

CEILING FAN SIZING

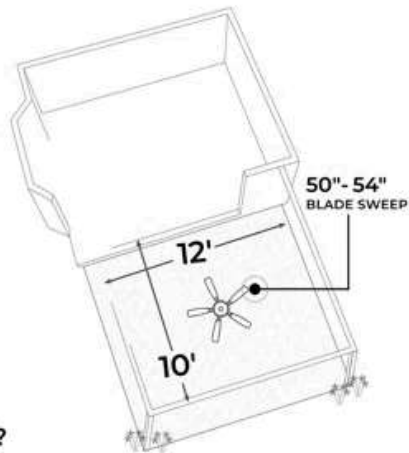
For All Your Spaces

- Determine the square footage of your space.**
Measure the length and the width of the space and then multiply. For example:

$$\begin{array}{ccc} \underbrace{10 \text{ Ft.}} & \times & \underbrace{12 \text{ Ft.}} & = & \underbrace{120 \text{ Sq. Ft.}} \\ \text{Width} & & \text{Length} & & \text{Space Area} \end{array}$$

- Find the right size ceiling fan.**

Space Size	Blade Sweep
90 SQ. FT. OR LESS	15" - 42"
90 - 100 SQ. FT.	44" - 48"
100 - 150 SQ. FT.	50" - 54"
150 - 300 SQ. FT.	56" - 70"
300+ SQ. FT.	70"+ or Multiple Fans



- High ceilings or outdoor spaces?**
Size up! These spaces require a larger fan for better airflow. Ideal fan installation should have a clearance of 8-9 feet under the blades.
