



Care & Maintenance Guide

For Geo Coverings Porcelain & Ceramic Products

Read First

Before cleaning, always review the technical specifications provided for the collection you've purchased. These details are available online and in the product brochure.

When using any cleaning product, follow the manufacturer's instructions closely—especially recommended dosages and set times. Always test cleaners on a spare tile or an inconspicuous area before applying them broadly.

Routine Cleaning & Maintenance

Porcelain tiles from Geo Coverings are engineered for easy upkeep. In most cases, clean water or a neutral pH cleaner is all that's needed. If using detergent, rinse thoroughly with clean water and dry to prevent residue buildup.

Promptly wipe up spills—especially acidic liquids—to avoid staining.

For textured or outdoor surfaces, the same cleaning approach applies. Keep in mind that outdoor tiles with added traction may require more frequent attention.

Pressure Washer Use:

If using a pressure washer, proceed with caution. Set the machine to its lowest pressure and test a small area first. Do not concentrate on one spot for long—excessive pressure can damage the tile's surface.

Post-Installation Cleaning

- Remove debris with a broom or vacuum.
- Pre-wet the tile surface with clean water to protect grout joints from the detergent.

- Use a suitable detergent and apply by hand with a soft cloth or via a machine (e.g., single-brush with medium bristles or low-pressure water cleaner).
- Soak up the solution using a cloth or vacuum.
- Rinse thoroughly with clean, warm water to neutralize any remaining detergent.
- Remove hardened residue by gently scraping if necessary.
- If additional cleaning is required, use a diluted neutral detergent followed by a warm water rinse and drying.

Avoid Using the Following:

- Steel wool, scouring pads, or abrasive materials that may scratch the surface
- Ammonia-based cleaners, which can discolor grout
- Bleach- or acid-based products for routine cleaning
- Oil-based detergents, waxes, or sealants
- Cleaners that contain dyes or added colors
