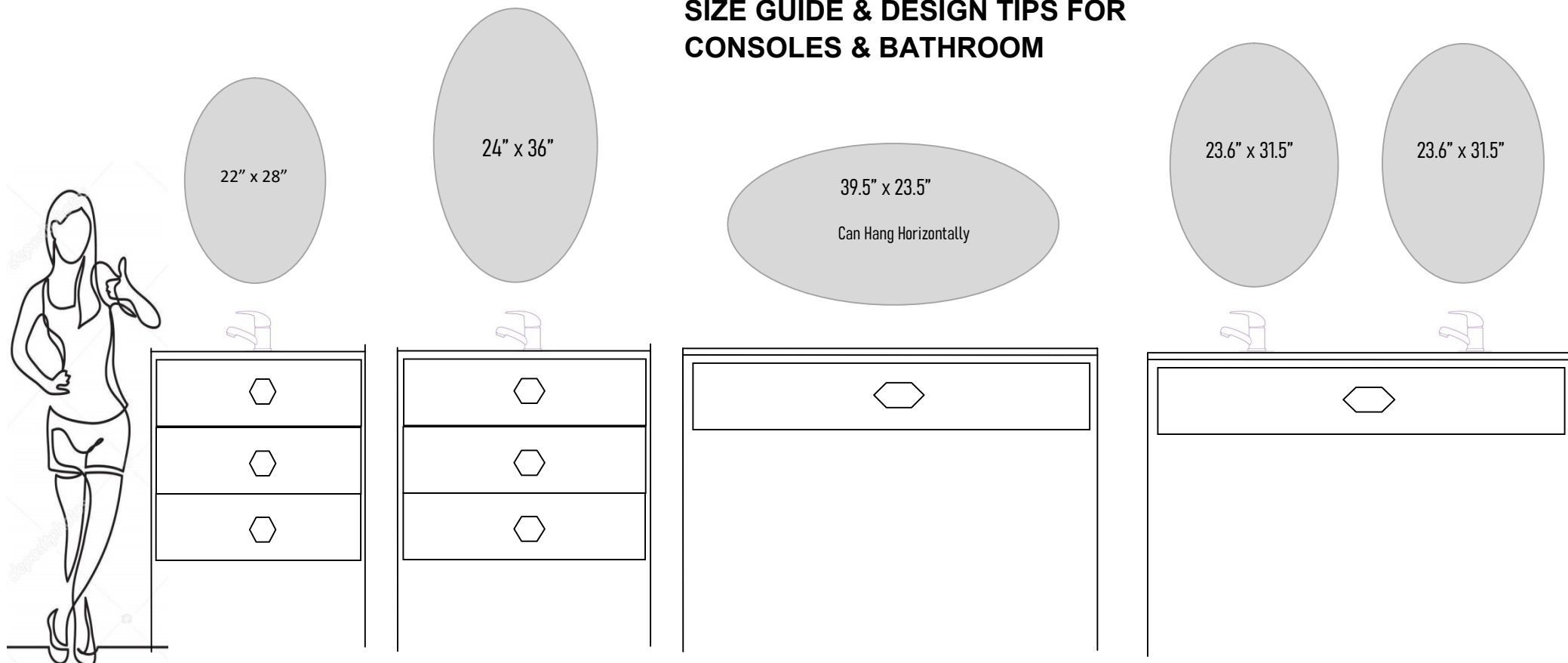


SIZE GUIDE & DESIGN TIPS FOR CONSOLES & BATHROOM



INTERIOR DESIGNER TIPS

- ⚡ When placing a mirror above a vanity, console table, arm chair or fire place - hang your mirror 6" – 8" above the visual line. This will protect your mirror from water splashes as well
- ⚡ Choose a mirror that is 1-2 inches shorter than the width of the countertop of your bathroom vanity
- ⚡ Make sure that the mirror is **tall enough** so that your head doesn't get cut off when you look into it
- ⚡ When hanging your mirror above a nightstand, centre the mirror above the night stand
- ⚡ If your mirror is going on a blank wall, centre it horizontally on the wall space and hang it so the vertical centre is at eye level- usually 60" from the floor
- ⚡ Hang mirrors with a buddy who can hold things up and give the chance to 'eyeball' your placement
- ⚡ ADA COMPLIANT MIRRORS – Just make the bottom edge of the reflective surface is no higher than 40" off the ground

⚡ All oval mirrors featured can be hung horizontally and vertically

FEATURED OVAL MIRRORS:

- ⚡ Measures 22" X 28":
- ⚡ Measures 23.6" x 31.5":
(.5" bevel)
(Scalloped edge & 0.5" bevel)
(polished & frosted edge)
(double v-groove etches)
(8" grey glass "frame")
(molten glass frame)
- ⚡ Measures 24" x 36":
(1" bevel)
- ⚡ Measures 39.5" x 23.5":
(polished edge)
