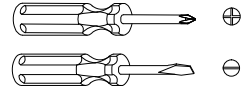

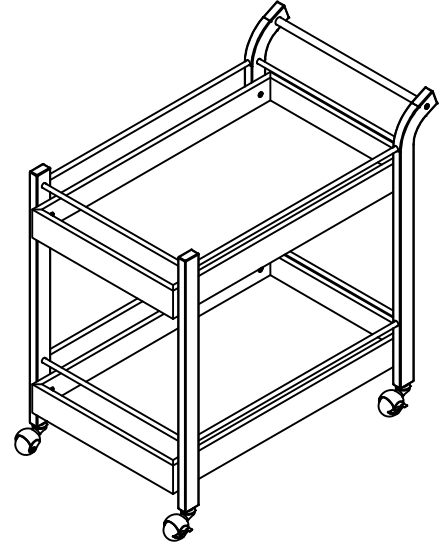

ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

1. Remove all packaging materials, staples and packing straps from the carton.
2. Refer to Parts List and Hardware List, and ensure parts and hardware are correct before assembly.
Contact customer service for missing parts.
3. Place all wooden parts on a clean, flat and soft surface (e.g. carpet or rug) to prevent scratch and damage to parts.

SAFETY PRECAUTION

1. KEEP ALL HARDWARE PARTS OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.
2. DISPOSE PLASTIC PACKAGING MATERIAL IMMEDIATELY TO AVOID ANY RISK OF SUFFOCATION TO CHILDREN AND ANIMALS.

TIPS FOR ASSEMBLY

1. Allow ample room for assembly and assemble the product near where the product will be placed.
2. Assemble the product on a surface that does not scratch or damage the exterior gloss and finish of the furniture.
3. Identify all of the parts, hardware and quantities required for each step.
4. During assembly, do not over-tighten any fittings as this may cause damage.
5. DO NOT USE POWER TOOLS TO ASSEMBLE THIS PRODUCT.
6. Always place the product on a flat, level surface.
7. Do not sit or stand on the partially assembled product; only use the product for which it is intended.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

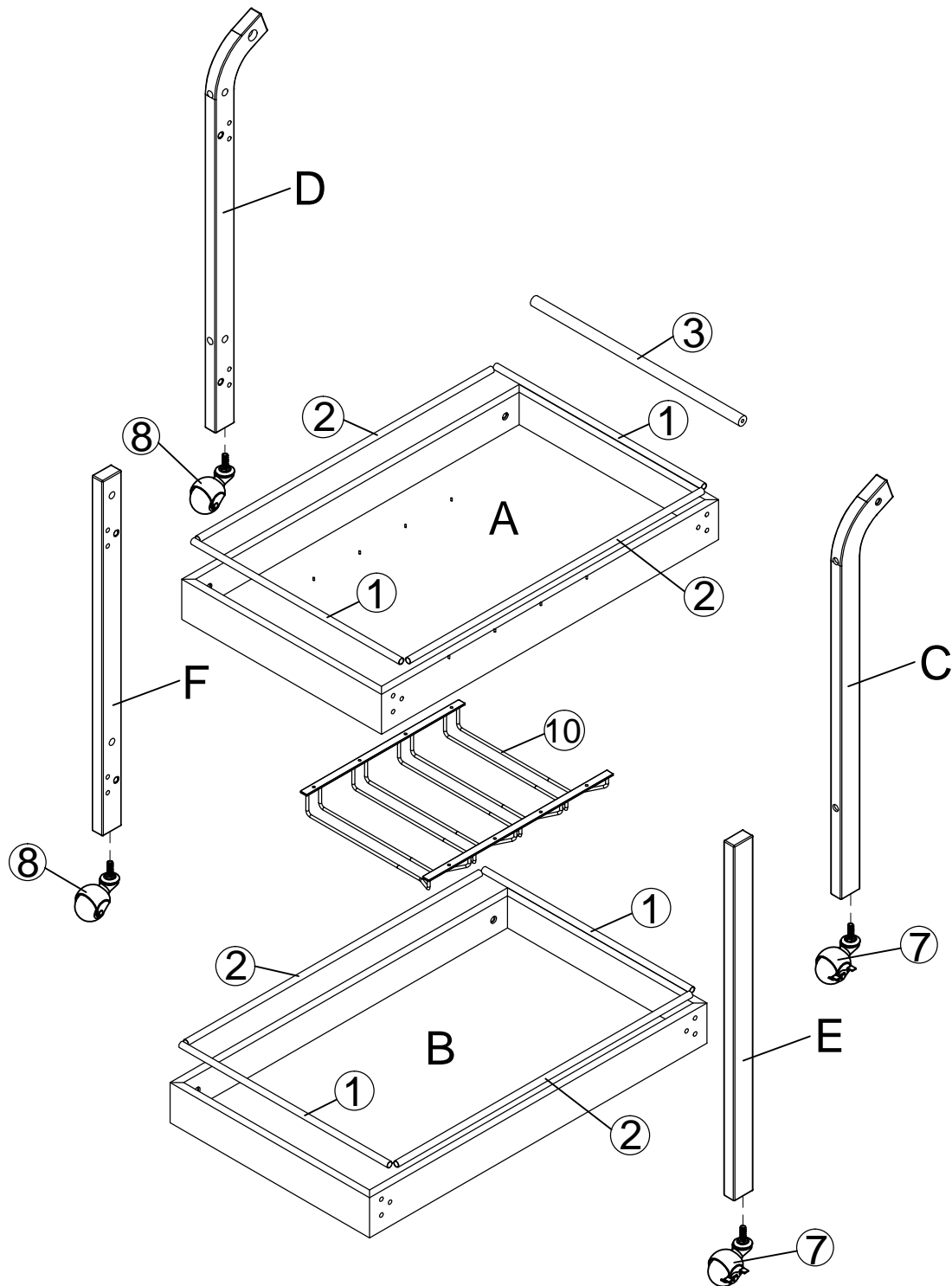
- Wipe clean with a soft, dry cloth; avoid the use of harsh chemicals or household cleaners as they may damage the exterior finish of the furniture.
- Hardware may loosen over time. Periodically, check that all connections are tight; re-tighten as necessary.
- Solid wood is impacted by heat and humidity fluctuations which may cause small joint separations or hairline cracks; place the furniture away from direct sunlight and air conditioning vents, heating vents or units to protect the furniture.

STEP 1



Place Top Tray (A) bottom side up as shown and position Wire Rack (10) to align the screw holes on each part. Use Screw (C) to fasten (10) to (A). Do not tighten (6) completely until all of the screws are in place.

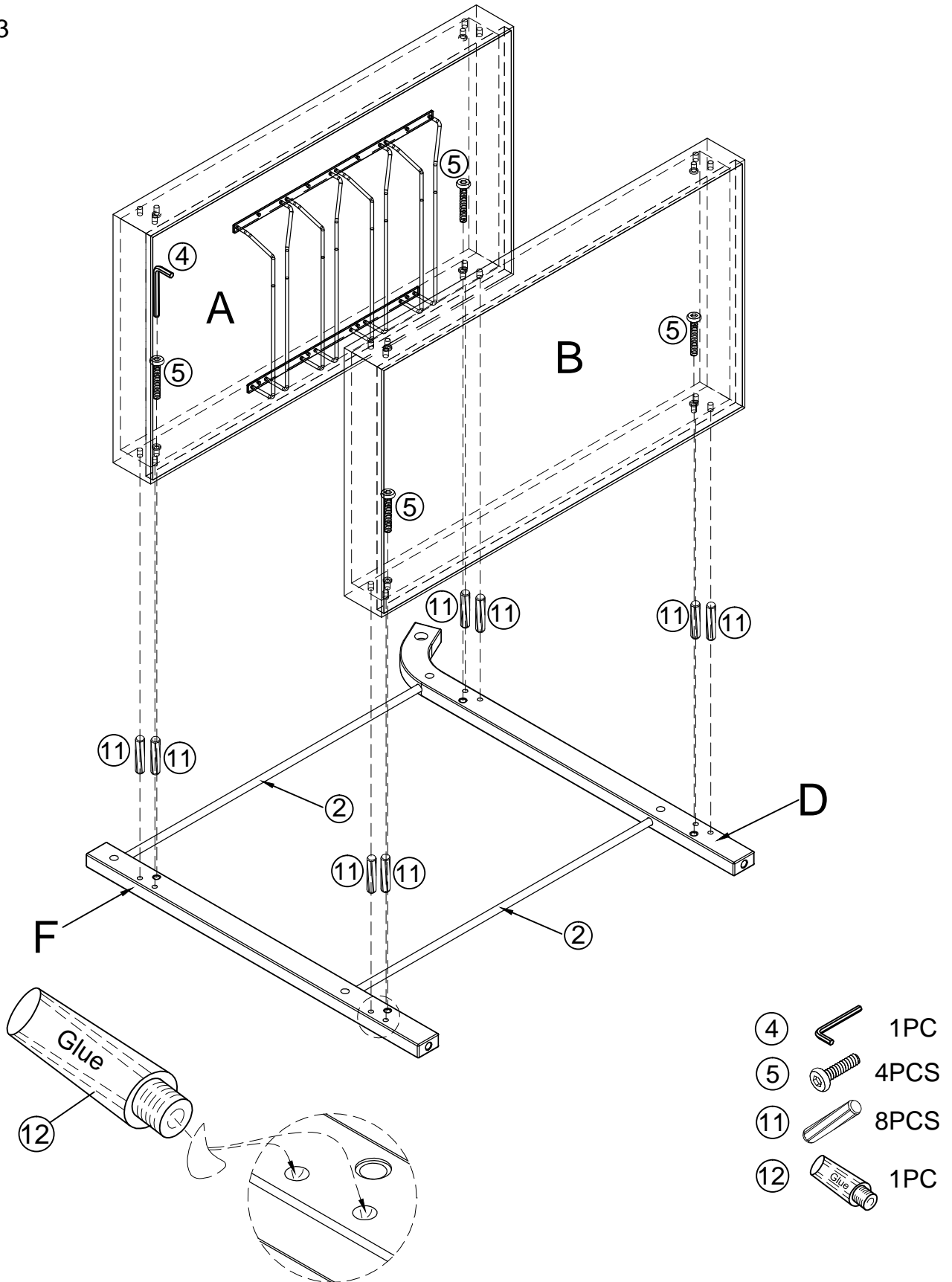
STEP 2



Attach Iron Stretcher (2) to Front Right Column (D) and Rear Right Column (F).

STEP 3

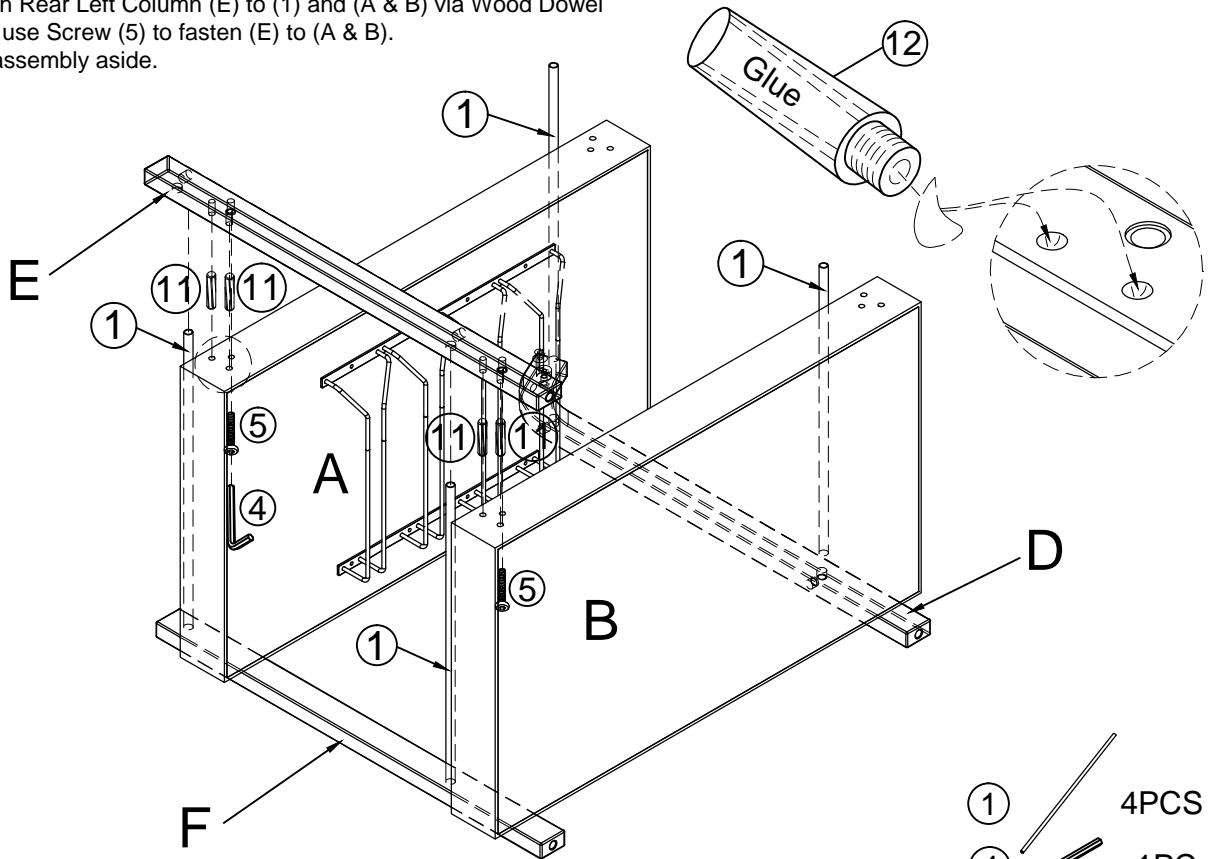


A. After drops glue, Insert Wood Dowel (11) into the designated holes on Front Right Column (D) and Rear Right Column (F).
 B. Attach Bottom Tray (B) to (D & F) via Wood Dowel s shown and use Screw (5) to fasten (B) to (D & F).
 C. Attach To Tray (A) from STEP 1 to (D & F) via Wood Dowel as shown and use Screw (5) to fasten (B) to (D & F).

STEP 4

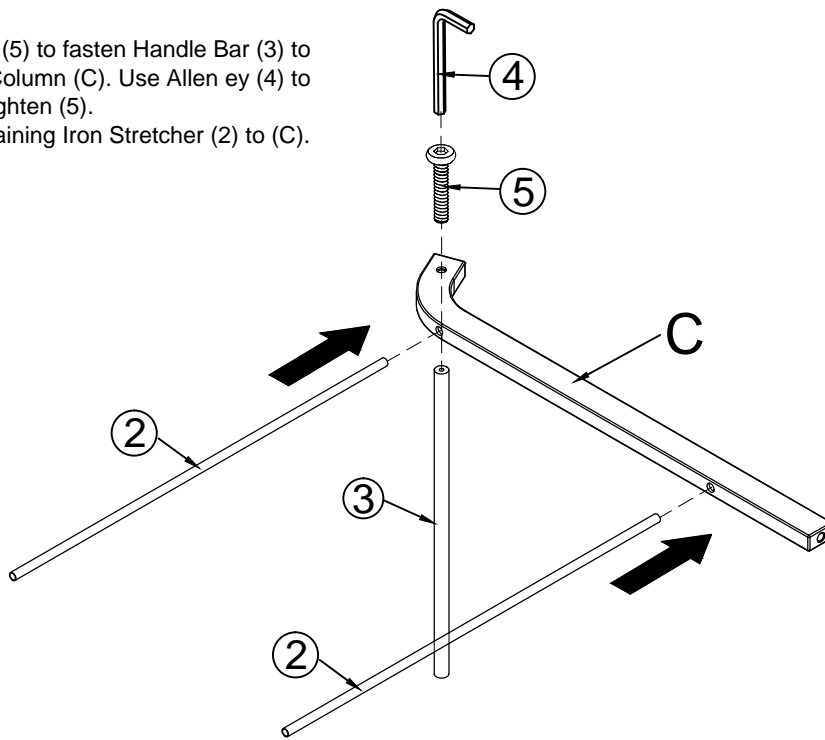
- A. Insert Iron Tray Support (1) into the designated holes on Front Right Column (D) and Rear Right Column (F).
- B. After drops glue, Insert Wood Dowel (11) into the designated holes towards the rear on the side panel of Top and Bottom Tray (A & B) as shown.
- C. Attach Rear Left Column (E) to (1) and (A & B) via Wood Dowel and use Screw (5) to fasten (E) to (A & B).
- D. Set assembly aside.

STEP 5

- A. Use Screw (5) to fasten Handle Bar (3) to Front Left Column (C). Use Allen key (4) to drive and tighten (5).
- B. Attach remaining Iron Stretcher (2) to (C).

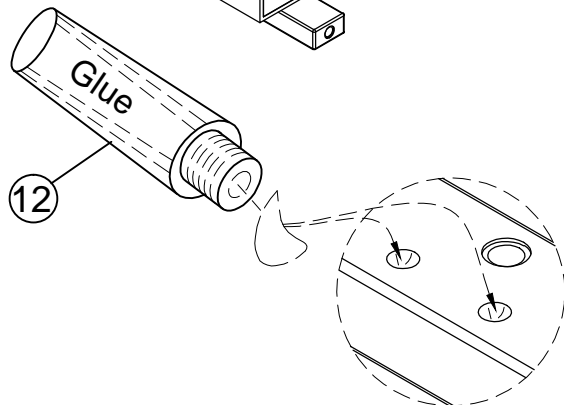
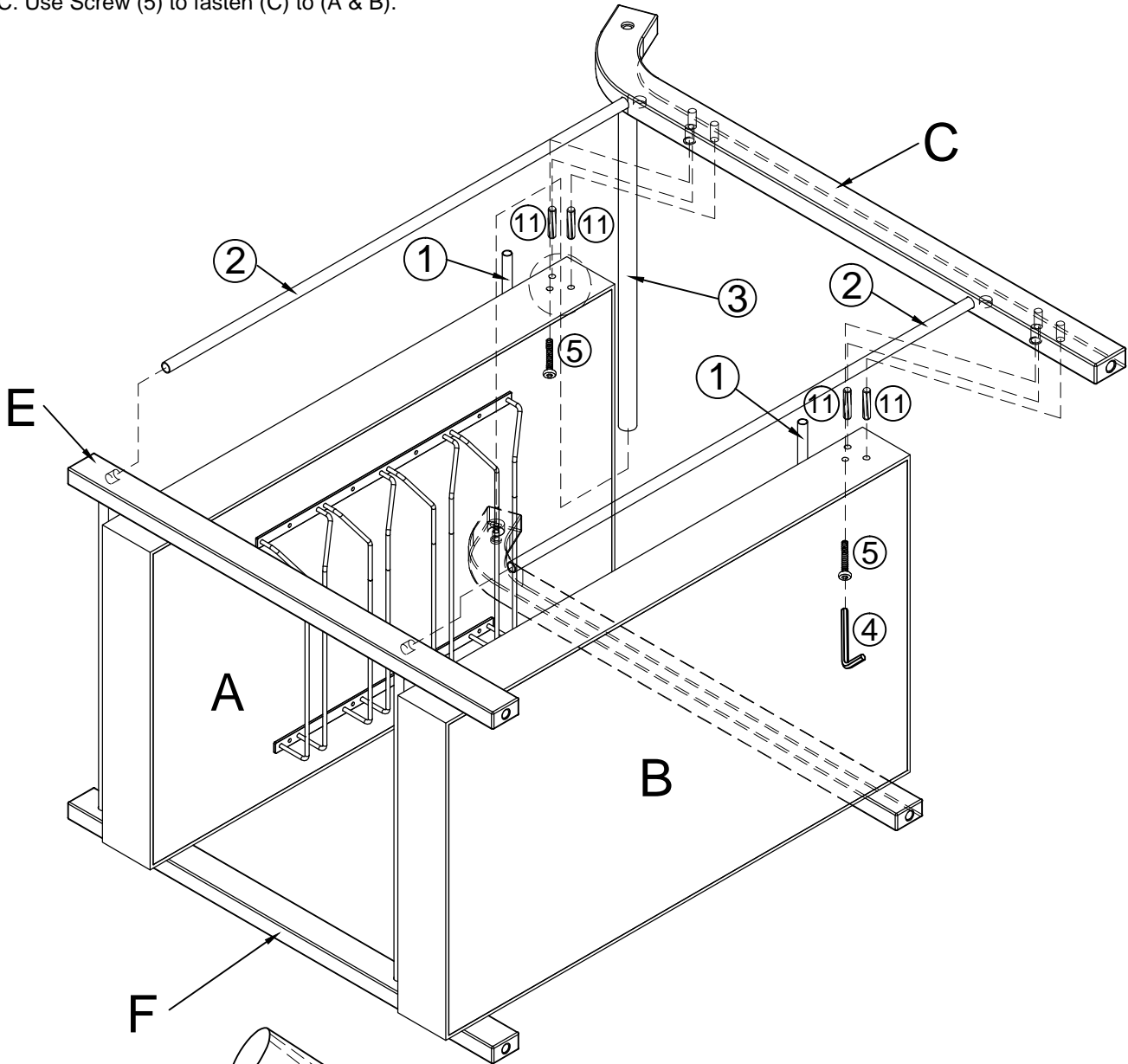

STEP 6

- A. On the assembly in STEP 4, After drops glue, insert Wood Dowel (11) into the designated holes towards the front on the side panel of Top and Bottom Tray (A & B).
- B. Attach the assembly from STEP 5 to the assembly in STEP 4:
1. Fit and attach Stretcher (2) on Column (C) to Column (E).
 2. Attach (C) to Side Panel of (A & B) via Wood Dowel and to Tray Support (1).
 3. Fit and attach Handle Bar (3) to Front Right Column (D).
- C. Use Screw (5) to fasten (C) to (A & B).



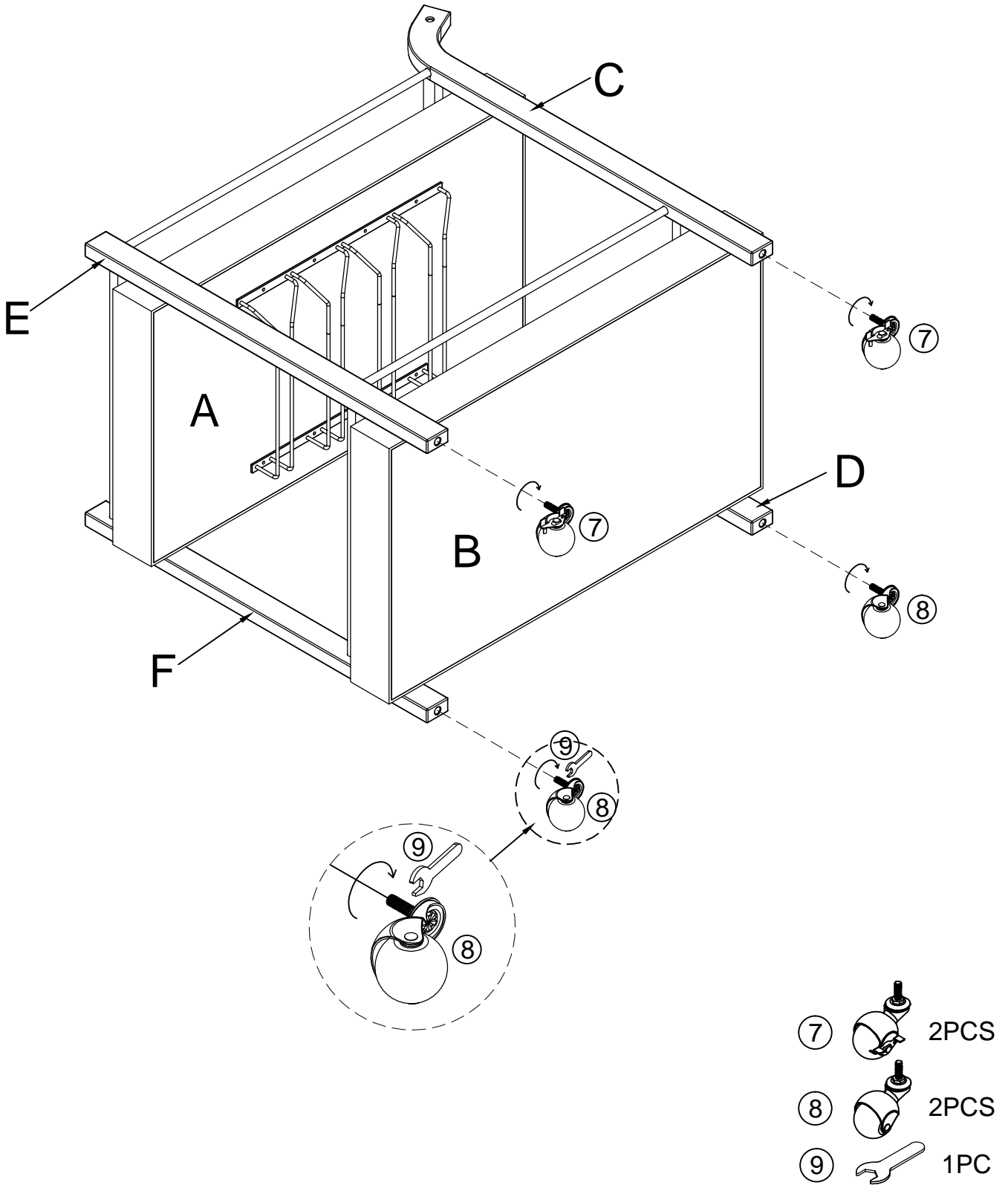

STEP 7

- A. Fit Castor with Lock (7) to the Column (C & E) and Castor (8) to Column (D & F).
- B. Use Wrench (9) to fasten and tighten (7 & 8) to the respective column.
- C. With assistance, set the assembly right-side up.

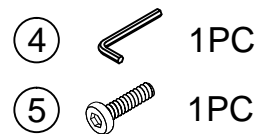
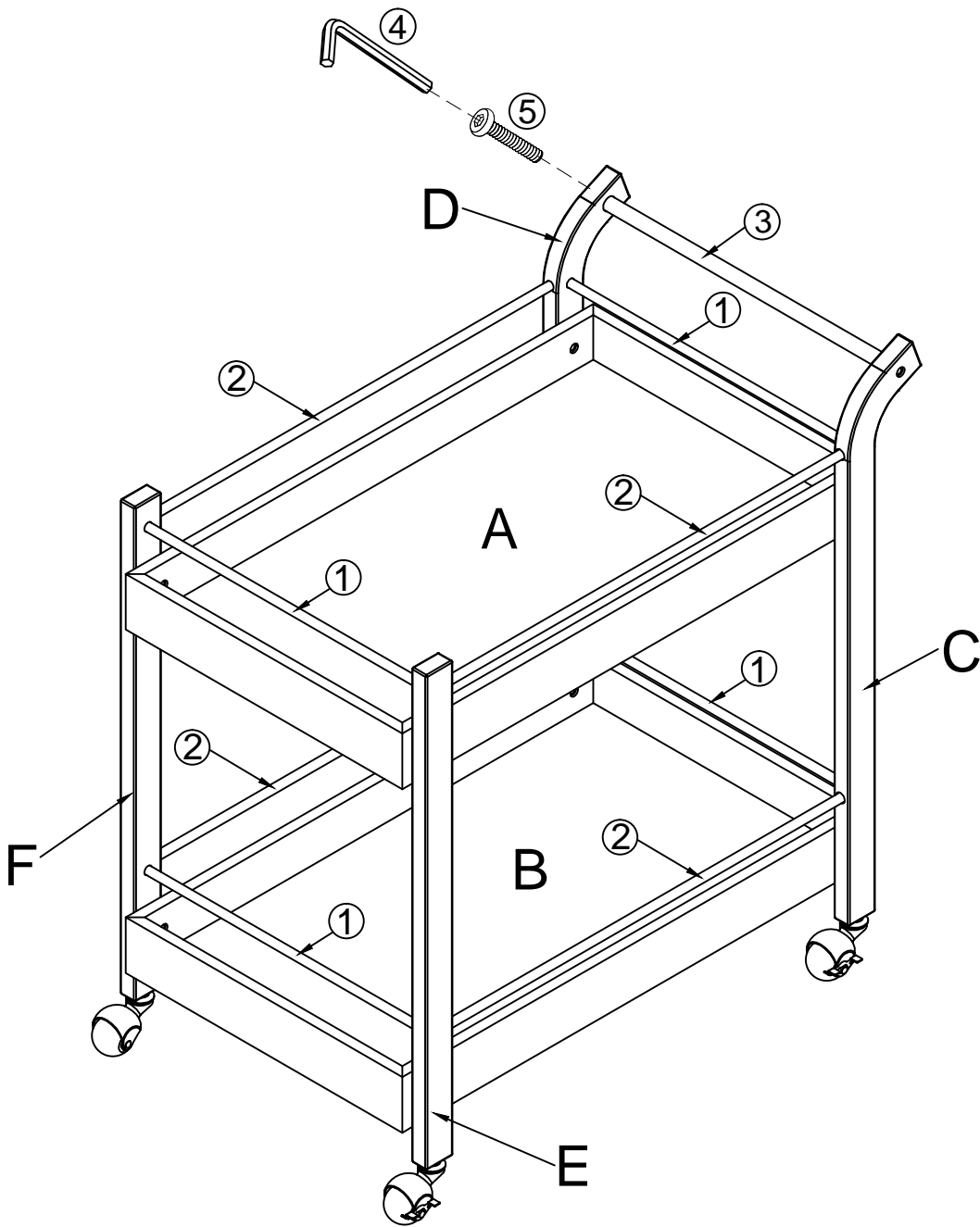

Use Screw (5) to fasten (3) to Front Right Column (D). Use Allen Key (4) to drive and tighten (5).
