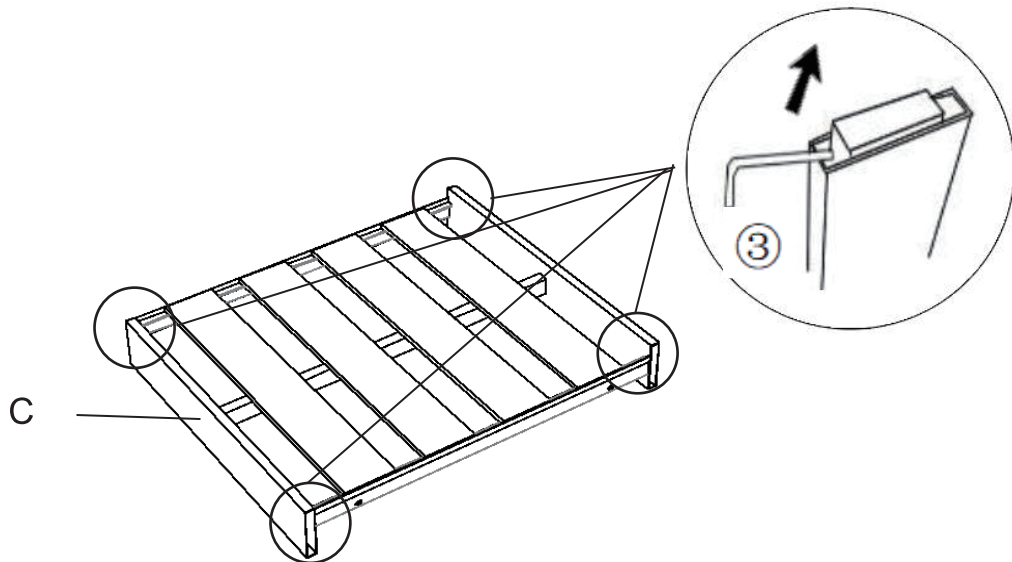
Assembly Steps

Overview



This Sofa Corner has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Sofa parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

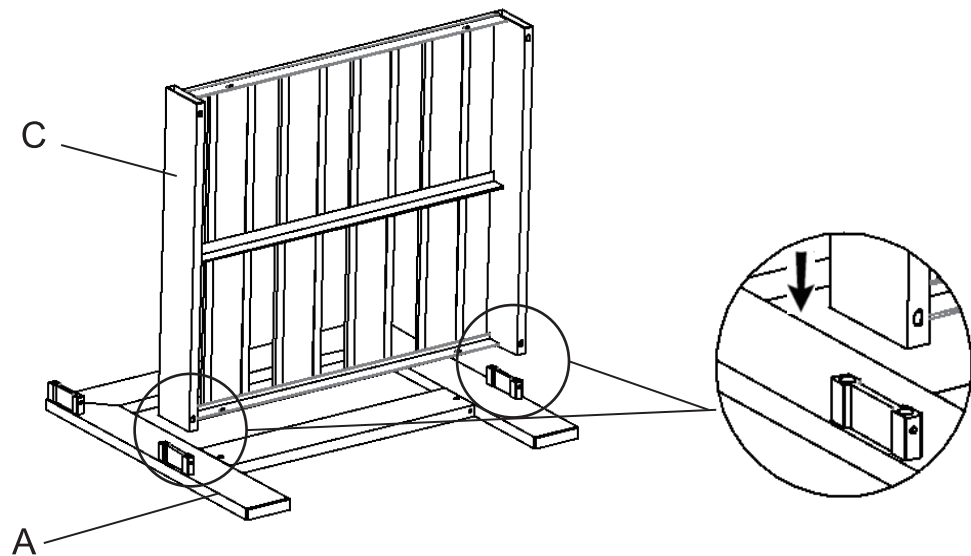
Step 1



Open the carton and place all parts on a clean, non-damaged surface.

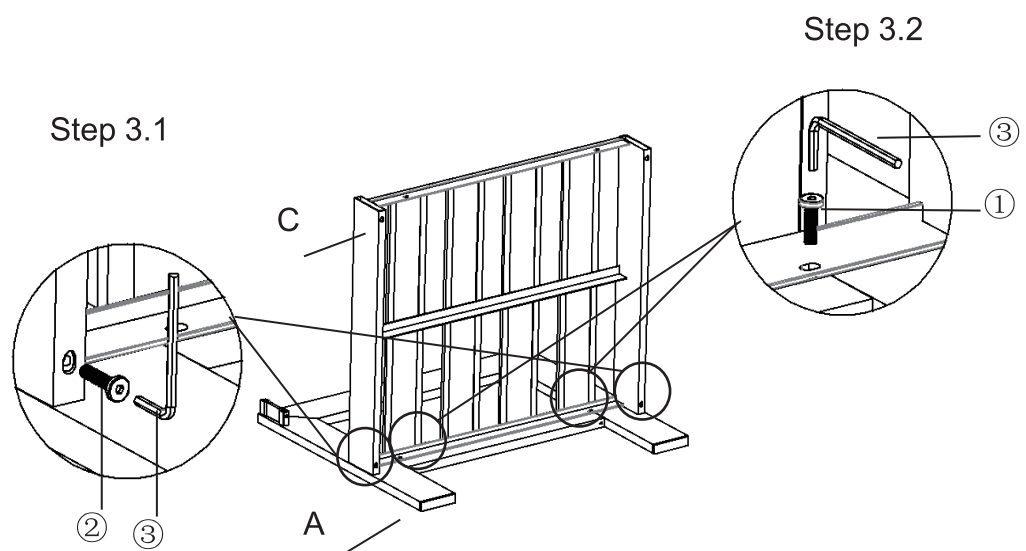
As shown above, use an inner Allen wrench (③) to remove the four ends of the Seat panel (C) plastic plug (to prevent the aluminum tube from being scratched).

Step 2



Place the Side Panel(A) with its inside facing up.
Insert the Seat Panel(C) into the Side Panel(A).

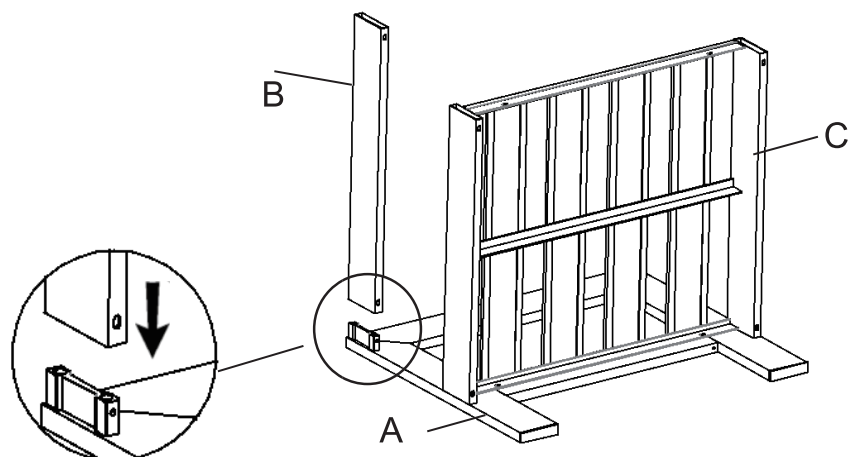
Step 3



3.1) Attach the Seat Panel(C) to Side Panel(A) using Bolts(2) with Allen wrench(3) as shown above.

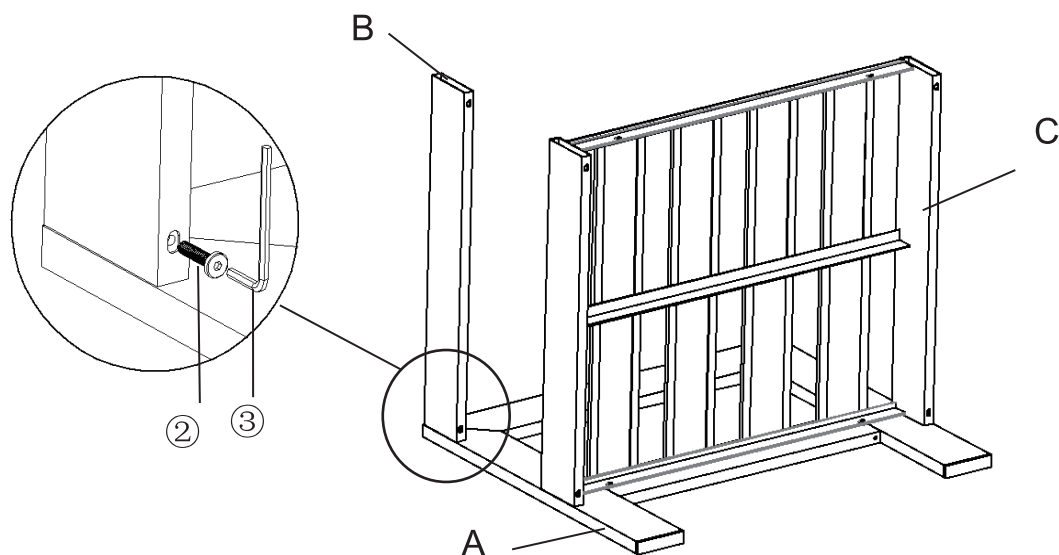
3.2) Attach the Seat Panel(C) to Side Panel(A) using Bolts(1) with Allen wrench(3) as shown above.

Step 4



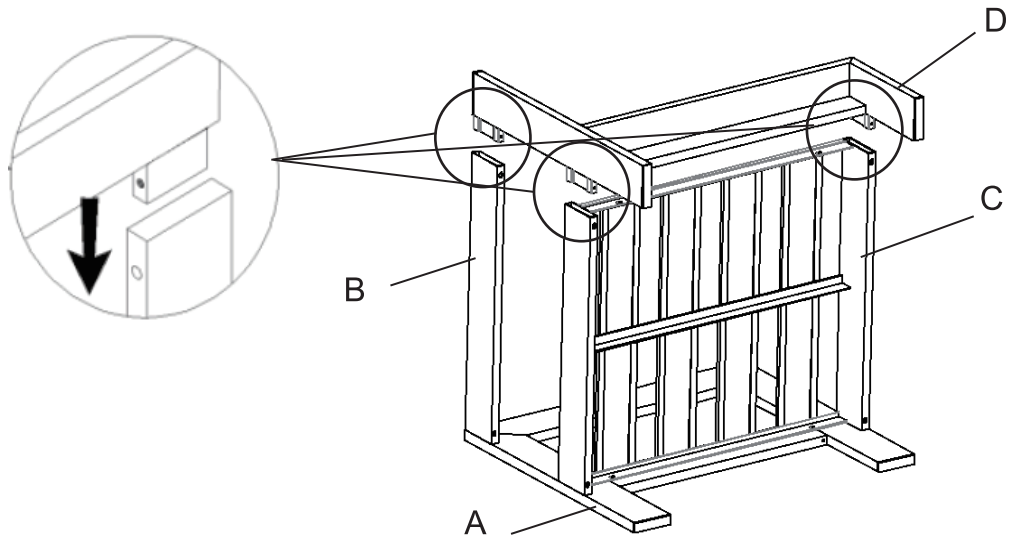
Insert the Back Support Bar(B) into the Side Panel(A).

Step 5



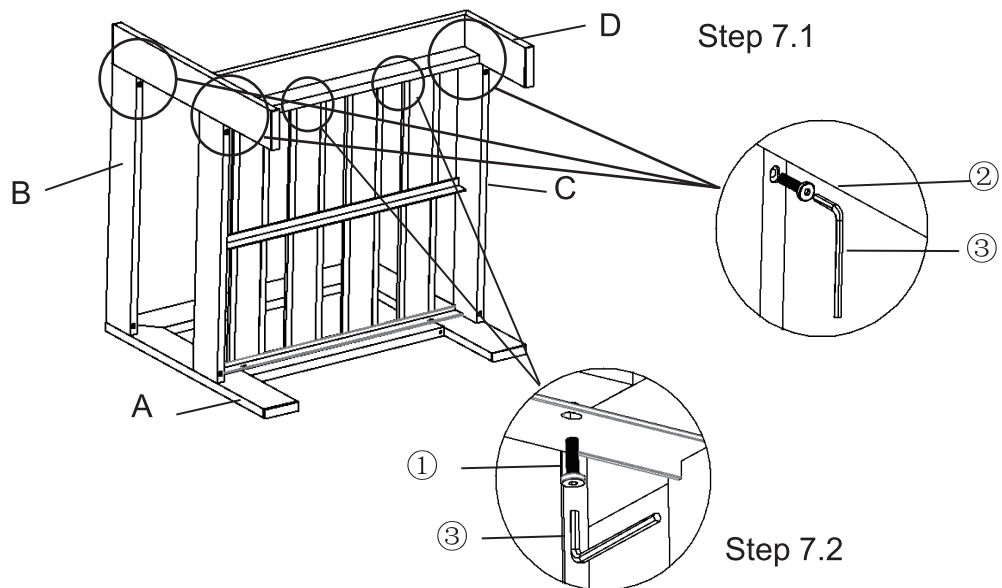
Attach the Back Support Bar(B) to the Side Panel(A) using Bolt(②) with Allen wrench(③).
Do not fully tighten Bolts.

Step 6



Insert the Leg Support Bar(D) into the Back Support Bar(B) and Seat Panel(C) as shown above.

Step 7

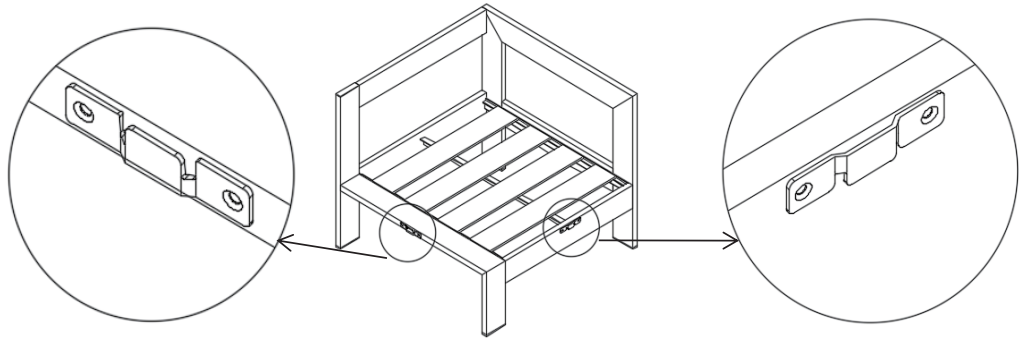


7.1) Attach the Leg Support Bar(D) to Back Support Bar(B) and Seat Panel(C) using Bolts(②) with Allen wrench(③) as shown above.

7.2) Attach the Leg Support Bar(D) to Back Support Bar(C) using Bolts(①) with Allen wrench(③) as shown above.

Do not fully tighten Bolts.

Step 8



Set up the corner sofa.

Place corner sofa on level.

Check and ensure that all parts are fully connected.

Sit gently and carefully on the corner sofa.

This will help align all the parts at all the joints.

Then carefully move away from the corner sofa and tighten all the bolts in sequence.

When tightening bolts, tighten them in sequence.

Do not tighten any bolts completely and proceed to the next bolt.

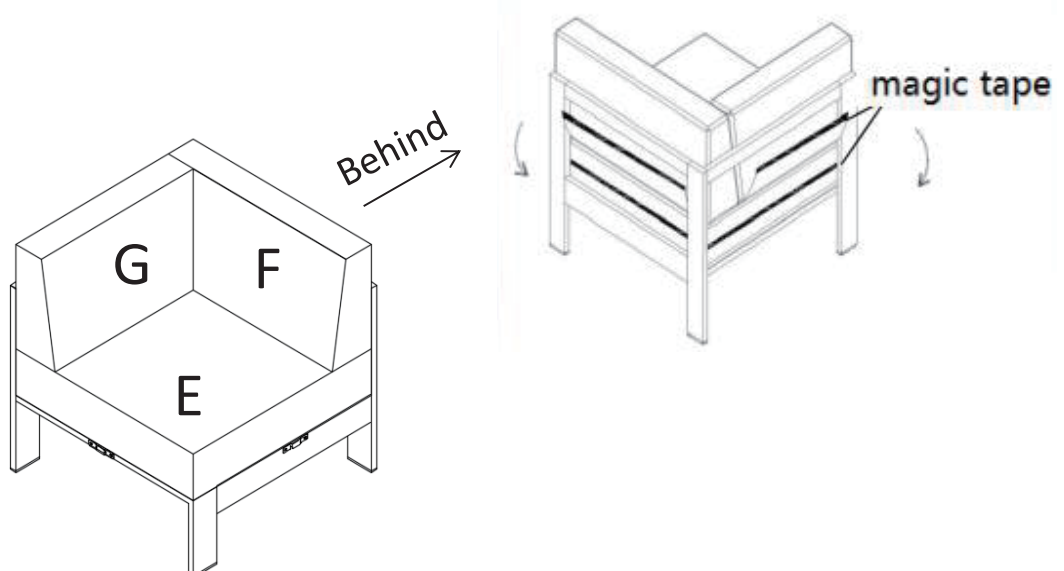
This can lead to distortion of the frame.

If there is still shaking, loosen the bolt and perform the same procedure.

If the sofa is unstable, the product may be damaged.

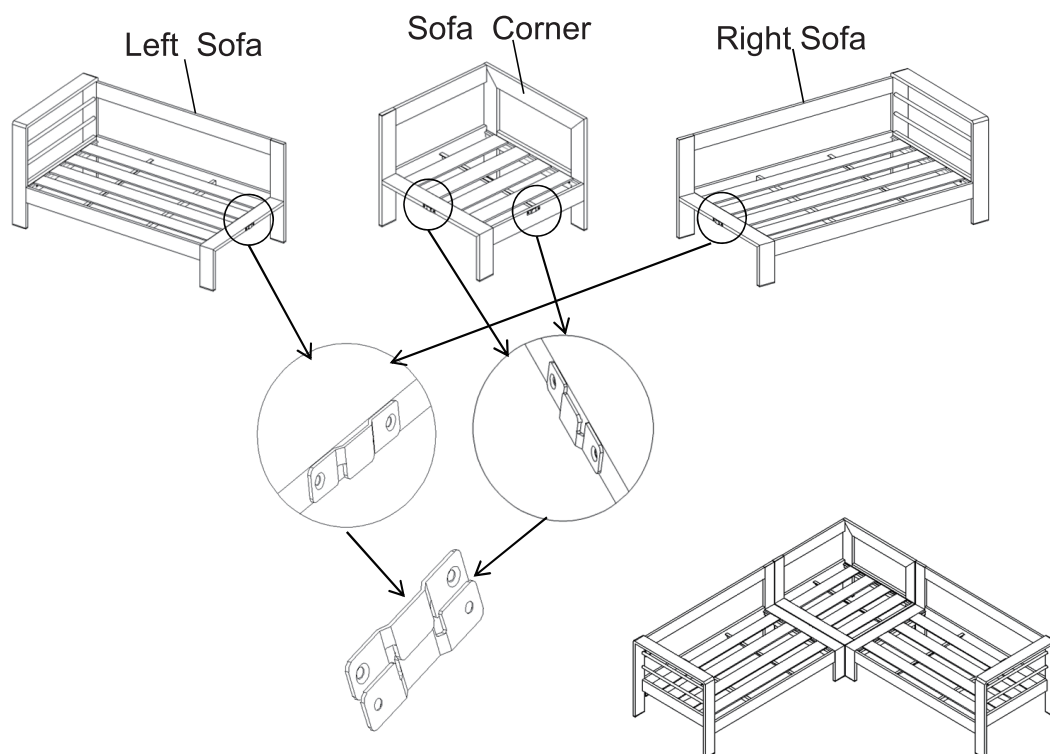
Note: this step is best done with the help of a second adult.

Step 9



Put Seat Cushion(E) and Back Cushions (F) and Small Back Cushion (G) on the Sofa and stick the magic tape from back cushion to seat cushion as shown above.
Your Sofa Corner is ready for use.

Step 10



With the assistance of your partner, slide the metal connector on the Left Sofa/Right Sofa into the metal connector on the Sofa Corner as shown in the picture. Assistance from an adult partner is needed for this assembly process. During this assembly process - do exercise caution. **Caution: Ensure that your fingers do not get caught or pinched in the assembly process.**

Care & Maintenance

-   • Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface
 -   • Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
 -   • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.
 -   • Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
 -   • Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
 -   • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.
 -   • Not for commercial use. For residential use only .
 -   • Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.

-   • Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth .
