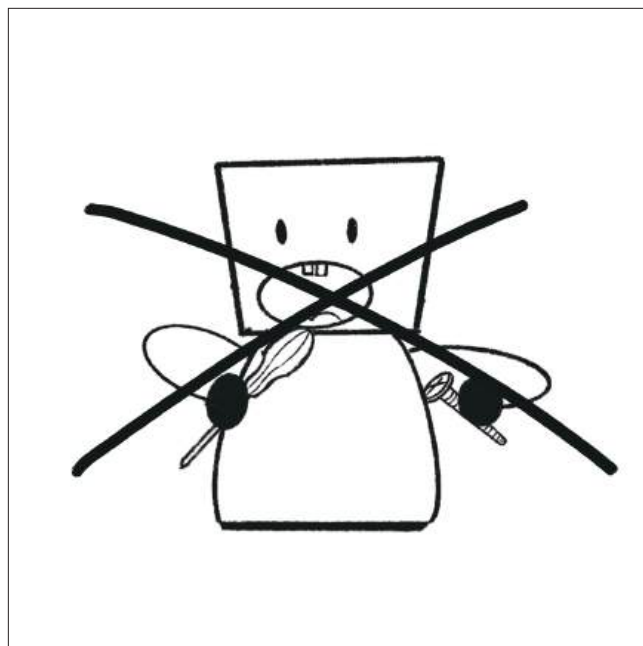
- **Do not** use damaged power plugs or loose power sockets.
- **Do not** move the product by pulling the power cord.
- **Do not** forcibly bend the power cord or place it under heavy objects.
- If the power socket is wet, carefully unplug the product's power plug.
- **Do not** touch the power plug with wet hands.
- Unplug the product's power plug before maintenance.
- For electrical products not in use for an extended period, ensure the power supply is disconnected.

Installation of Anti-Tip Device Kit:

Weight Capacity:

–**Do not** place items exceeding the maximum weight capacity of the product. (For the product's weight capacity, please refer to the product link.)

Usage Scenarios and Maintenance Methods

- **Do not** place the product in a humid environment.
- Avoid direct exposure to high temperatures and keep it away from heat sources.
- Clean and maintain the product regularly.
- Place it on a flat surface. When moving is required, ensure that at least two people lift it together.
- Check the condition of screws regularly. If any screws are loose or fall off, reinforce them promptly.

Wooden products

Preparation before Installation

–Please read the assembly instructions carefully before installation and keep this manual for future reference. Check that all components are complete, including panels, hardware fittings, screws, plastic parts and other small components.

Ensure that **only adults** perform the installation, and keep children away from the installation area.



Notes

- Avoid prolonged exposure of the furniture to direct sunlight or proximity to heating appliances to prevent local discoloration and fading.
- **Do not** allow easily combustible or oxidizable items to come into direct contact with the furniture surface, as this may cause chemical reactions and damage the furniture finish.
- Climbing or playing on the product is prohibited to avoid accidental injury. **Do not** use the product as a support or stand on it for high-altitude operations.
- **Do not** forcefully open or close the furniture doors and drawers. Use appropriate force during operation to prevent loose connections.
- When moving the furniture, remove all items inside the cabinet and secure movable parts such as doors and drawers to prevent the furniture from tilting or parts from falling and causing injury. Never drag or push hard during movement to avoid loose fasteners or broken parts. The product must be lifted off the ground by multiple people simultaneously; ensure safety during handling.
- When children use this product, adult supervision is required to ensure safe use.
- Strictly use anti-tip components as specified in the instruction manual.

- **Do not** slide hard objects directly on the furniture to avoid scratching the surface; prevent hard objects from colliding with the furniture to protect its surface from hard scratches.
- Avoid prolonged contact of panel edges with water or liquids, as this may cause panels to absorb moisture and swell.
- Avoid prolonged exposure to high temperatures, as it may cause surface bulging on vacuum-formed/laminated components.
- **Do not** use any acidic or corrosive cleaners for surface cleaning.
- Secondary drilling is not recommended, as it may damage the internal structural strength.



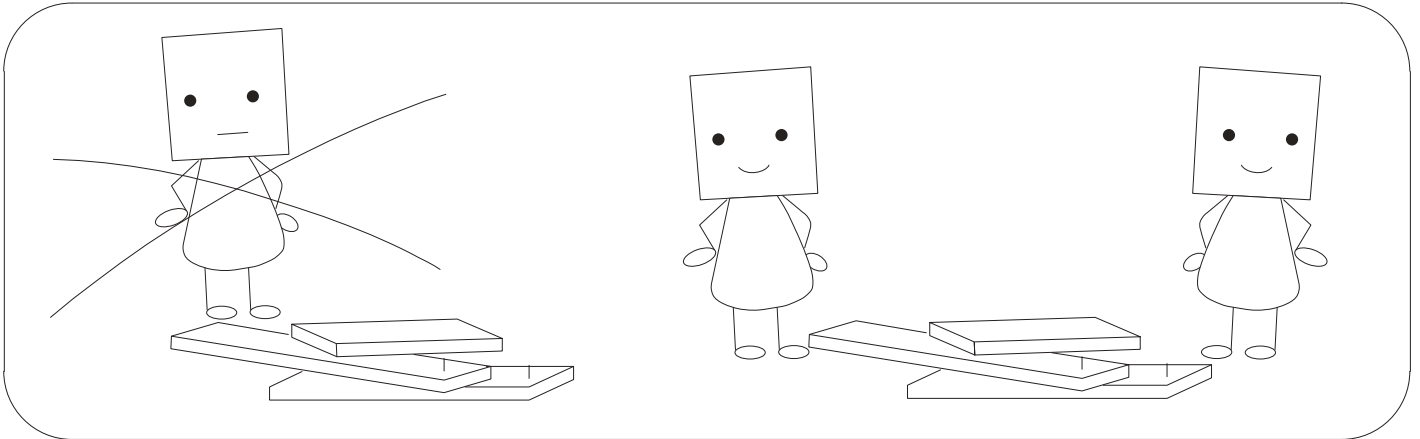
Maintenance Methods

- (1) Regularly remove dust from the furniture surface with a soft cloth or wool brush to prevent dust from scratching the paint finish.
- (2) If there are water stains on the product, wipe them dry with a dry cloth immediately. Do not allow moisture to remain on the furniture surface to avoid long-term dampness.
- (3) If the environment where the product is placed is humid, it is recommended to place dehumidifying products inside the cabinet.
- (4) Place high-temperature or frozen items on the product only after placing a heat-resistant mat underneath. For heavy or hard items, use a soft decorative tablecloth or felt pad on the surface to provide protection.
- (5) Lubricate connectors: Regularly lubricate moving parts (such as hinges and slide rails) to maintain flexibility.

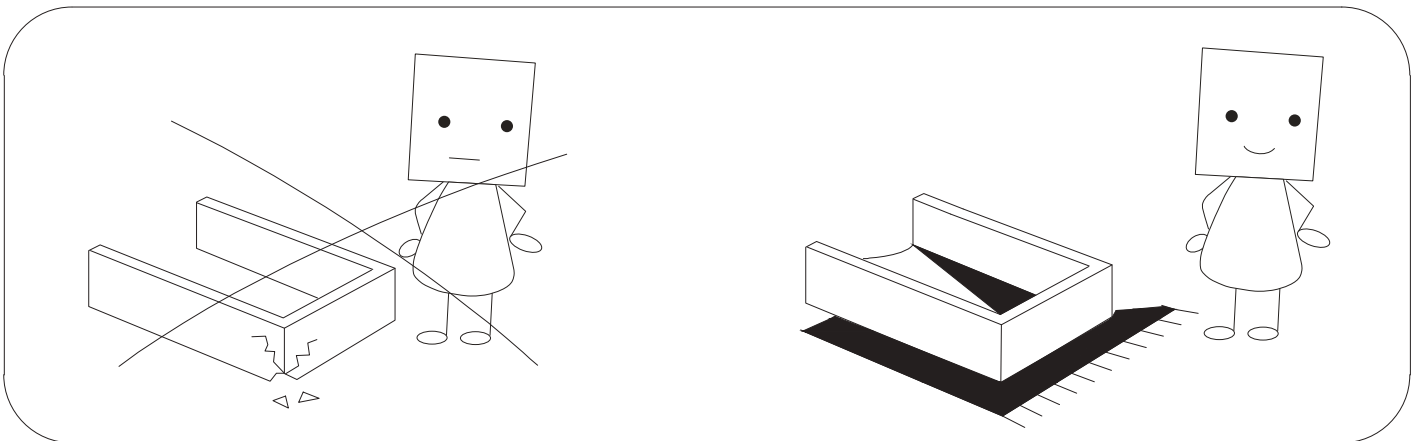

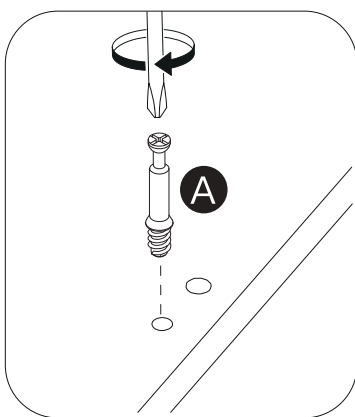
1. Use electric drill for easier installation experience.

Light strip

Preparation before Installation

Before installation, please carefully read the instructions for this type. Check whether the light strip, power adapter, controller (if any), and connecting wires are in good condition, without extrusion, cuts, or exposed wires.

Confirm that the output voltage (V), current (A), or power (W) of the power adapter fully matches the rated input parameters of the light strip. **Strictly prohibit use with overvoltage or overpower!**

Confirm that the type of the controller (RF remote control, WiFi, Bluetooth, DMX, etc.) is consistent with your needs and compatible with the light strip (in terms of voltage and signal protocol).

Instructions for Use

(1) Operate the on/off function, dimming, color adjustment, and mode switching according to the controller's instructions. Avoid prolonged full – power operation in extremely high – temperature environments (such as direct sunlight without heat – dissipation measures) or enclosed, poorly ventilated spaces.

(2) Unless necessary, **Do not** frequently turn the power on and off. Avoid pulling, squeezing, or folding the light strip, as this may cause circuit breaks and render the light source inoperable.



Notes

- **Stay away from all water sources:** Use the light strip away from water sources or humid environments.
- **Strictly prohibit live – line operation:** All installation, cutting, connection, and maintenance must be carried out when the power is off.
- **Power adapter:** Be sure to use the original or high – quality power adapter with strictly matching parameters.

- **Pay attention to temperature:** It is normal for the light strip to feel slightly warm when working. But if it feels scalding hot ($> 50^{\circ}\text{C}$), it indicates poor heat dissipation or overload. You must immediately cut off the power and check (installation environment, power matching, whether there is a local short circuit).
- **Professional installation:** For complex installations (such as long – distance, high – power, special environments) or if you lack electrical knowledge, it is recommended to seek the help of a professional electrician.
- **Child safety:** Keep children away from this component; Prevent children from biting, swallowing, or wrapping it around their bodies.



Maintenance Methods

(1) **Cleaning Method:** Before cleaning, be sure to disconnect the power supply and wait for the light strip to cool down. Use a dry or slightly damp soft cloth to gently wipe dust and stains on the surface of the light strip. The surface of the encapsulated glue is relatively easy to clean. It is strictly forbidden to use corrosive chemical cleaning agents (such as strong acids, strong alkalis, alcohol, gasoline, thinner, etc.), abrasives, steel wire balls and other hard objects for wiping, so as not to damage the surface finish, transparency of the encapsulated glue layer or cause aging and cracking. **Do not** soak the light strip in water for cleaning!

(2) **Inspection and Maintenance:** Regular inspection (recommended quarterly or semi – annually): Check whether the light strip has physical damage (such as cuts, indentations, colloid cracking, degumming). Check whether all connection points (joints, solder joints, power interfaces) are firm, free of rust, and free of water ingress marks. Check whether the waterproof measures (end caps, connector seals, sealant) are in good condition and not aged and ineffective. Check whether the fixing devices (back glue, buckles, cable ties) are loose or fallen off.

Power strip

Preparation before Installation

Ensure the rated voltage range marked on the power strip covers your local voltage. **Never use** it if they don't match!

Carefully check the maximum rated power (in Watts, W) or maximum current (in Amperes, A) marked on the power strip. This indicates the total load limit the strip can handle.

Instructions for Use

(1) Insert the power strip plug fully into the wall socket to ensure good contact.

(2) Plug appliances directly into the power strip's sockets. Never daisy-chain (cascade) another power strip onto this one, especially for high-power devices. This significantly increases the risk of overloading and circuit overheating.



Notes

- **Waterproof and moisture – proof:** Keep away from water sources. Do not cover the power strip (such as covering it with blankets, books, curtains). Ensure there is enough space around for heat dissipation. Stay away from heat sources and flammable materials. **Do not** let heavy objects press on the power cord or the power strip itself. **Do not** bend, pull, or step on the power cord. Do not use nails to fix the power cord.
- **Regular Touch Checks:** After using for a while (especially after using high-power devices), gently touch the power strip casing and power cord with the back of your hand. A slight warmth is normal (heat is generated when electricity passes through), but if it feels hot to the touch, stop using it immediately and unplug all devices!
- **Child Safety:** If there are children in the household, choose a power strip with safety shutters (to prevent foreign objects from being inserted into individual sockets) and educate children not to play with the power strip or power cord.



Maintenance Methods:

(1) Regular Cleaning: Be sure to first unplug all plugs and disconnect the power strip from the wall socket, then wipe dust off the casing and power cord with a dry, soft cloth, use a dry, soft brush to clean gaps, strictly prohibit using liquid cleaners like wet cloths, cleaning agents, alcohol, sprays, etc. as liquid seeping inside can cause short circuits and electric shock risks; if there's dust in the sockets, carefully clean them using a can of dry compressed air (keep a certain distance) or a dry, soft brush and never poke the sockets with metal objects such as paper clips or toothpicks!

(2) Regular Inspection: Conduct inspections once a month or once a quarter: check if the power cord has damage, hardening, cracks, indentations, or pet bite marks; check if the plug and sockets have signs of scorching, deformation, looseness, or poor contact; inspect the casing for cracks, deformation, or traces of abnormal heating; and smell for any unusual burning odor (even when not powered on, internal faults may leave residual odors). If any of the above issues are found, stop using it immediately and replace it!

(3) Avoid Improper Operation: **Do not** force mismatched plugs into the sockets; when plugging in or unplugging, hold the plug itself with your hand and **Do not** pull the power cord; **Do not** place the power strip in locations where it may be stepped on or cause people to trip.
