# Tall Bookcase




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#### Part Identification

While not all parts are labeled, some of the parts will have a label or an inked letter on the edge to help distinguish similar parts from each other. Use this part identification to help identify similar parts.






(1G) SAFETY BRACKET - 1




(4G) METAL BRACKET - 8




(31G) CORNER BRACKET - 2





- Assemble your unit on a carpeted floor or on the empty carton to avoid scratching your unit or the floor.
- Push thirty-two HIDDEN CAMS (1F) into the ENDS (A and B), TOP (D), BOTTOM (E), and SHELVES (F and G). Then, insert the metal end of a CAM DOWEL (2F) into each HIDDEN CAM, except the ENDS (A and B) and TOP (D).







Fasten the UPRIGHT (C) to the TOP (D). Use two BLACK 1-7/8" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (2S).




Do <u>not</u> stand the unit upright without the BACK fastened. The unit may collapse.




- Insert a METAL PIN (1R) into each SHELF (F).
- Fasten the SHELVES (F) to the UPRIGHT (C). Tighten two HIDDEN CAMS.
- NOTE: Be sure the METAL PINS (1R) in the SHELVES (F) insert into the holes in the UPRIGHT (C).







- Insert two METAL PINS (1R) into each PINNED SHELF (G).
- Insert the METAL PINS (1R) in one end of the PINNED SHELVES (G) into the holes in the UPRIGHT (C).




Fasten the BOTTOM (E) to the UPRIGHT (C). Use two BLACK 1-7/8" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (2S).





- Insert fourteen METAL PINS (1R) into the SHELVES (F and G).
- Fasten the ENDS (A and B) to the TOP (D), BOTTOM (E), and SHELVES (F). Tighten ten HIDDEN CAMS.
- NOTE: Be sure the METAL PINS (1R) in the SHELVES (F and G) insert into the holes in the ENDS (A and B).
- Fasten the BASES (J and K) to the ENDS (A and B). Use four BLACK 1-1/4" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (7S).






- Fasten seven METAL BRACKETS (4G) to the ENDS (A and B) and BOTTOM (E). Use seven BLACK 9/16" LARGE HEAD SCREWS (1S).
- NOTE: Be sure the BRACKETS are even with the edges of the ENDS and BOTTOM.
- Fasten the BASE (I) to the ENDS (A and B) and BOTTOM (E). Use seven BLACK 9/16" LARGE HEAD SCREWS (1S) through the METAL BRACKETS and into the BASE.





- Fasten two CORNER BRACKETS (31G) to the MOLDINGS (N and O) and TOP (D). Use eight BLACK 9/16" LARGE HEAD SCREWS (1S).
- Fasten a METAL BRACKET (4G) to the TOP (D). Use a BLACK 9/16" LARGE HEAD SCREW (1S).

Fasten the FRONT MOLDING (M) to the TOP (D) and MOLDINGS (N and O). Use five BLACK 9/16" LARGE HEAD SCREWS (1S) through the METAL BRACKET (4G) and CORNER BRACKETS (31G) and into the




- Carefully turn your unit over onto its front edges. Unfold the BACK (H) and lay it over your unit.
- Make equal margins along all four edges of the BACK (H). Push on opposite corners of your unit if needed to make it "square".
- Fasten the BACK (H) to your unit using the NAILS (1N).
- NOTE: Be sure to tap NAILS into the holes that line up over the UPRIGHT (C) and SHELVES (F and G).




Do <u>not</u> stand the unit upright without the BACK fastened. The unit may collapse.





- ▼ Carefully stand your unit upright.
- We recommend using the SAFETY BRACKET (1G) for added stability. Use a BLACK 9/16" LARGE HEAD SCREW (1S) into the top of the unit and a BLACK 1-7/8" FLAT HEAD SCREW (2S) into a stud in your wall.
- Push a CAM COVER (13P) onto each visible HIDDEN CAM.
- Separate the CARDS on the CARD SHEET (38M) and insert into the CARD HOLDERS.
- NOTE: Please read the back pages of the instruction booklet for important safety information.
- This completes assembly. Clean with your favorite furniture polish or a damp cloth. Wipe dry.

Improperly moving furniture that is not designed and equipped with casters.	<ul> <li>Furniture can tip over or break if improperly moved.</li> <li>Physical injury.
