5' BED

IMPORTANT : READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE ASSEMBLING OR USING YOUR 5' BED FRAME

PLEASE KEEP THESE INSTRUCTIONS FOR FUTURE REFERENCE.

HEALTH & SAFETY:

DO NOT jump on this bed frame.

DO NOT use this bed frame if any parts are missing, damaged or worn.

DO NOT use this bed frame unless all fixings are secured.

Please keep small parts out of reach of children.

Always use on a level, even surface.

WARNING : If this bed is placed on a non- carpeted floor you must place some protection under all legs to stop the bed frame from moving. if this is not adhered to there is no guarantee if the bed frame collapses.

CARE & MAINTENANCE:

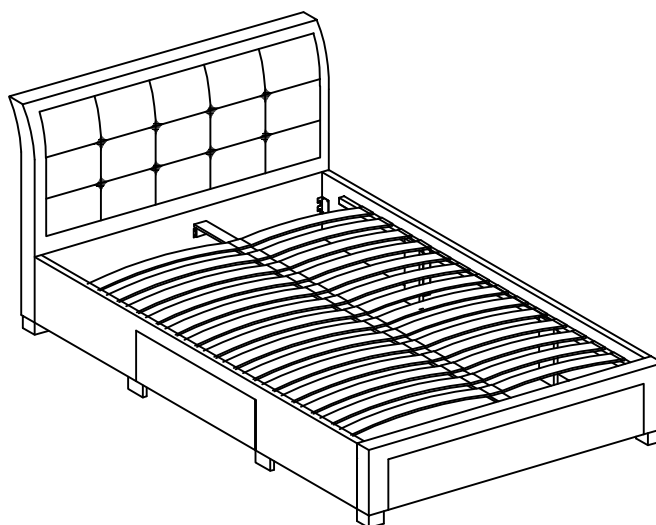
Assembly in the room use.

Periodically check all screw & fixings to ensure they are secure.

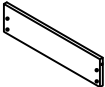
DO NOT push the bed frame as this will damage the legs.

Always lift the bed with two people to reposition.

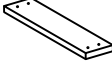
Keep any sharp objects away from the frame.



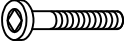
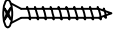
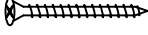
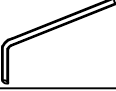

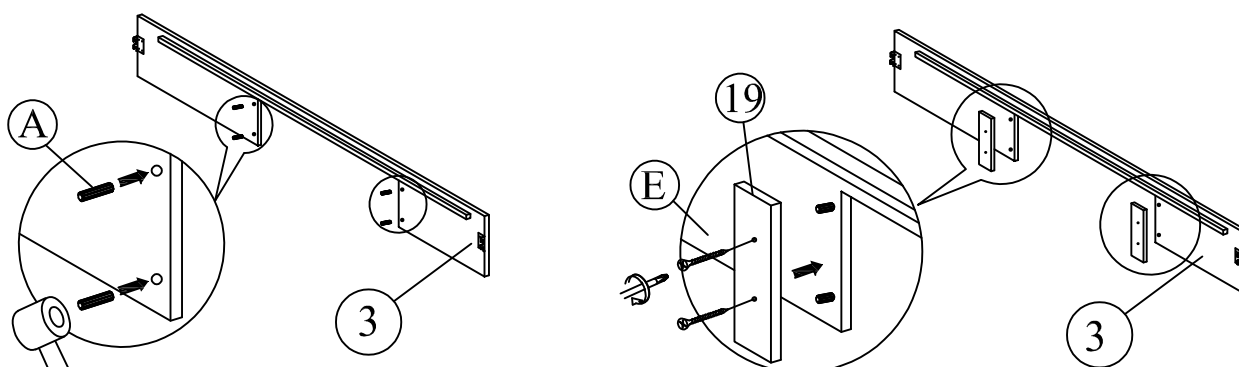
Step 1 : Tighten the legs (9) to both headend (1) and footend (2) as shown.

DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.



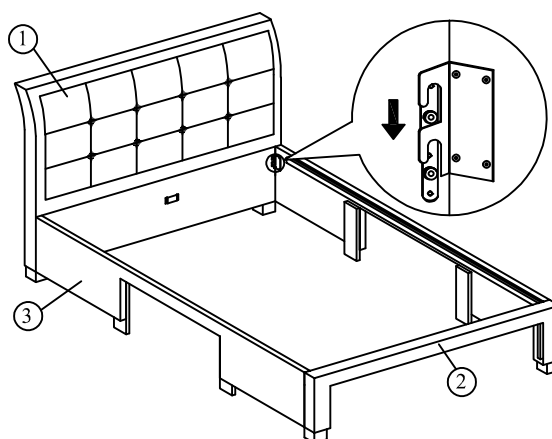
Step 2 : Attach plastic dowel (A) to side rail (3). Tighten the side rail support (19) to the side rail (3) with screws (E) using screw driver (not included) .

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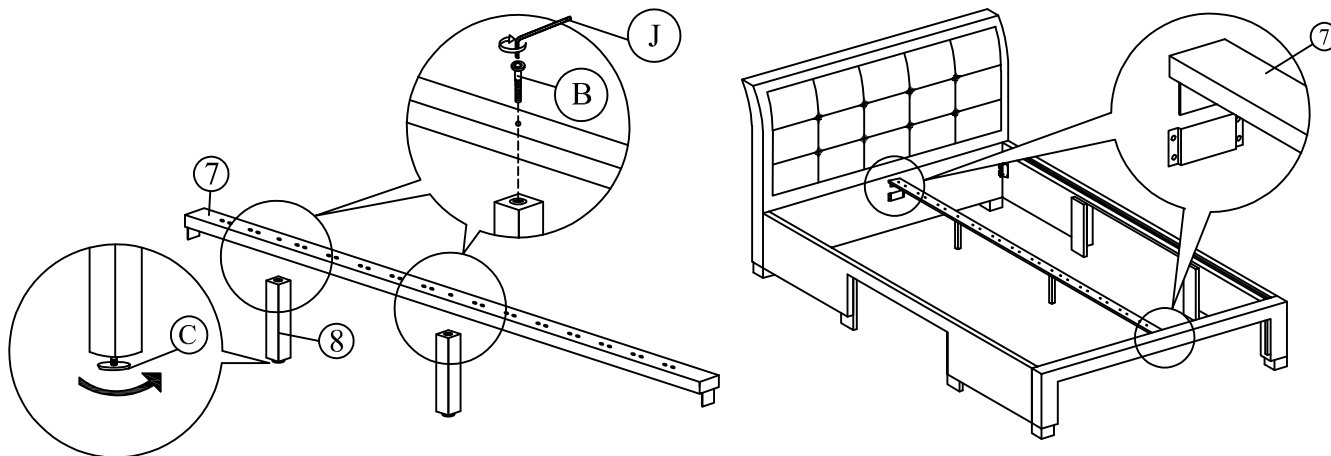
Step 3: Attach side rail (3) to headend (1) and footend (2) by pushing the bracket down to fit it.

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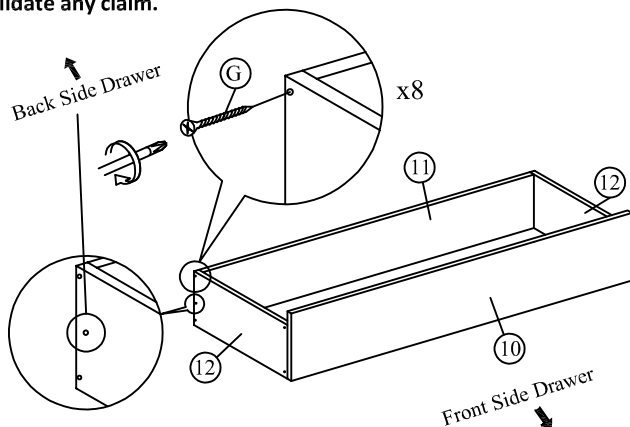


Step 4 : Attach the support legs (8) to the center rail (7) using screw (B) and allen key (J) as shown. Slide the center rail (7) to the headend (1) and footend (2).

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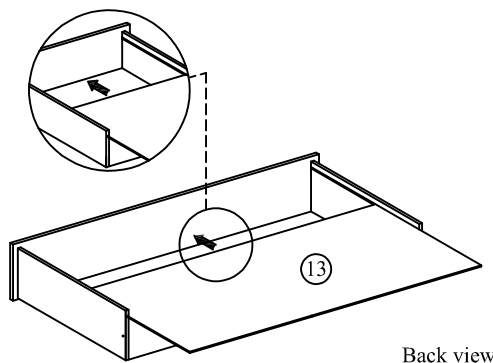


Step 5 : Tighten the footend side panel (12) to the footend front panel (10) and footend back panel (11) with screws (G) using screw driver (not included). **DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.**

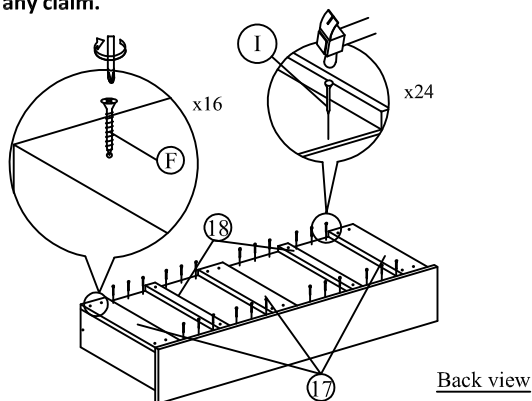


Step 6 : Slide the footend bottom panel (13) to the set up drawer.

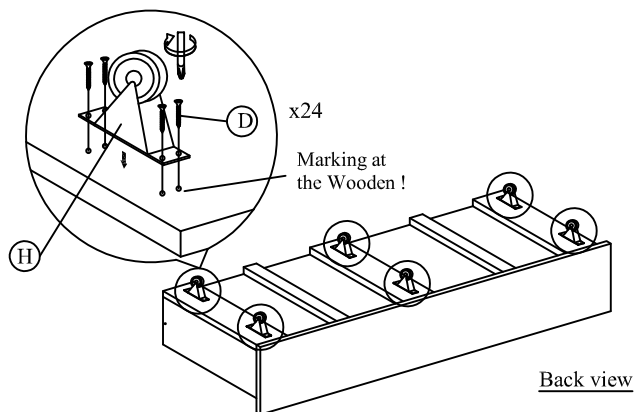
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Step 7 : Tighten the bottom panel support (17&18) with screws (F) using screw driver (not included). Attach the bottom panel with Nail (I) using the hammer (not included). **DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.**

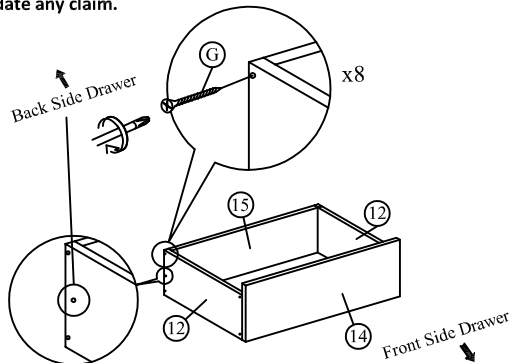


Step 8 : Tighten the roller (H) with screws (D) using screw driver (not included). **DO NOT use any power tools as this may damage the frame and will invalidate any claim.**



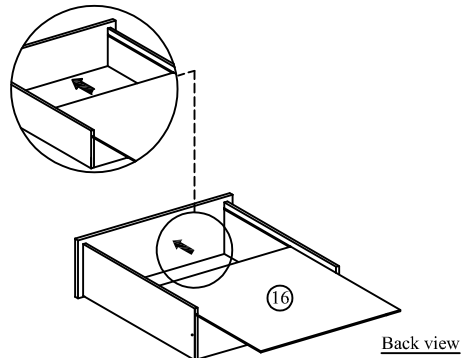
Step 9 : Tighten the side rail side panel (12) to the side rail front panel (14) and side rail back panel (15) with screws (G) using screwdriver (not included).

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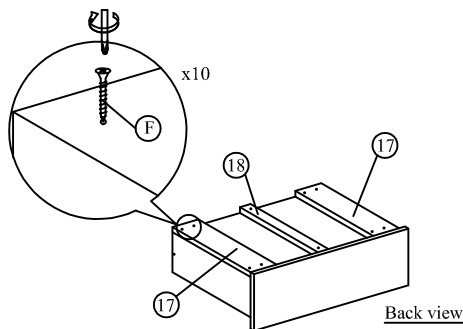
Step 10 : Slide the side rail bottom panel (16) to the set up drawer.

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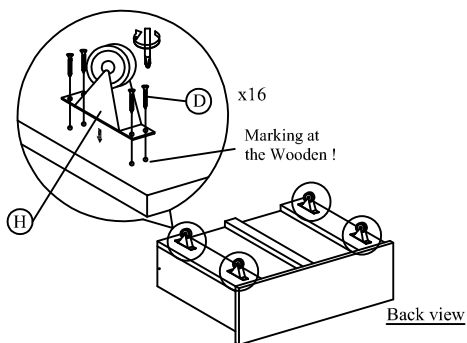
Step 11 : Tighten the bottom panel support (17&18) with screws (F) using screw driver (not included).

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Step 12 : Tighten the roller (H) with screws (D) using screw driver (not included).

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Step 13 : Affix the Slat (4) to the side rail support wood and the center rail (7). Tighten all the 4 corner with allen key (K).

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
