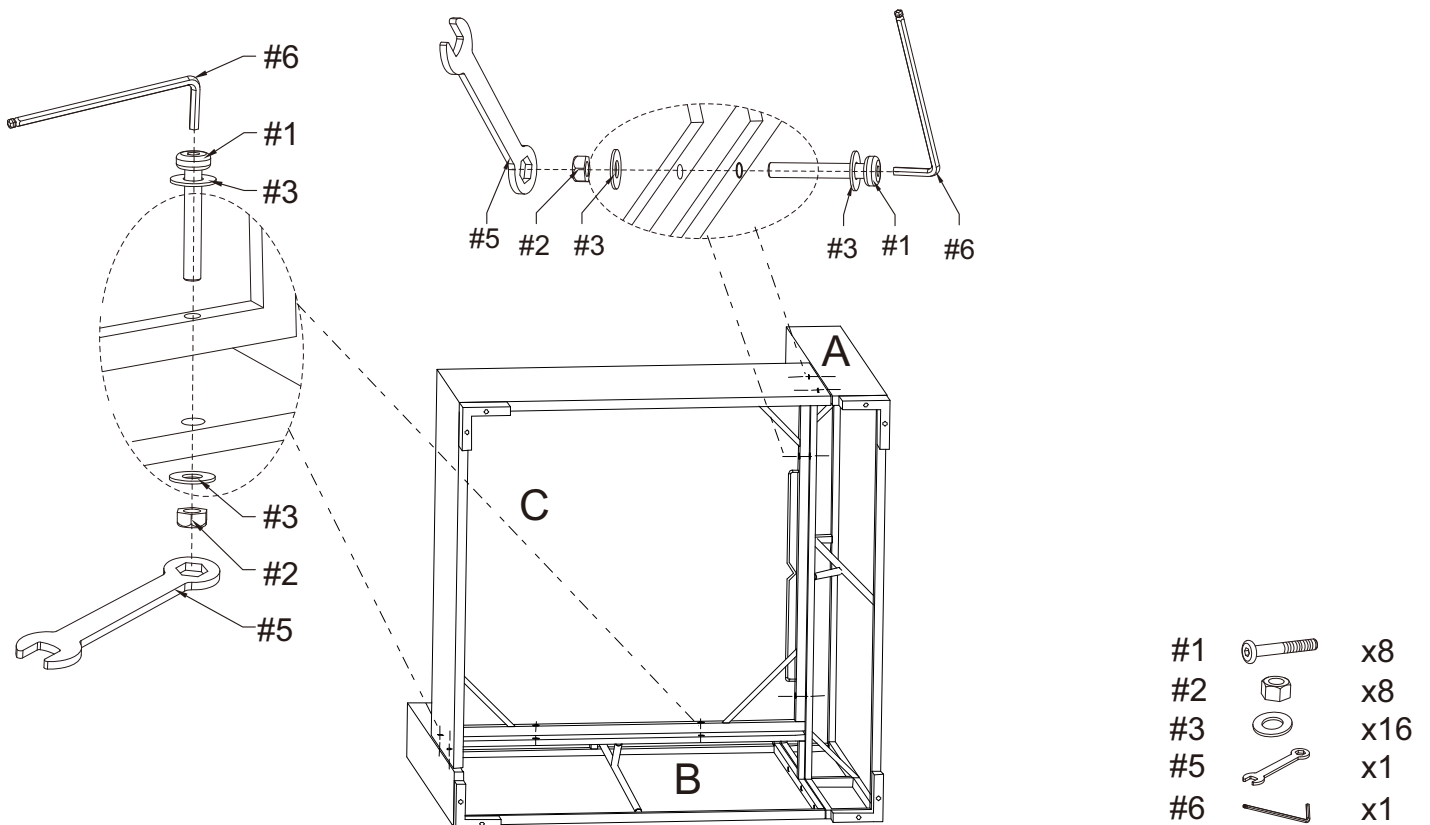
Step 1. Lay back panel (part B) down on a soft flat surface, such as carpet, as shown below. Attach arm panel (part A) to back panel (part B) using bolts (part #1), washers (part #3) nuts (part #2), wrench (part #5) and allen key (part #6).

NOTE: Please do not fully tighten bolts until unit is fully assembled.

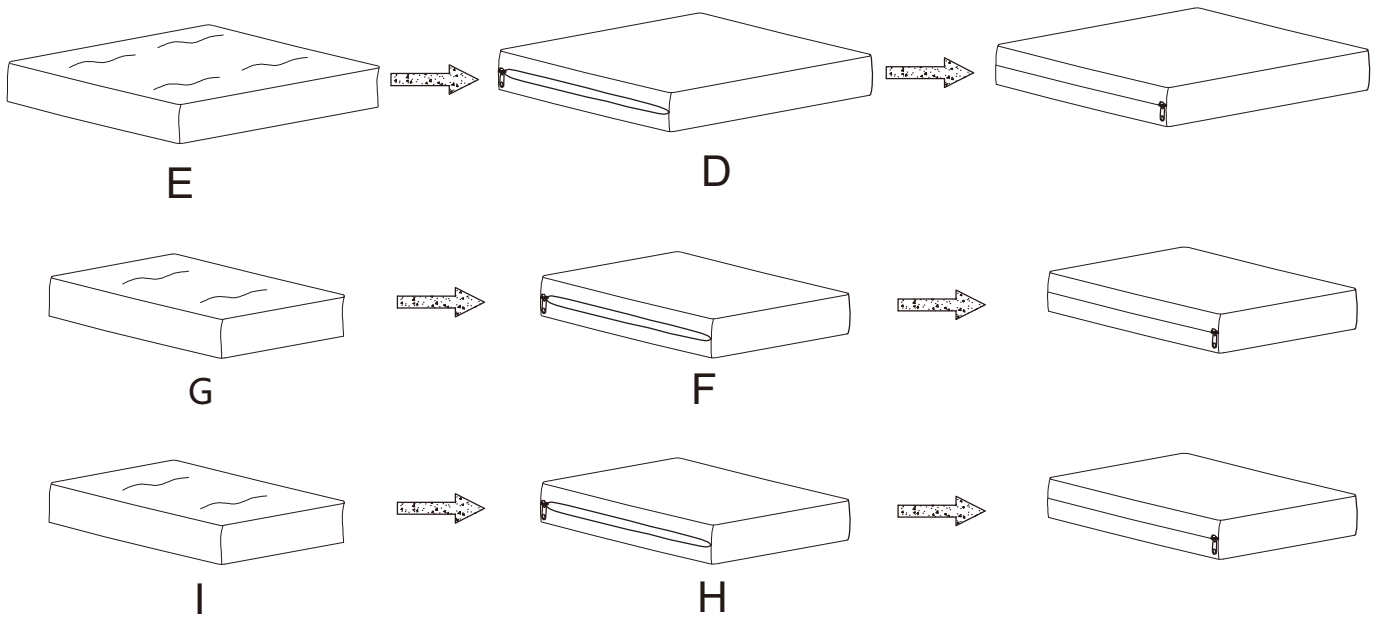


Step 2. Attach seat panel (part C) to assembled unit (parts A&B) using bolts (part #1), washers (part #3), nuts (part #2), wrench (part #5) and allen key (part #6).

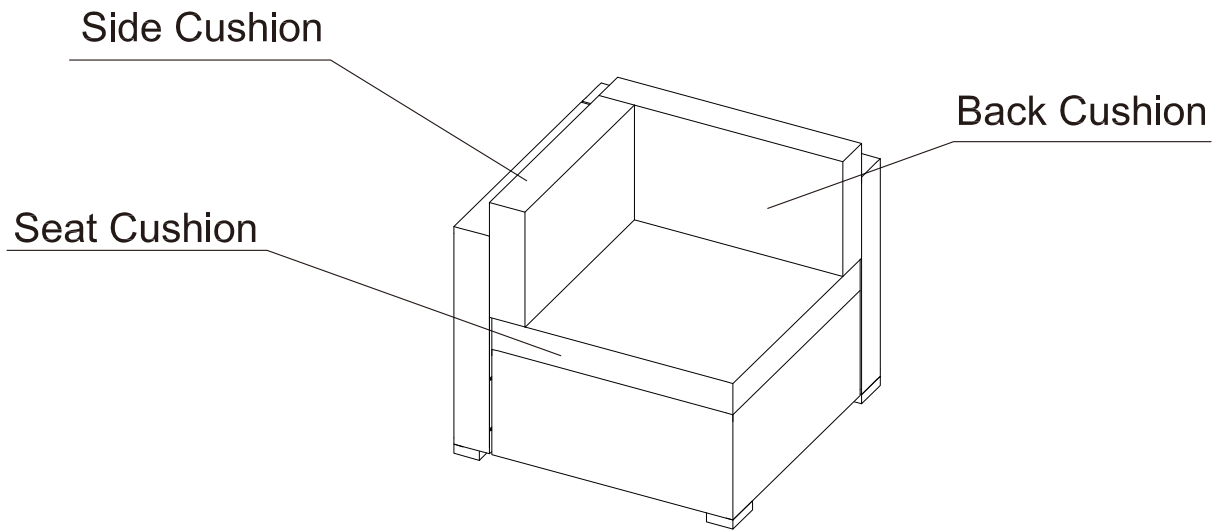
NOTE: Please fully tighten all bolts at this time.



Step 3. Insert core of seat cushion (part E) into cover of seat cushion (part D).
Insert core of back cushion (part G) into cover of back cushion (part F).
Insert core of side cushion (part I) into cover of side cushion (part H).



Step 4. Carefully turn the assembled chair upright and add cushions as shown below.



Step 6. Use plastic clips (part #4) to secure additional units together as shown.
