Care & Maintenance

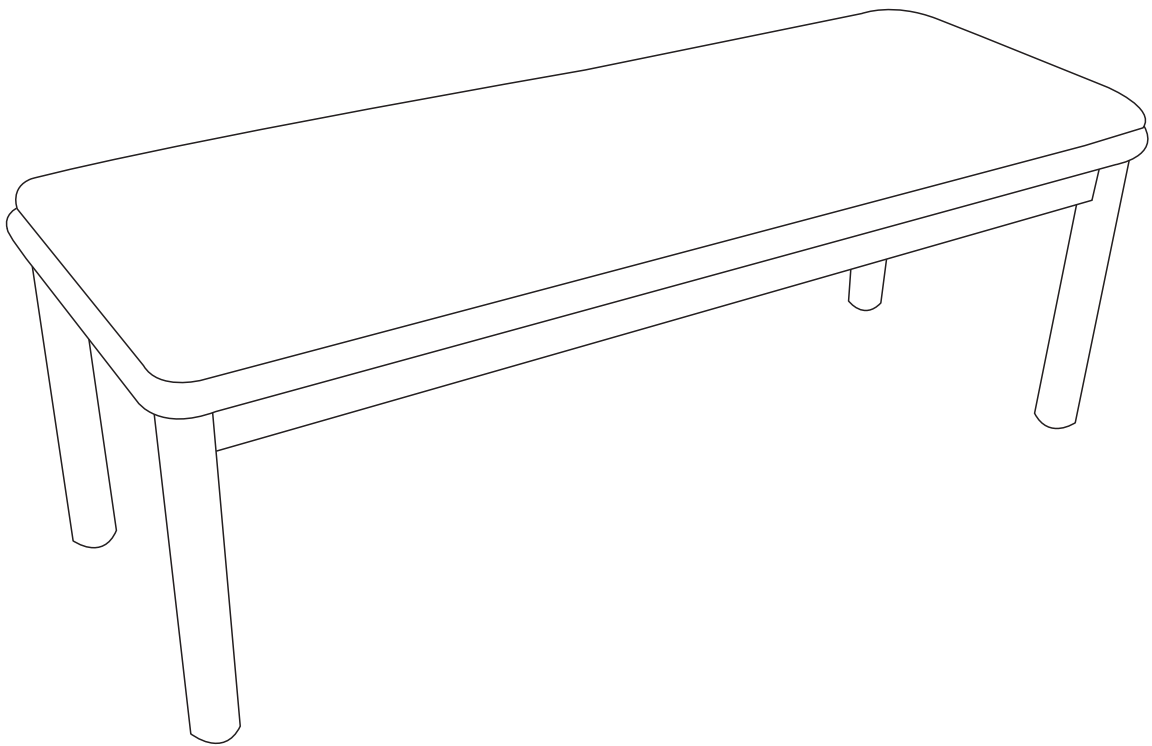
- ⊘  ● Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
- ✓  ● Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.
- ⊘  ● Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
- ⊘  ● Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
- ⊘  ● Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.
- ⊘  ● Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.
- ⊘  ● Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
- ⊘  ● Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.
- ⊘  ● Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
- ⊘  ● Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



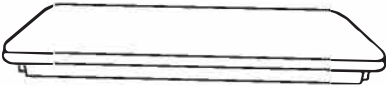
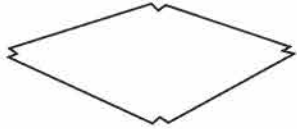
- Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

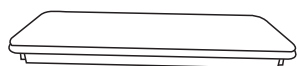

Before Beginning Assembly:

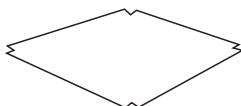
Unpack all the parts for a clear overview.

- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-



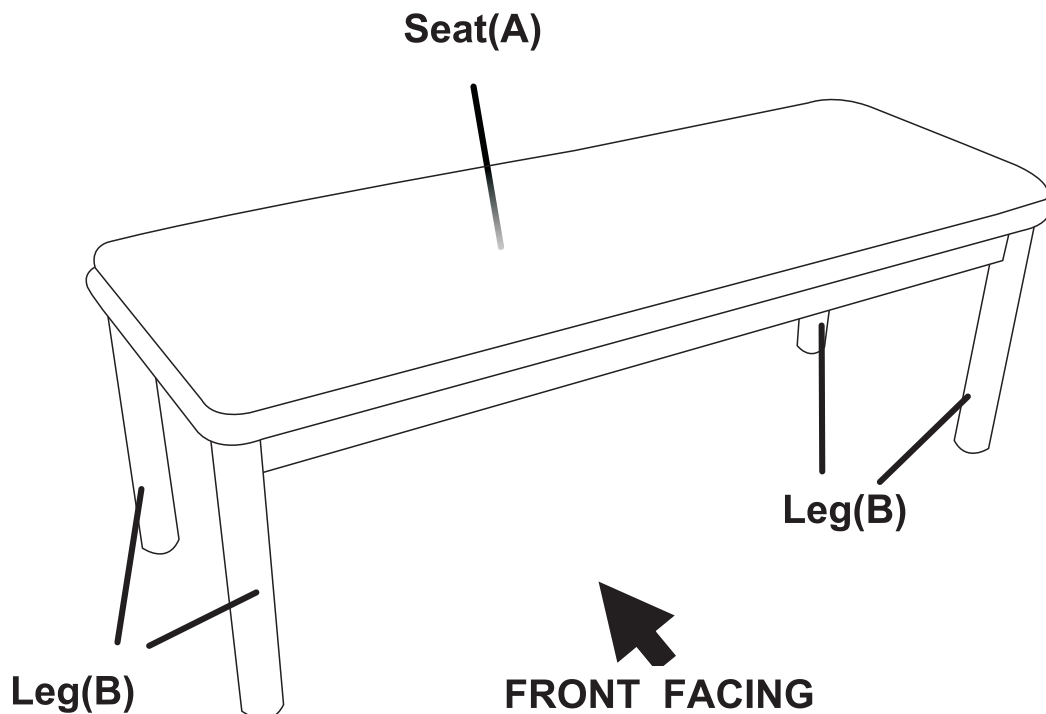
- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-



- Save all packaging until finished-

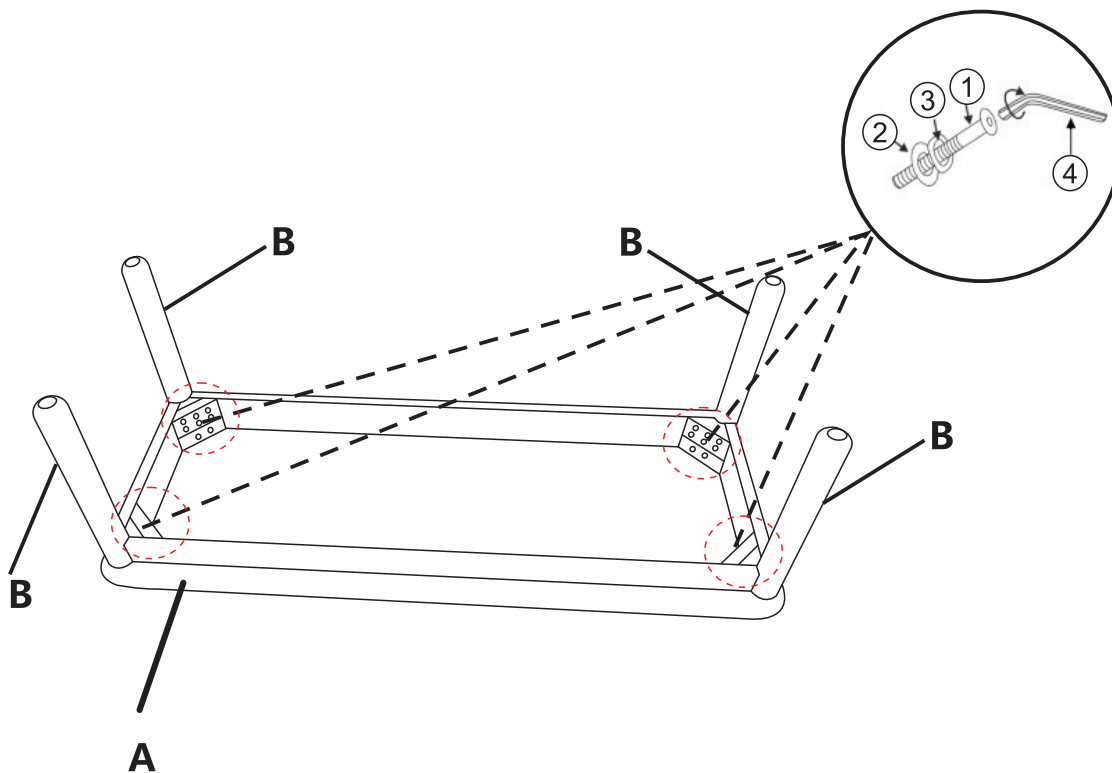
Assembly Steps

Overview



This Ottoman Bench has multiple parts and may require up to some 10 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Ottoman Bench parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

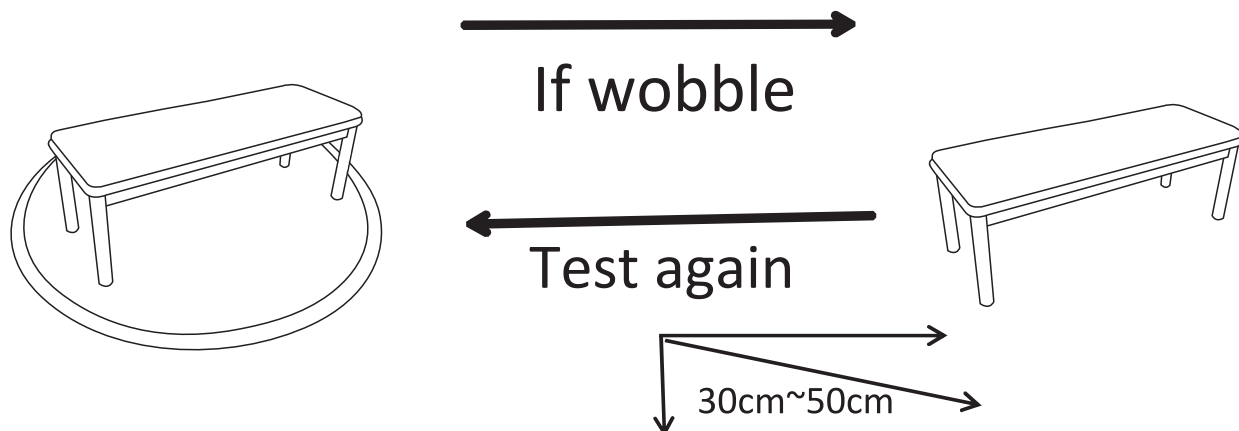
Step 1



Lock the Legs(B) to Seat(A) by using 8 Bolts (①), 8 Flat Washer Rings (②) and Spring Washer Rings (③) and tighten them with Allen Wrench (④) .

**WARNING!! DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN.
OVER TIGHTENING COULD LEAD TO DAMAGE OF THE
PRODUCT.
TIGHTEN ONLY UNTIL SECURE AND STABLE.**

Step 2



Place the Bench on a Level Surface to check if it wobbles.

If it wobbles, lift the Bench some 30cm to 50cm high from the ground, keep your feet and toes well away from the drop zone, and drop the Counter freely and vertically with the four legs, hitting the ground at the same time. This Drop Test will help to ensure that all the bolts and gaps to all reach full alignment.

Test again for evenness on Level Surface.

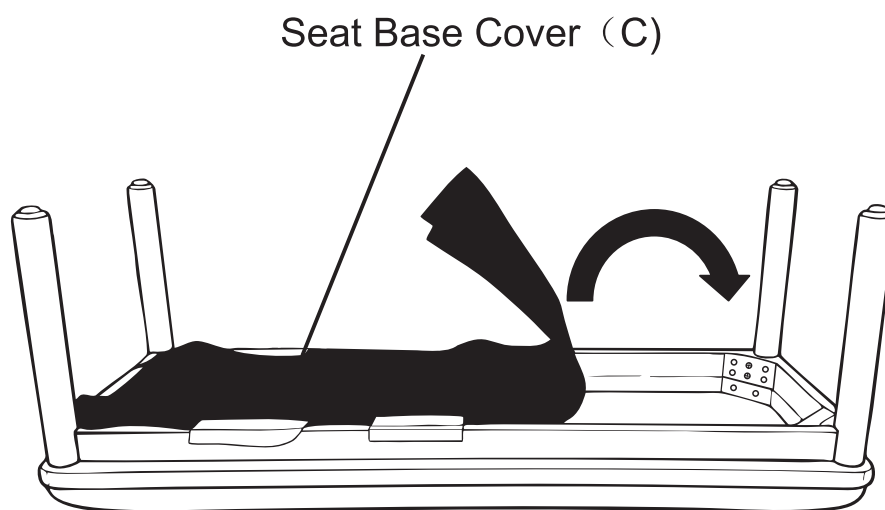
If no wobbles are found, proceed to tighten all the Bolts.

Caution: When tightening the Bolts, tighten sequentially.

Do not tighten any screw fully and then towards the next one, this would cause the frame to warp. If it still wobbles, loosen the bolts and execute this same drop test.

If the Bench is not Stable it could lead to damage to the product.

Step 3



Finally, seal the Seat Base Cover (C) back on to the underside of the Bench seat . Turn it the right side up.

Inspect and make sure all parts are connected.

The Bench is ready for use.

Caution: This Bench can only be used on a flat, level surface.
