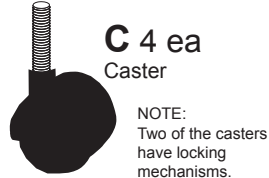
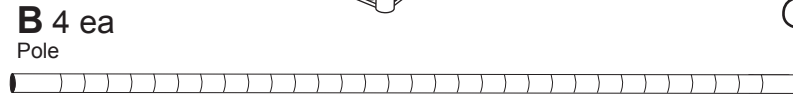
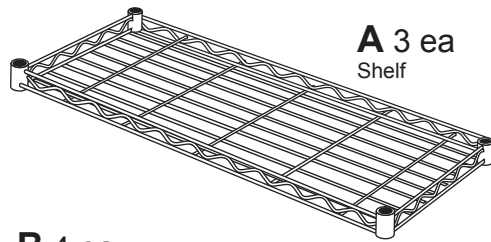


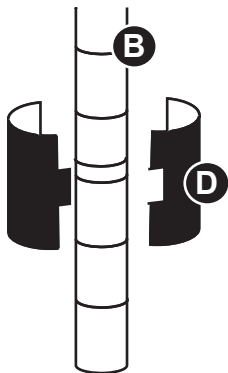
Laundry Cart



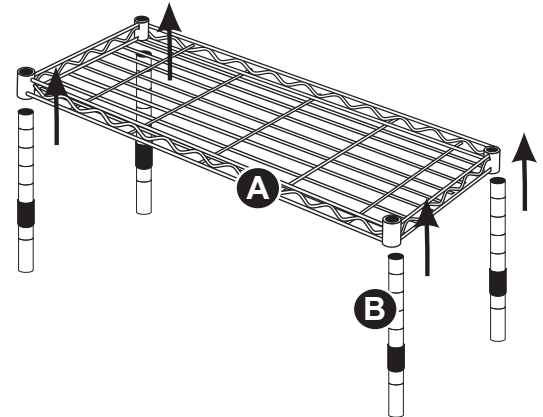
Assembly Time:

household items.

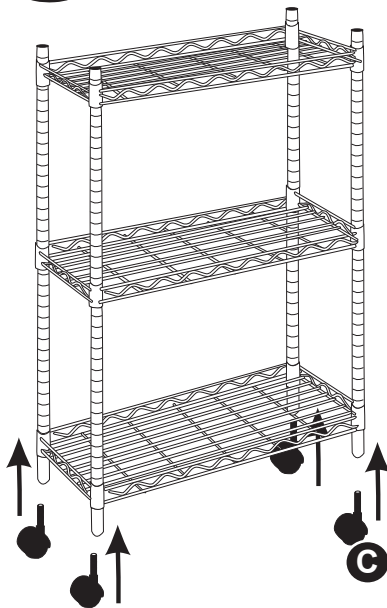
Tools Needed: No additional tools
required. A wrench is included. A
rubber mallet might help to seat
shelves onto sleeves.



STEP 1 Starting at the bottom (the end with the plastic cap is the top), snap two plastic sleeves (D) onto poles (B) at double grooves (suggested placement) located near bottom of the poles. The sleeves are marked with a directional arrow to show proper placement. Use grooves on poles to ensure even shelf placement among the four poles. NOTE: Place only enough sleeves to assemble bottom shelf. This step will be repeated for each shelf.



STEP 2 Slide poles (B) through shelf corners (A) until shelf rests firmly on sleeves. Push or gently tap the shelf down at corners to level shelf.



STEP 3 Repeat step 2 until all shelves are placed on the poles, sliding middle shelf over top of poles next and then the top shelf. Screw casters (C) into bottom of each of the four poles. Use included wrench tool (E) to tighten casters.
