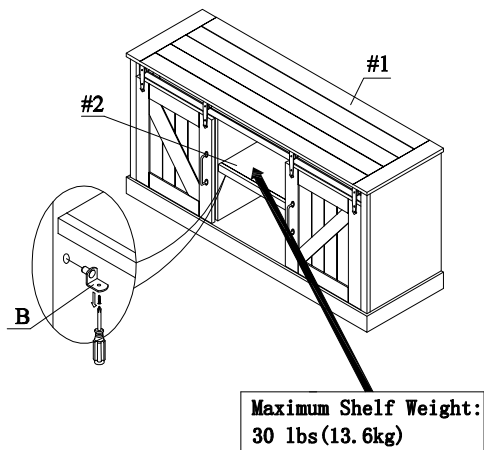

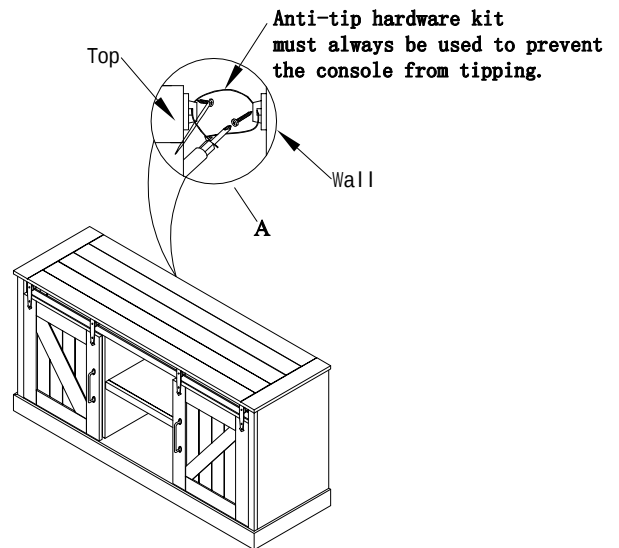

Avoid placing furniture directly near heat or air conditioning outlets. Exposure to extreme temperature variations can damage any fine wood furniture, including variations caused by humidifiers, heat vents and fire places.

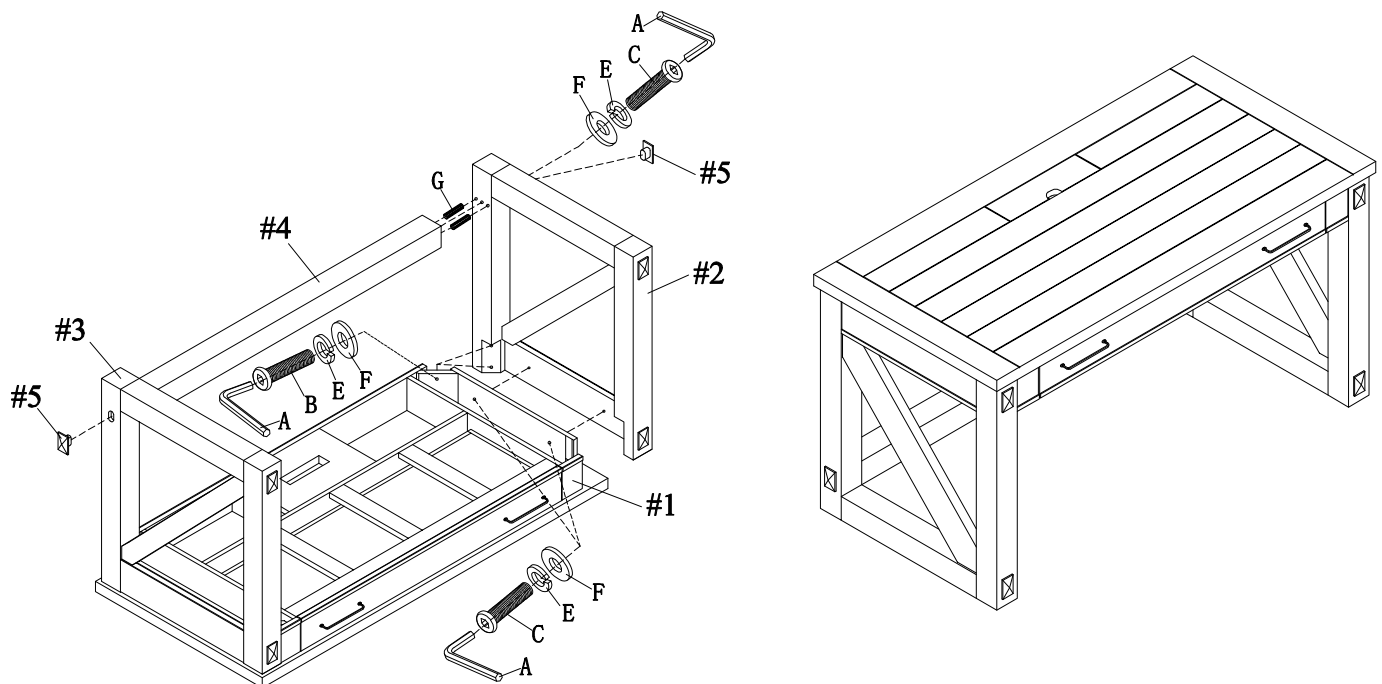

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:

Place table top (#1) upside down on a soft clean cloth. Attach leg (#2) into the corresponding corner of writing table top. Secure each leg with bolt (B)(C) through Lock Washer (E) and Flat Washer (F) through the hole located at each corner and into the leg. Fasten the Bolts with Allen Wrench(A)



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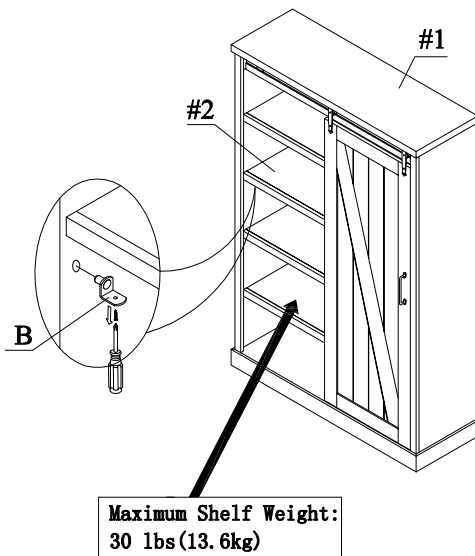
