Excess water buildup can cause the frame system to become unstable and collapse, possibly causing injury. Any personal accessories or modifications to the product should be removed before the onset of inclement weather, such as heavy rain, wind, lightning, hail, snow, etc.

This product should be properly taken down to avoid permanent damage to product components and any possibility of personal injury. This product is not a toy and is not designed for use by children. Under no circumstances should this product be used as a permanent or temporary storage facility for children's toys, garden tools, personal belongings, or similar valuables.


CARE AND MAINTENANCE

For long-lasting durability and the best possible protection for your canopy, follow these care and maintenance instructions: Your product is NOT machine washable or dryable. Use mild soap (not detergent) and plenty of water to clean the top. Let the fabric and frame dry completely to avoid mildew before closing and storing. The frame will operate and look better if occasionally wiped with silicone spray, especially before and after use in damp conditions. Remove excess sllicone residue before applying top. Use a seam sealer if the top leaks or drips water, which is available at most sporting goods and hardware stores. Slightly tighten the bolts if the frame becomes loose.




STEP 3

STEP 1


Pull up one section of the leg tube and open the frame. NOTE: Be careful to prevent your hands from pinching.






SECTION D Take Down The Canopy




STEP 1

Remove the wind ropes and floor spikes.






Lock the frame.
