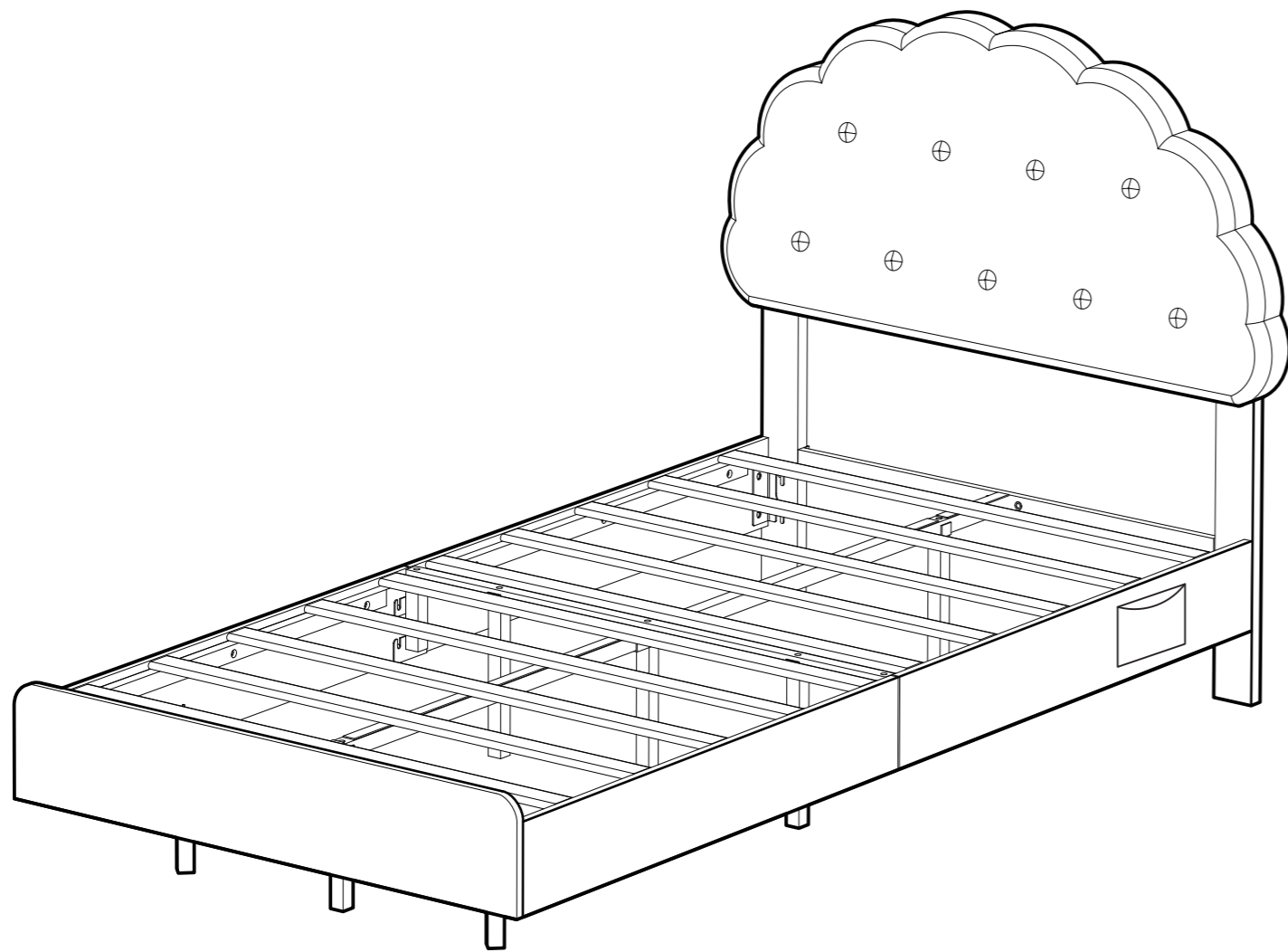
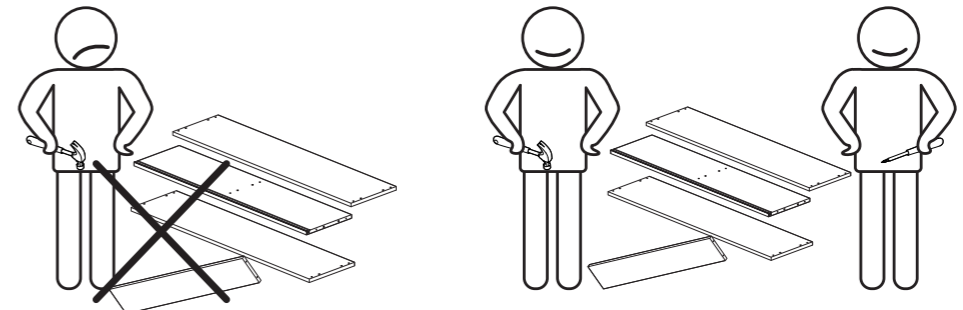


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



WARNING

- Carefully read and follow all instructions. Save for future reference.
- Intended for indoor use only. Do not leave the bed outdoors.
- This product is to be assembled by an adult. Children are not allowed to assemble the product. Keep unassembled and small parts out of reach of children.
- Follow the instructions for assembly and use. We shall not be liable for damage or injury resulting from improper assembly or use.
- DO NOT use if any part is missing or damaged.
- DO NOT allow children to jump on the bed.
- DO NOT place near ignition or heat sources.
- Keep away from sharp objects and corrosive chemicals.
- Fully tighten all bolts and screws before use. Bolts and screws may become loose after long period of use. Regularly check and make sure all bolts and screws are fully tightened.
- Clean with a soft, slightly damp cloth. In case of stubborn stains, carefully clean with nonabrasive sponge.
- Dispose of all packaging materials properly. Keep away from children and pets. Keep plastic bags away from babies and small children.



We recommend at least 2 people for the assembly.

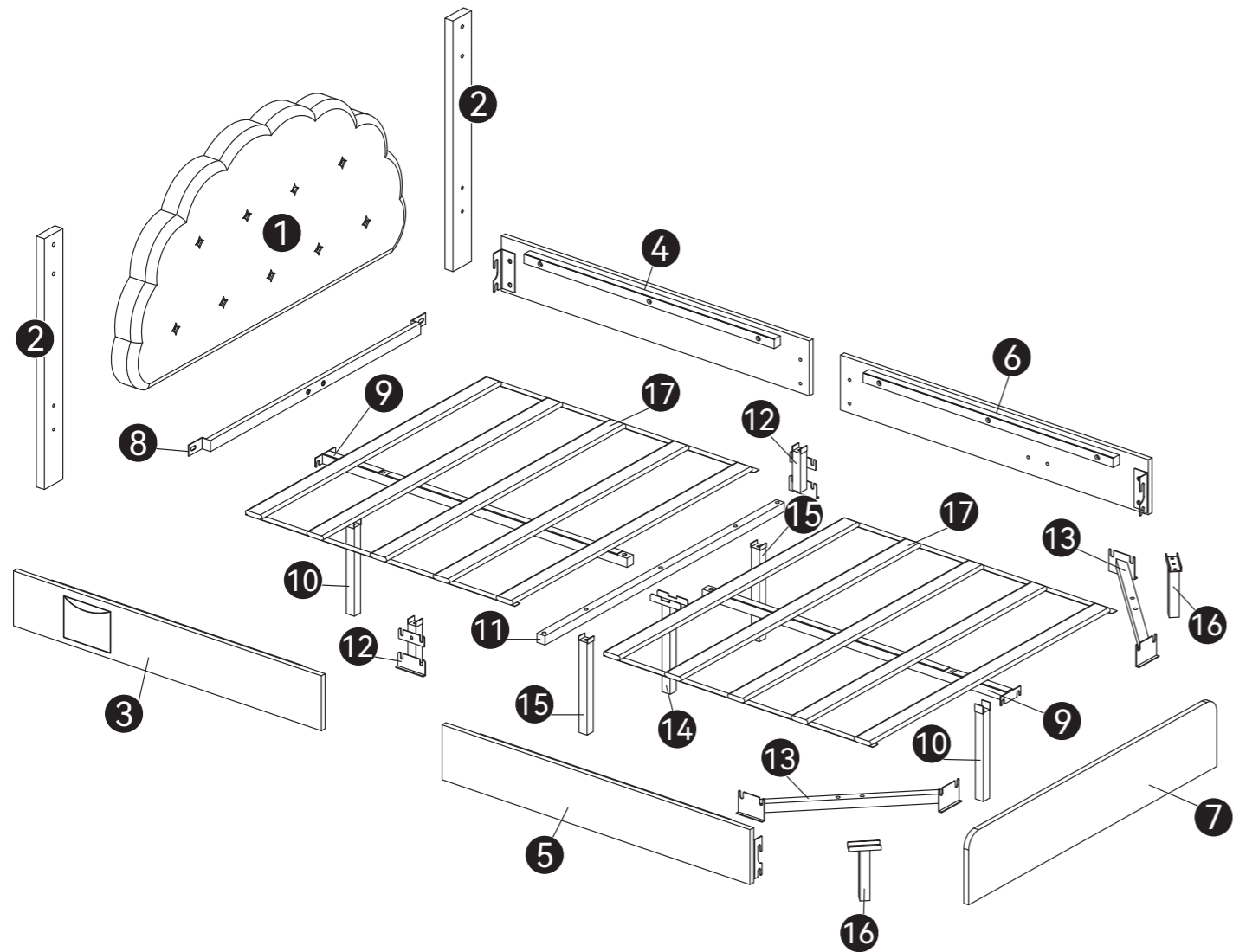




















PARTS DIAGRAM

The spare parts are the additional parts provided in case of missing or damaged ones. Keep the spare parts and tools for future use.



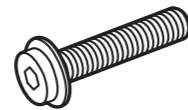

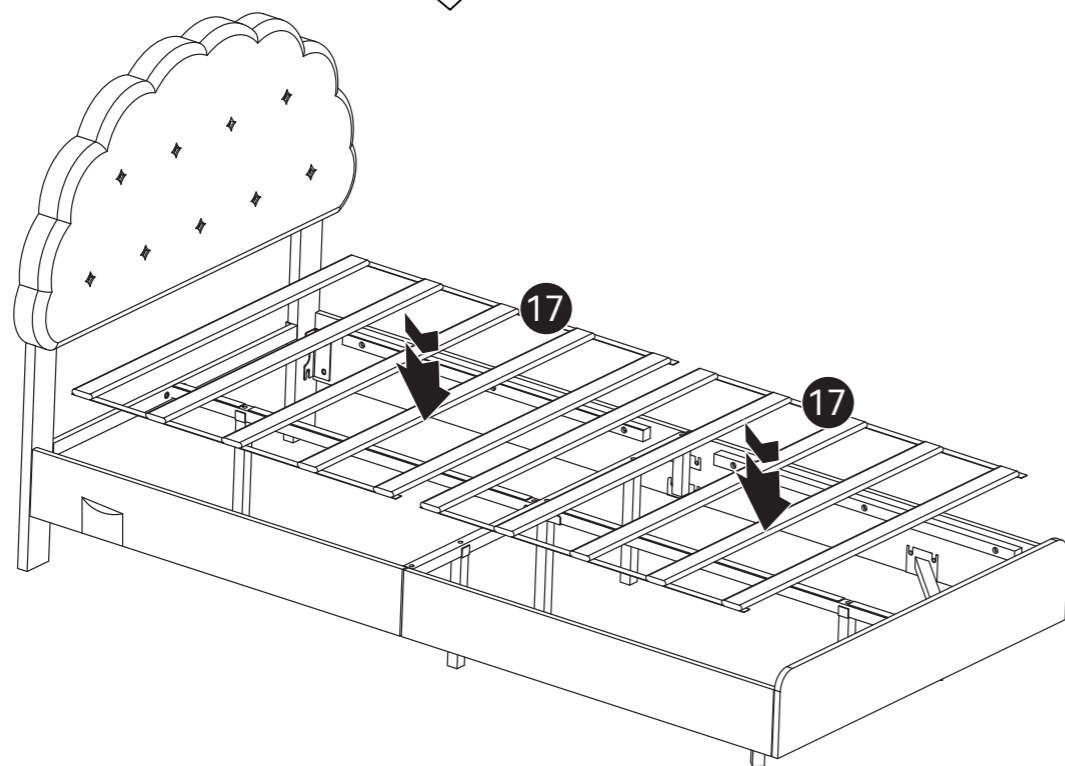
Attach the LED strip light to the side of the bed frame, following the directional arrow as illustrated.

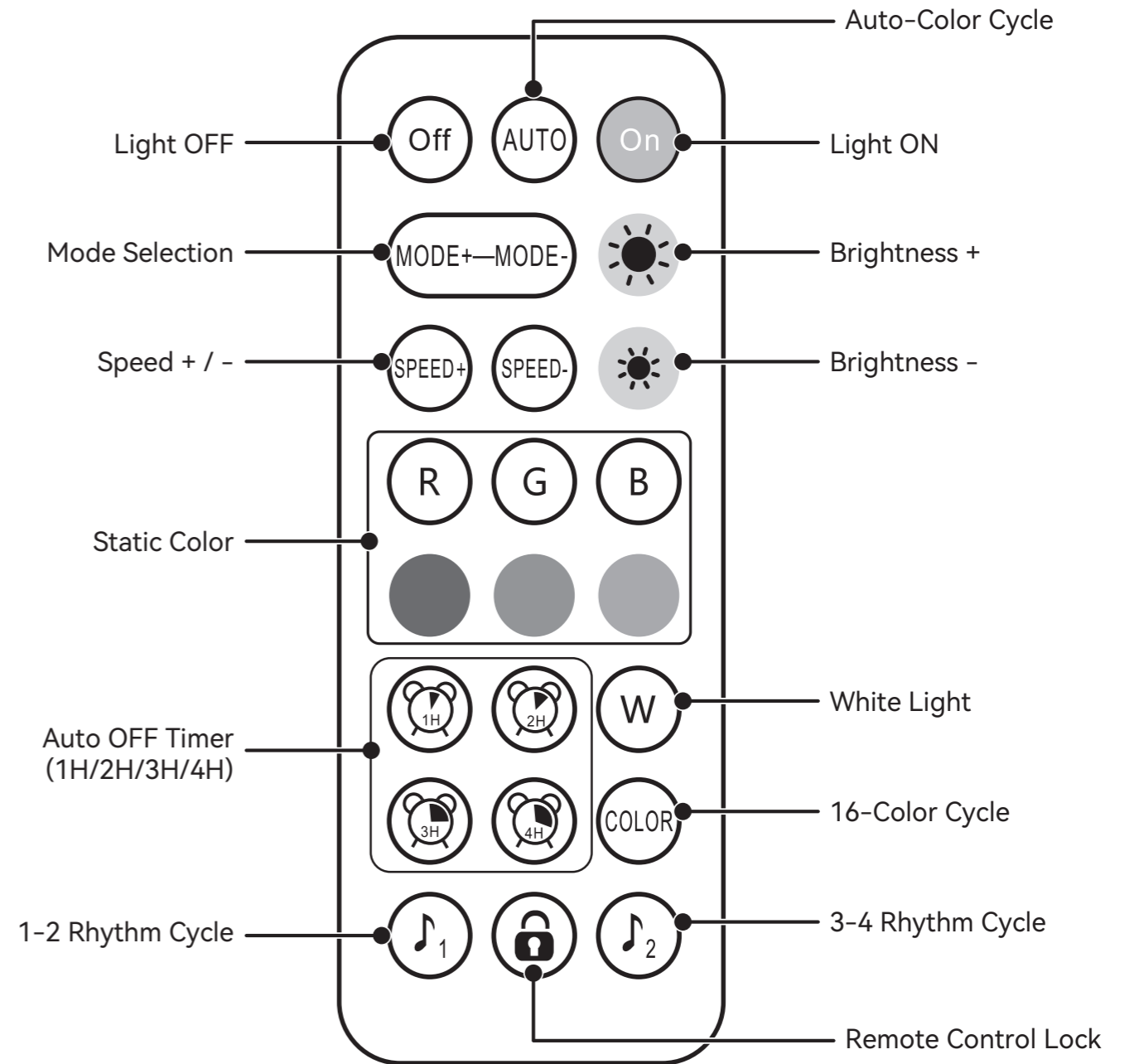

Using with Remote Control

Remove the plastic tab underneath battery before use.



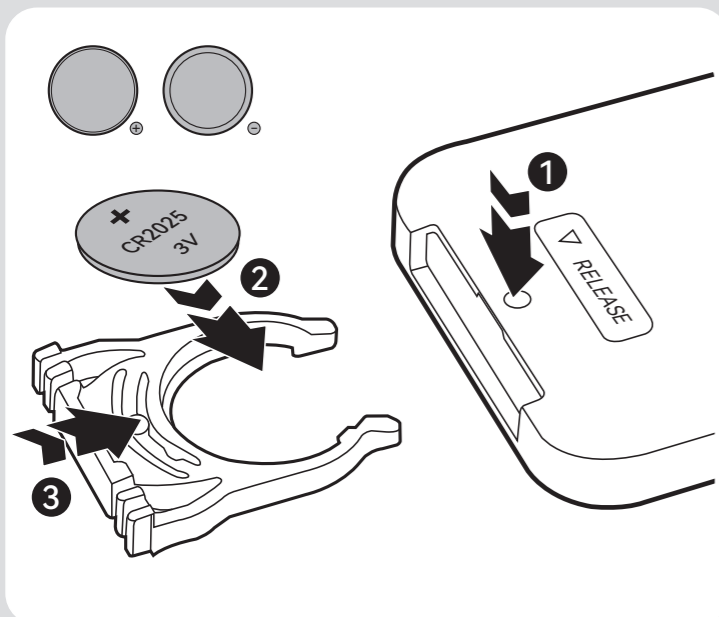
WARNING

Replacing Battery

- Replace with new battery of the same type (CR2025, 3V) when necessary.
- When not using the remote control for an extended period of time, take out the battery.



- 1 Press with an eject pin. Pinch the locking tab in then hold to pull the battery compartment cover out.
- 2 Replace the battery with the same type, making sure the (+) side facing up.
- 3 Install the cover back in place.

FCC Compliance
