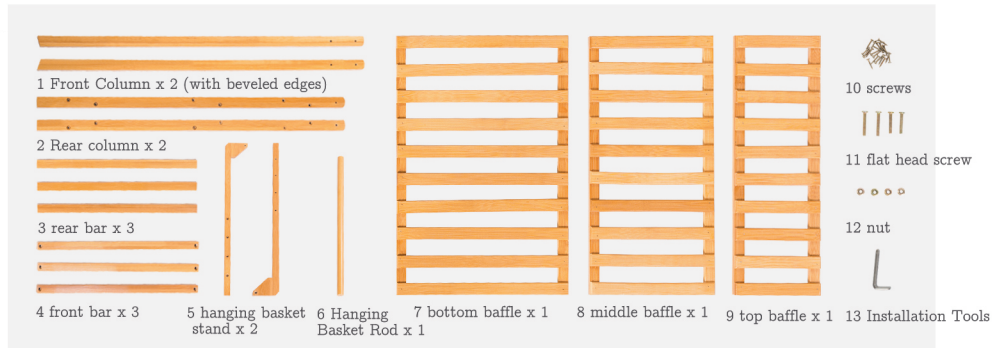


Installation guide

Simple composition (The following is an example of 50 primary colours)

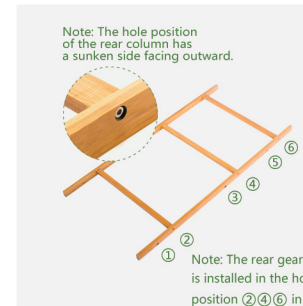


! Installation Tips

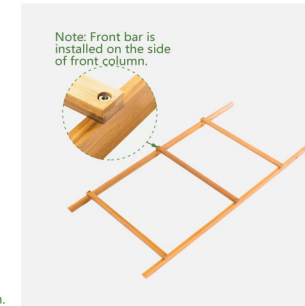
- ① Please read the instructions carefully to understand the cautions in installation and maintenance of flower racks.
- ② Follow the assembly instructions strictly.
- ③ Check carefully whether the parts in the packing box are complete or not.
- ④ Assemble on packing boxes to avoid damage to flower racks and room floors
- ⑤ Clean the flower rack surface only with a rag or a slightly wet cloth. Do not use strong scrubbing.
- ⑥ The use of mismatched parts may lead to product damage. Please confirm various parts types before assembling.



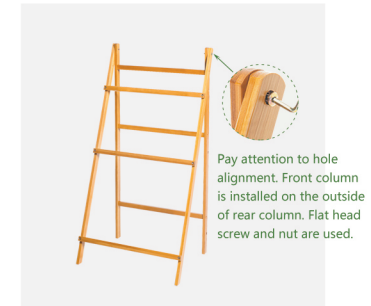
Start assembling ! Wear gloves when installing flower racks



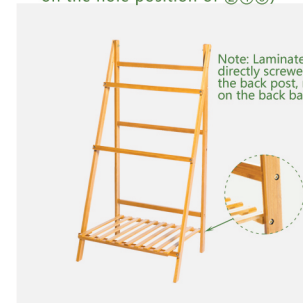
- ① Take out the rear column and the rear bar for installation (as shown in the figure, the rear bar is installed in turn on the hole position of ②④⑥)



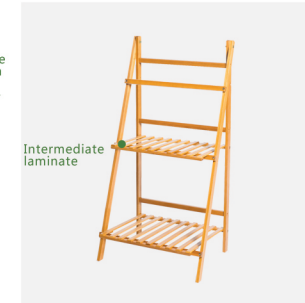
- ② Take out the front column and the front bar for installation, as shown in the figure.



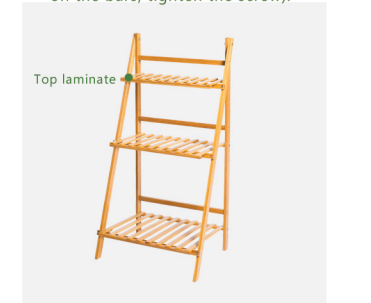
- ③ Fix the top of the front and rear columns with screw (as shown in the figure, there are holes on both bars, align the holes on the bars, tighten the screw).



- ④ Take out the bottom laminate and install it between the front column and the rear column (as shown in the figure, there are holes on the two rear columns, align the laminate to the holes and tighten the screw).



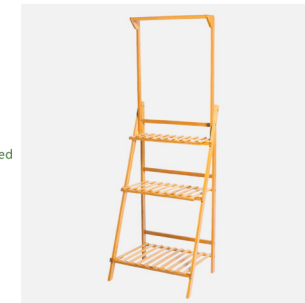
- ⑤ Take out the middle panel and install it in the same way as shown in the figure.



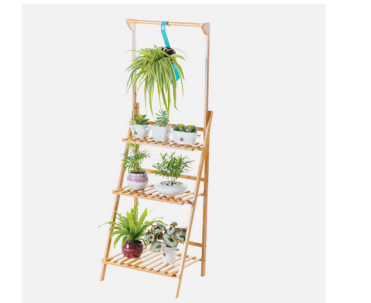
- ⑥ Remove the top panel and install it in the same way as shown in the figure.



- ⑦ Remove the suspension basket foot and install it on the front column (as shown in the figure, the suspension basket foot is provided with a number of different height holes, which can adjust the height freely).



- ⑧ Finally, remove the suspension basket and install it as shown in the figure.



- ⑨ Is the installation procedure very simple? Put your potted plants on the table!
