

Small Kitchen Island

Assembly Instructions

Parts Included :

- (1) Table top part (A)
- (1) Shelf (B)
- (4) Legs (C)
- (4) Towel Bracket (D)
- (2) Towel Bar (E)

Hardware Included :

- (8) Nuts (F)
- (8) Flat washers (G)

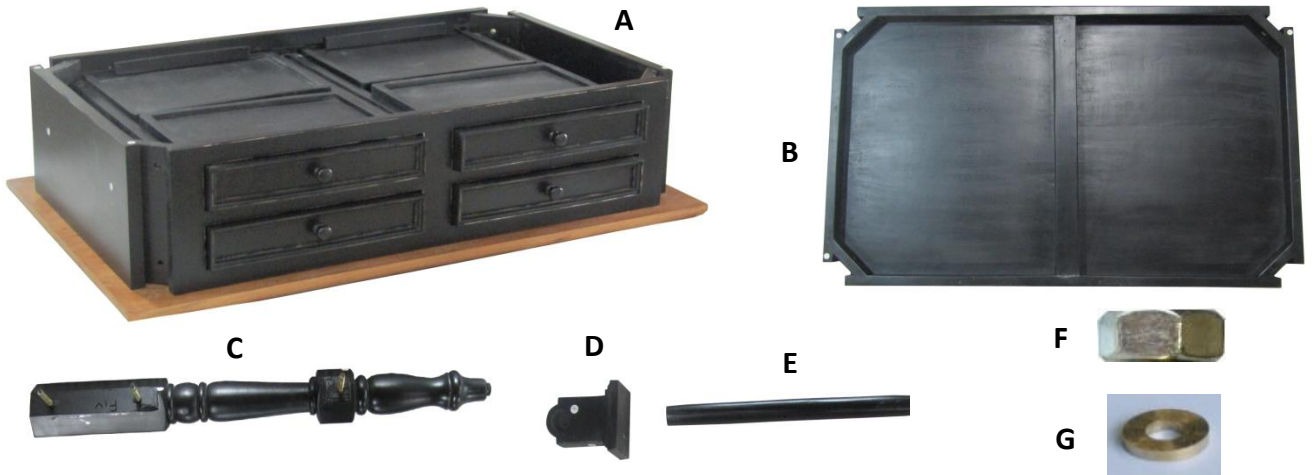
Tools Needed :

- Wrench



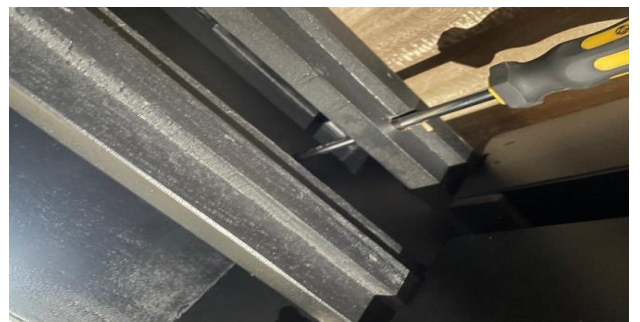
Pre-Assembly :

- Please read all instructions carefully and completely before assembly.
- Remove all parts and hardware from box along with any protective packaging.
- Do not discard any contents until after assembly is complete to avoid discarding small items accidentally.
- For your convenience and ease, assembly by two people is strongly recommended.



Assembly Instructions :

1. Carefully lay the table top (A) upside down on a carpeted or scratch-free surface.
2. Insert the hanger bolts on the two legs (C) into the pre-drilled holes on the wood frame.
3. Insert the flat washer (G) lock washer and nut (F) into long bolt. Do not tighten yet.
4. Align the shelf (B) in place and then align the other two legs to the frame and shelves, insert the flat washer (G), lock washer and nut (F) into long bolt.
5. Tighten all nuts with wrench. **DO NOT OVER-TIGHTEN.**
6. Align one towel bracket, and then align the hanging towel bar. Place the other towel bracket, then put the screws. Open top and bottom drawer to gain access to the hole in the runner, under the top, in order tighten the top screws for the towel brackets. See images below. Tighten the screws but do not over tighten.



Care instructions:

- This item is intended for indoor use only. To prevent fading, avoid placing item in direct sunlight.
- To clean, use any furniture polish such as "Pledge" with a soft cloth. Apply the polish to the cloth then wipe item. Wipe spills immediately.
- Avoid the use of cleaners or abrasives as they may damage the finish.
- To prevent marking, do not write directly on surface.
- To prevent discoloring, do not use rubber-based place mats.
- Do not place hot plates/cups or cold drinks directly on the surface.
- KD furniture should be tightened periodically to avoid damage. DO NOT OVER-TIGHTEN.
