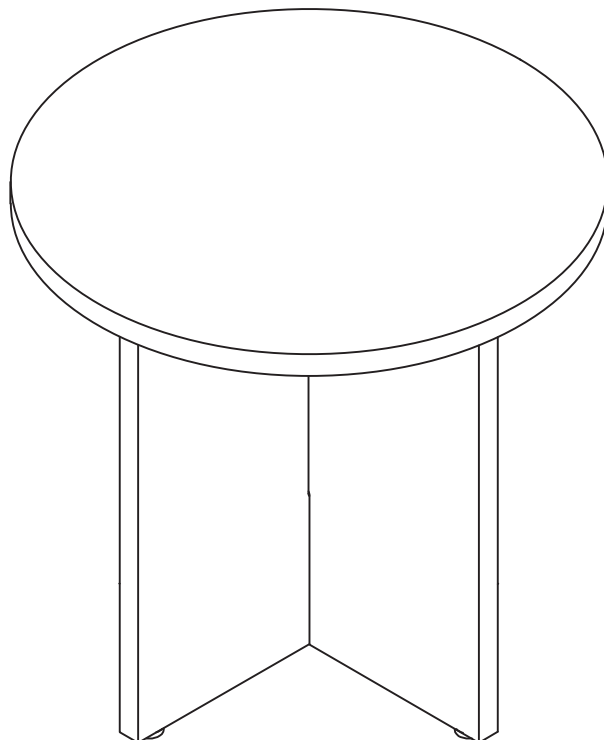




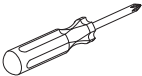
Round Top X-Base Accent Table

Assembly Instructions



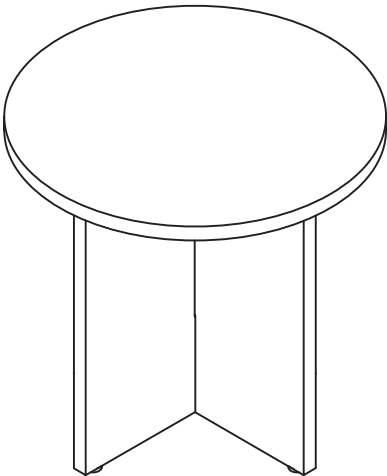
Hardware Pieces			Quantity	Your Parts			Quantity
A		Square Bracket	1	1	Tabletop		1
B		"X" Bracket	1	2	Lower Leg		1
C		Screw	8	3	Upper Leg		1
D		Hex Bolt	4				
E		Spring Washer	4				
F		Flat Washer	4				
G		Allen Key	1				
H		Wood Dowel	4				

What You'll Need

- Phillips screwdriver 
- A blanket or a flattened box to protect your piece during assembly

Before Assembling, Remember!

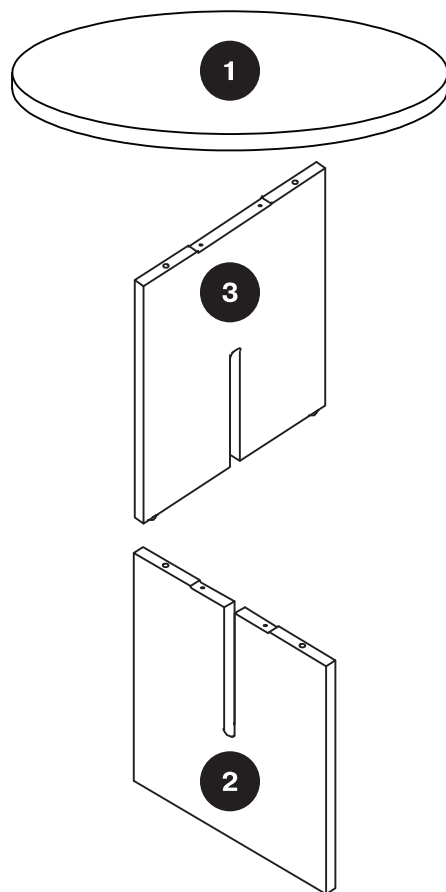
- Make sure all hardware and pieces are accounted for before discarding the box.
- Pay close attention to all holes on each panel during assembly.
- Do not overtighten screws, as this may cause splitting.
- Use hand tools when assembling.
- No power tools allowed!





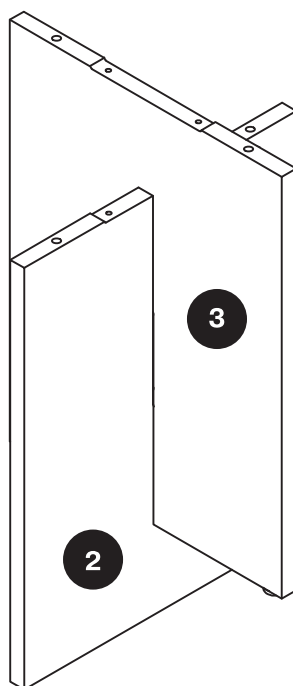

Let's Build a Table!



Step 1

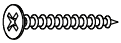
Align the slots on the Lower and Upper Legs (2, 3) and slide them together.

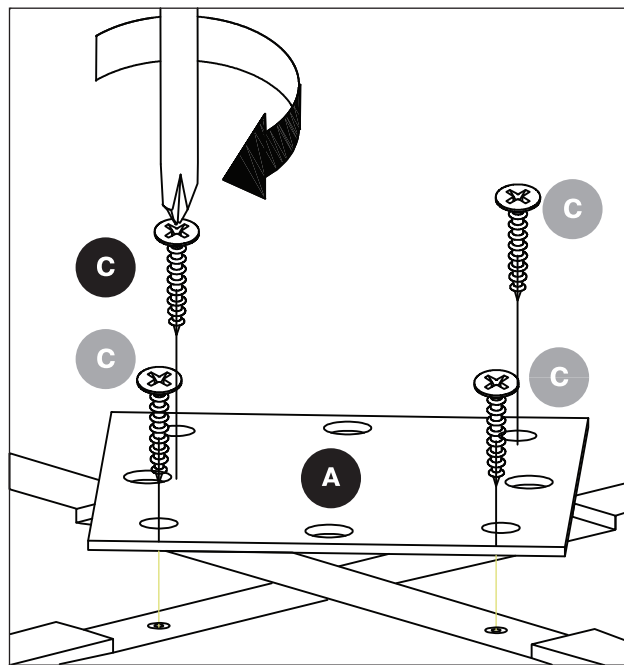
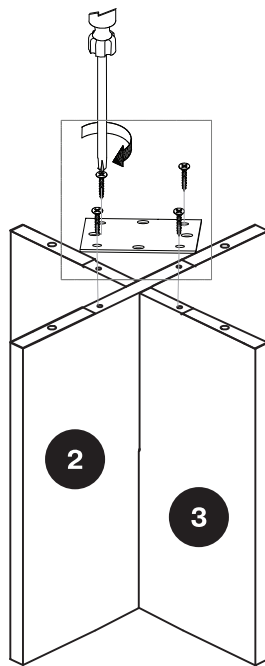


Step 2

Orient the Legs so the feet are facing down. Attach Square Bracket (A) to the top of the Legs with Screws (C), using a Phillips screwdriver.

A  Square Bracket x 1

C  Screw x 4



Step 3

Place Tabletop (1) upside down on a blanket or box. Place Wood Dowels (H) into the holes indicated on the Tabletop. Line up the legs with the Wood Dowels as shown. Attach the Legs to the Tabletop with Hex Bolts (D), Spring Washers (E), and Flat Washers (F) using the Allen Key (G).

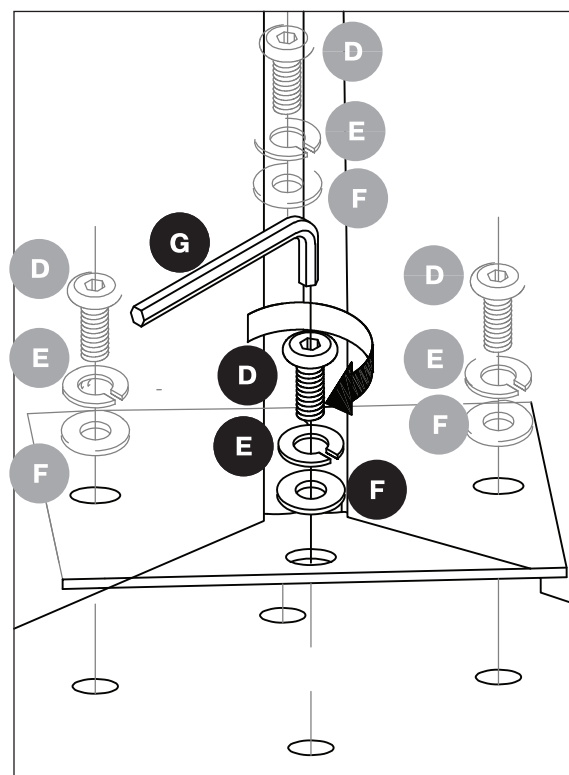
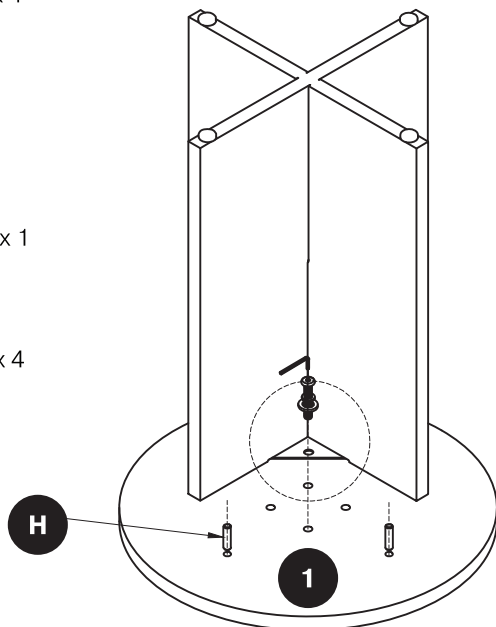
D  Hex Bolt x 4

E  Spring Washer x 4

F  Flat Washer x 4

G  Allen Key x 1

H  Wood Dowel x 4



Step 4

Attach "X" Bracket (B) to the bottom of the Legs with Screws (C).

Screw x 4

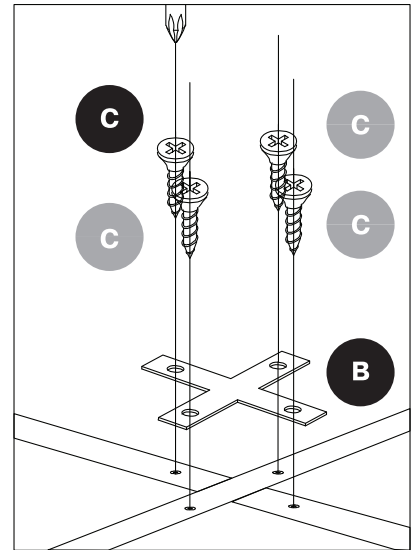
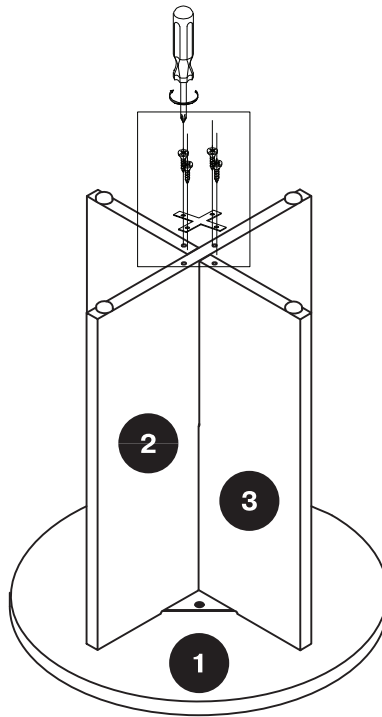
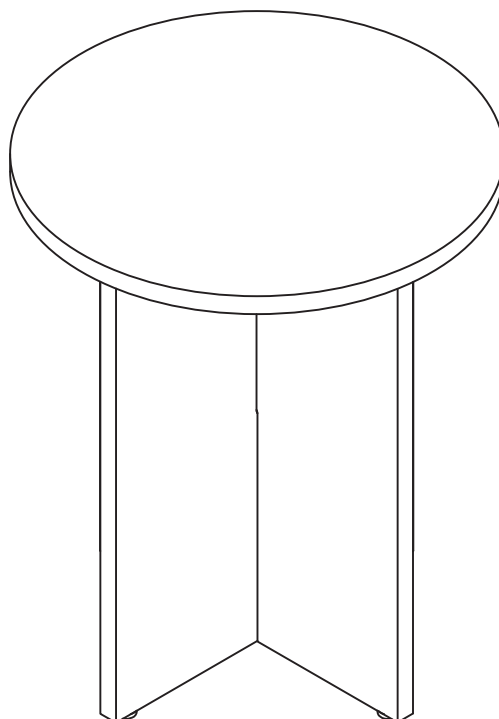


Table Finished
