Introduction

The box is an intelligent controller. With 5 touch buttons, it can turn ON/OFF the light and turn ON/OFF the induction function, change light colors, and adjust the light luminance.



Operation



This touch button is the master switch of the smart box,

which can turn off all functions of the box and control the light strips on/off operation.

The operation that can be turned on and off with just a light tap. Press and hold to adjust the brightness. Upon first power-up, the default light will be set to white.



This touch button is used to turn on/off the induction function.

A. touch this button once to turn on the induction function (indicator light on).

After the person leaves or remains stationary for more than 30 seconds, the light strip goes out; people and objects within a range of 1 meters move will light up the light strip.

B. Long press this button for 0.5 seconds to turn off the human body induction function (the indicator light goes out). At this point, keep the light strip as it was before turning off and no longer be affected by human and object activities. By default, induction function is enabled when powered on.



This touch button is the Dynamic Phantom Color Mode, which includes 5 magical lighting effects.

Simply tap to cycle through the options. (Attention: This mode cannot adjust the brightness)



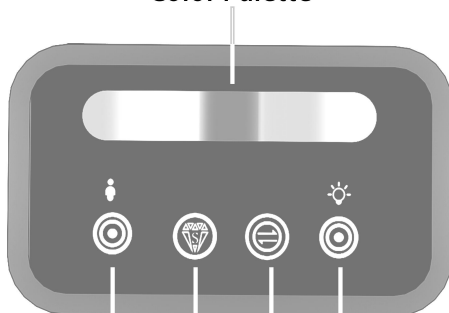
