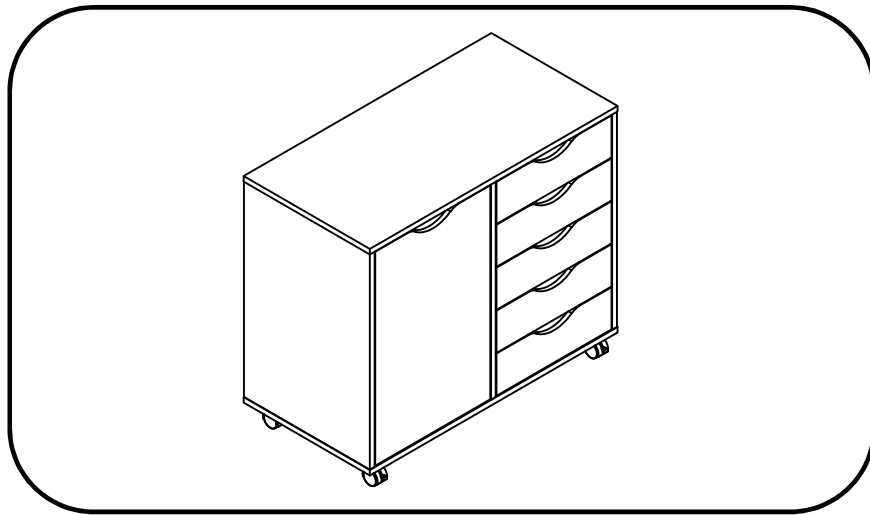

WARNING CAUTION

ADULT ASSEMBLY REQUIRED

CHOKING HAZARD

- This product includes small parts, sharp points and sharp edges in its unassembled state. Keep unassembled parts away from children under 3 years of age, and animals.

SAFETY WARNINGS

- Follow the information on the warnings appearing on cabinet and on the carton. Do not remove warning label from cabinet.
- Do not allow children under 3 years of age to use the cabinet.
- Do not use substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.

FURNITURE TIP-OVER HAZARD

Children have died from furniture tip-over

To reduce the risk of furniture tip-over:

- ALWAYS install tip-over restraint especially if used by a wall or in the open.
- NEVER put a TV on this product
- NEVER allow children to stand, climb or hang on drawers, doors, or shelves.
- NEVER open more than one drawer at a time.
- ALWAYS place heaviest items in lowest cabinet.

PARENTAL SUPERVISION IS REQUIRED

- Parents or Guardians should supervise use under the intended age specifically regarding children that may have access to it and climb on the unit.
- Do not allow horseplay on, under, or behind the unit and prohibit jumping on the cabinet.
- If used improperly, your table may be pulled over or fall, creating risk of injury or damage. Children should not be permitted to climb or pull on the cabinet.

USE, MAINTENANCE & ASSEMBLY

- Periodically check and ensure that the components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.
- Use on level surfaces only. Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damage to unit or floor.
- Do not use this item if any components are missing or damaged.
- Do not use substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.
- Only clean using damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- Check you have all components and tools listed on page 4
- Do not stand or put weight on this product during assembly, this could cause damage.
- Remove all hardware from the plastic bags and separate them into groups.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Certain assembly steps may be easier with 2 people.
- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.
- We do not recommend power screwdrivers. Only use hand screwdrivers to prevent damage to unit.
- Keep these instructions for future reference.

Select G (×10) .Divide G(×10) into Drawer Slide Inner(×10) and Drawer Slide Outer(×10).

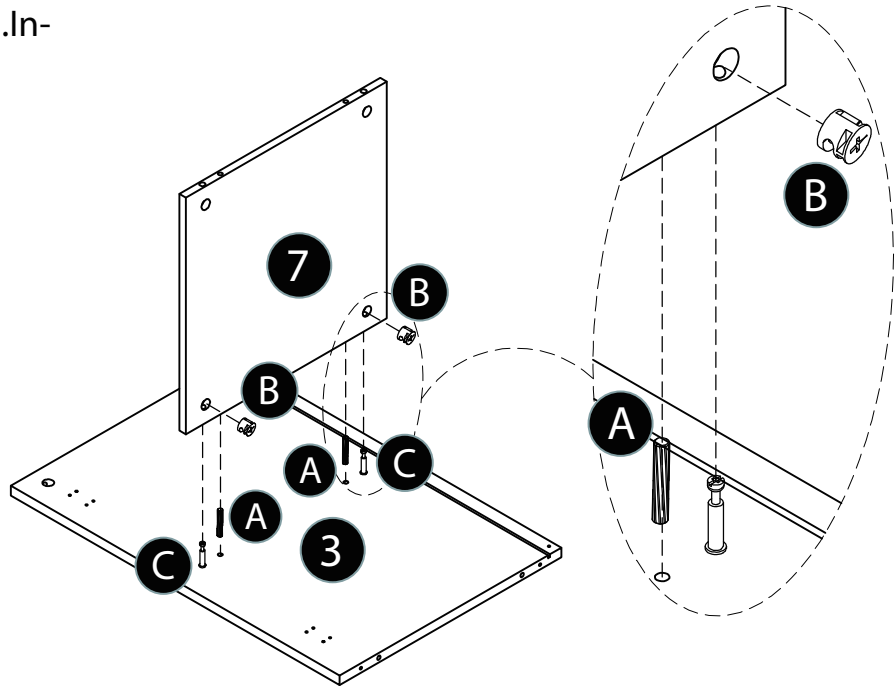
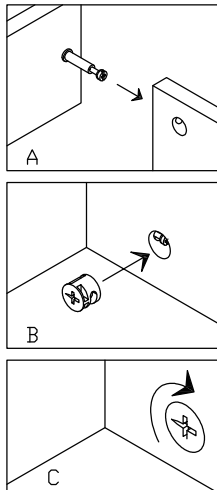
Select 3(×1) and C(×2).Insert C(×2) into 3.

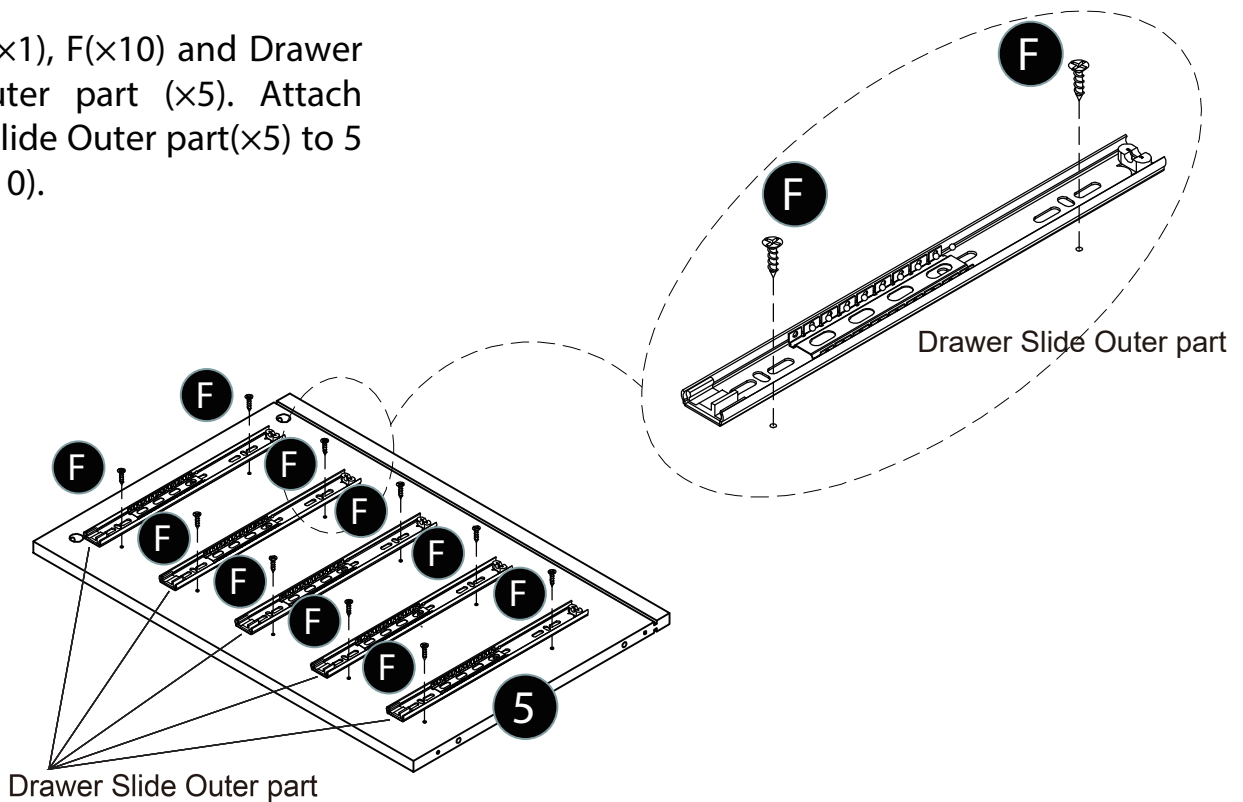

Select 7(×1), A(×2) and B(×2). Insert 7 into 3 with A(×2) and C(×2). Insert B(×2) into 7.

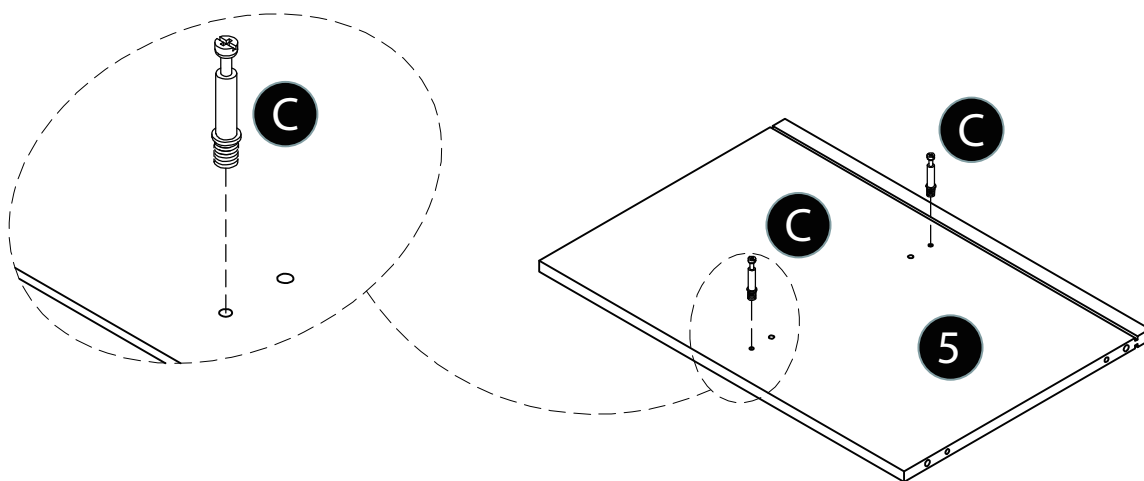
Select 5(×1), F(×10) and Drawer Slide Outer part (×5). Attach Drawer Slide Outer part(×5) to 5 with F(×10).

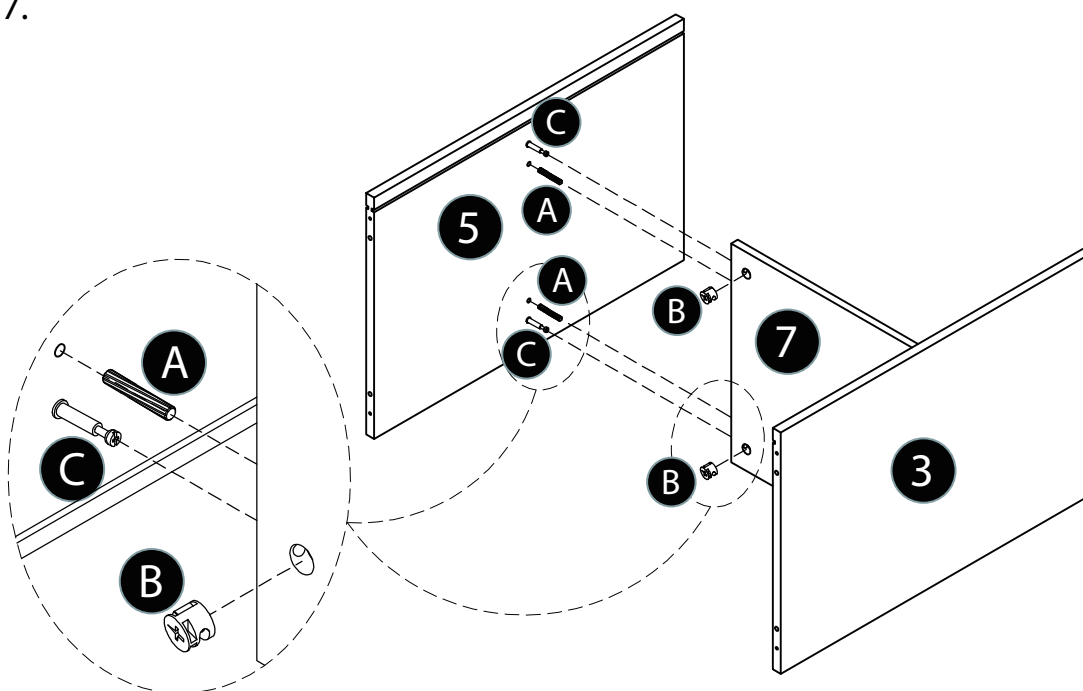

Select 5(×1) and C(×2). Insert C(×2) into 5.

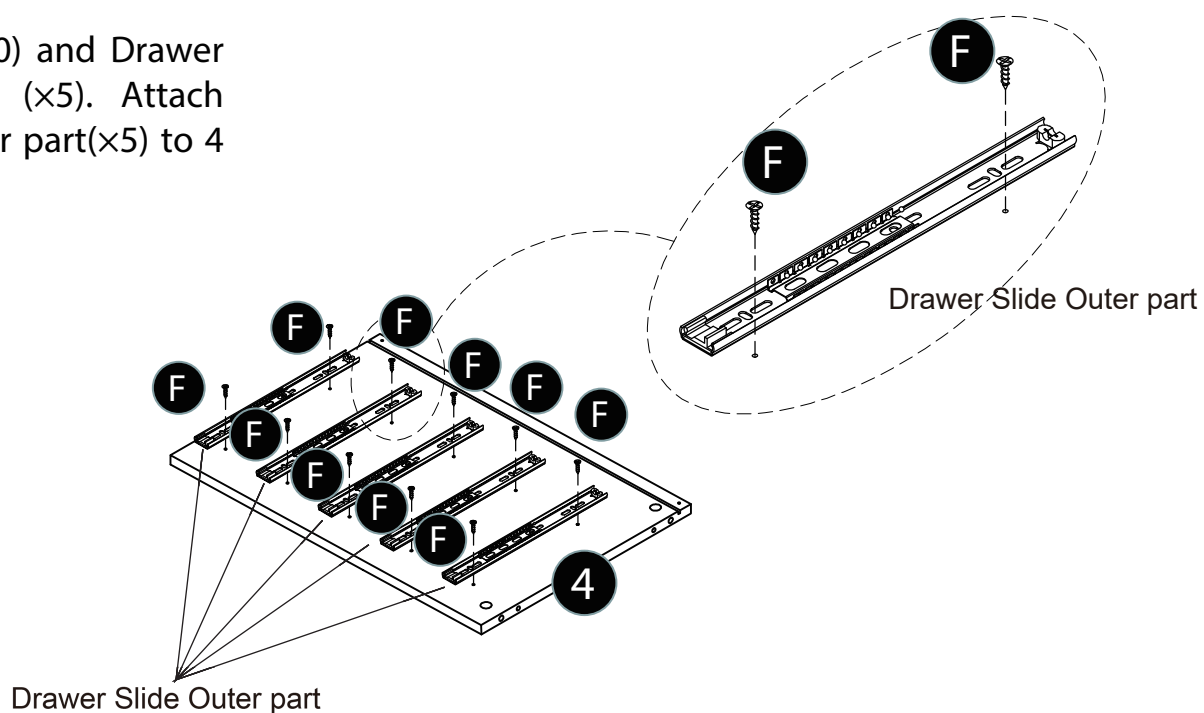
Insert 7 into 5 with A(×2) and C(×2).
Insert B(×2) into 7.

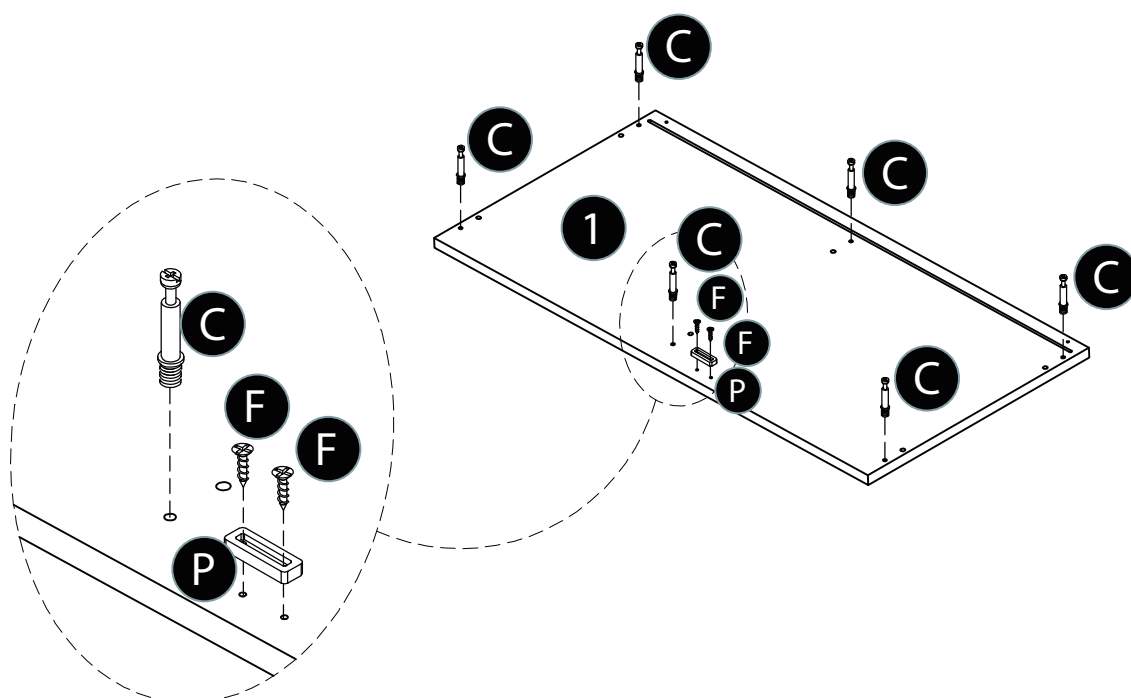

Select 4(×1), F(×10) and Drawer Slide Outer part (×5). Attach Drawer Slide Outer part(×5) to 4 with F(×10).

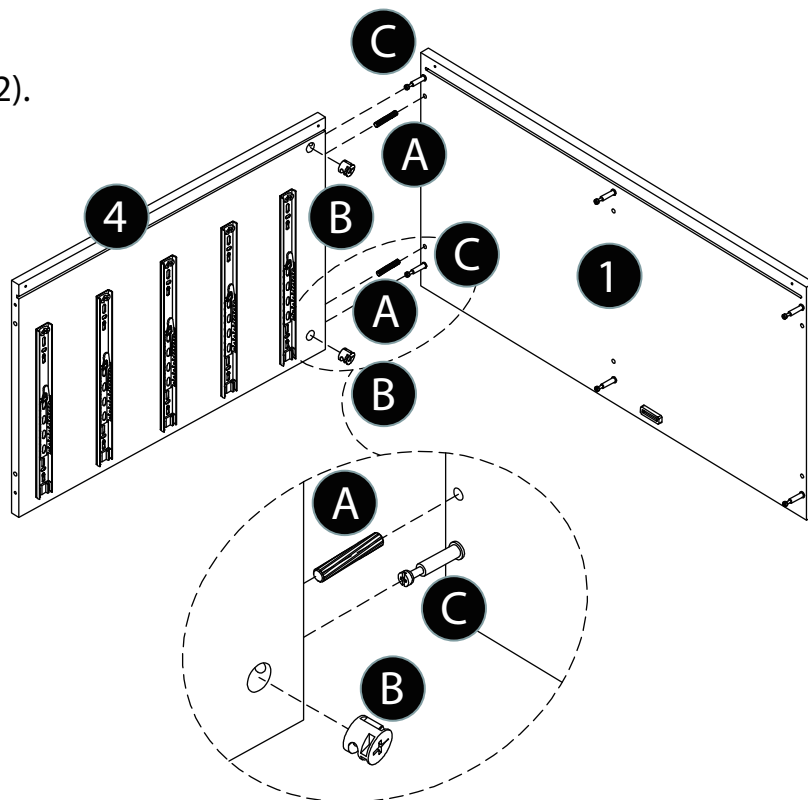
Install C(×6) into 1. Insert F(×2) into P(×1) into 1.

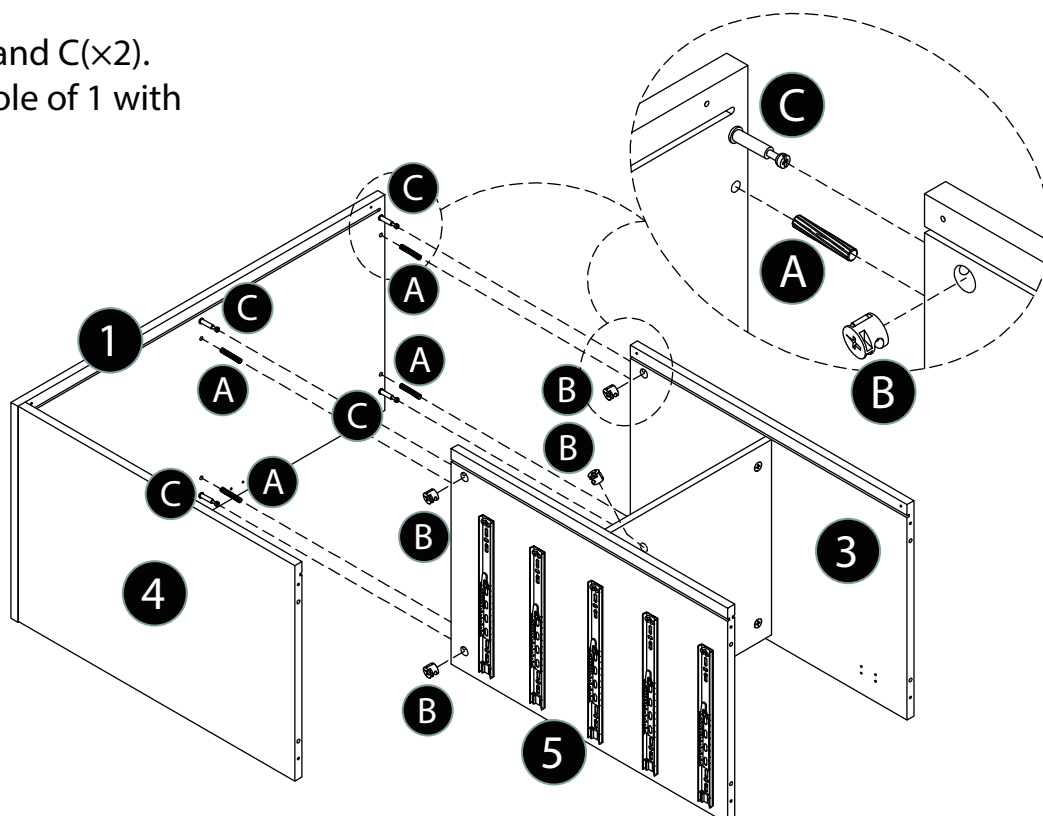

Insert 4 into 1 with A($\times 2$) and C($\times 2$).
Insert B($\times 2$) into 4.

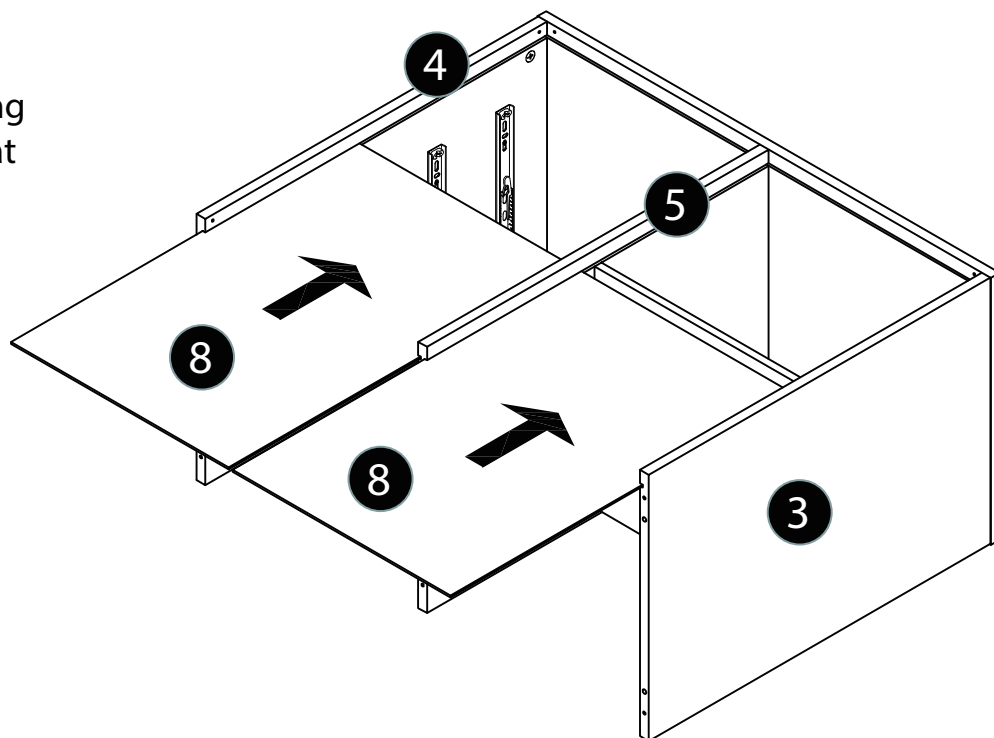
Insert 3 into 1 with A($\times 2$) and C($\times 2$).
Insert 5 into the middle hole of 1 with
A($\times 2$) and C($\times 2$).
Insert B($\times 2$) into 5.
Repeat for 3.

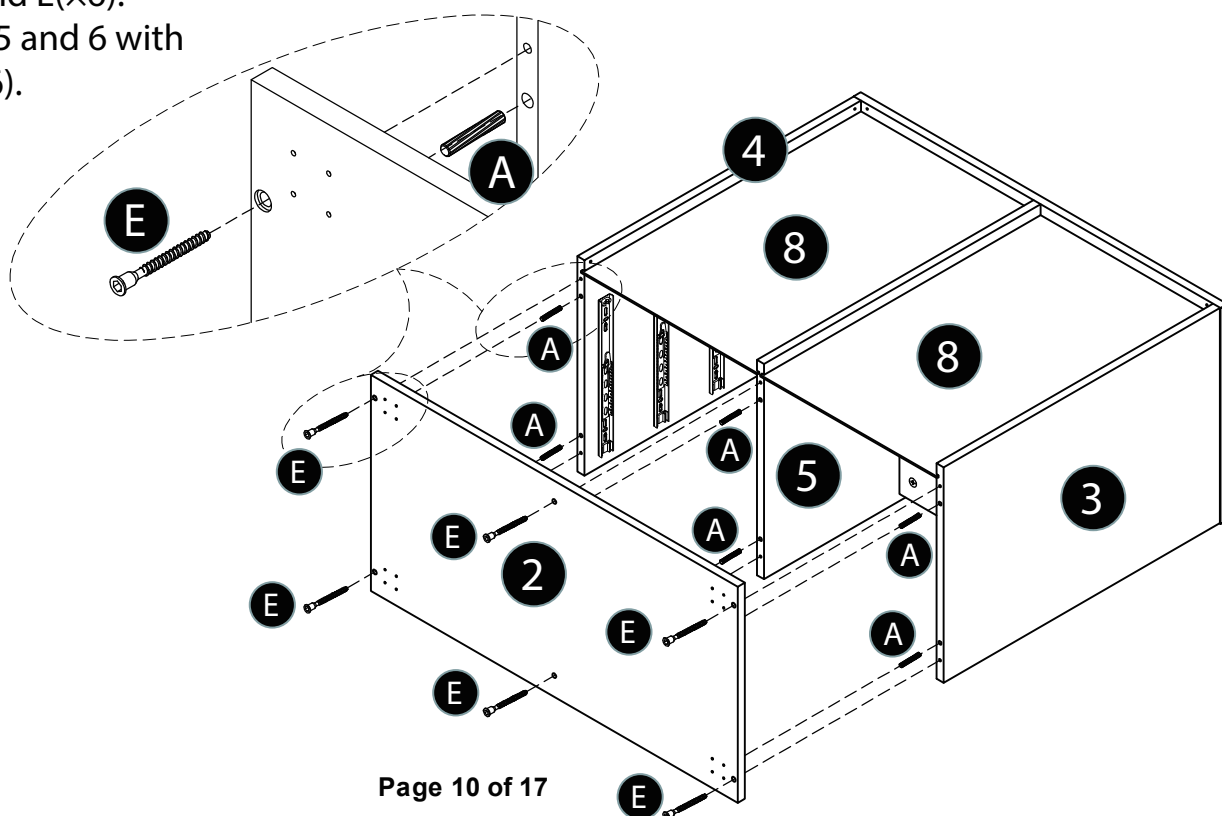

Select 8(x2). Install 8(x1) along the grooves of 3 and 5. Repeat for the other 8.

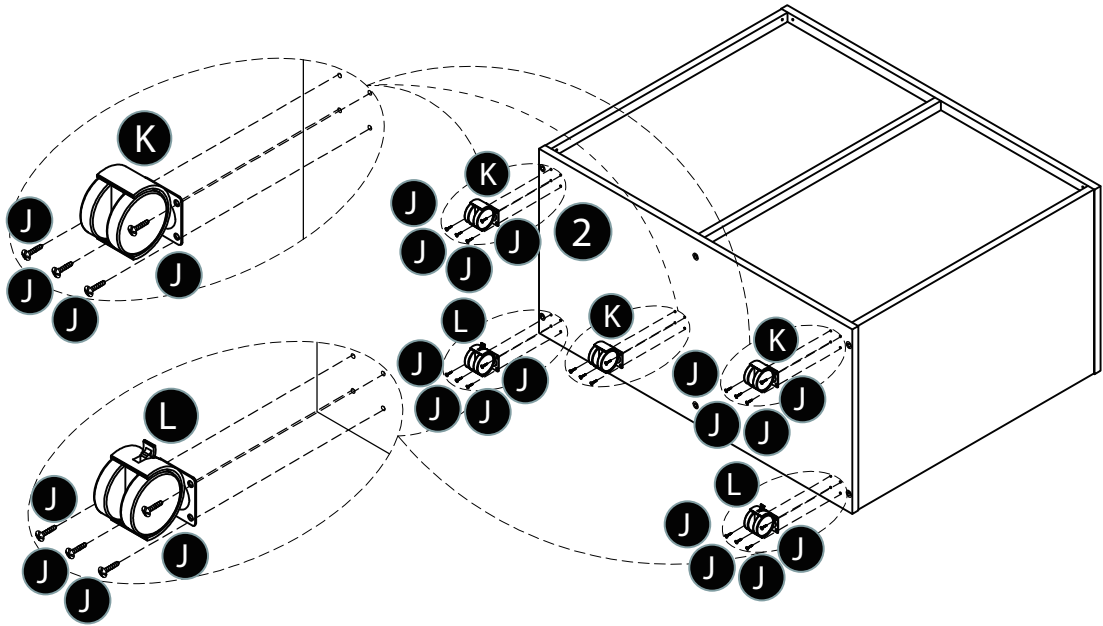
Select A(x6) and E(x6).
Insert 2 into 4,5 and 6 with
A(x6) and E(x6).

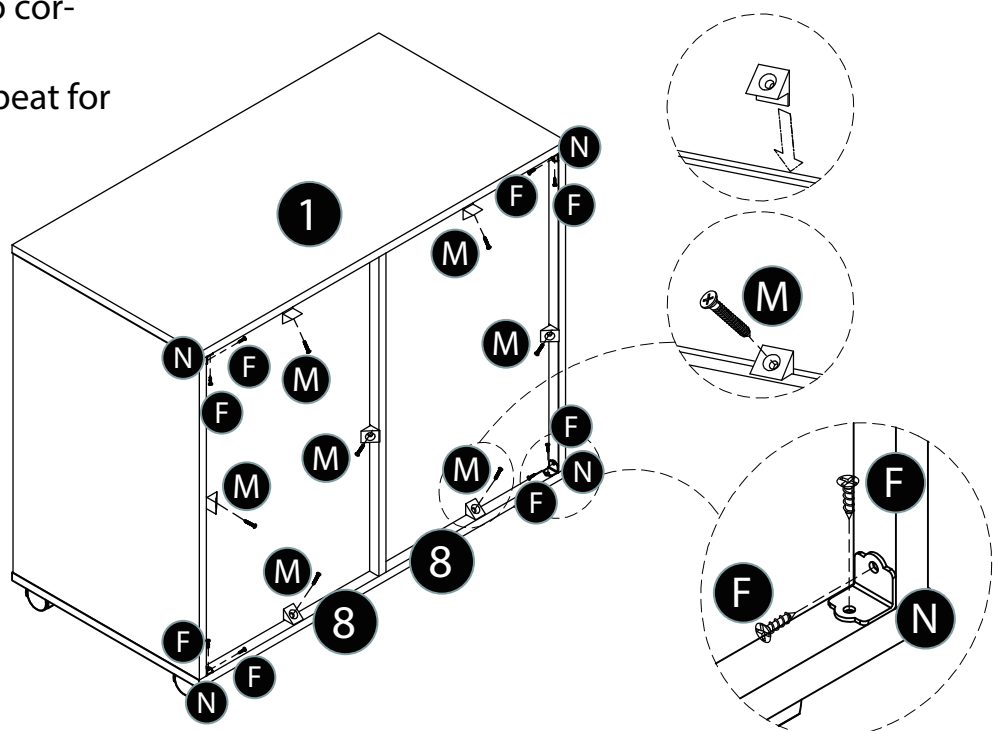

Select K($\times 3$), L($\times 2$) and J($\times 20$).
Insert K($\times 2$) into 2 with J($\times 8$).
Repeat for L($\times 2$).

Select F($\times 8$), M($\times 12$) and N($\times 4$).
Insert N($\times 4$) into F($\times 8$) into corners of 8($\times 2$).
Insert M($\times 4$) into 8($\times 1$). Repeat for the other 8.

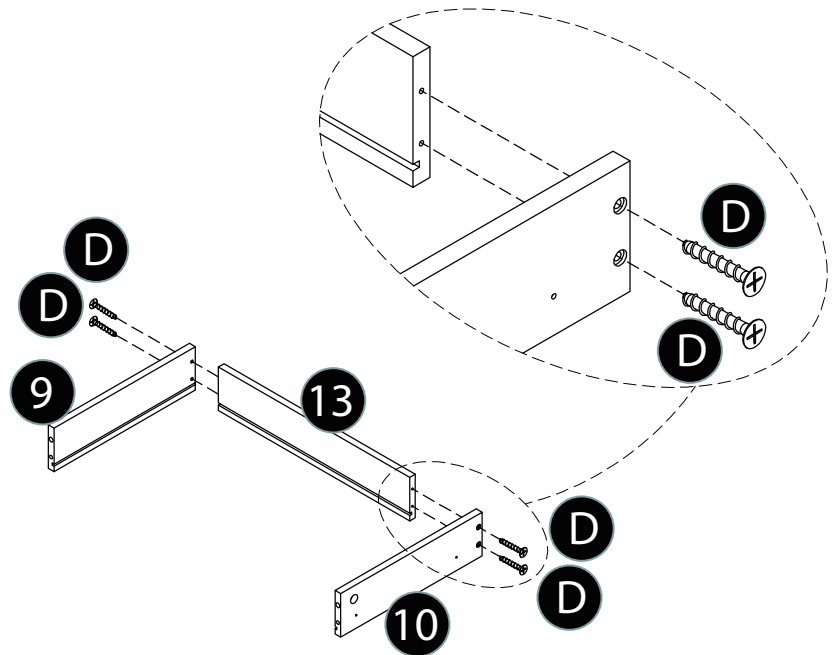

Select D(×20), 9(×5), 10(×5) and 13(×5).

Insert D(×2) into 9(×1) into one side of 13.

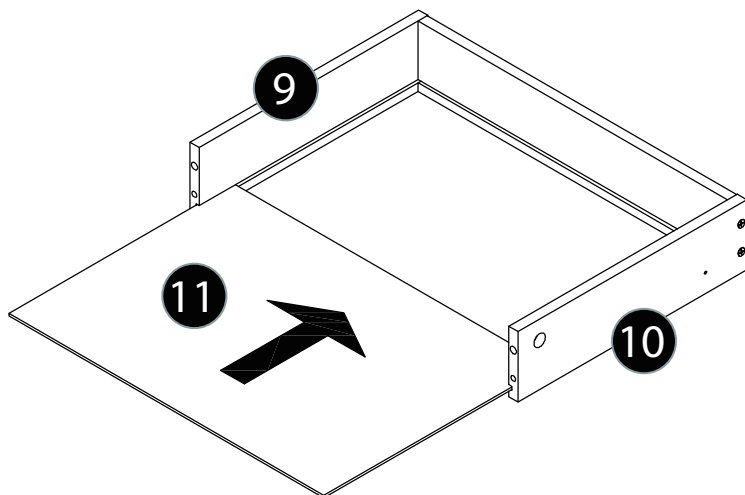
Repeat for another 9(×4) and 13(×4).

Insert D(×2) into 10(×1) into the other side of 13. Repeat for another 10(×4) and 13(×4).

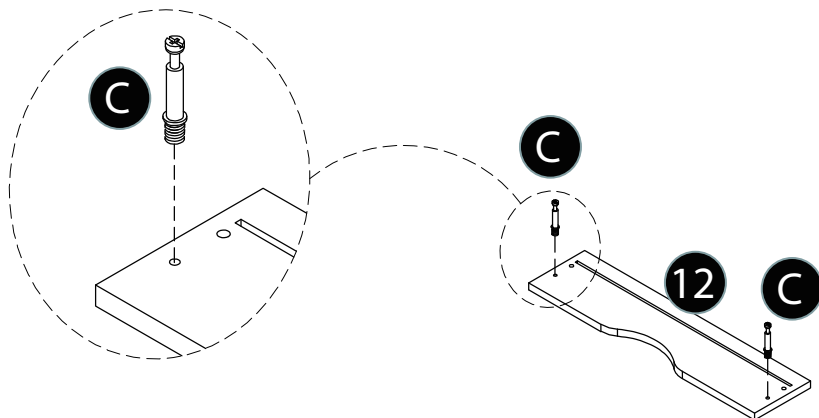
Install 11(×5) along the grooves of 9(×5) and 10(×5).

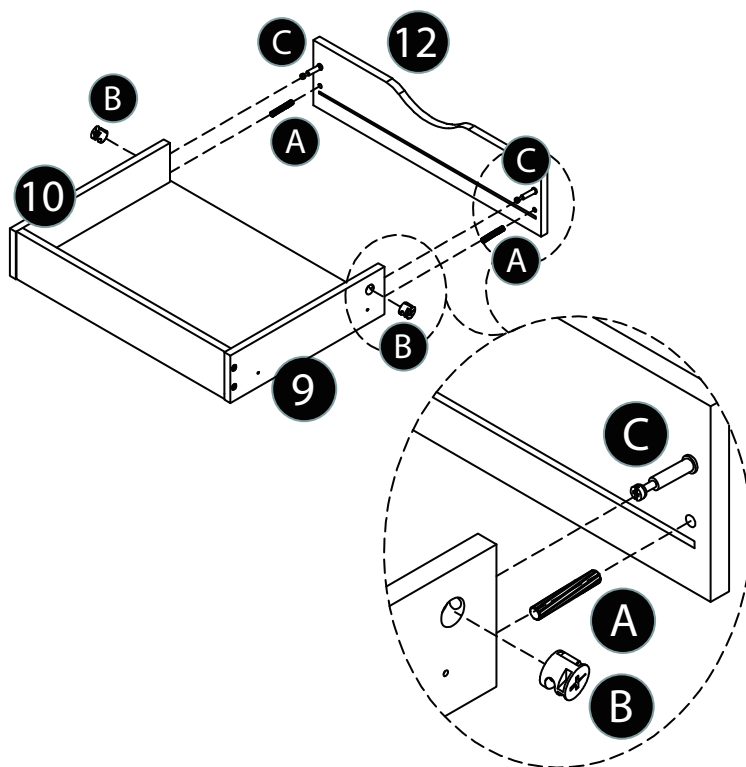

Select 12(×5) and C(×10).
Insert C(×2) into 12(×1).
Repeat for another 12(×4).

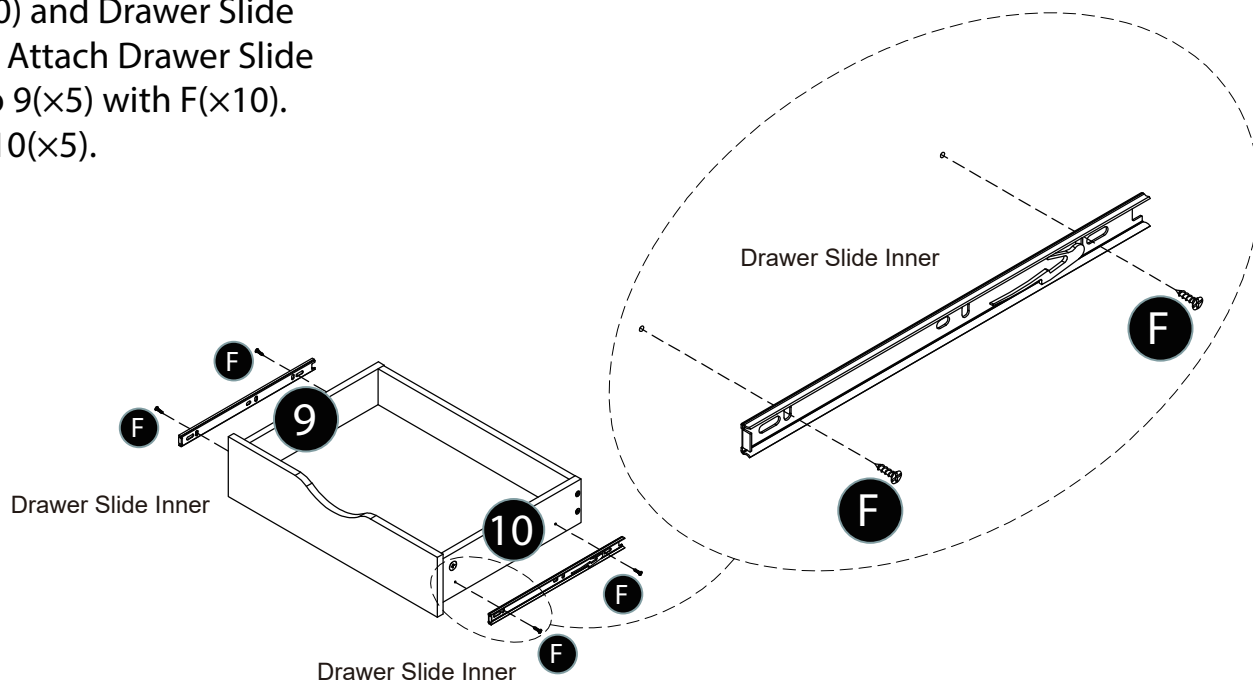
Select A(×10), B(×10) and 12(×5).
Insert 12 into 9 and 10 with A(×2),
B(×2) and C(×2). Repeat for another
12(×4).

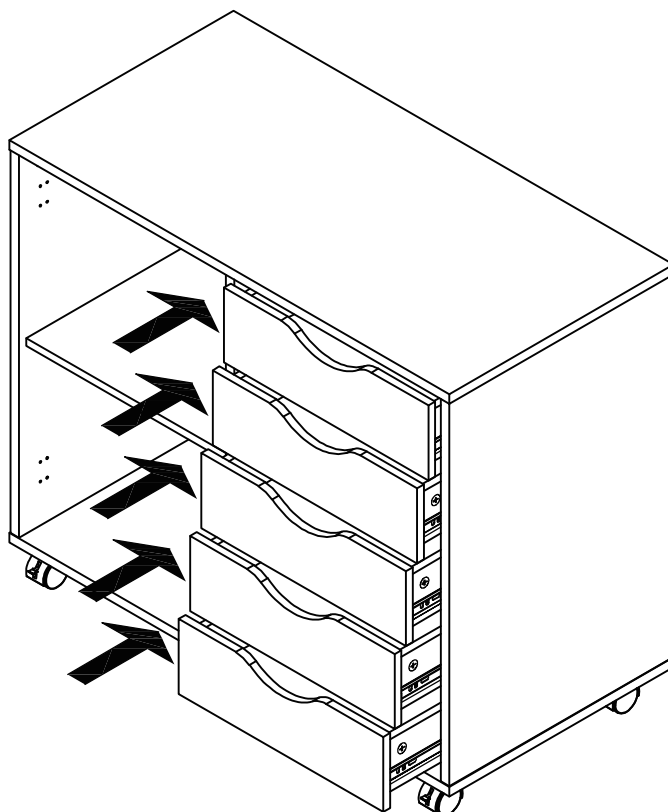

Select F(×20) and Drawer Slide Inner (×10). Attach Drawer Slide Inner(×5) to 9(×5) with F(×10). Repeat for 10(×5).

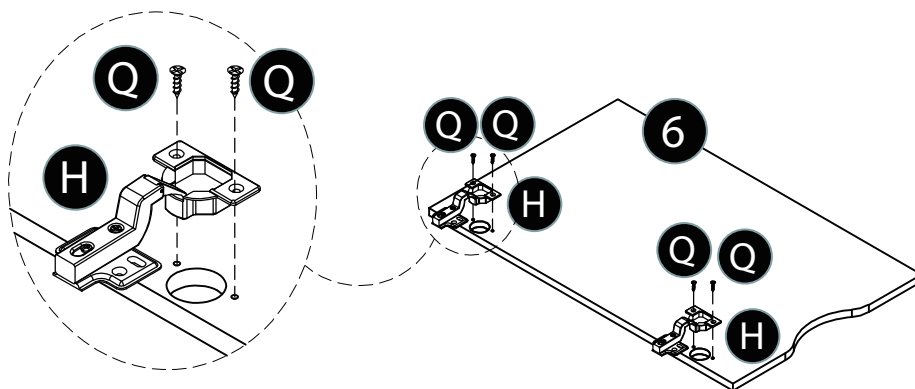
Carefully insert drawer box by aligning inner and outer slides and pushing drawer into place until clicks on both sides. Repeat for other drawer boxes. Note: it may be easier to insert inner to outer by fully extending drawer slide out.

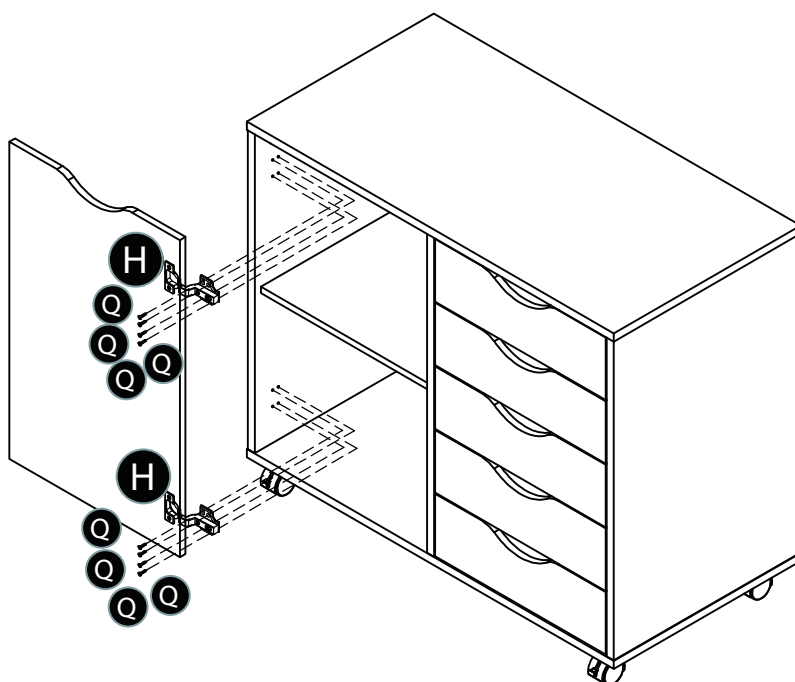
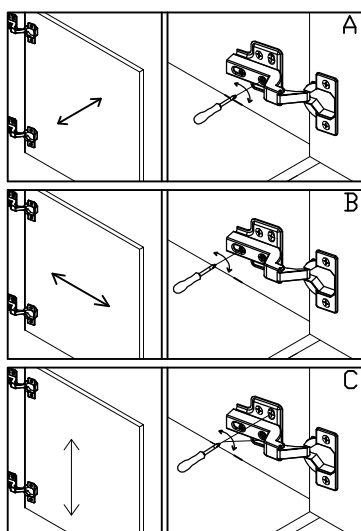

Select 6(×1),H(×2) and Q(×4).
Insert H(×2) and Q(×4) into 6.

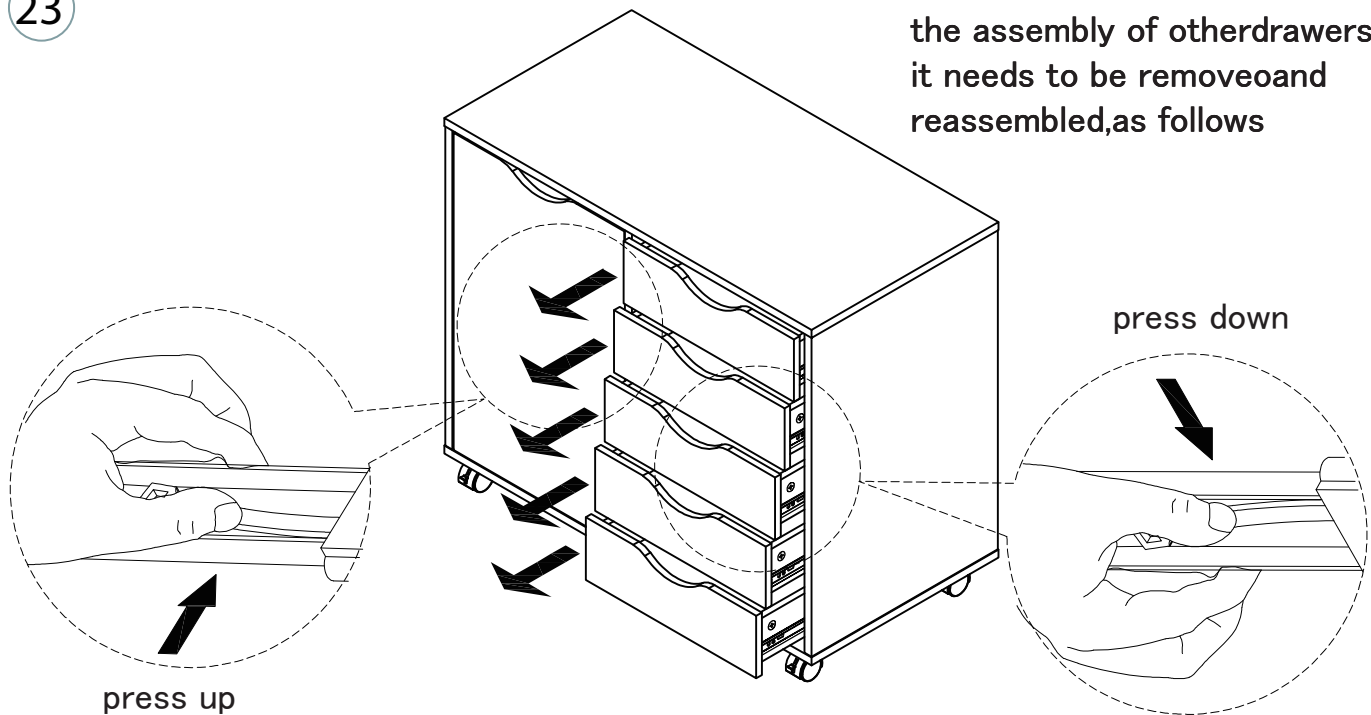
Insert H(×1) into Cabinet with
Q(×4).
Repeat for the other H(×1).



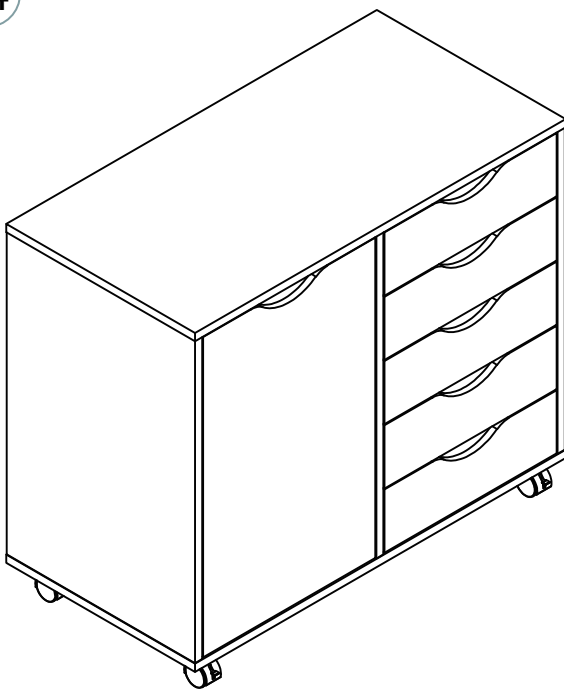
HOW TO REMOVE A DRAWER

If the drawer is installed in a cabinet and the position is incorrect or affects the assembly of other drawers, it needs to be removed and reassembled, as follows

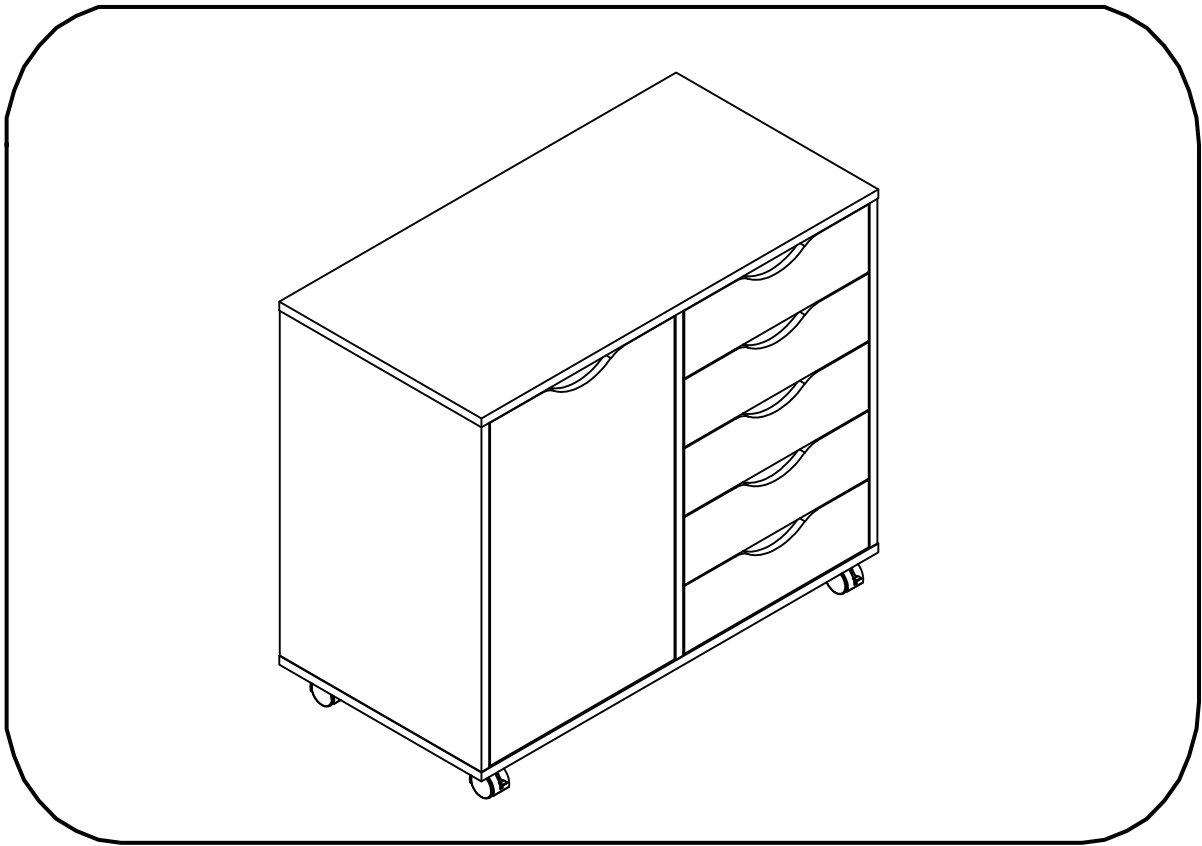
