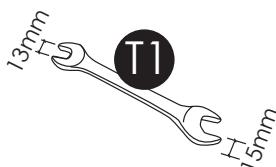

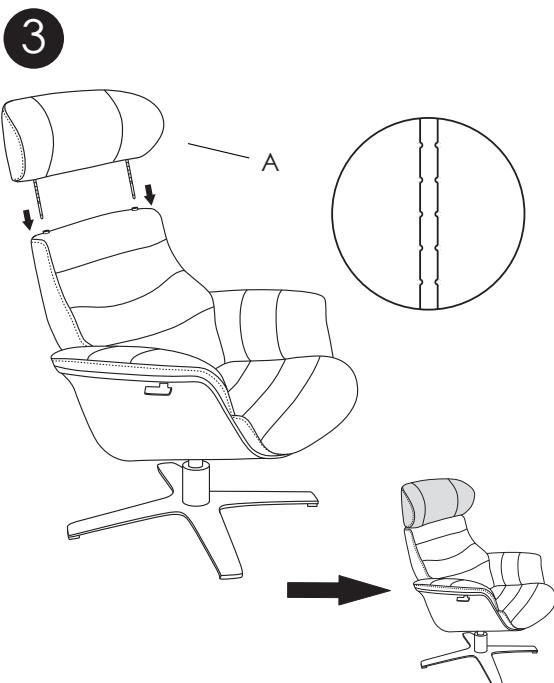
- 1** The Leather pad is used to prevent noise and should be kept in place until assembly completed.



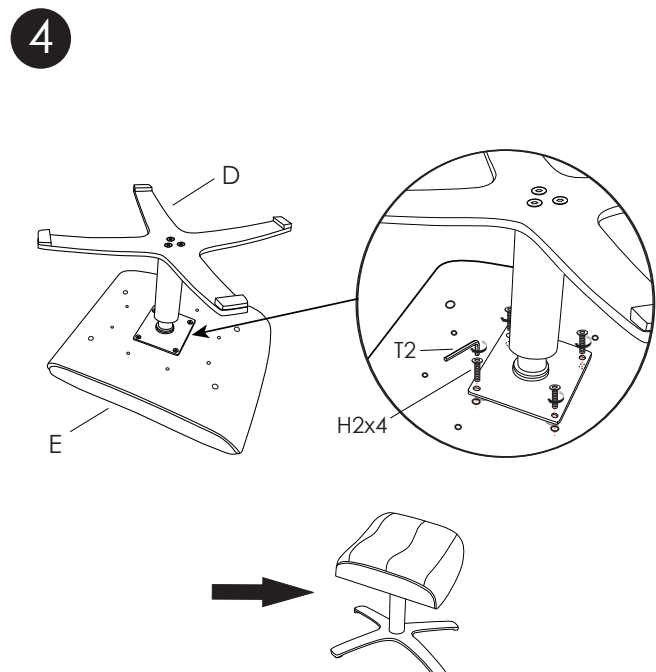
Unscrew locknuts.



Put the chair base on the bottom of chair Body in the right assembly position, and fully screw all locknuts.



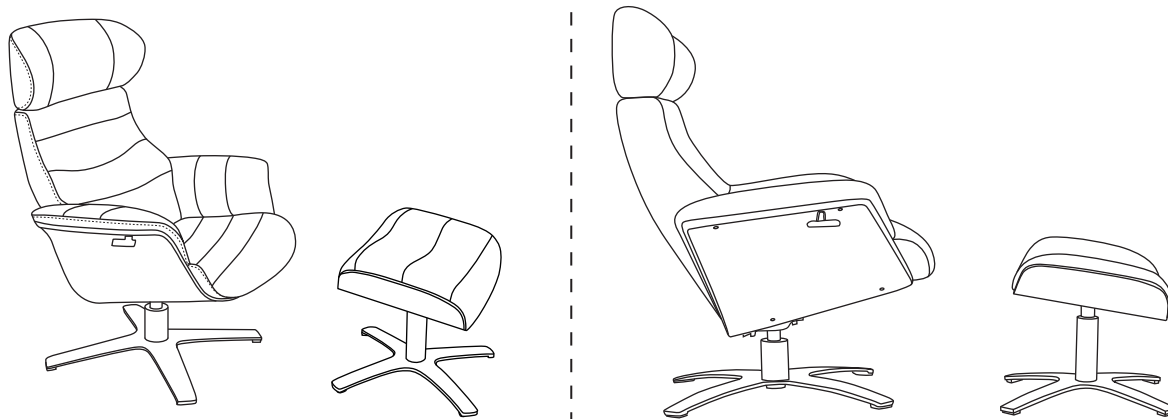
Assembly the headrest.



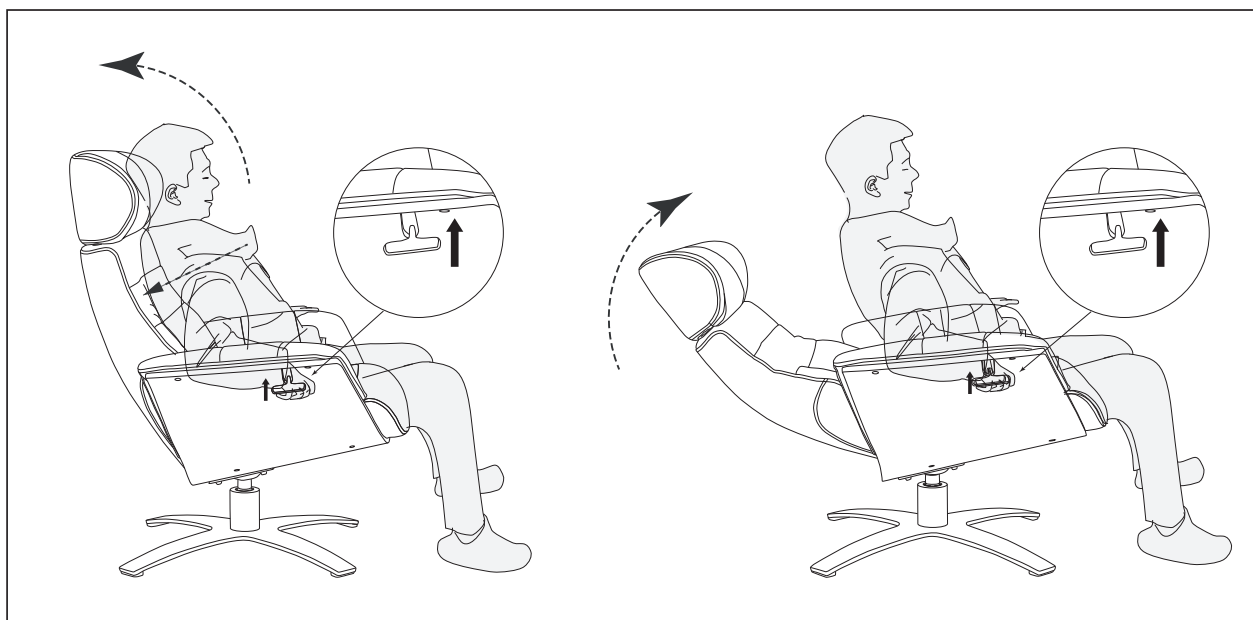
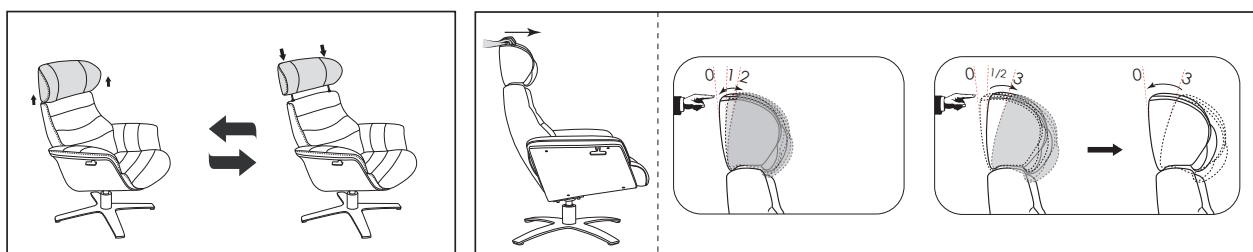
Assembly the ottoman base, and fully tighten all bolts.

PRODUCT WARRANTY

1-year limited on leather against splitting, peeling, and/or tearing.

1-year limited on internal and external frame structure.

1-year limited on cushioning material, seat springs and mechanism.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

Periodic dusting will prolong the life of your leather.

General cleaning can be done with a damp, clean, soft white cloth.

Periodically, a mild leather cleaner can be used on the headrests and armrests. This will help prevent buildup of body and hair oils which can harm the leather over time.

For more stubborn stains, a mild leather cleaner can be used or consult a professional leather technician.
