INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

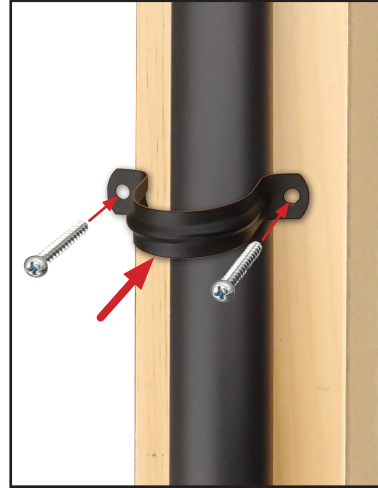
Option 1 – Installation onto Wooden Decks Using Included U-Brackets

This method will work on any deck material if it has a post to install the brackets on.

Tools Needed:

- Drill or Impact Driver
- Included Installation Screws
- Pencil or pen to mark holes

1. If installing on a deck you will not need the ground screw but you will need the U-Brackets
2. Each pole comes with two brackets so once you pick the desired location (against a deck post) assemble the pole
3. Line your pole up with the post and with the pole flush on the deck screw the bottom bracket over the pole.
4. Then adjust your pole to be as straight as possible and screw in the top bracket.
5. Repeat for the 2nd pole as needed.



Option 2 – Installation into Ground

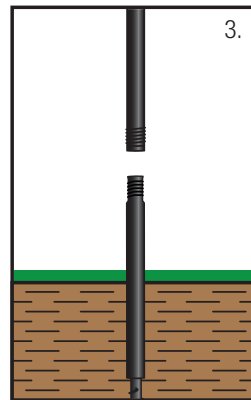
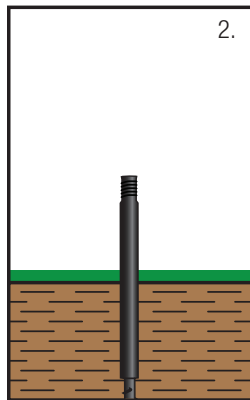
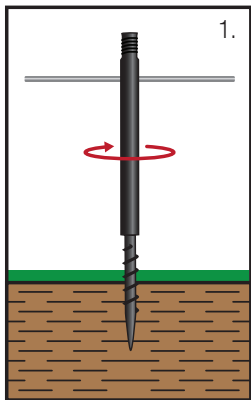
Tools Needed:

- Installation Rod (provided)



Check for any underground pipes or wire before installing ground screw.

1. Place your Ground Screw in the desired position and put the installation rod through the cross hole
2. Screw into the ground until the rod is about 2" from the ground
3. Connect the additional pieces and screw onto the base



How do I secure the lights to the Circle Topper?

All you need to do is just add the string light cord between the gap in the topper for the lights to be secured.



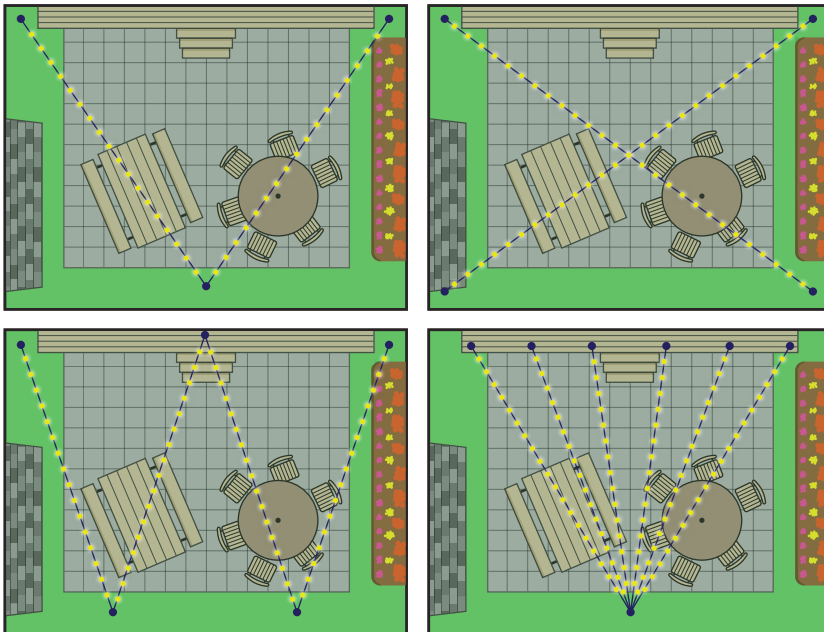
How do I determine my string light pattern?

The ideal design will start with asking yourself 3 questions:

1. What area do I want to illuminate?
2. Where is my power source?
3. Are there structures or trees that I want to attach the lights to?
***This will help you determine where you need to place poles.

Once you have these questions answered you can begin your design:

1. Start at the power source – this is often an outlet and might require running an outdoor-rated extension cord to where your lights will begin. If using your structure, be sure to have hooks installed to aid in installation.
2. Decide which pattern will best illuminate the area you need. Popular designs are V, X, W, and a Fan as seen below:



3. Draw a rough sketch with measurements.
4. Start by hanging your first patio light string with the male plug end closest to your outlet.
5. If working with multiple light strings, finish hanging your first string and then connect the male end of the second string to the female end of the first string. Continue this pattern until all strings have been hung.
