A IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: RISK OF ELECTRICALSHOCK

- Turn off electrical power at fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring fixture to the power supply.
- Turn off the power when you perform any maintenance.
- Verify that supply voltage is correct by comparing it with the luminaire label information.
- Make all electrical and grounded connections in accordancewith the National Electrical Code and any applicable local code requirements.
- All wiring connections should be capped with UL approved wire connectors.

CAUTION: RISK OF INJURY

- · Wear gloves and safety glasses at all times when removing luminaire from carton,installing, servicing or performing maintenance.
- Avoid direct eye exposure to the light source while it is on.
- · Account for small parts and destroy packing material, as these may be hazardous to children.

WARNING: RISK OF BURN

- Allow fixture to cool before handling. Do not touch enclosure or light source.
- Do not exceed maximum wattage marked on luminaire label.

TURN OFF ELECTRICITY

At main fuse box (or circuit breaker box) Before removing the old fixture



REQUIRES 2 PEOPLE

Assistance will be required to support the fixture during installation

1 Carefully organize and place all parts on a smooth, flat surface. Line up all of the parts according to the assembly diagram.

Pole Connections:

- a. Screw UPPER POLE into the SOCKET ASSEMBLY, and then secure the MIDDLE POLE to bottom of SOCKET ASSEMBLY.
- b. Screw DECORATION LID o bottom of MIDDLE POLE, and then secure the LOWER POLE to bottom of DECORATION LID.
- c. Secure the LOWER POLE to top of the BASE.
- 3 Attach the SHADE onto UPPER POLE using DECORATIVE NUTS.
- **⚠** Place the CAGE onto the SHADE.
- Install the bulbs (not included). Check relamping label at socket area or packaging for maximum allowed wattage.
- 6 Plug the power cord into the outlet and turn on at PULL CHAIN SWITCH.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

This product has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other) as a feature to reduce the risk of electric shock. This plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Never use with an extension cord unless plug can be fully inserted. Do not alter the plug.

BULB REPLACEMENT

Before replacing the bulb, be sure that the shade and bulb are cool and lamp is unplugged.

Unscrew existing bulb from socket and replace with a new bulb. plug power supply cord back into oulet.
