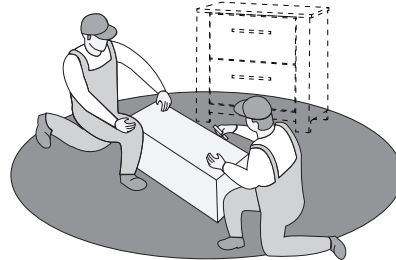
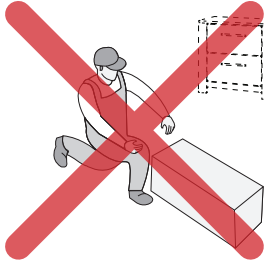
TEAM ASSEMBLY

Have at least 2 people put the product together to prevent injury and damage.



ASSEMBLE IN PLACE

Put together near the intended location to avoid moving later.



CLEAR WORKSPACE

Ensure ample room to maneuver during assembly.



AVOID SCRATCHES

Assemble on cardboard, blankets, or carpet to prevent scratches.



FLAT SURFACE

Place on a level surface with furniture legs evenly contacting the floor.

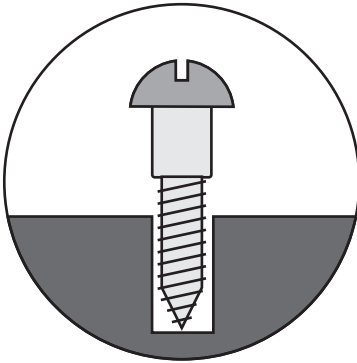


ASSEMBLY SAFETY STEPS



FAILURE TO FOLLOW THE GUIDELINES BELOW MAY RESULT IN INJURY AND/OR PROPERTY DAMAGE.

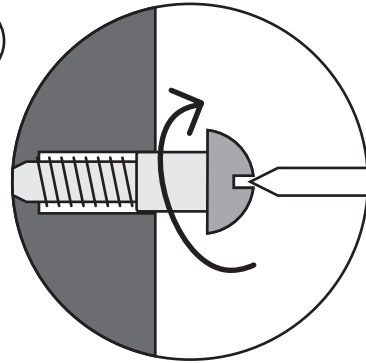

POSITIONING

Insert all hardware and parts in the correct holes.

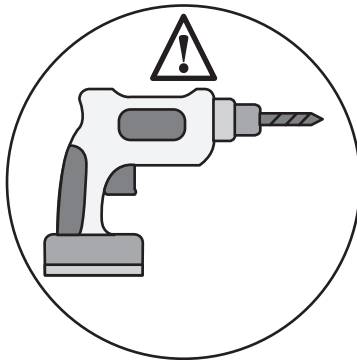

TIGHTENING

Only tighten bolts when the step is fully completed.

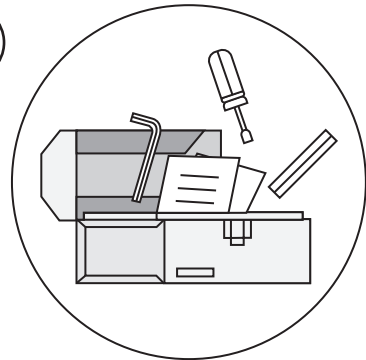

TOOLS

Use hand tools unless the manual specifies power tools.

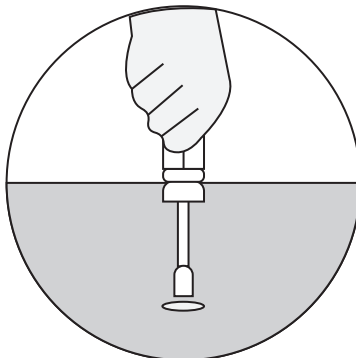
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INSTRUCTIONS

MAINTENANCE

Check for loose joints after 2 weeks and re-tighten every 6 months.

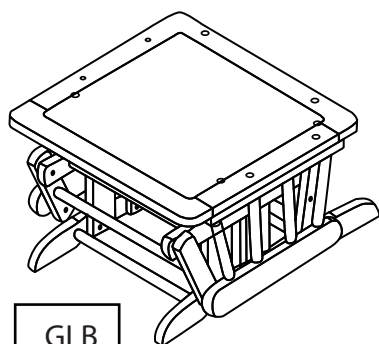
DISCLAIMER:

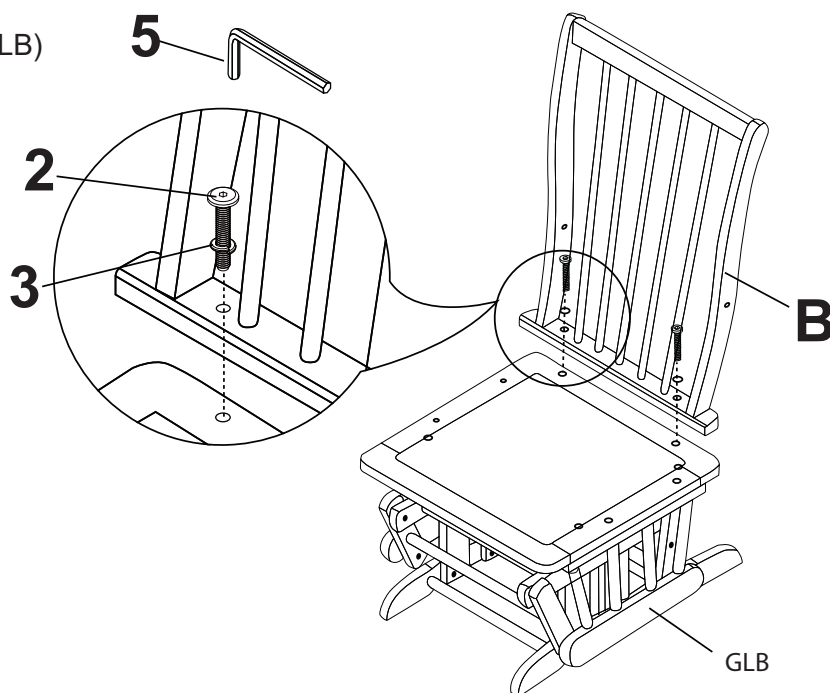
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION

ITEM NO: F6780 / F6790

1

Attach the back frame (B) to Glider base (GLB) using bolts (2) and washer (3). Use Allen key (5) to fasten bolts.

Note: Leave bolts loose to allow easier assembly of arms in following steps.



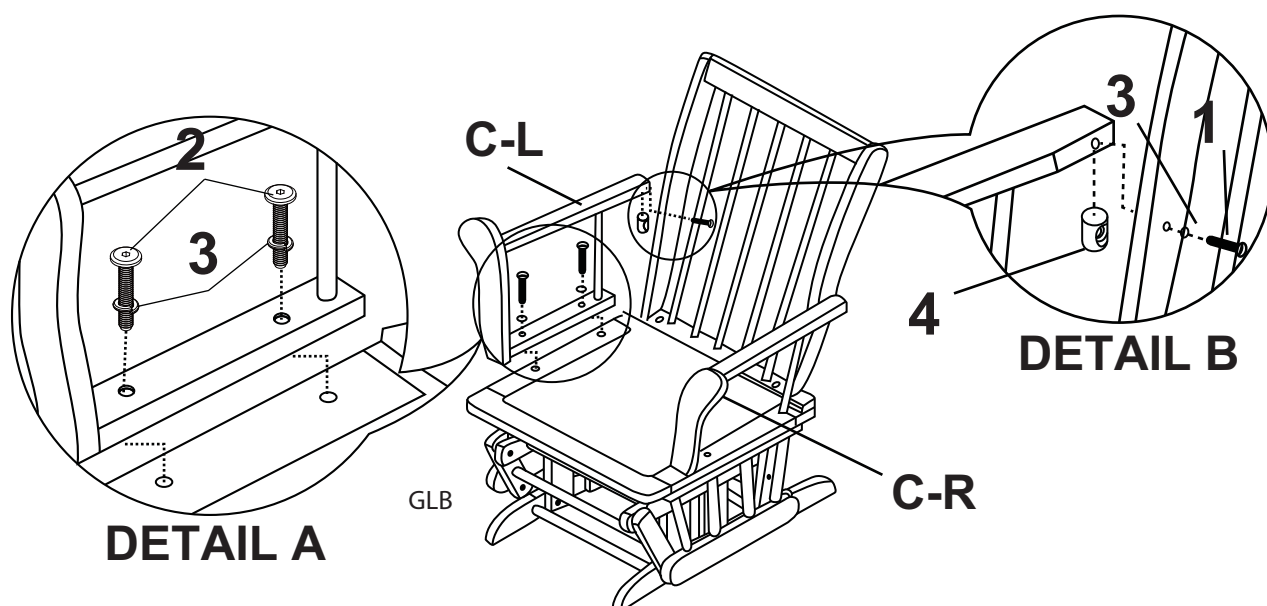

2.1 Attach the right arm assembly (C-R) to back frame (B) using bolt (1), washer (3) and barrel nut (4). Insert barrel nut (4) into the hole underneath the armrest as per DETAIL B. Use Allen key (5) to fasten bolts.

2.2 Attach the right arm assembly (C-R) to the base (GLB) using bolts (2) and washer (3) as per DETAIL A. Use Allen key (5) to fasten bolts.

2.3 Repeat steps 2.1 and 2.2 to assemble left arm assembly (C-L).

NOTE: REGULARLY CHECK AND RETIGHTEN ALL ASSEMBLY BOLTS.

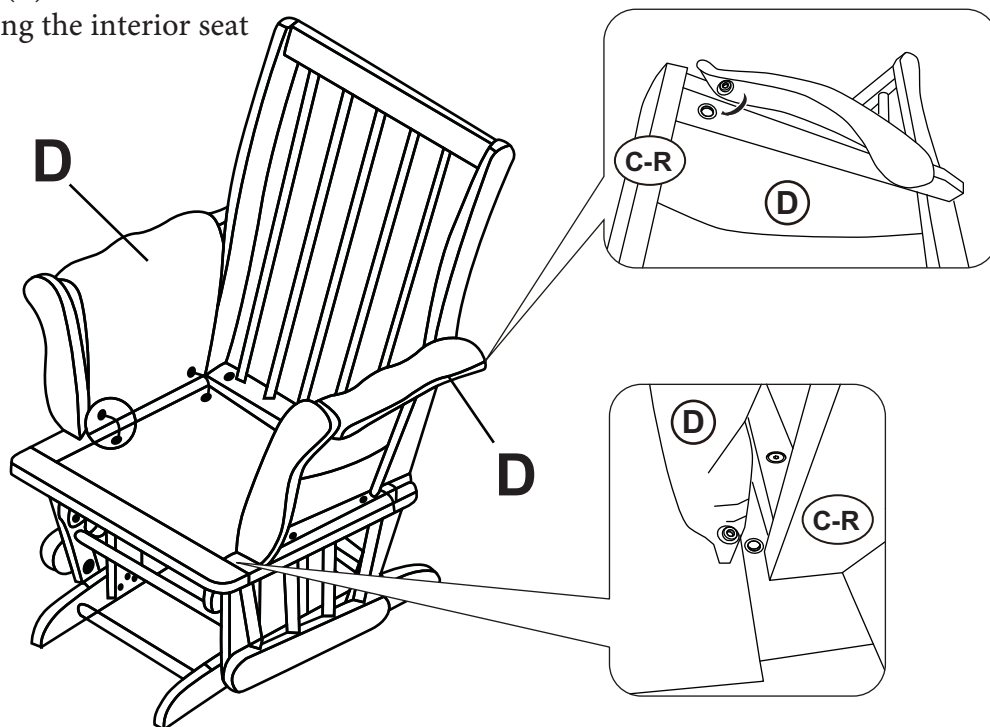

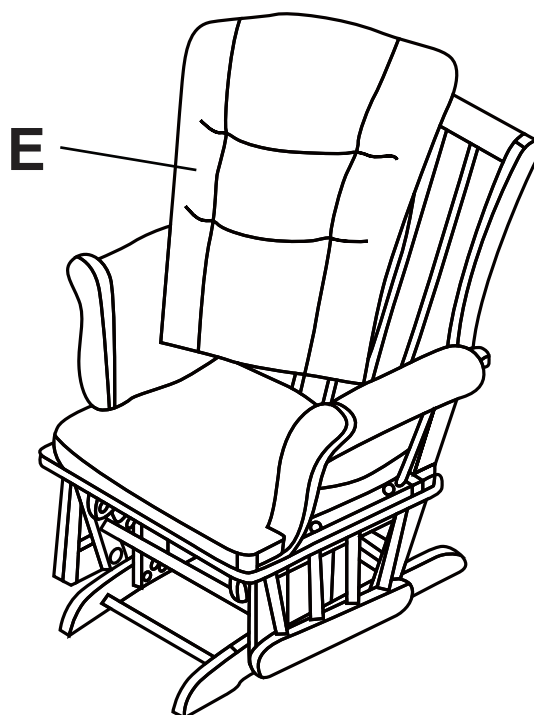
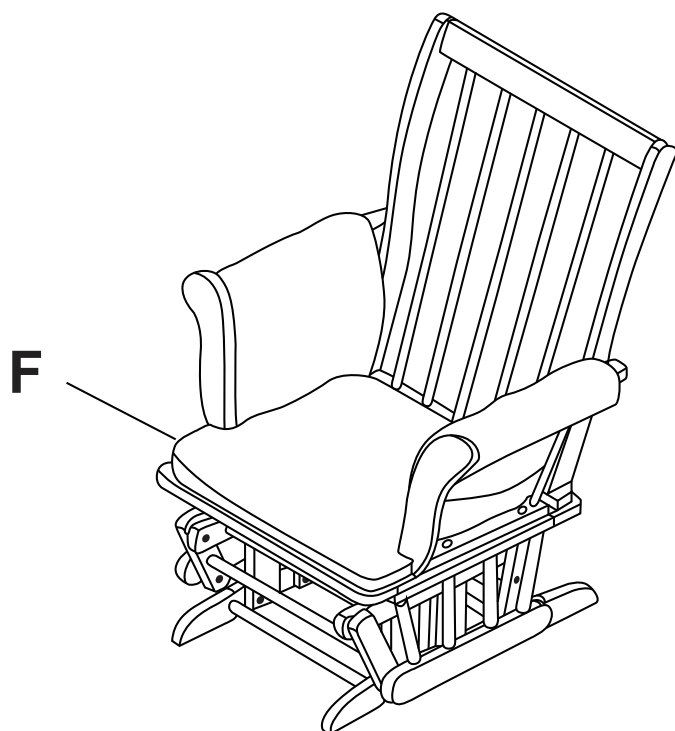
Attach the armrest cushions (D) to the armrest by buttoning the buttons along the interior seat and on the sides.

(E) to the back frame



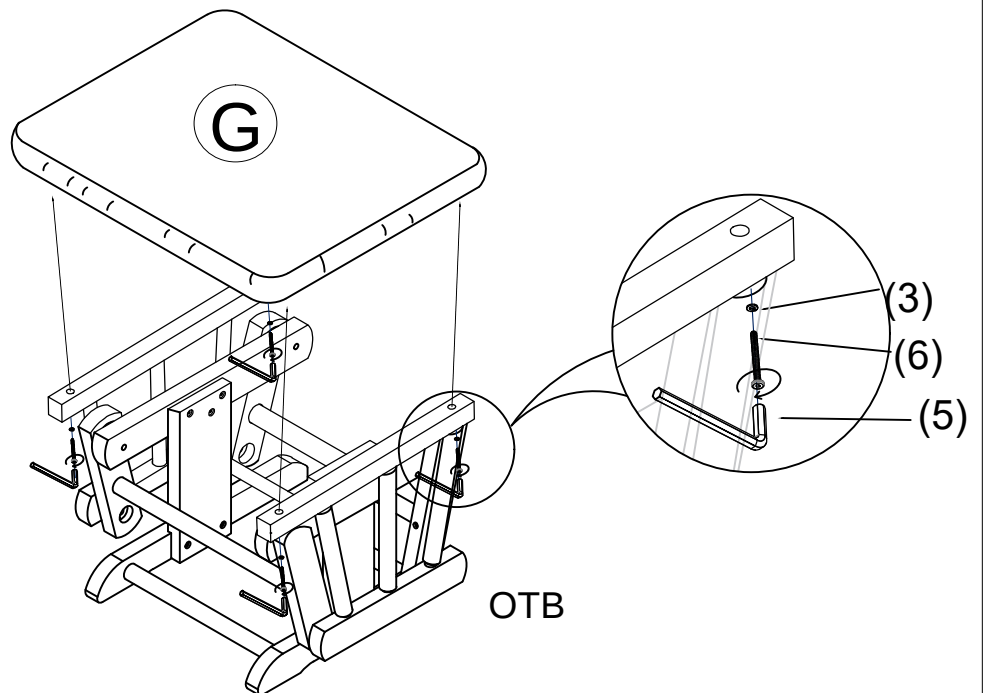
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION
