Open the velcro decking on the bottom of the seat frame (#1) to find parts and hardware.

Align back frames (#2,3) to the seat frame (#1), then secure by using bolts (#A) with washers (#B,C).

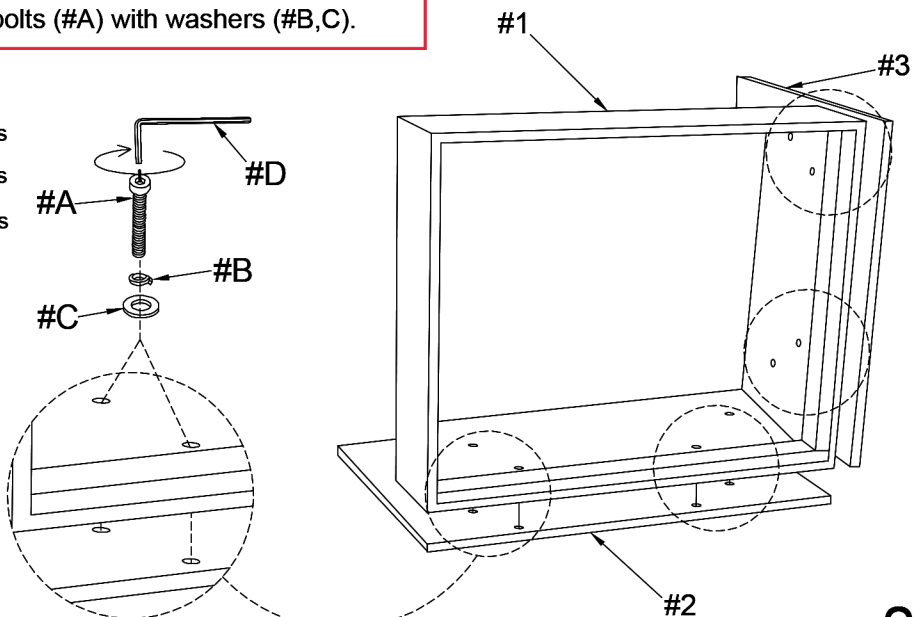

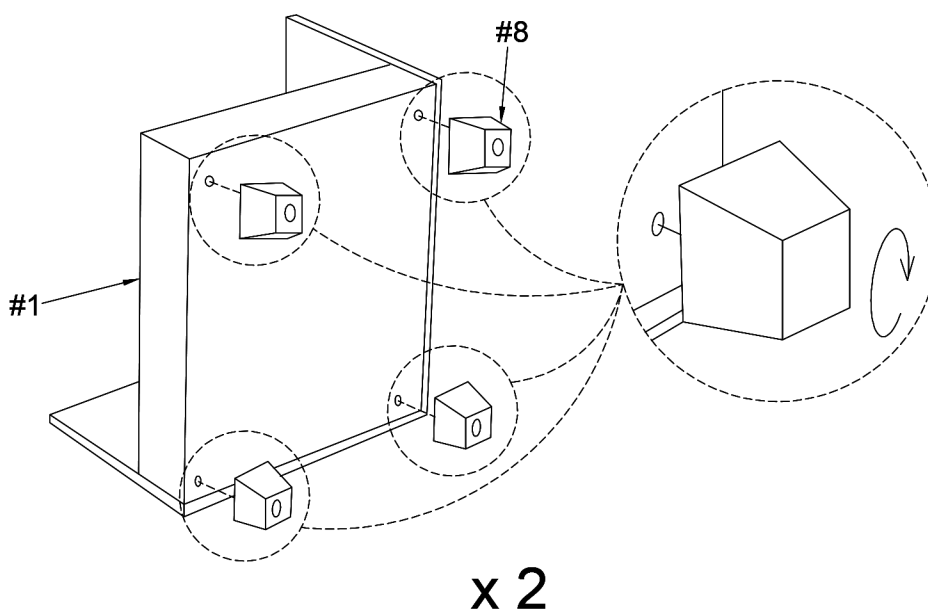

Attach seat frame velcro back, then attach legs (#8) to the seat frame.



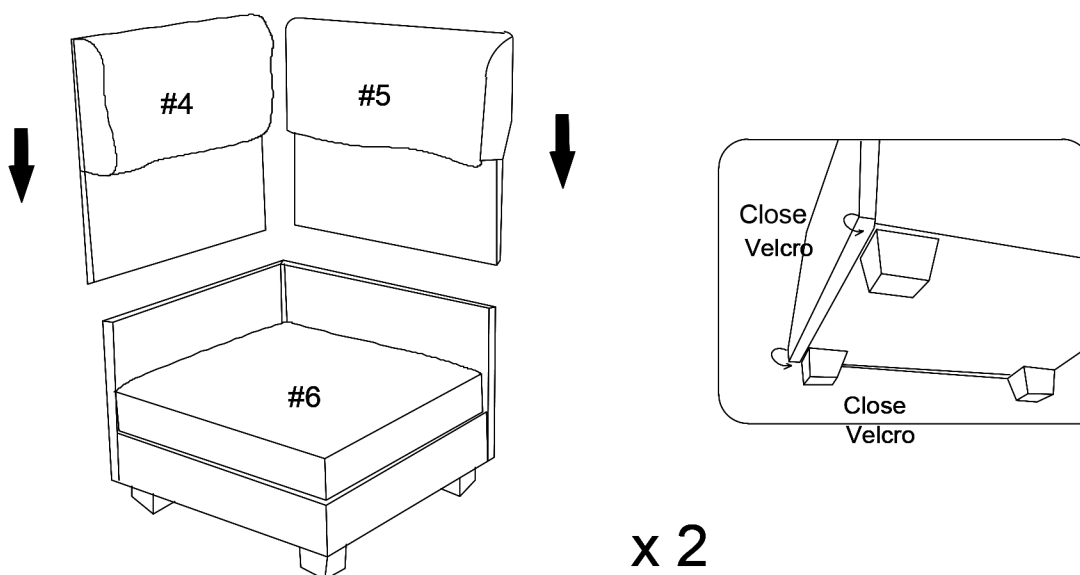

Exploded View

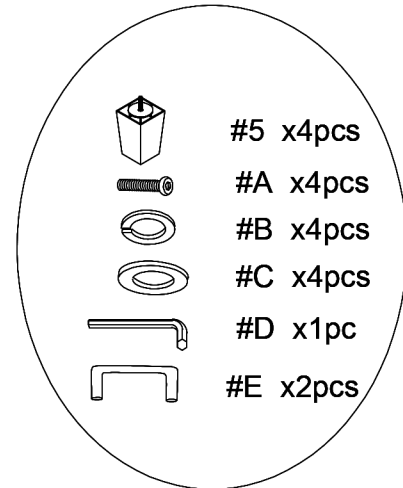

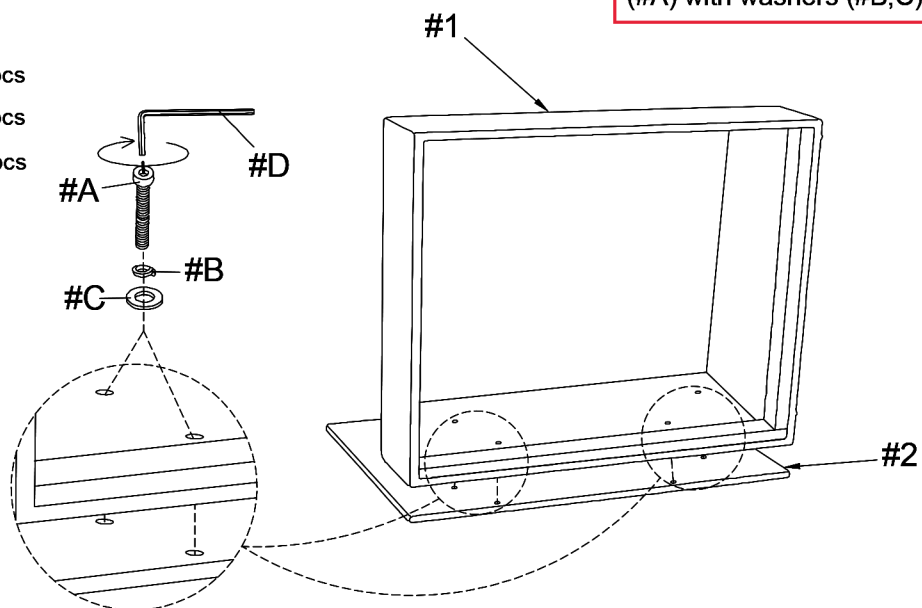


Open up the velcro on the bottom of the seat frame (#1) to find parts and hardwares.

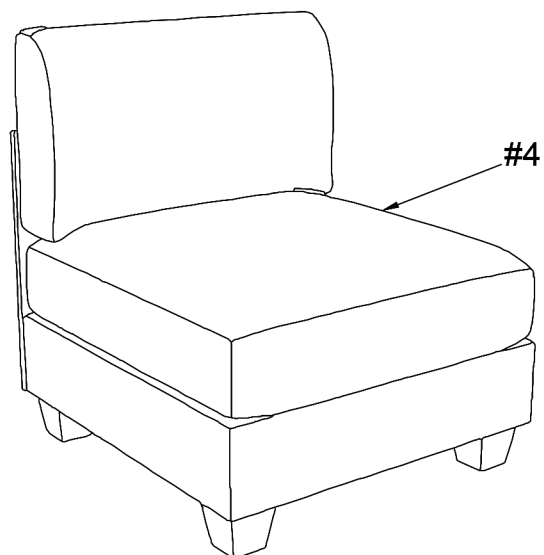


Align chair cushion (#3) to frame, then secure by attaching velcro together.

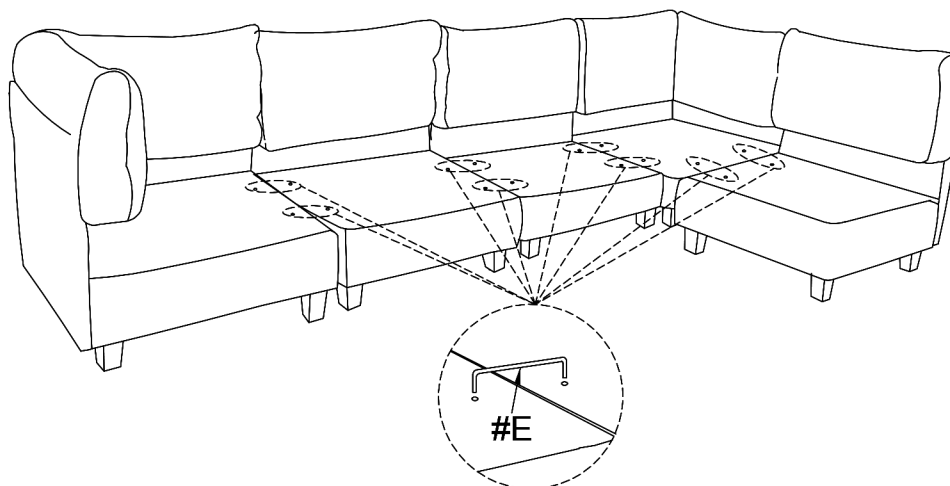

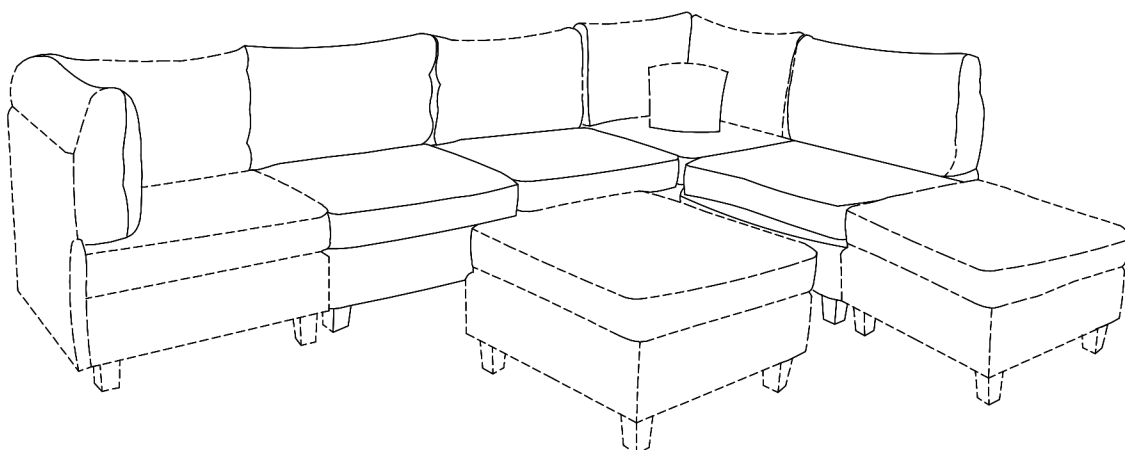
