Installation Instruction for Room Divider Track

STEP 1:

Step 1. Measure the exact length of the track needed.



STEP 2:



Step 2. If the track length needed to be shortened, mark the track at the desired cutting point.

STEP 3:



Step 3. Cut at the marked piece of track to the desired length. Note: Power saw is recommended for a better result; however use the saw included if you don't have power saw.

STEP 4:



Step 4. Hold the track to the ceiling where it is to be installed and mark all the pre-drilled holes across the length of the track on the ceiling for drilling. Note: This process will be easier if you have a second person to hold up the track while marking the holes.

STEP 5:



Step 5. Place the end cap piece on 1 side and tighten the end cap screw till flush with the track surface. Note: Don't over tighten the screw.

STEP 6:



Step 6. Using a ¼ inch drill bit, drill the holes in the ceiling at the marked locations. Insert the mounting screw plastic anchors on all drilled holes and tap it with your hand or use mallet. Note: for ceiling made out of wood, please screw directly to the ceiling

STEP 7:



Step 7. Screw the track directly to the ceiling, placing one screw through each of the pre-drilled holes across the length of the track. Be sure that there is a screw within 6 inches of each end of the track.

STEP 8:

Step 8. Place as many hook sliders needed.



STEP 9:



Step 9. Hang your room divider curtain(s) by placing the grommets on the hook sliders.



Step 10. Install the end cap piece on the opposite end of the track.



STEP 11:



Step 11. Tighten the screw on the end cap.



STEP 12:



Step 12. There you have it! A ceiling track room divider kit setup in no time. Note: With multiple track piece installations, ensure that each additional track piece is precisely aligned with the next one, first to last, to complete the system. Additional holes may need to be drilled in the flange of the track to complete your particular installation.
