

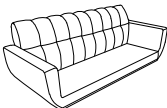
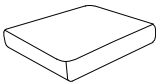
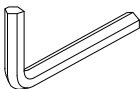
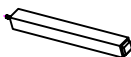
# Assembly Instruction



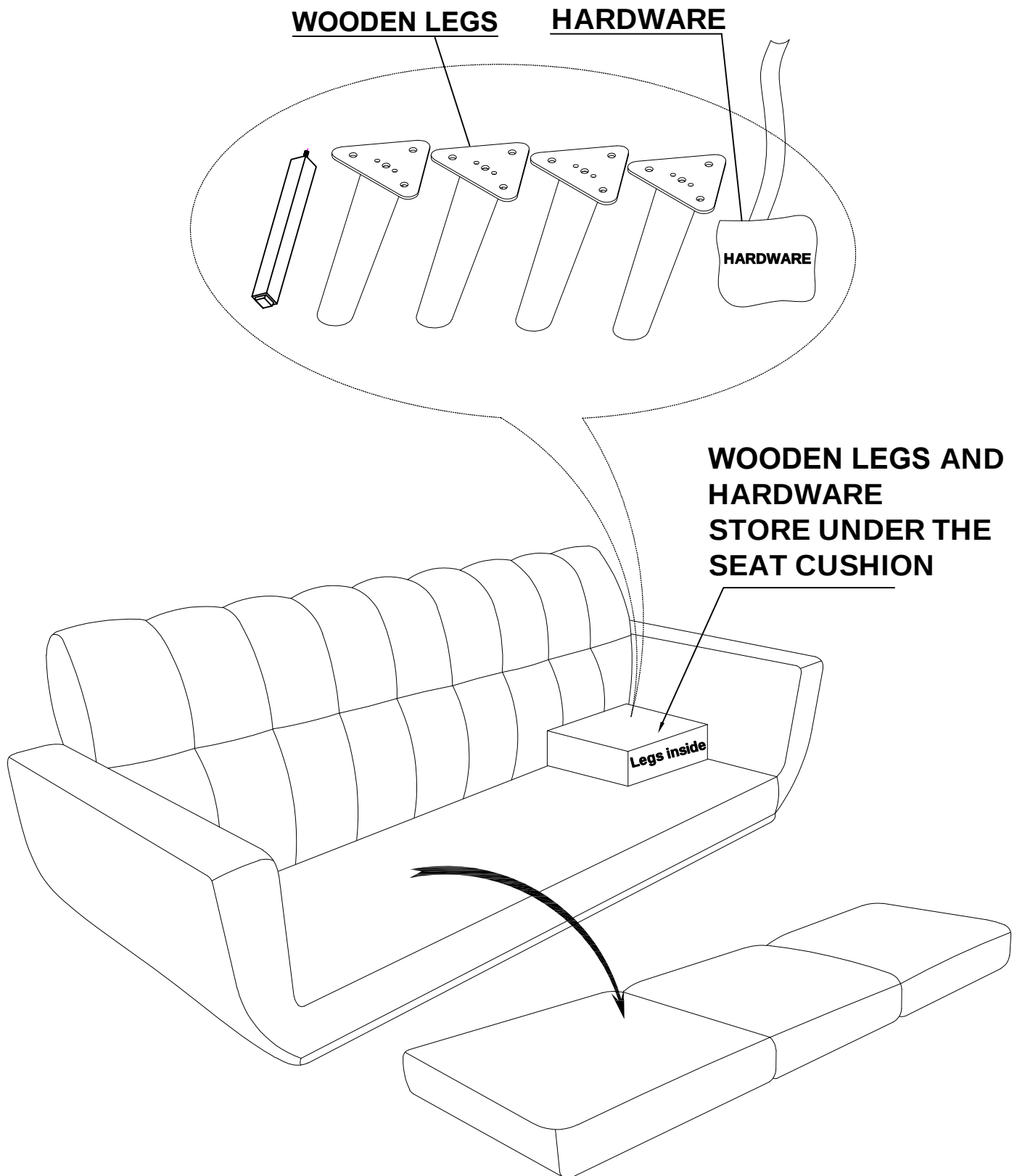
**Legs & hardware are stored under the seat cushion, please take out the legs and hardware for assembly.**

**Note: Do not use power tools for assembly. Power tools increase the risk of over tightening which lead to splitting or cracking the wood.**

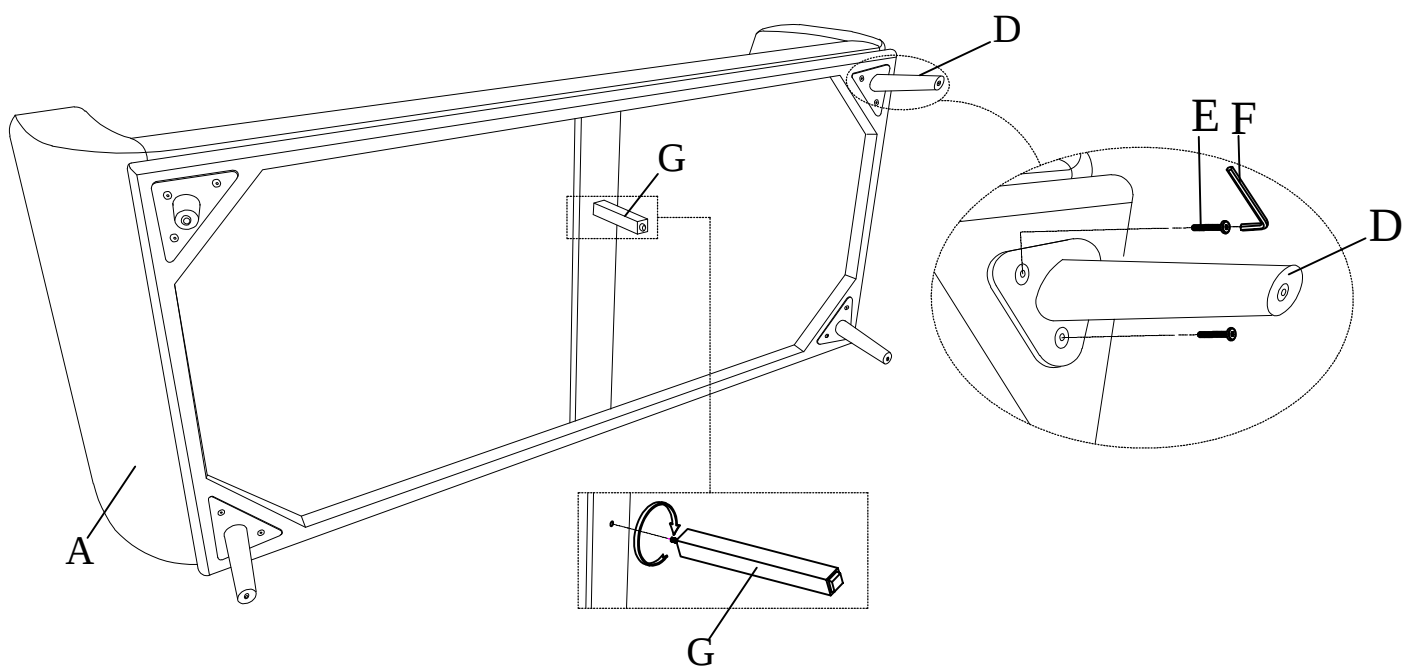

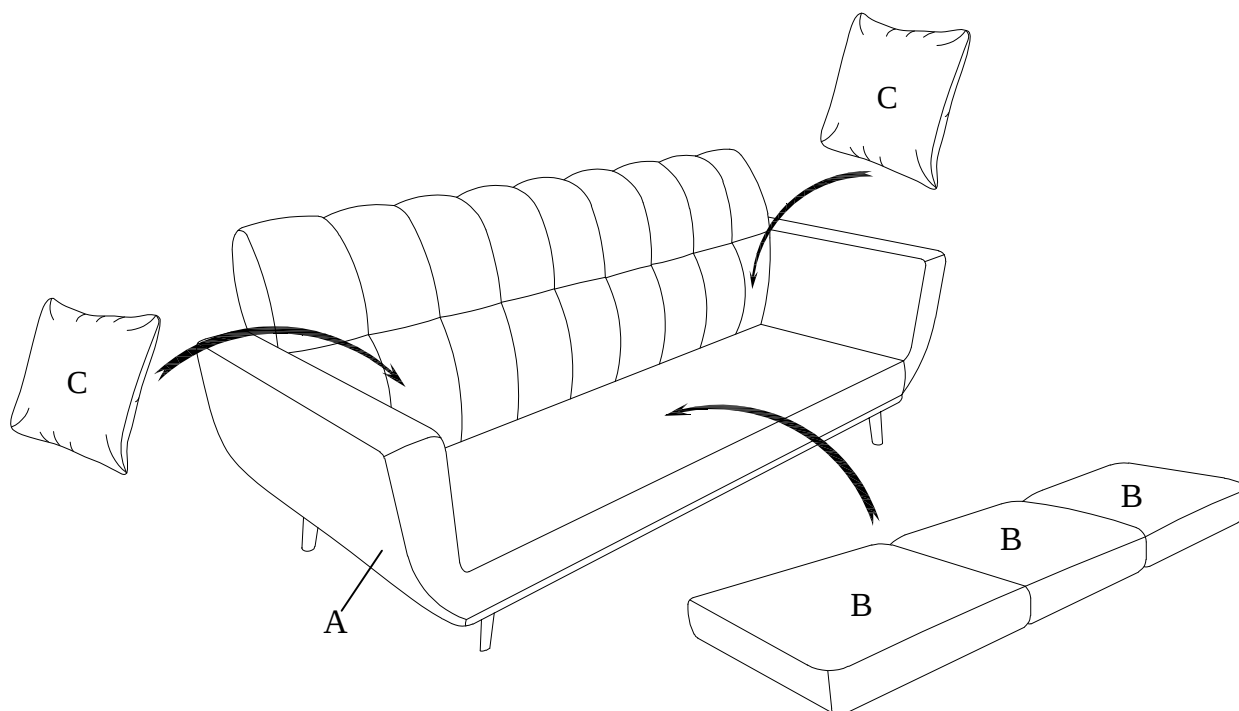

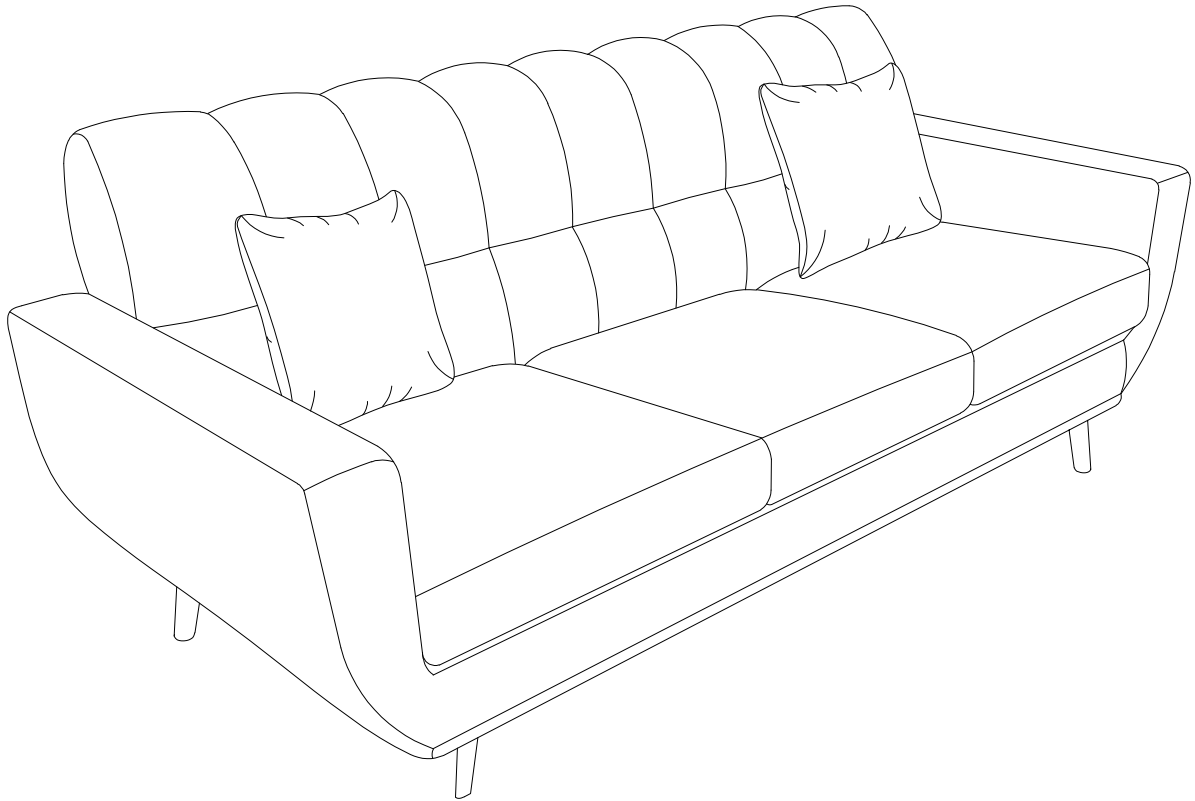

## **Care Instruction for chenille fabric Furniture:**

**In order to maintain the original appearance of your chenille fabric, please follow below simple care procedures:**

- **Avoid exposing furniture directly to sunlight or heating and air conditioning outlets. Sunlight and/or exposure to heating and air conditioning outlets will fade/damage chenille fabrics. Do not place your upholstered furniture too close to windows, radiators, or vents, and be sure to use windows, radiators, or vents.**
- **Vacuum or wipe with a soft cloth to remove dust.**
- **Hardware may loosen over time. Periodically check to make sure all connections are tight. Re-tighten if necessary.**



**For items use on wooden floor, hard surfaces or carpets, it is recommended to Install protective pads under all legs and supports to avoid/prevent from damages/scratches and discoloration.**
