


## Before Beginning Assembly:









<u>Step 7</u>	

With assistance from your adult partner(s), turn the Sunlounger right side up.

Inspect the Sunlouger and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

In a sequential manner, tighten all Screws and Bolts at all joints.

CAUTION : When tightening these screws and bolts, tighten sequentially.

DO NOT tighten any screw or bolt fully and then move towards the next one. This could cause the frame to warp.

WARNING!! IF THE SUNLOUNGER IS NOT STABLE, IT COULD LEAD TO DAMAGE OF THE PRODUCT. Your Sunlounger is ready to be used.
