




Assembly: Steps 1-2

- 1. Place the Tub Basin (A) onto the Tub base (C). Attach the Basin using a Hex Bolt (E), Washer (F), Spring Washer (G), and Nut (H) in every pre-drilled hole in the Tub base (C) as pictured in the illustration to the right.
- 2. Place the Sponge Gasket (J) around the bottom of the Drain (I), then place them into the designated hole on the bottom of the Tub Basin (A). Place the Rubber Gasket (K) under the Drain (I), then use the Fixed Nut (L) to secure the Rubber Gasket (K) into place under the drain. Connect the Plumbing Hose (M) to the Drain.




Assembly continued: Steps 3-4

- 3) Place the Tub Racks (B) into the Tub Basin (A).
- **4)** To raise the Tub Racks (B), rest them on the Tub Rack Ledge in the center of the Tub Basin (A).



Assembly continued: Steps 5-7

- 5) Adjust leveling feet on the Tub Base (C) to have the drain approximately 1/8" lower than the opposite side of the tub. This allows water to drain better.
- **6)** Adjust Retractable Ramp (D) to desired position.
- 7) Rotate the Side Door Lock(N) to open and close.



CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Rinse thoroughly after bathing pet. Make sure tub is clean and dry after use. Clean with mild soap or a stainless steel-approved cleaner only. Do not use harsh or abrasive cleaners, bleach, or tools with metal or textured parts, as these can scratch or damage the tub.
