Warnings and Cautions

Thank you for choosing our Outdoor storage shed. Please read and understand this entire manual before attempting to assemble or install the product.

The shed is intended for storage purposes only. It is not designed for habitation.

GENERAL BESTPRACTICES FOR ASSEMBLY

- 1. Please check with your local governing authority/local municipal codes regarding installation and permitting of such structures before assembly.
- 2. The assembled Outdoor storage shed should be located at least 6 feet from any obstruct ion such as fence, garage, house, overhanging branches, laundry lines or electrical wires.
- 3. It is strongly recommended to secure the shed to an immovable object or anchor to the ground by drilling holes in the shed floor (at the pre-marked locations) and inserting proper screws into the ground (screws are not included).
- 4. Familiarize yourself with the product and check all parts against the packing list. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not install. Contact us immediately.
- 5. Always wear work gloves, safety goggles and long sleeves when assembling or performing any maintenance on your shed.
- 6. Save all packing materials until assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding smaller parts or hardware.
- 7. Requires two or more people to assemble and install safely and correctly.

WARNINGS

To reduce the risk of serious injury, read the following safety instructions thoroughly before assembling and using the Outdoor storage shed.

- 8. The product is required to be installed on level solid surface and is not intended for unsecured use. The Outdoor storage shed is to be anchored to the surface with appropriate bolts or anchors. Do not assemble the gazebo on soil, earth, or bare ground.
- 9. Keep children and pets away from the working area during assembly and adjustments.
- 10. Please ensure that there is no snow or leaves on the roof. A large amount of snow on the roof can damage the cabin and make it unsafe. This product has passed the wind resistance test: level 8 (46 miles per hour), and the roof load test with a capacity of 800 pounds.
- 11. On snowy days, it is necessary to regularly clear the accumulated snow. You can use plastic rakes to remove the excessive snow and ice blocks on the roof. Take corresponding safety precautions to prevent the fallen snow from causing damage.
- 12. Do not leave children unattended around or inside outdoor storage sheds.
- 13. The weight of the items hung on the hooks inside the roof should not exceed 30 pounds.
- 14. Avoid using a lawnmower or mechanical scythe near the shed.
- 15. Wash the shed with a garden hose or a mild detergent solution. Do not use a metal brush or abrasive cleaners, including degreasers and oil- or acetone-based cleaning materials, as these may stain or damage the shed.
- 16. Do not store hot items, such as recently used grills and blowtorches, and volatile chemicals in the shed.
- 17. Wind direction is an important factor to consider when determining the location of the shed.

Reduce exposure to the wind, in general, and of the door side in particular. Keep doors closed and locked when the shed is not in use to prevent wind damage.

18. Do not stand on the roof.

Lost accessories or parts costs will be incurred after 90 days of the date of purchase.




Site preparation

1. Leveling the ground.




2. Recommendation: Construct a wooden or concrete base as a foundation.
