

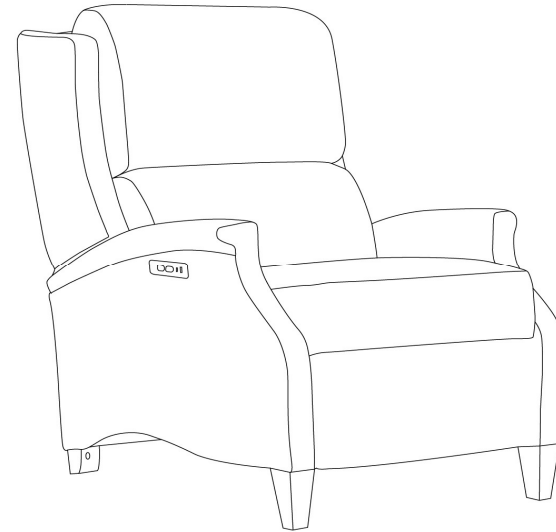
# LY & S Assembly Instructions

## Power Recliner

### IMPORTANT NOTE

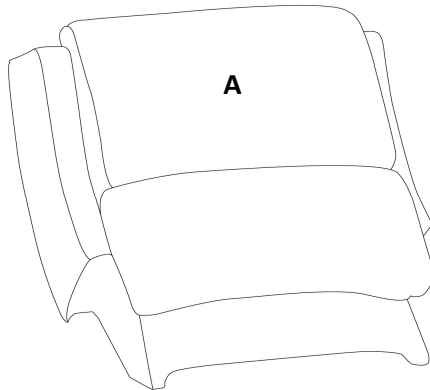
Read these instructions carefully, and familiarize yourself with each procedure before assembling the furniture. Check that you have all the component parts, and familiarize yourself with each part before proceeding.

Take all the fittings out of the plastic bag and separate them into groups. Ensure you have enough space to lay out all the parts before assembly. To prevent damage to the parts, we recommend that you assemble the unit on a soft, level surface.

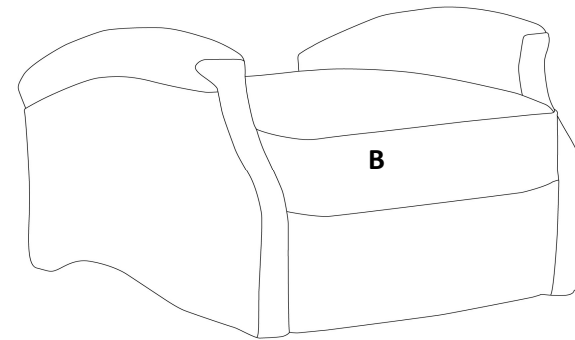


## Part List

## Assembly Instructions

### STEP 1

Detach the transformer and sofa legs from the back of the Seat (B). (See Figure 1.)

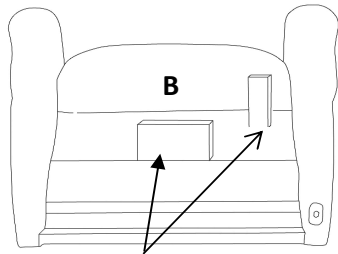

### STEP 2

Transformer x1; screws x2; screwdriver x1; front legs(higher) x2; back legs x2

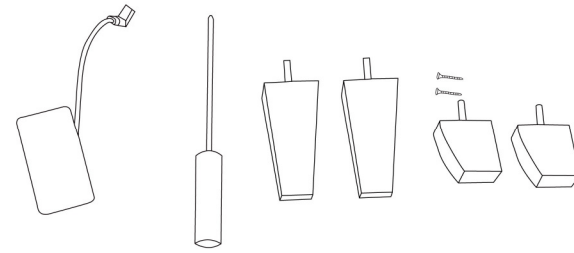

### STEP 3

Install the legs as Figure 3

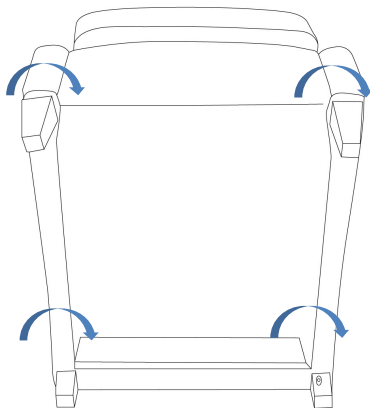

### STEP 4

Install the screws for back leg with screwdriver. (See Figure 4.)

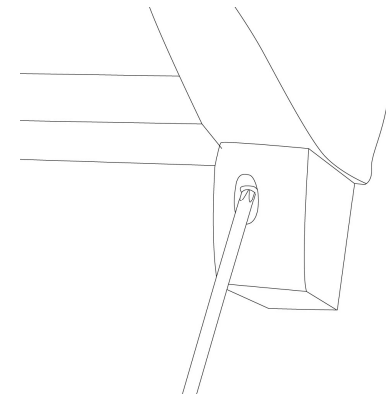

## STEP 5

Attach the Back (A) to the Seat (B). Ensure latches are secure. (See Figure 5.)

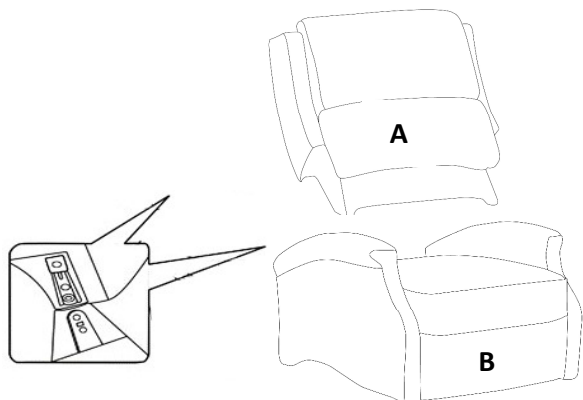

## STEP 6

Connect the headrest cable to the power button control cable, and place them behind the flap

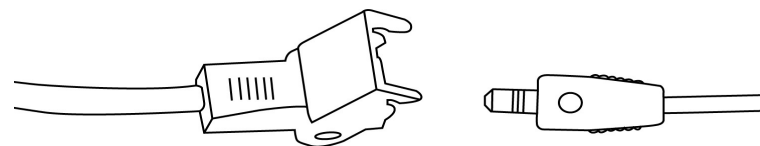

## STEP 7

Flip up the back flap. Connect the transformer cable to the power button control cable, and place them behind the flap. (See Figure 7.)

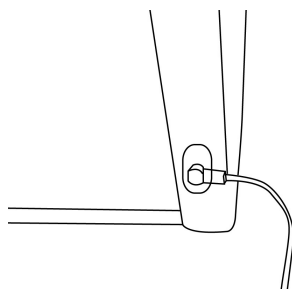

## STEP 8

Fasten the back flap to the bottom of the furniture. (See Figure 8.)

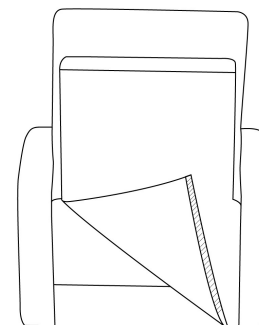
