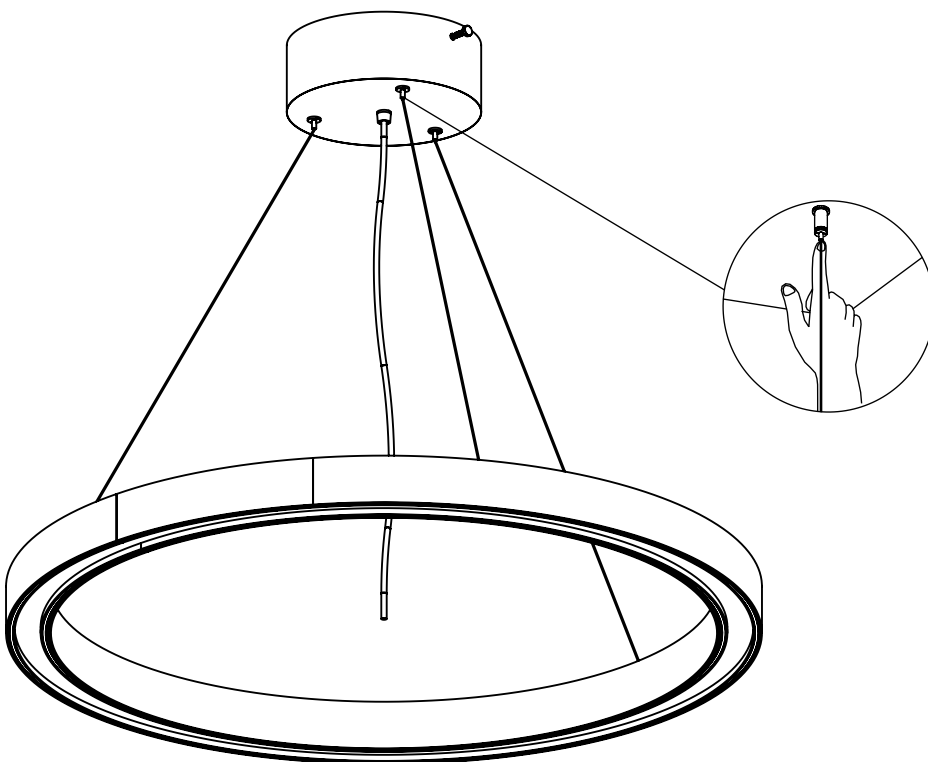

INSTALLING THE FIXTURE ON CEILING

Turn OFF the power before start the installation.

- ① Pass the support steel cables through the holes on adjustable make sure that the end pass through the hole in the side. Then, screw these assemblies into each anchor fixed on ceiling.

Reserve excess cable by wrapping it or cut it using suitable pliers.

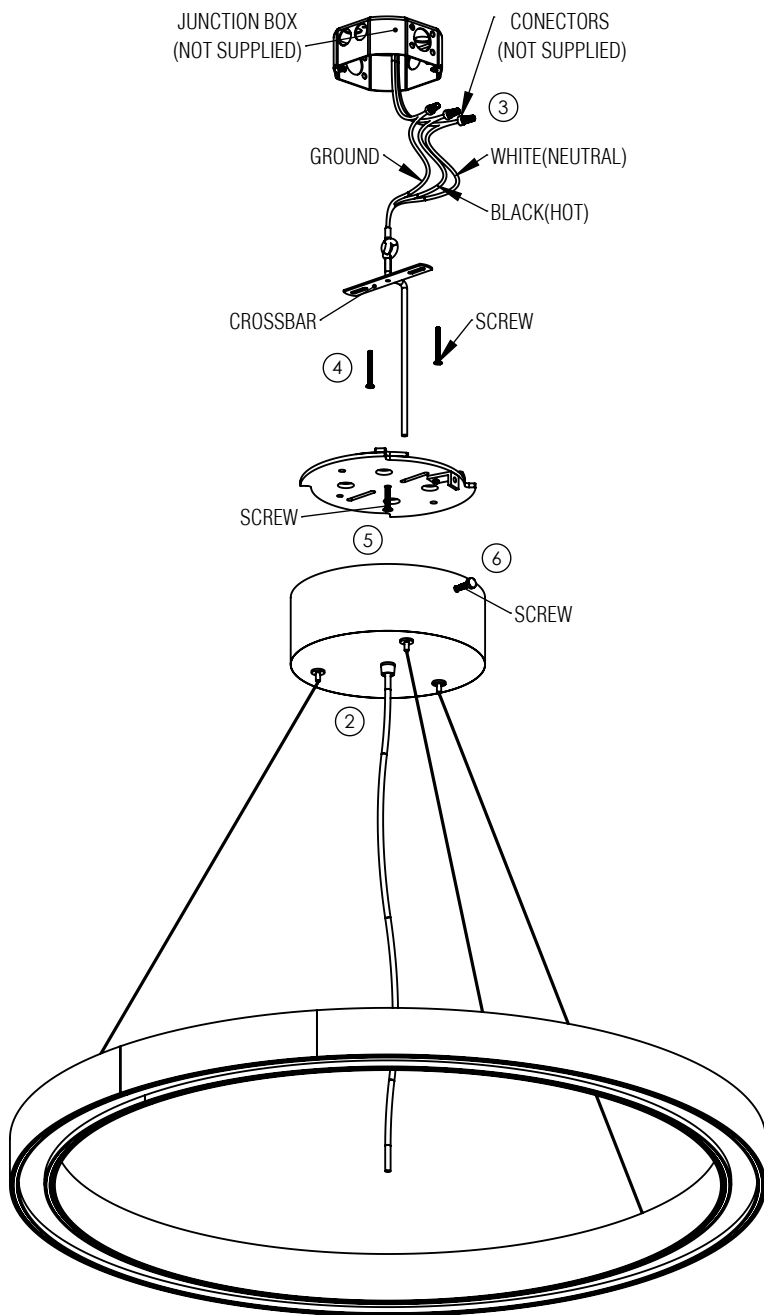

MAKING ELECTRICAL CONNECTIONS

- ② Pass the power supply cable through the strain relief cone, threaded tube nipple, canopies and crossbar.
- ③ Connect the electrical supply wires to the junction box in accordance to all applicable local codes, as shown in the diagram.

MOUNTING ON THE FIXTURE

- ④ Attach the crossbar to the junction box using the supplied screws.
- ⑤ Bring the canopy base to the ceiling and secure it by screwing.
- ⑥ Bring the canopy to the ceiling and secure it by screwing the side of the canopy at its base.

Turn ON electrical power.

Your luminaire is now ready for use.
