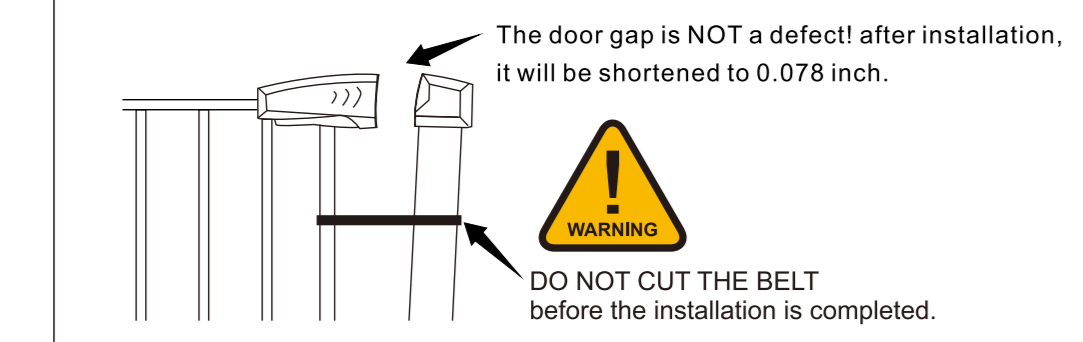


AUTO CLOSE SAFETY GATE Installation Instructions

WARNING:
To help your installation, **Do not cut off the belt** before installation is completed! **The door gap is NOT a defect!** It will be shortened to 0.078 inch after installation.

Product & Parts

a Main Gate	b Extension	c Tension Bolt
d Wall Cup	f Wrench	g Reinforcement Slot
h Dry Wall Anchor	i Screw	

WARNING: This package contains small parts and sharp points in an unassembled state. Keep out of reach of children. Adult assembly required.

Special Reminder

Optional for Pressure Mounted and Hardware Mounted, Two installation methods, you can choose any one

INSTALLATION GUIDE

METHOD A: Pressure Mounted follow STEP 1→2→3→4

METHOD B: Hardware Mounted follow STEP 1→2→5→6→3→4

Notice: screw in Mounting Cups when using gate on stairs

Bottom of stairs

If the gate is used at the bottom of the stairs to prevent the child from climbing up the stairs, it must be placed on the lowest stair.

floor

Top of stairs

If the gate is used at the top of the stairs to prevent the child from falling down the stairs, it must be placed on any stair below the level of the top stair.

Method A: Pressure Mounted Installation

STEP 1. Measure the width of the opening where you intend to install the gate. Please refer to the following diagrams to determine the correct installation configuration.

29.5"~32.3"	32.3"~35"	35"~37.8"	37.8"~40.5"

STEP 2. Insert 4 bolts into 4 corners of the gate/extension. Add the reinforcement slot at the bottom.

Notice: The bottom of the gate frame must be CLOSE to the floor, do not hang on the ground

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STEP 3. Rotate both of the bottom Tension Bolts clockwise at the same time. Note: Make sure the bottom of the gate frame remains completely flat on the floor. Next, Rotate both of the top Tension Bolt clockwise at the same time.

Rotate the bolts until the gap about 0.07in(The best gap is 0.078in ≈ 2mm)

Rotate 4 bolts

STEP 4. Cut off the belt and test the gate:
1. Push the gate to check stability.
2. Open and close the walk through gate

Opening Method:
Press the up & down button at same time and lift the gate panel UP to open.

Finish pressure mounted installation

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Method B: Hardware Mounted Installation

Repeat step 1 & step 2, then follow the below step ↓

STEP 5. Pre-assemble the gate, and locate four points for hole drilling. Hold the wall cup in position and mark the center with a pencil. Then remove the gate

STEP 6. Drill hole for the 4 marked positions, then put dry wall anchor(h), and use screw (i) and (e) to fix the wall cup (d).

The product does not contain the installation tool

Then repeat step 3, step 4 and step 5

Finish hardware mounted installation

TROUBLE SHOTING

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If the walk through gate does not close properly:

A. Tension bolts need to be adjusted.
Solution: Loosen or tighten the upper tension bolts. Ensure the upper latch handle engages securely when the gate swings closed. (Please refer to step 6)

B. Gate is not properly aligned onto the door frame.
Solution: Adjust the gate by loosening all tension bolts and reposition gate. Make sure the gate is properly aligned onto the door frame/door opening. Then re-tighten tension bolts.

If you need to reinstall the gate elsewhere in the future:
Solution: Use a rope/belt to tie the guardrail before removing, otherwise you may need the assistance of others to help you install it.

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WARNING

- To prevent serious injury or death, securely install gate or enclosure and use according to manufacturer's instructions.
- Never use with a child able to climb over or dislodge the gate or enclosure.
- This product will not necessarily prevent all accidents.
- Never leave child unattended.
- Use only with the locking mechanism securely engaged.
- Intended for use with children from 6 months through 24 months of age.
- Stop using gate if any parts are missing or become damaged.
- Periodically check all fasteners to be sure they are tight and secure.
- Adult Assembly Required.
- The surfaces that the gate is to be fixed to must be suitable for the purpose and must be structurally sound;
- Indoor use only, is not to be exposed to outdoor elements;
- Install this gate away from heaters and other sources of heat.

- Children have died or been seriously injured when gates are not securely installed.
- ALWAYS install and use gates as directed using all required parts.
- You MUST install wall cups to keep gate in place. Without wall cups, child can push out and escape.
- NEVER use to keep child away from pool.
- Gates that are recommended for use at the top of stairs shall specify where the gate must be installed as a minimum distance to the first step of the stairs.
