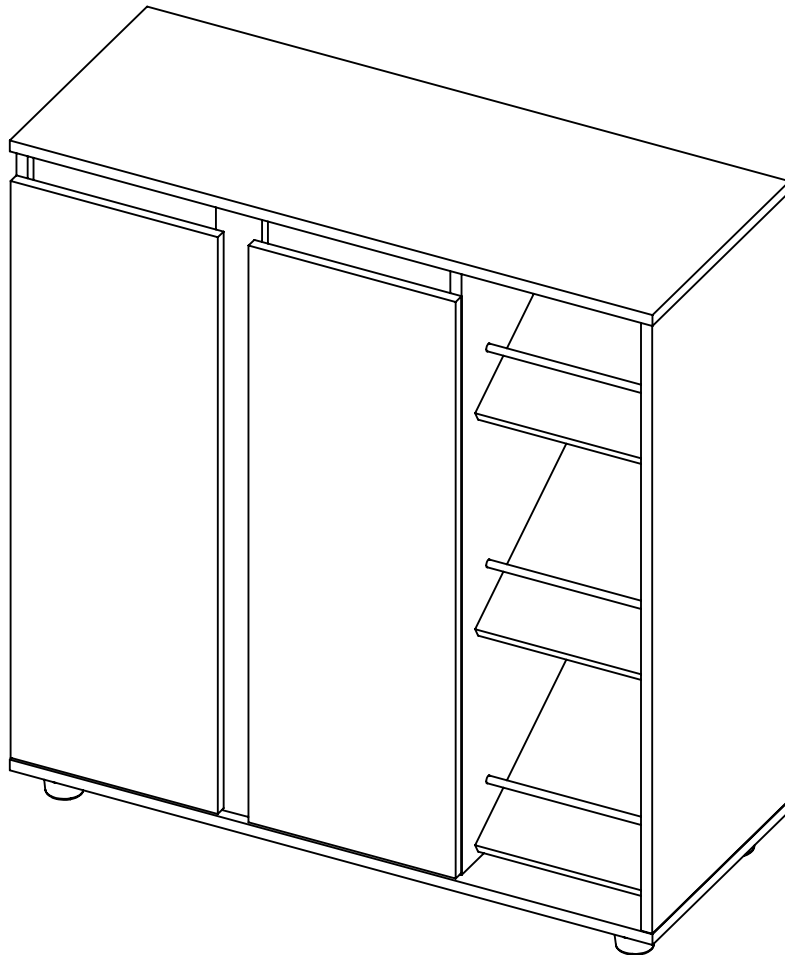


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

SHOE RACK



THIS FURNITURE MUST BE FIXED TO THE WALL

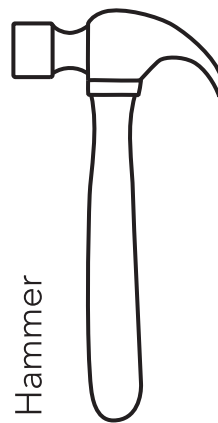
To ensure the safety of those using this closet, it is crucial to properly secure it to the wall using a wall anchor . This product includes the necessary items for fixing the furniture to the wall. However, it is important to note that incorrect installation or failure to use the tip-over device can result in serious injury or even death.

For this reason, we highly recommend that a professional installer handle the installation of the closet to the wall.

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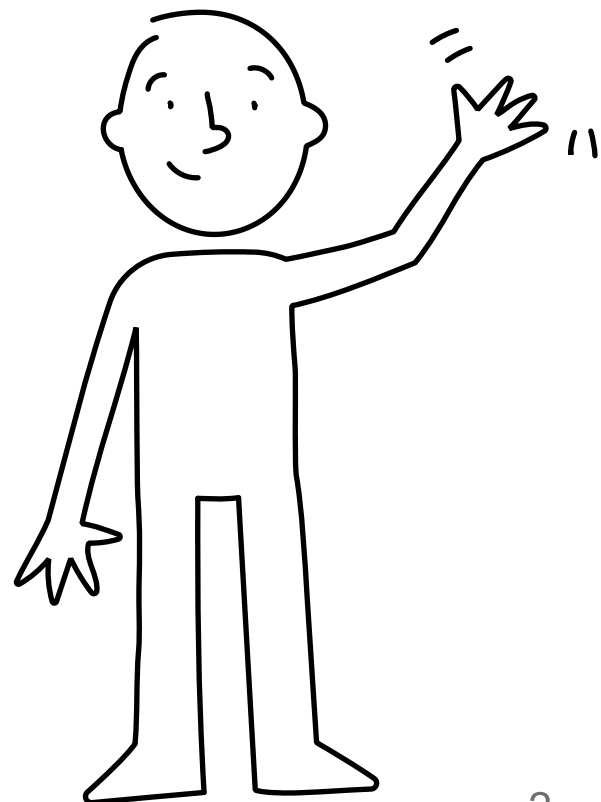
What will you need?

An electric screwdriver isn't necessary, but it can make the work much easier :)



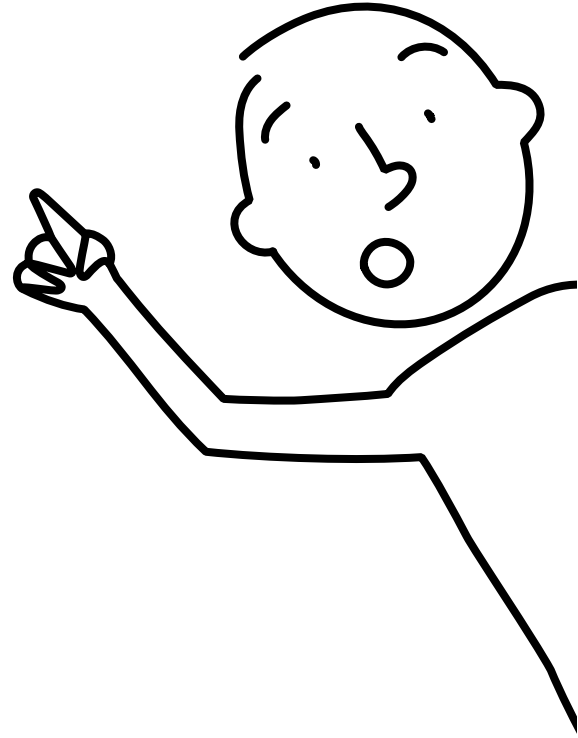
Where should you start?

Please make sure that the quantity of each one is correct, and that everything is in good shape.

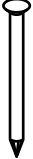
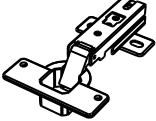
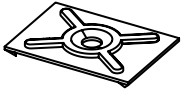
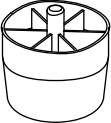
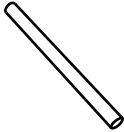

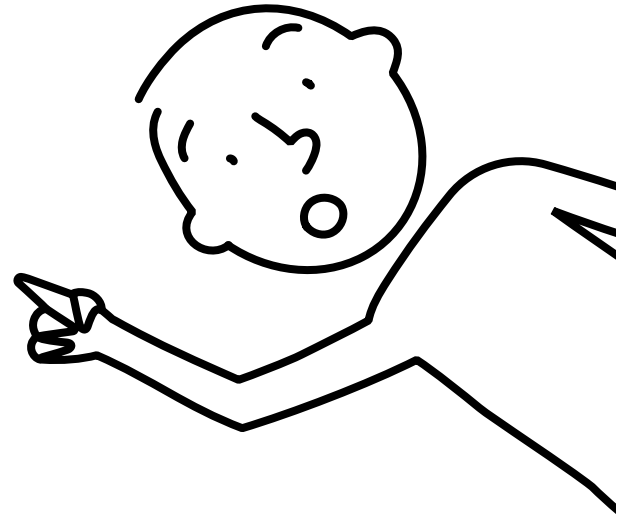


Be careful!, try not to lose anything from this bag, its content is necessary for assembling your closet.

How do the dowels and Minifix system work?

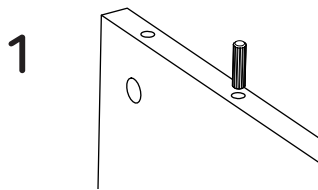
this is so important too!

Everytime you're using one of these connectors during the assembly, you should follow these same steps.

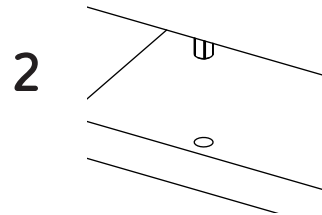


Wood dowels

They are little wooden cylinders.



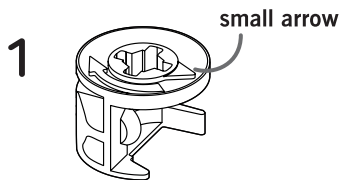
Put in the dowel inside the indicated hole and softly hit it until it's fully inside.



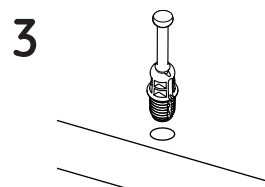
When joining two panels together, don't forget to gently hit the panels to adjust the joint.

Minifix system

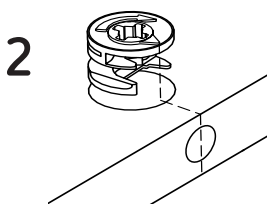
It's a joint compound of two parts: a spreading bolt and a Minifix cam.



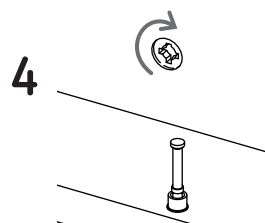
This is a Minifix cam. It has a little arrow on its upper surface.



This is a spreading bolt. You should put it with the black plastic part facing down.



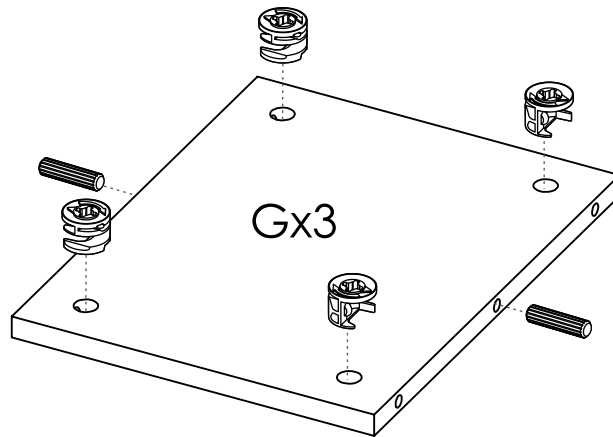
You should insert these cams with the little arrow pointing towards the drilling on the panel's edge (shown on the left).



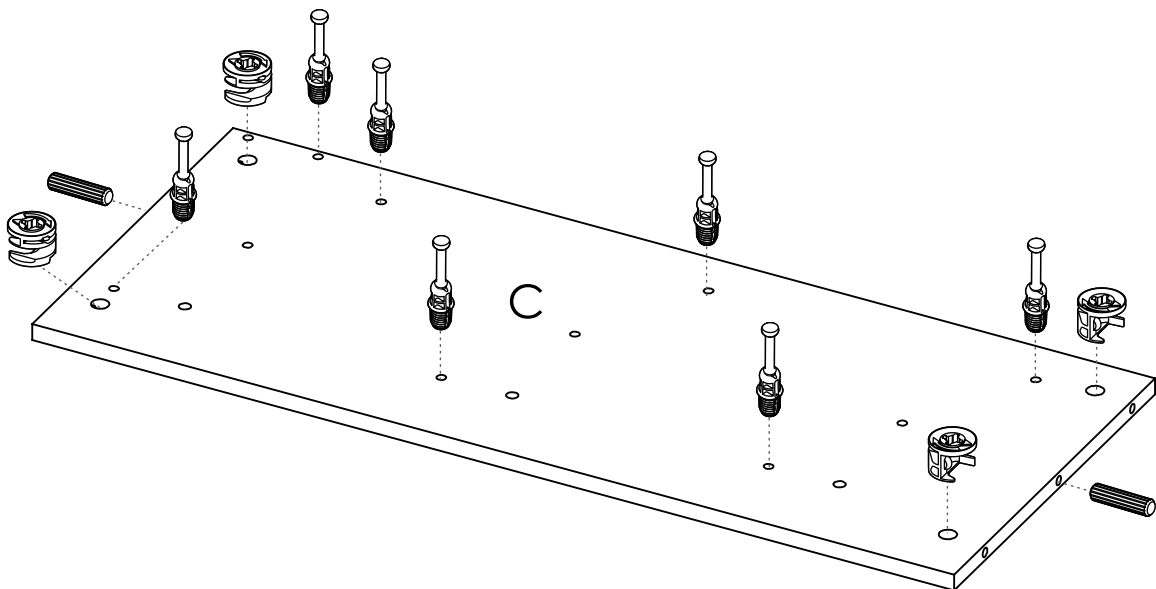
After joining two panels together you should turn the cams 180° with a phillips head screwdriver to adjust and secure the joint.

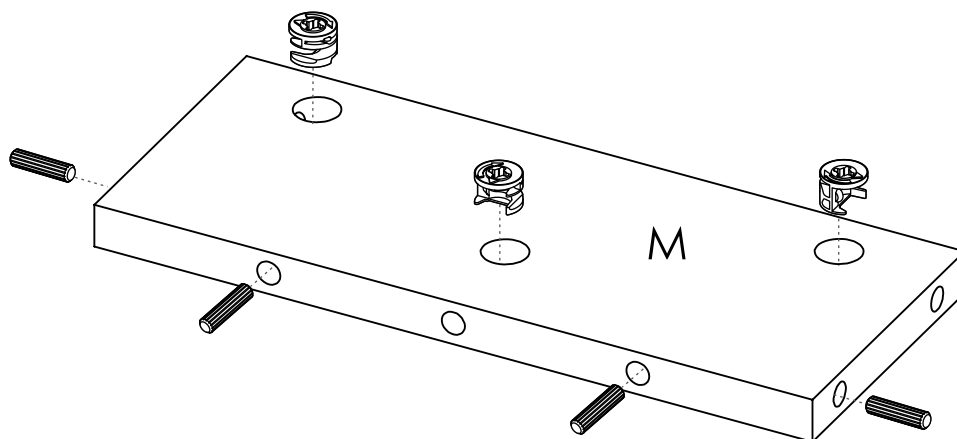
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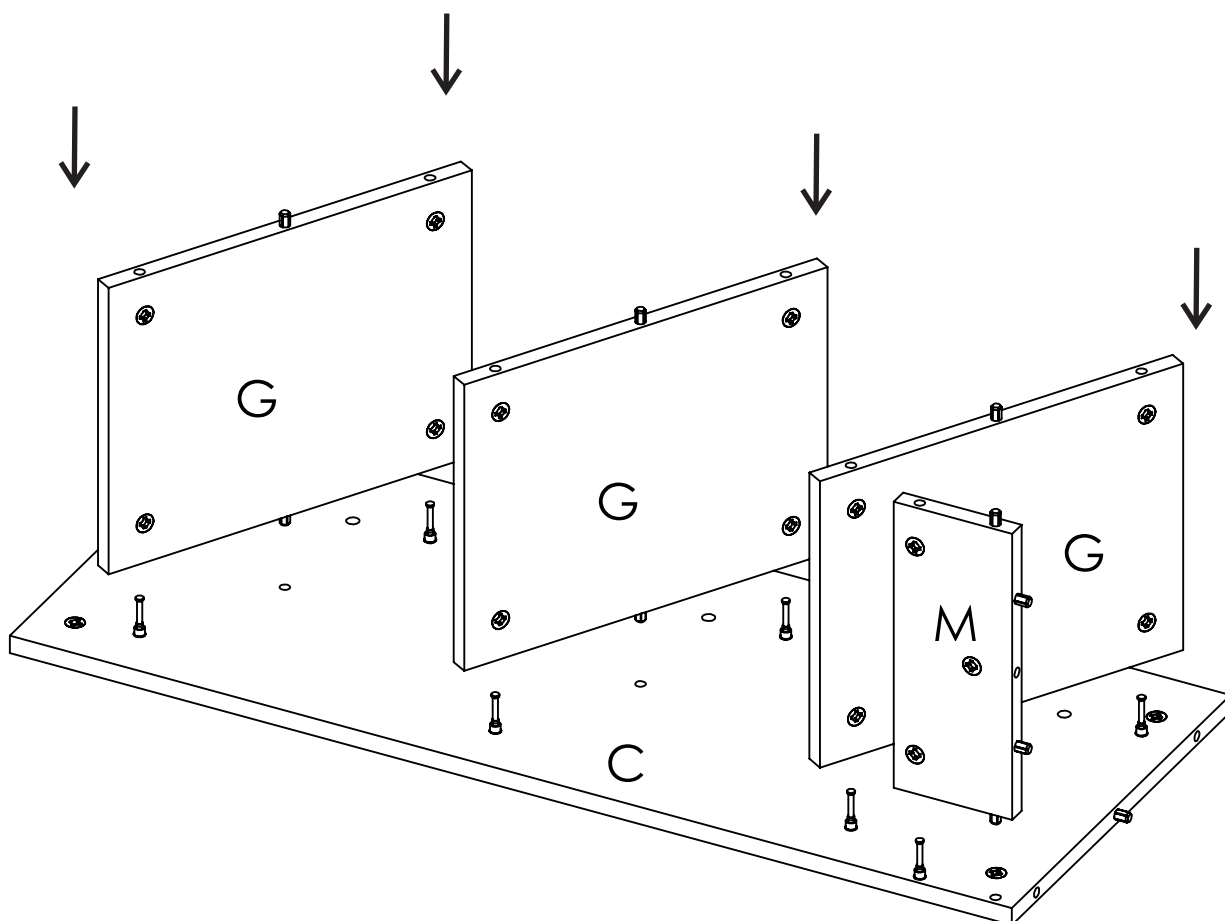
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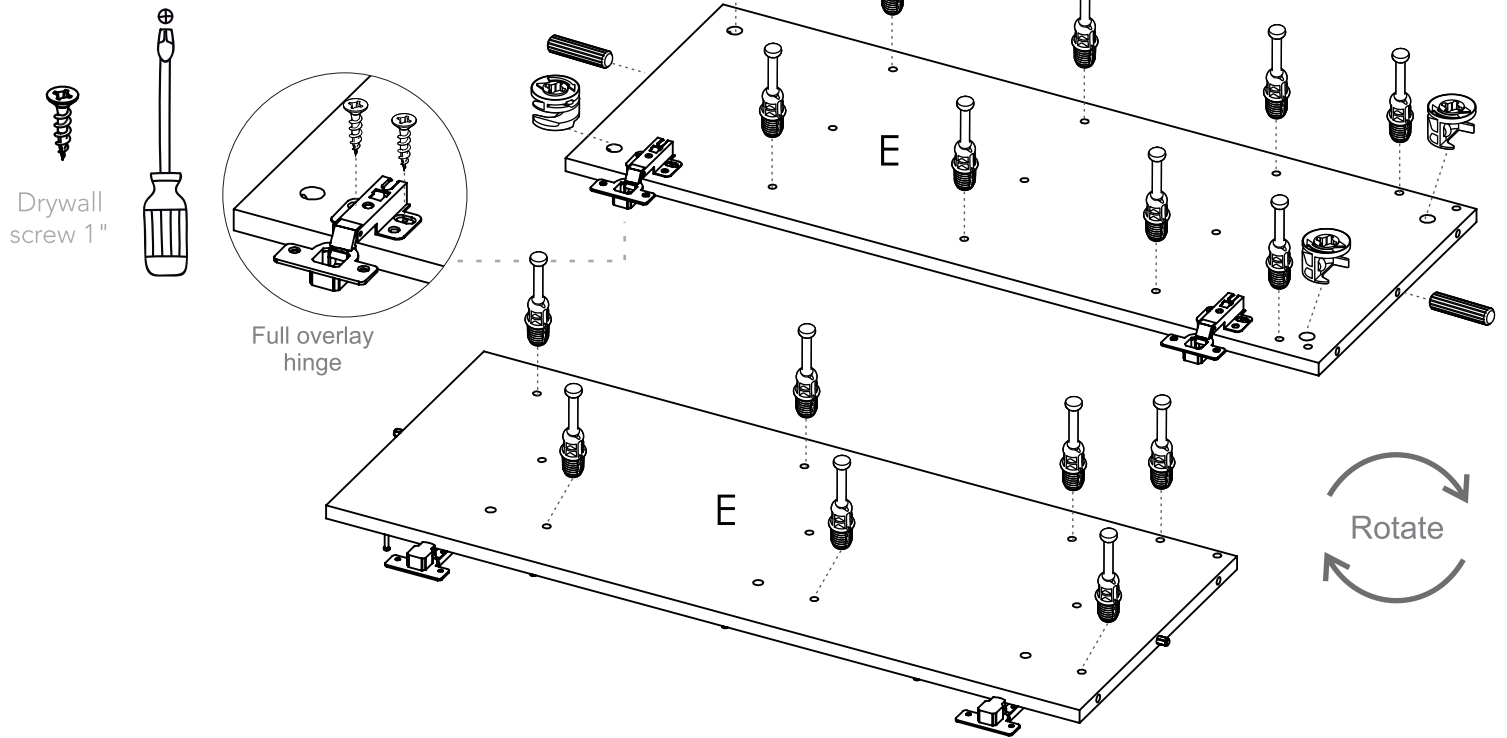
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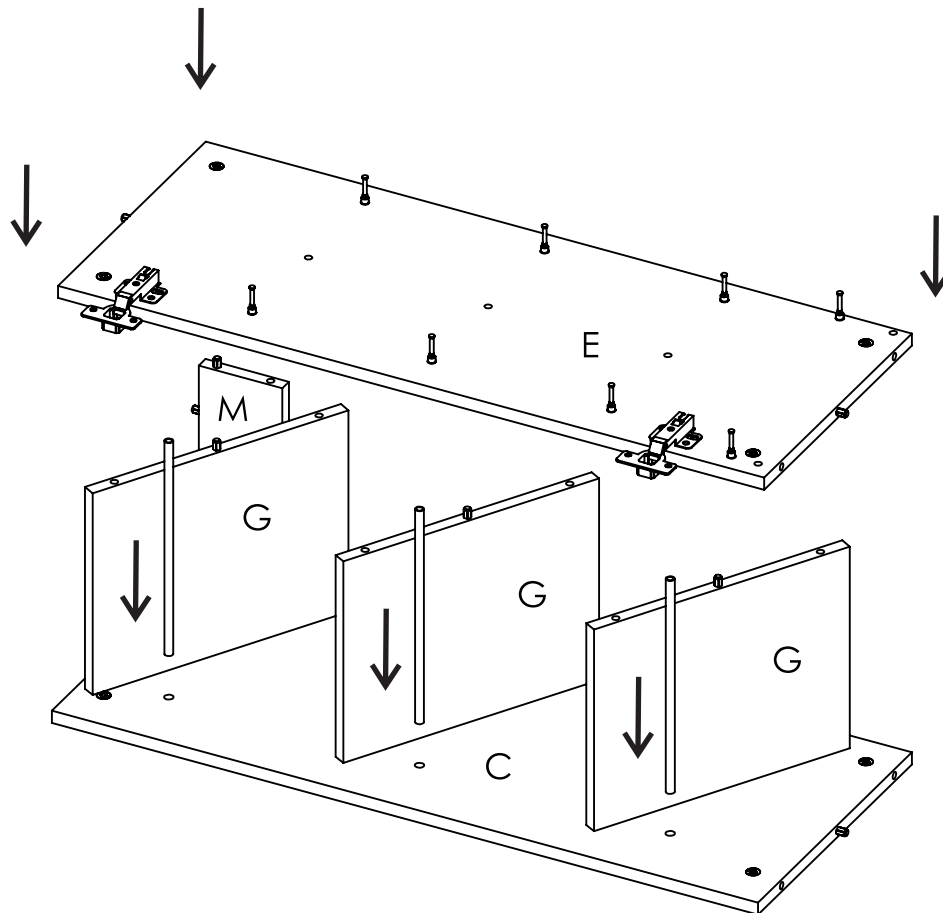
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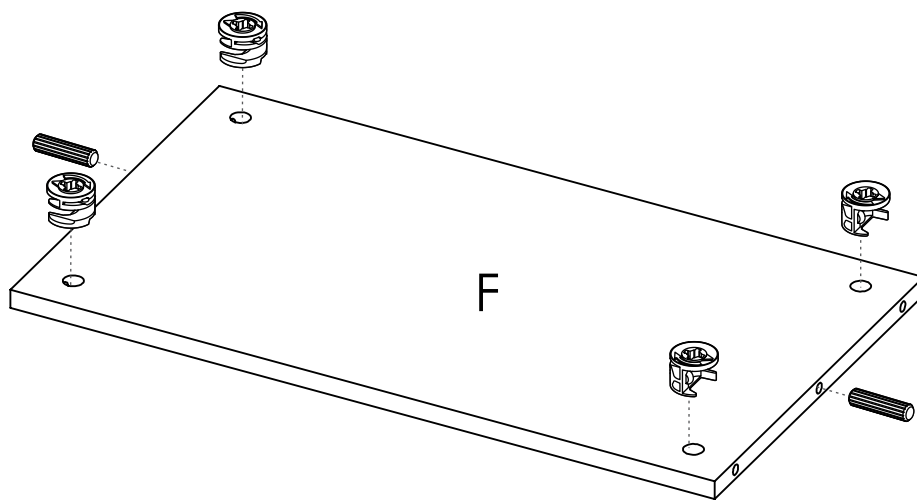
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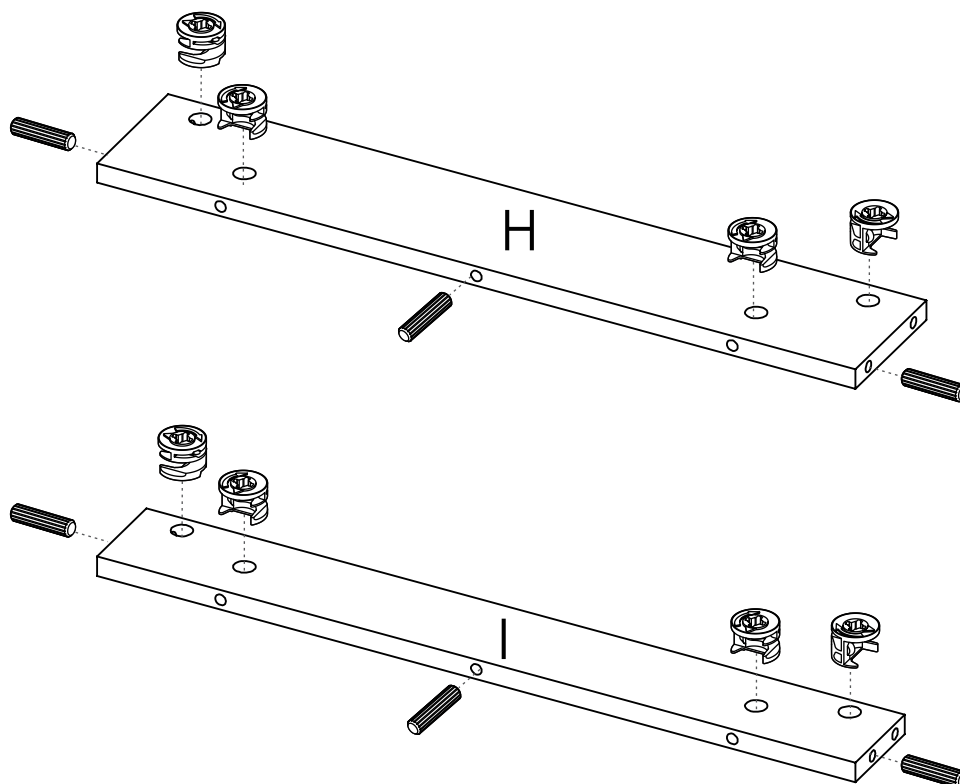
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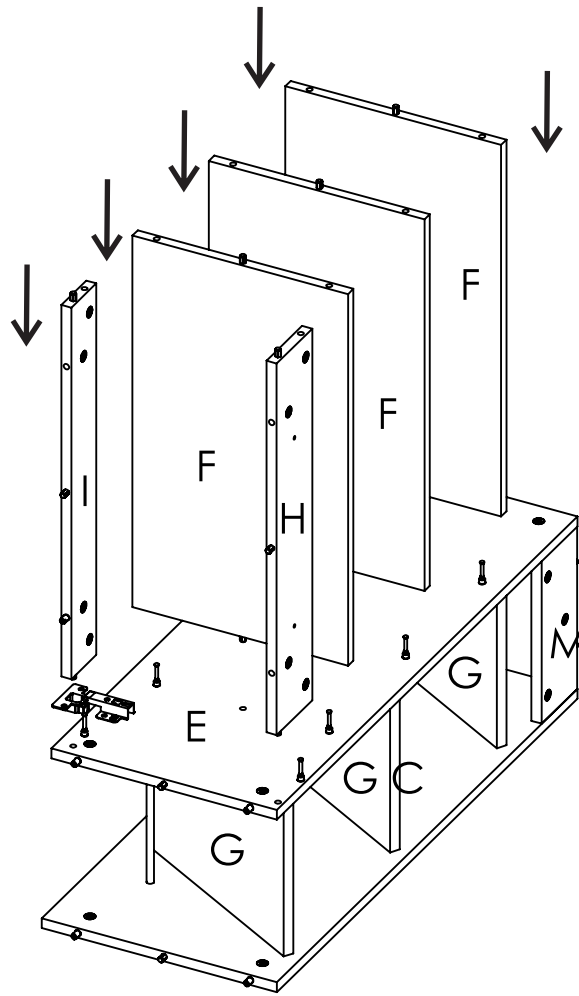
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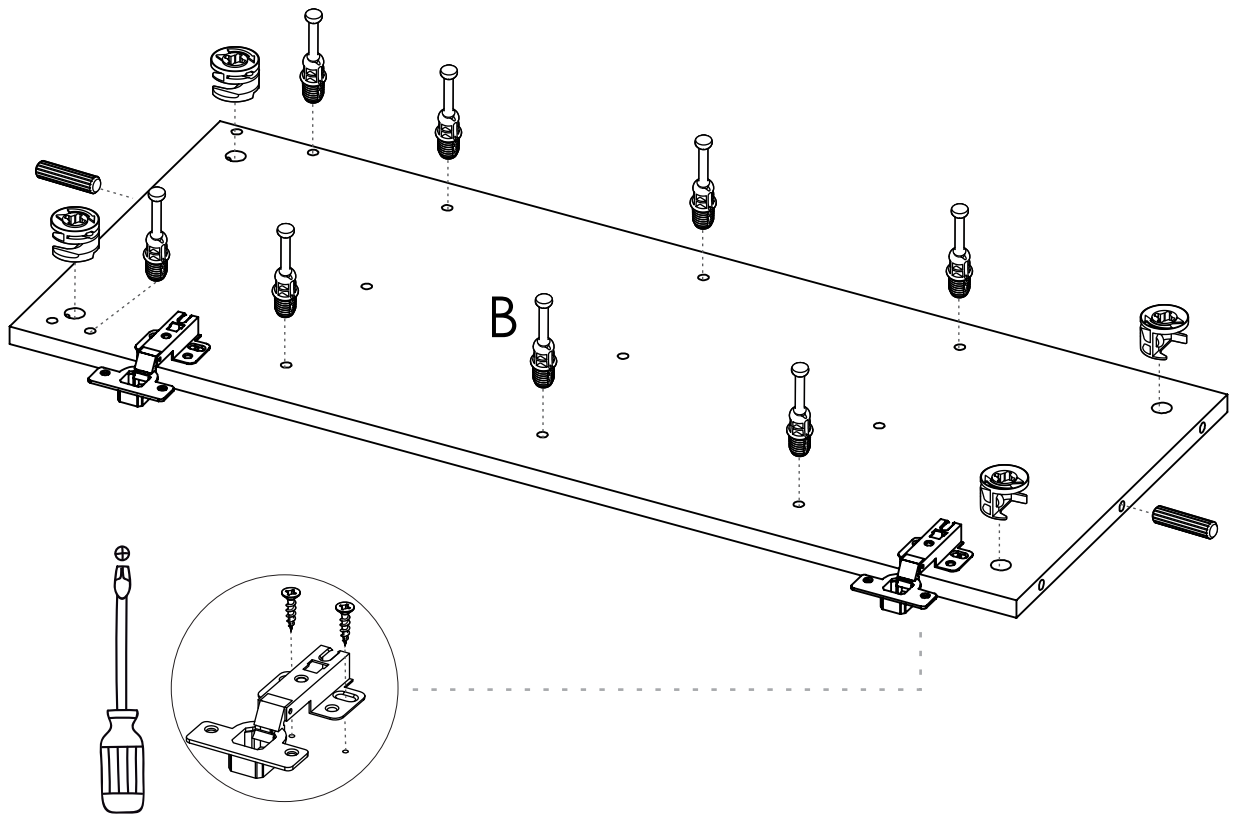
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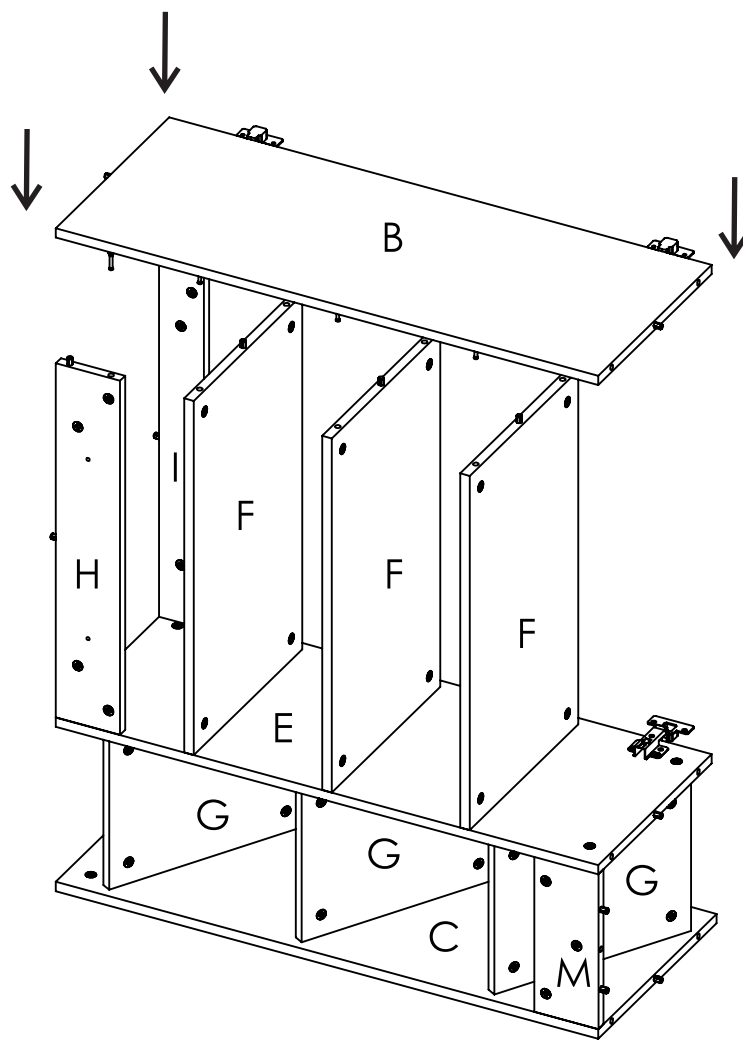


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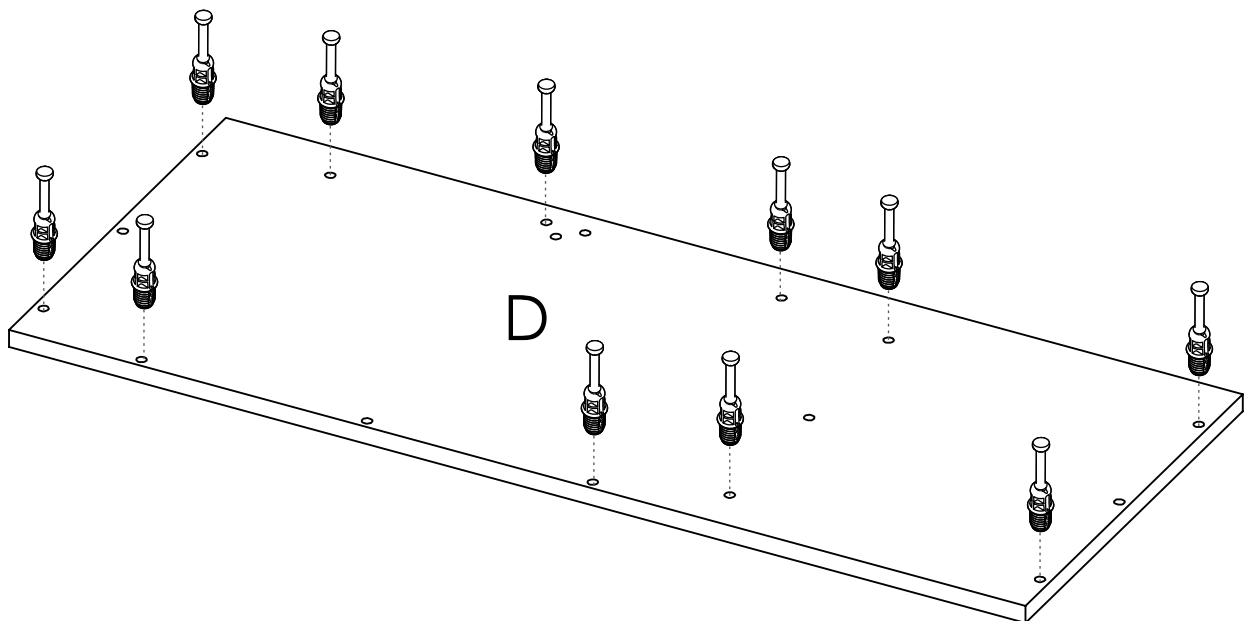


Full overlay Hinge

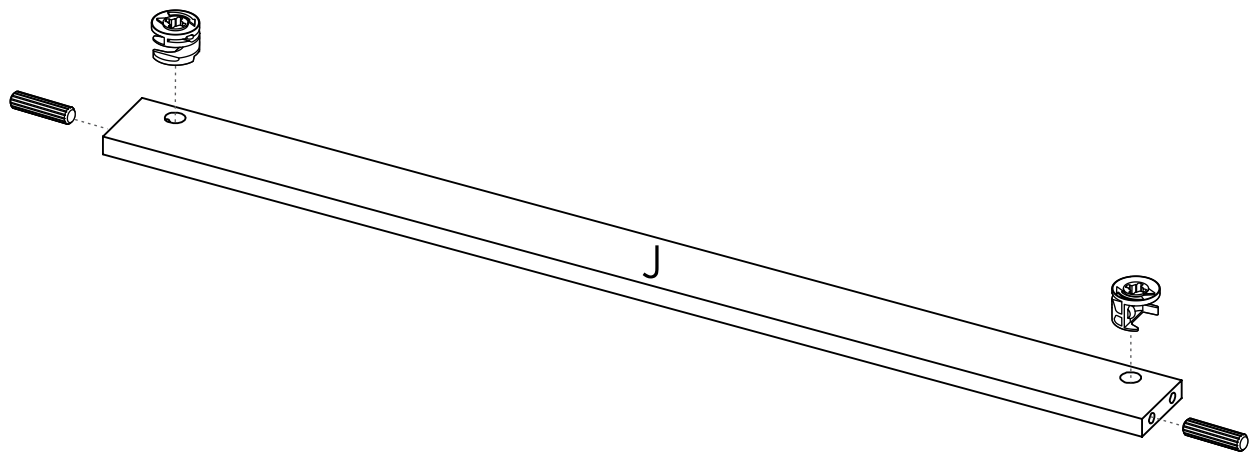
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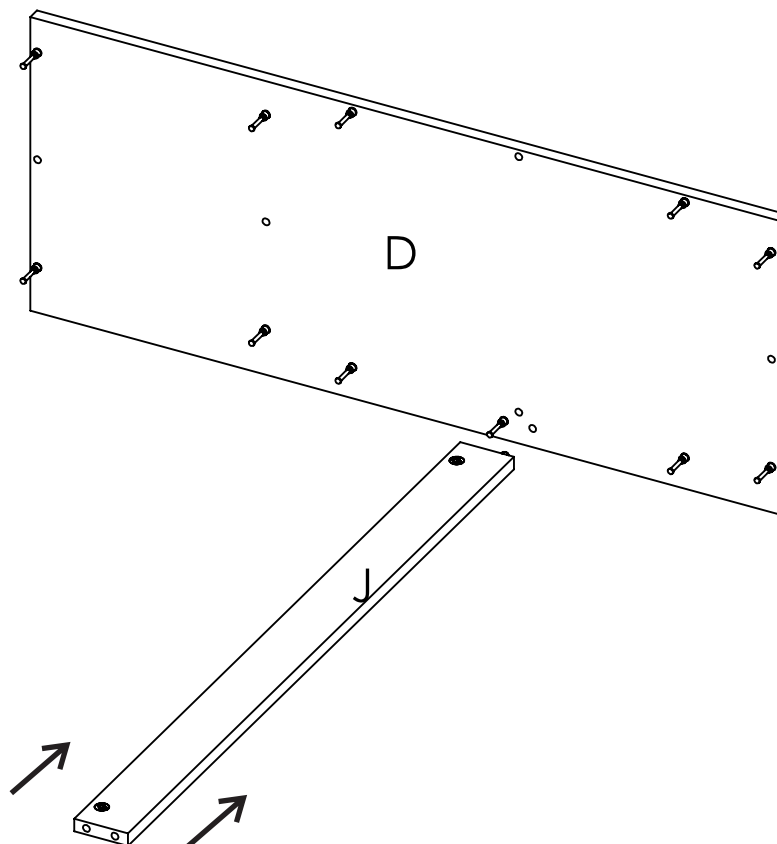
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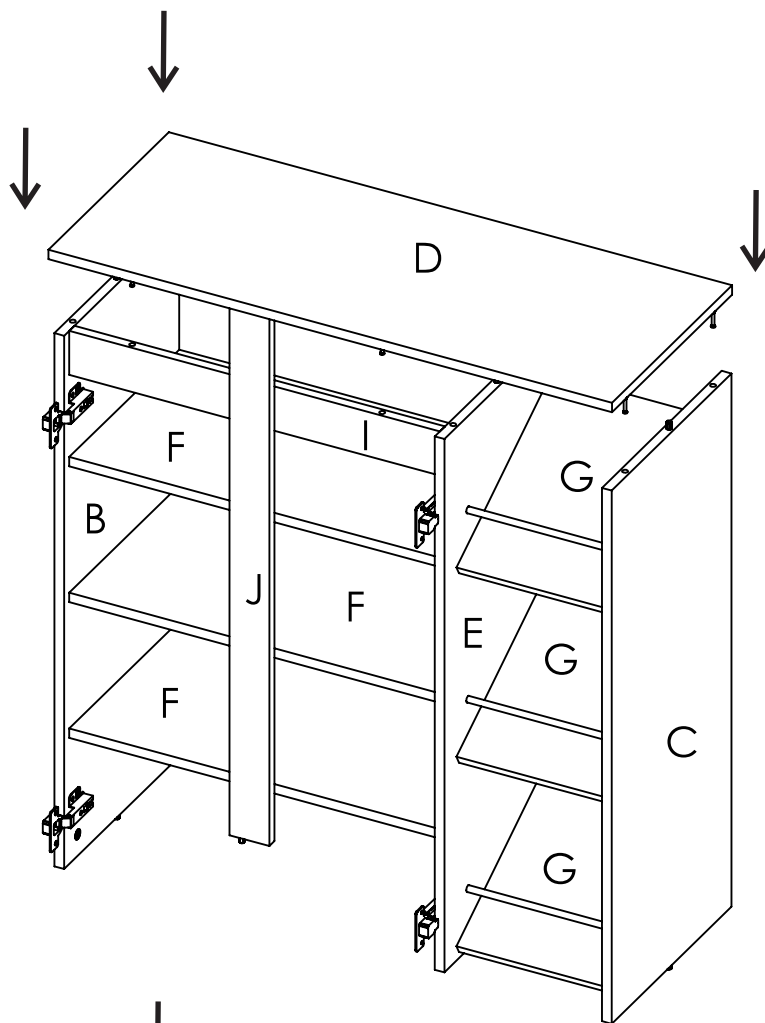
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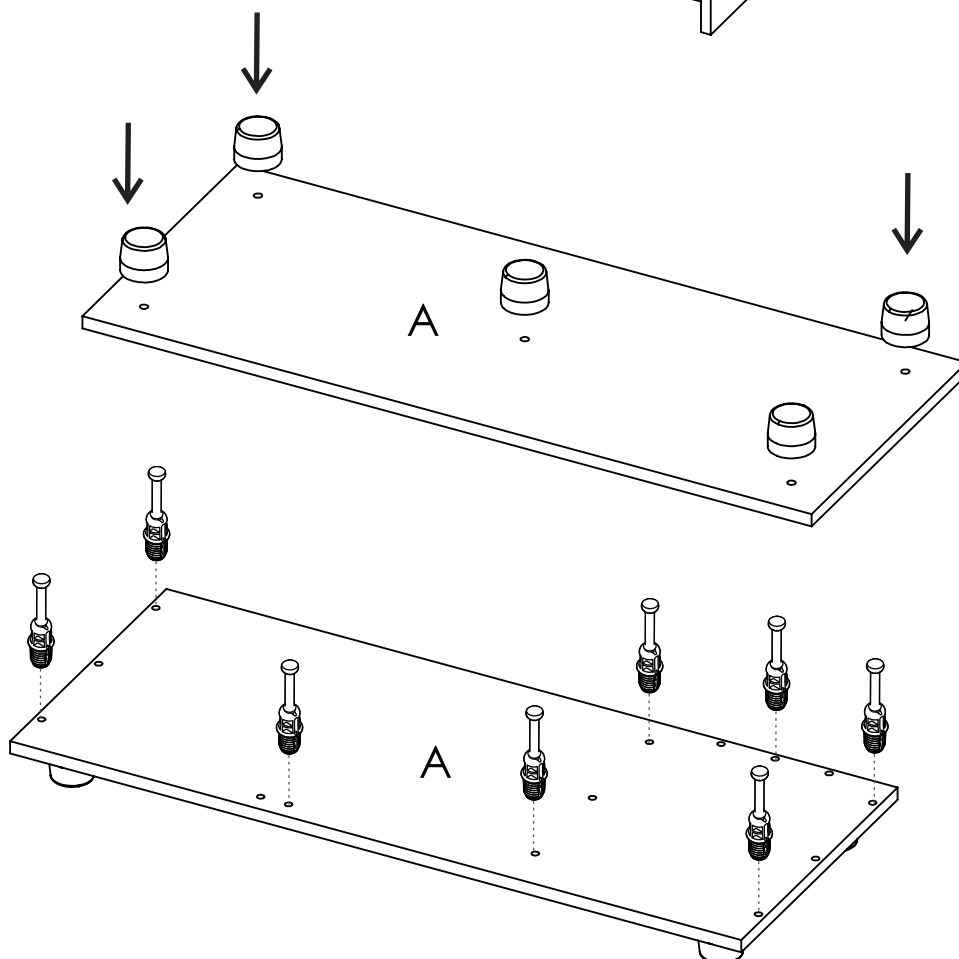

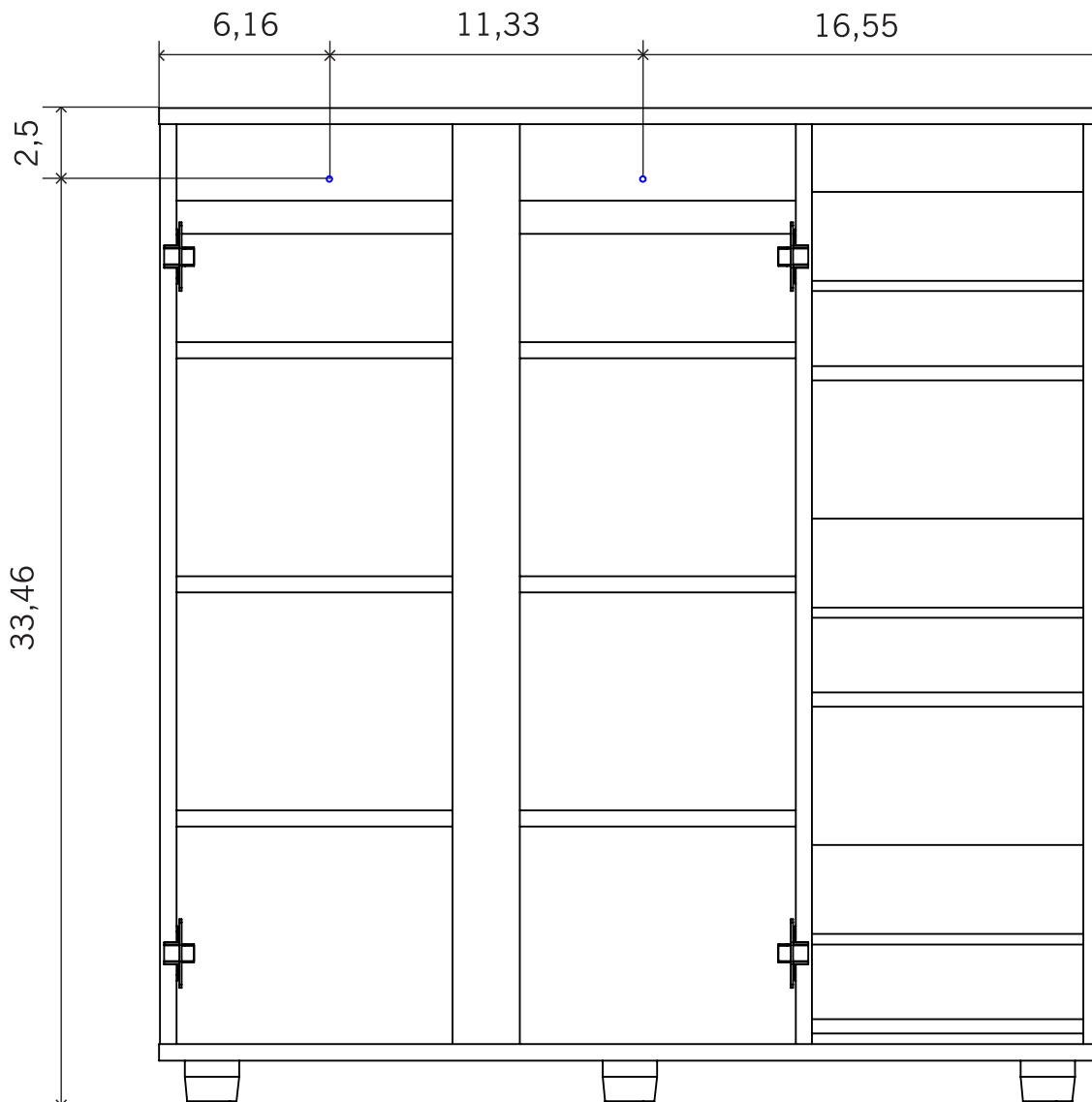
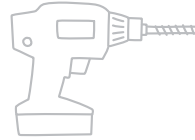


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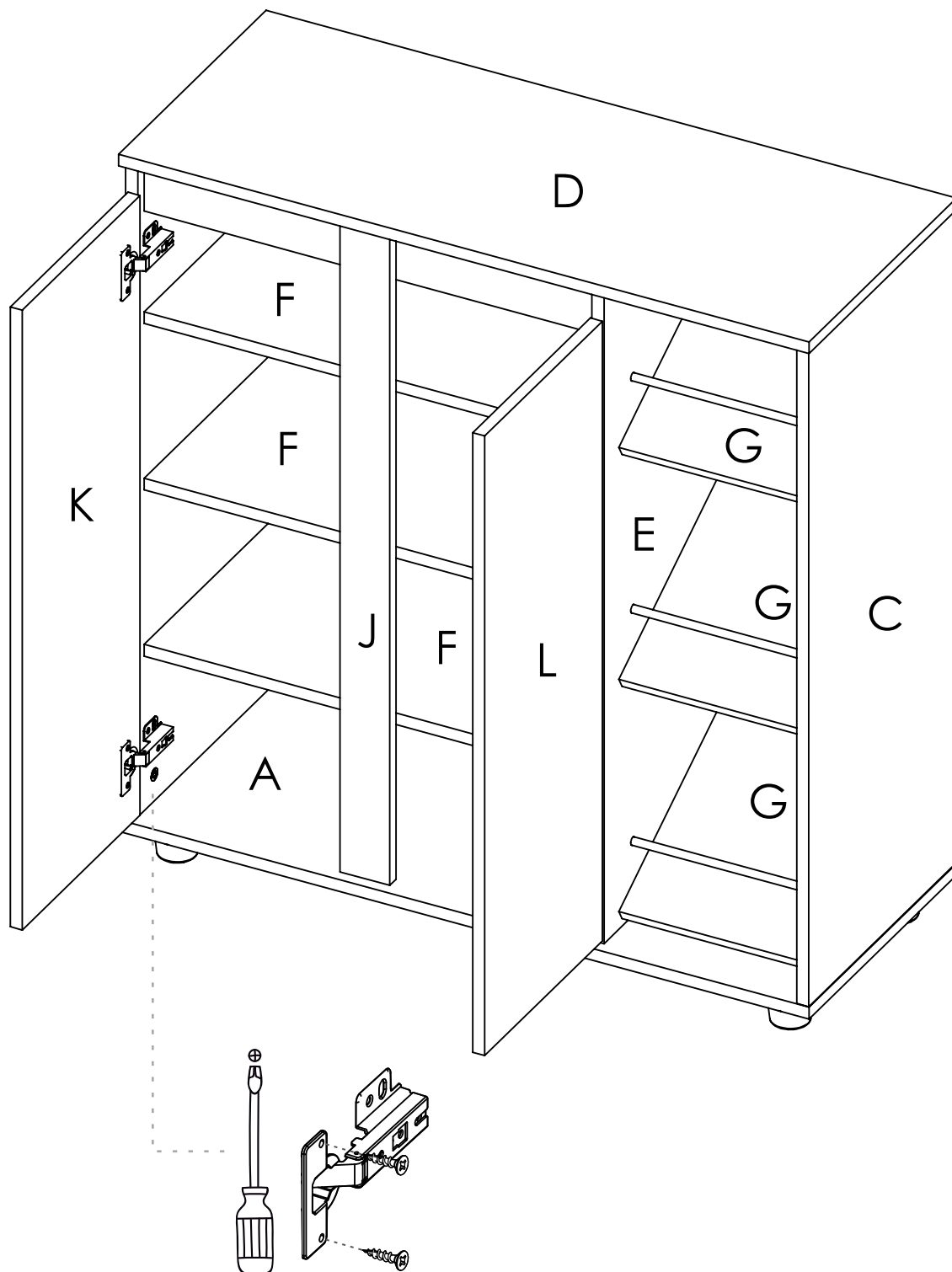
CHAZOS

Fix your cabinet to the wall

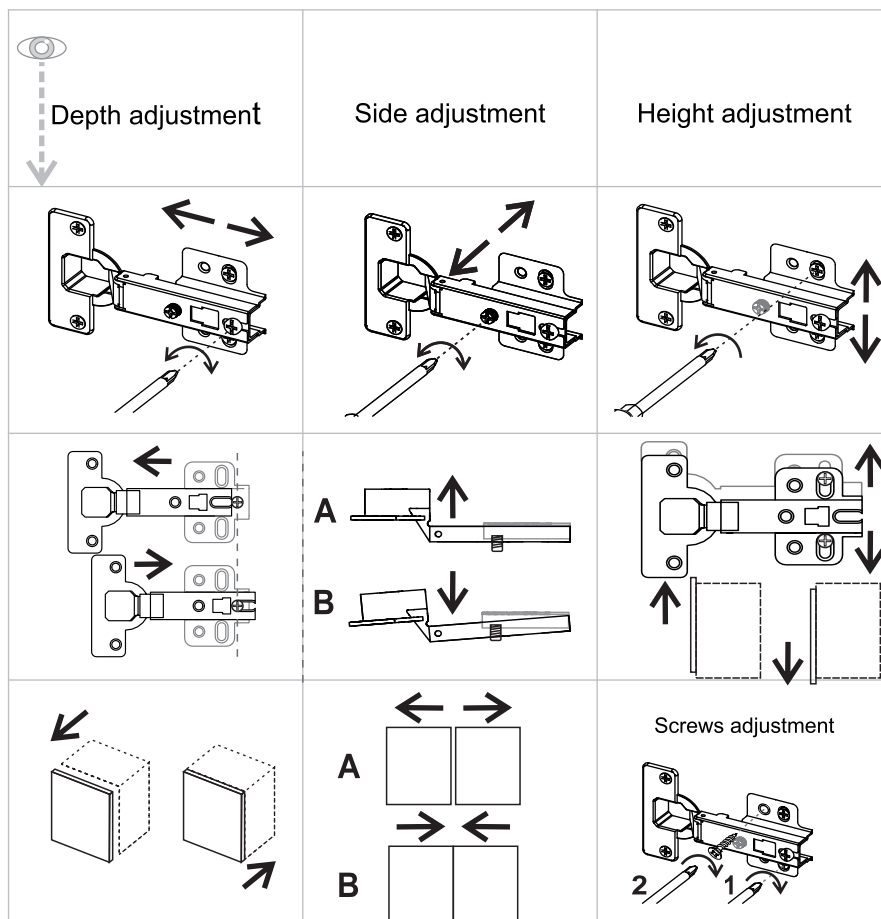
- 1 You must drill the bottoms guided by the holes in the structures with a 3/16" drill bit.
- 2 On the wall, measure and mark the points shown below.
- 3 Drill on the markings with a 5/16" drill bit.
- 4 Insert the wall anchors inside the drillings.
- 5 Place the cabinet and secure it with the screws.



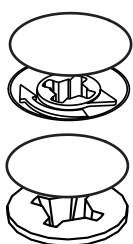

Use the settings according to the specific need.

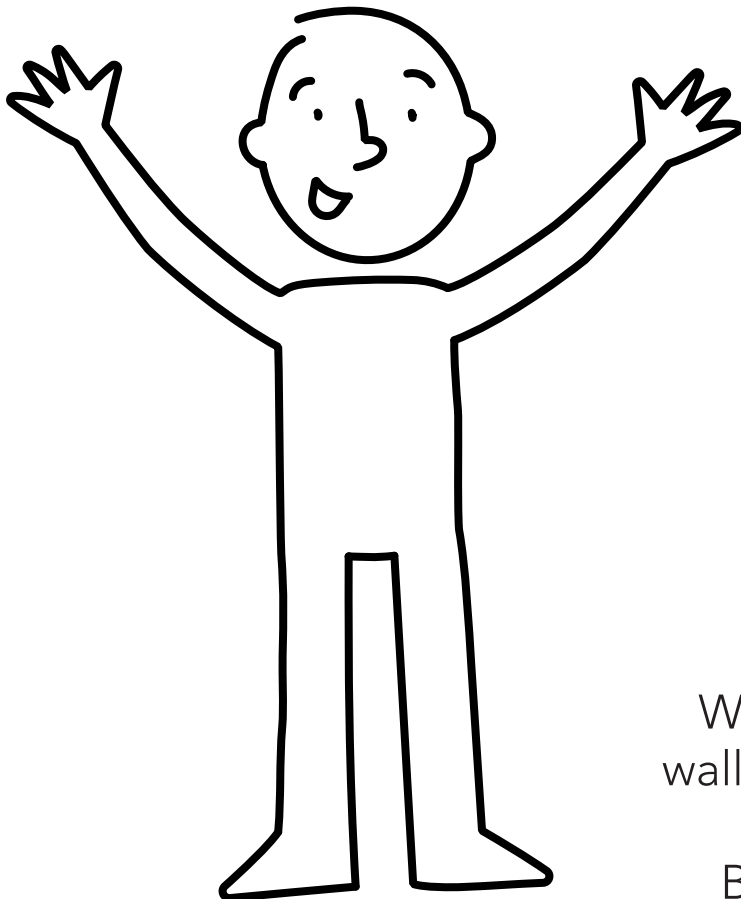
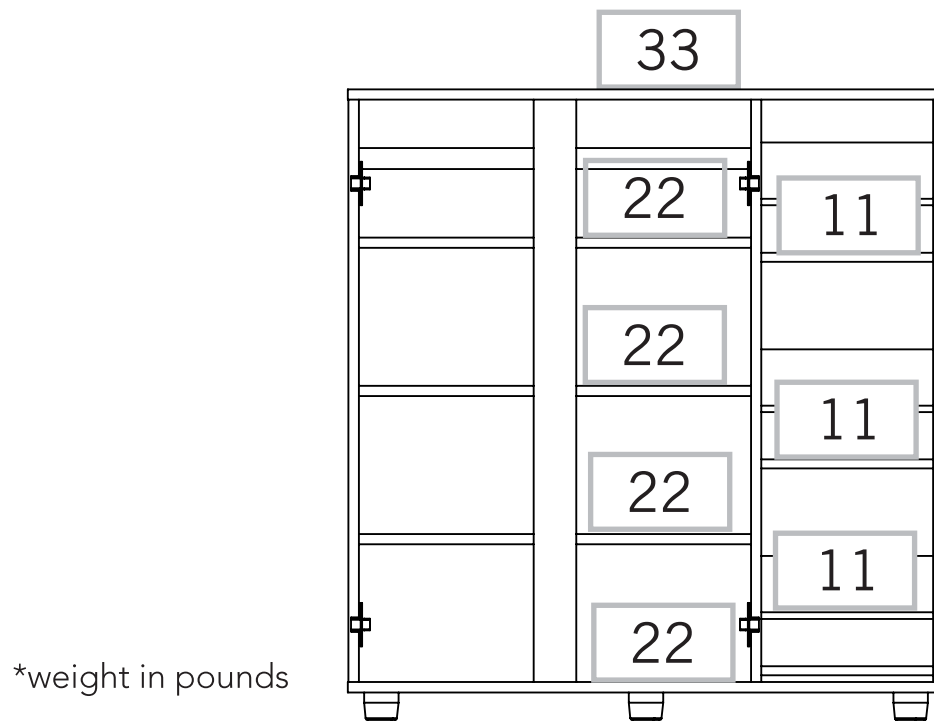


After you finish the adjustment of the cams and screws, cover them with the cover caps.

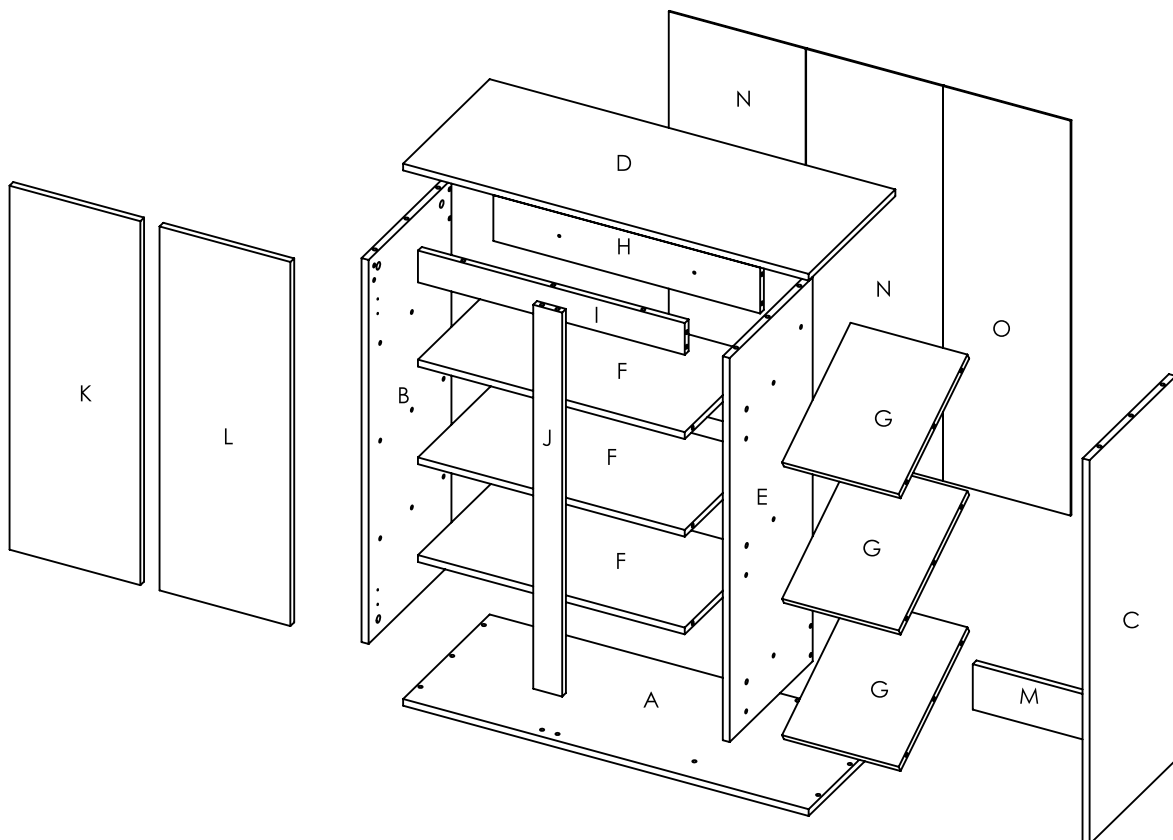
SUPER IMPORTANT!

We suggest fixing the closet to the
wall, so we can avoid the table tipping
and harming anyone.
Be specially careful with the kids.

Taking care of your shoe rack:

- Do not paint the shoe rack.
- The table it's exclusively for indoor spaces. Do not expose it to the direct sun.
- Clean the metallic hardware with a dry cloth.
- DO NOT overload the shoe rack (see suggested loads)
- Do not hit or hammer the shoe rack (only when indicated here).
- Clean it with thinner, a soft soap solution or simply a damp cloth.
- Don't drag the shoe rack, lift it up with other people.
- Avoid direct contact with water, fire or exposing it to high heat.

WARRANTY POLICY

The product has a 3-year warranty coverage on wooden parts and a 1-year warranty coverage on hardware pieces from the manufacturing date, which can be found in the lot number printed on the product box and the assembly instructions leaflet.

The warranty covers material and workmanship defects that impair the assembly or proper functioning of the cabinet.

This warranty is not valid if defects or imperfections are caused by failure to follow assembly instructions, warnings, and recommendations, misuse, intentional damage, fire, flood, modifications or alterations, or repairs performed by unauthorized persons, or if the product is assembled more than 3 months after the date of purchase. These defects **MUST** be reported before the warranty period expires. Once the product has been assembled, the company will not be responsible for defective and/or damaged parts.

This warranty is **ONLY** valid for the **ORIGINAL PURCHASER** and does not apply if the product has been resold, rented, or otherwise transferred.

No liability is assumed for incidental or consequential damages caused by or to the product (this may not apply in your state).

To validate this warranty, you must contact customer service via email describing the product defect, including the lot number, and providing your sales receipt or proof of purchase, or contact customer service by phone. Replaced parts will remain under the original warranty period. Damaged parts will become the property of the company.

No other warranties are applicable to this product.
