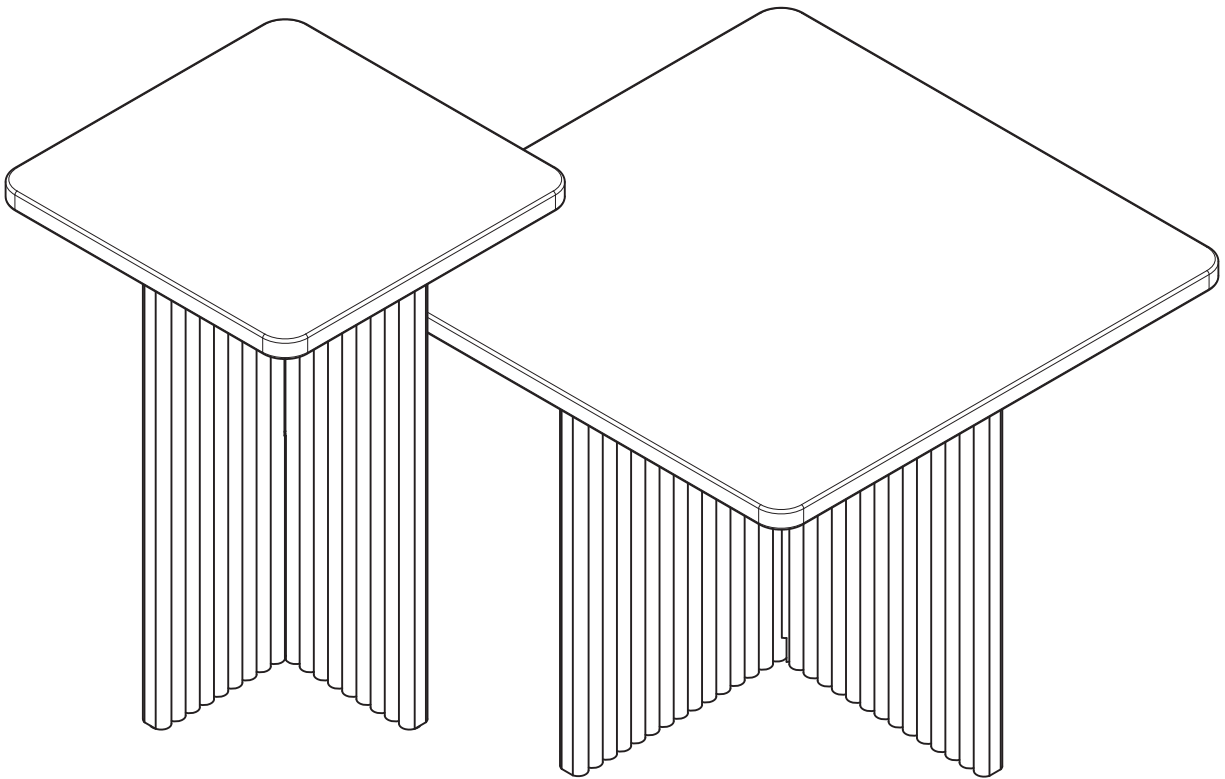











# **Square Fluted Nesting Coffee Table Set**

Assembly Instructions



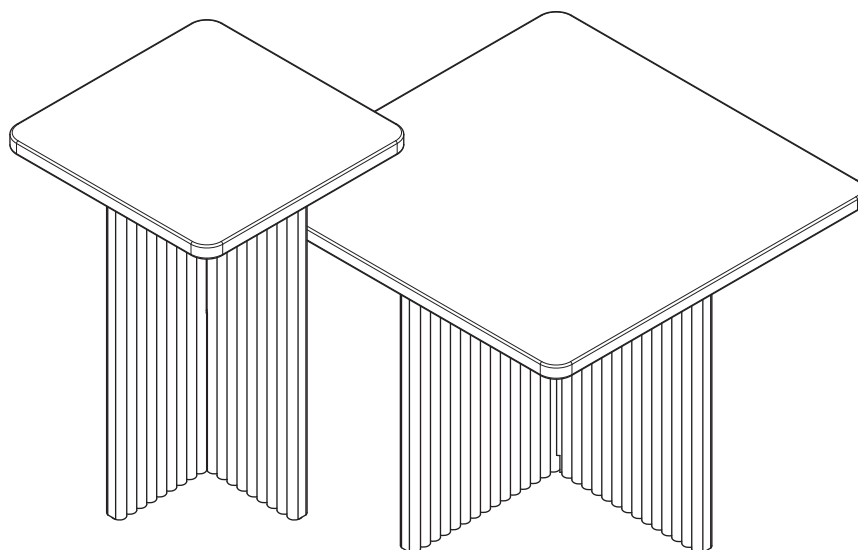
Hardware Pieces		Quantity	Your Parts		Quantity	
1		Metal Plates	2	A	Large Table Top	1
2		Screws	16	B	Short Upper Leg	1
3		Hex Bolts	8	C	Short Lower Leg	1
4		Spring Washers	8	D	Small Table Top	1
5		Flat Washers	8	E	Tall Upper Leg	1
6		Allen Key	1	F	Tall Lower Leg	1


### What You'll Need

- Phillips screwdriver 
- A blanket or a flattened box to protect your piece during assembly

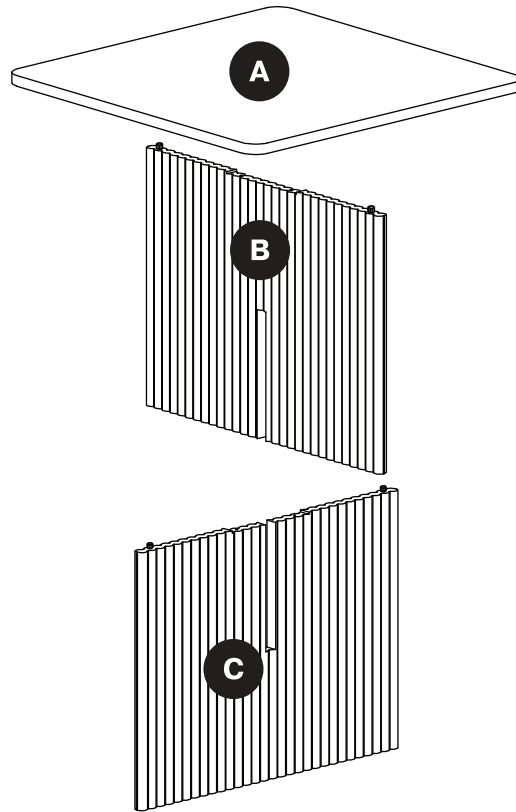
### Before Assembling, Remember!

- Make sure all hardware and pieces are accounted for before discarding the box.
- Pay close attention to all holes on each panel during assembly.
- Do not overtighten screws, as this may cause splitting.
- Use hand tools when assembling.
- No power tools allowed!



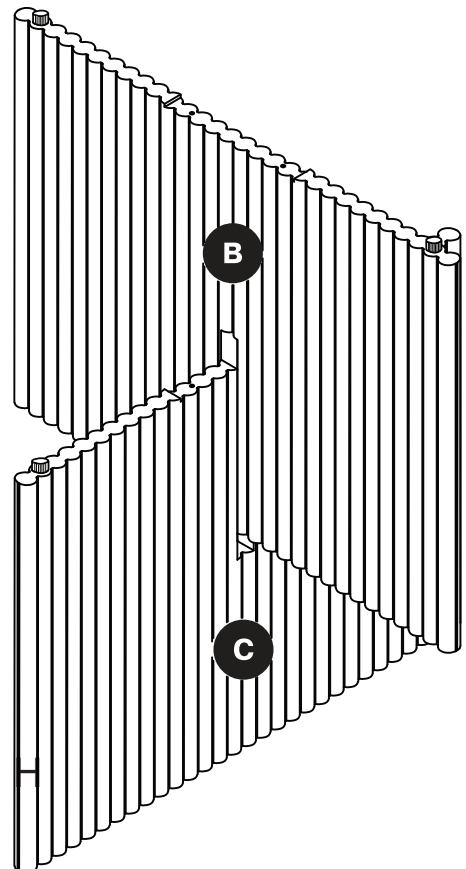

# Let's Build the Short Table!





## Step 1

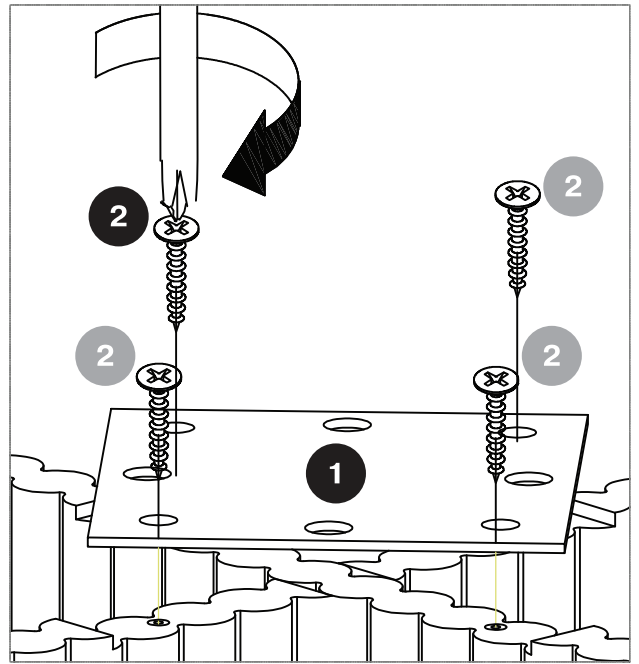
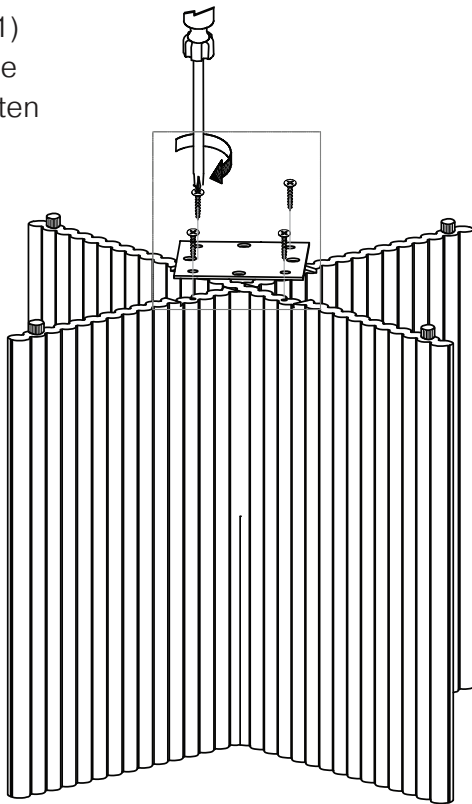
Align the slots on the Upper and Lower Legs (B&C) and slide them together.



## Step 2





Line up the Metal Plate (1) with the holes on the table legs, then insert and tighten Screws (2).

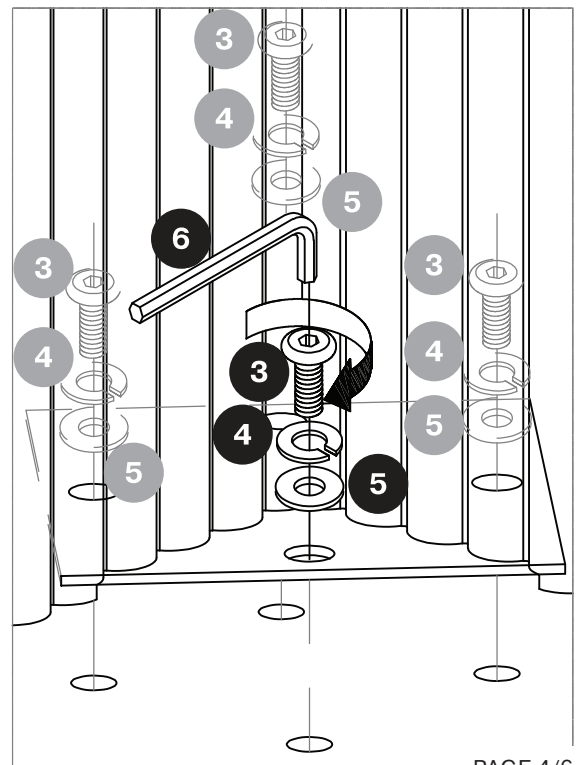
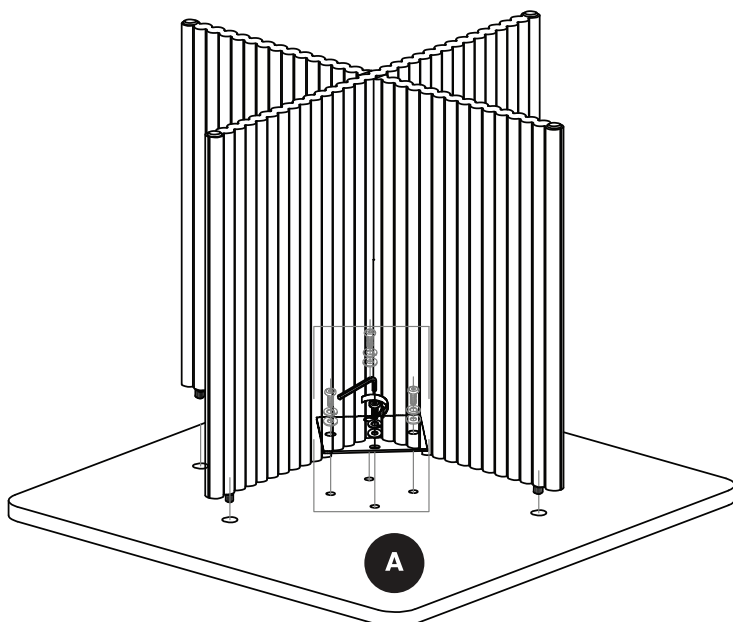
- 1**  Metal Plate x 1
- 2**  Screw x 4



## Step 3

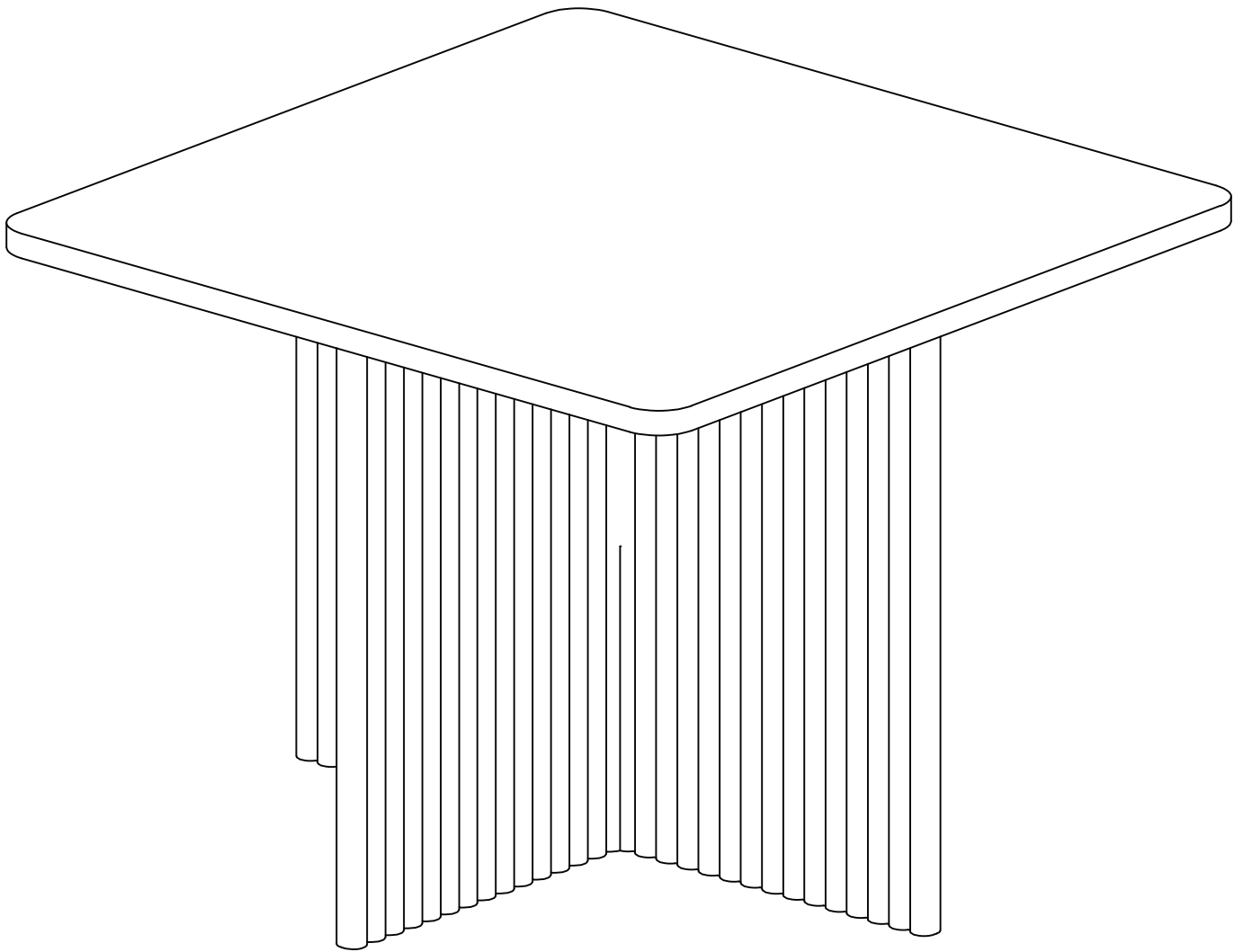
Place your Table Top (A) upside down on a blanket or box. Put the legs on top (with the rubber feet facing up) and line up the holes and wooden dowels. Put a Spring Washer (4) and then a Flat Washer (5) on each Hex Bolt (3), and use your Allen Key (6) to tighten the bolts.

- 3**  Hex Bolt x 4
- 4**  Spring Washer x 4
- 5**  Flat Washer x 4
- 6**  Allen Key x 1



# Short Table Finished

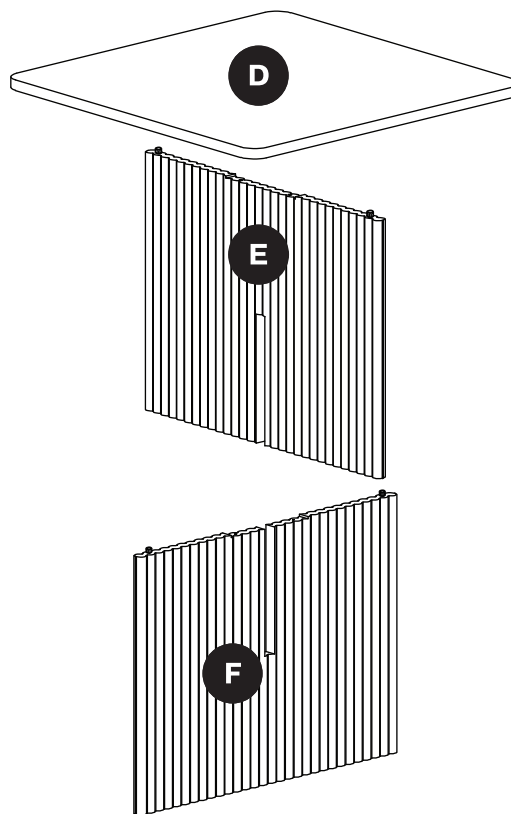
Carefully flip the table over.



# Now Let's Build the Tall Table!

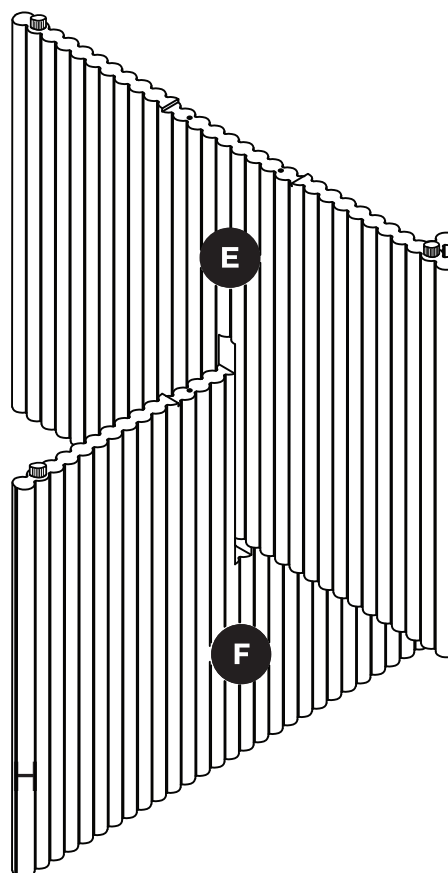
## Step 4

Gather the remaining wood pieces together.





## Step 5

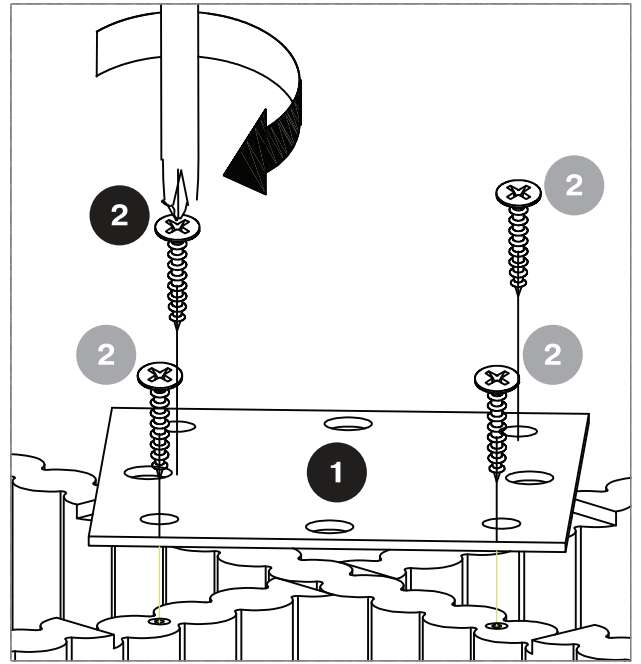
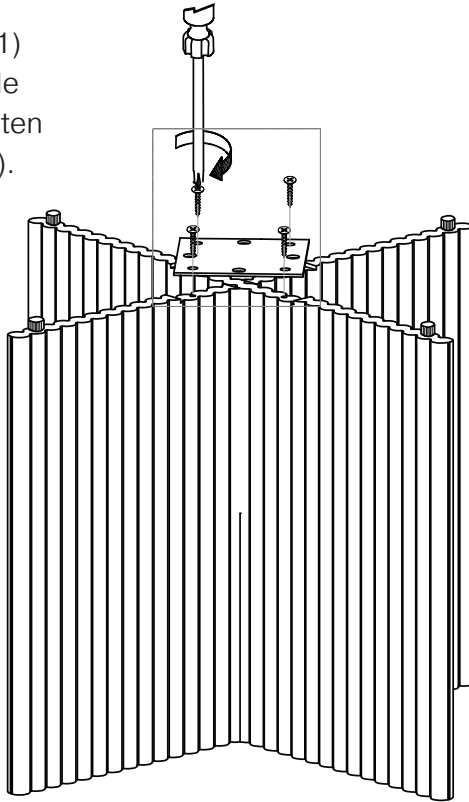
Align the slots on the Tall Upper and Lower Legs (E&F) and slide them together.



## Step 6





Line up the Metal Plate (1) with the holes on the table legs, then insert and tighten the remaining Screws (2).

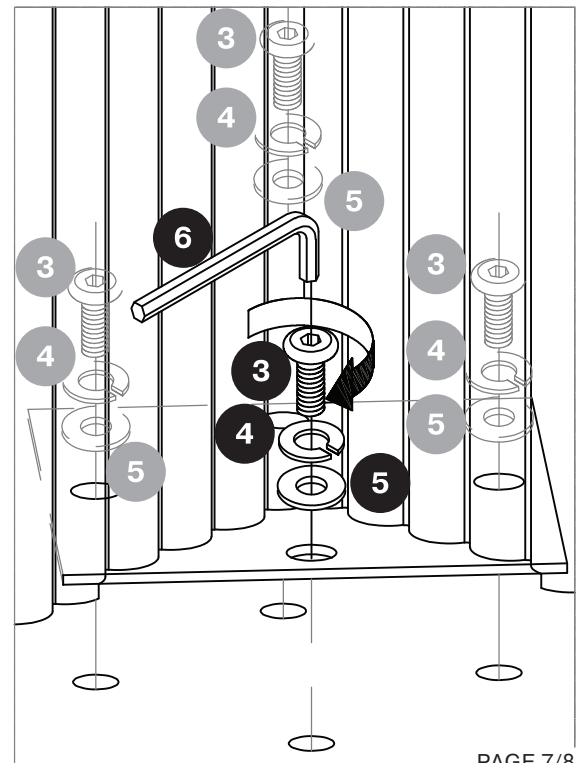
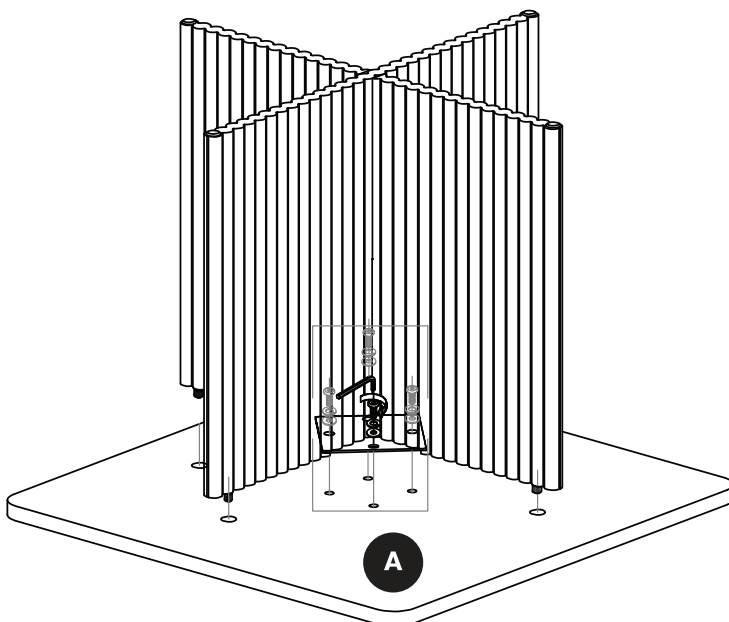
- 1**  Metal Plate x 1
- 2**  Screw x 8



## Step 7

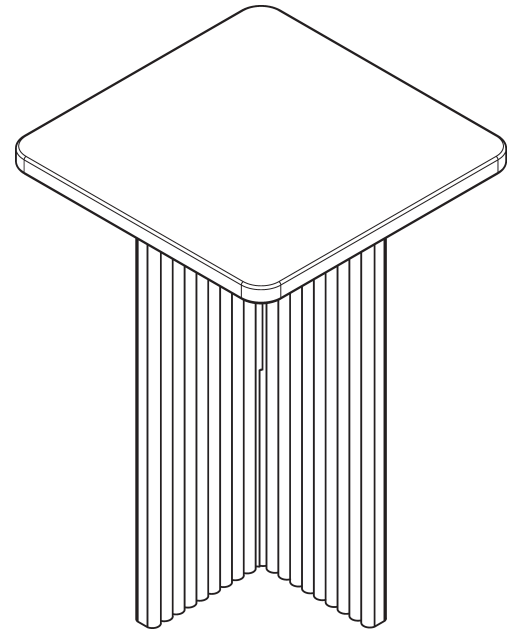
Place your Small Tabletop (D) upside down on a blanket or box. Put the legs on top (with the rubber feet facing up) and line up the holes. Put a Spring Washer (4) and then a Flat Washer (5) on each Hex Bolt (3), and use your Allen Key (6) to tighten the bolts.

- 3**  Hex Bolt x 4
- 4**  Spring Washer x 4
- 5**  Flat Washer x 4
- 6**  Allen Key x 1



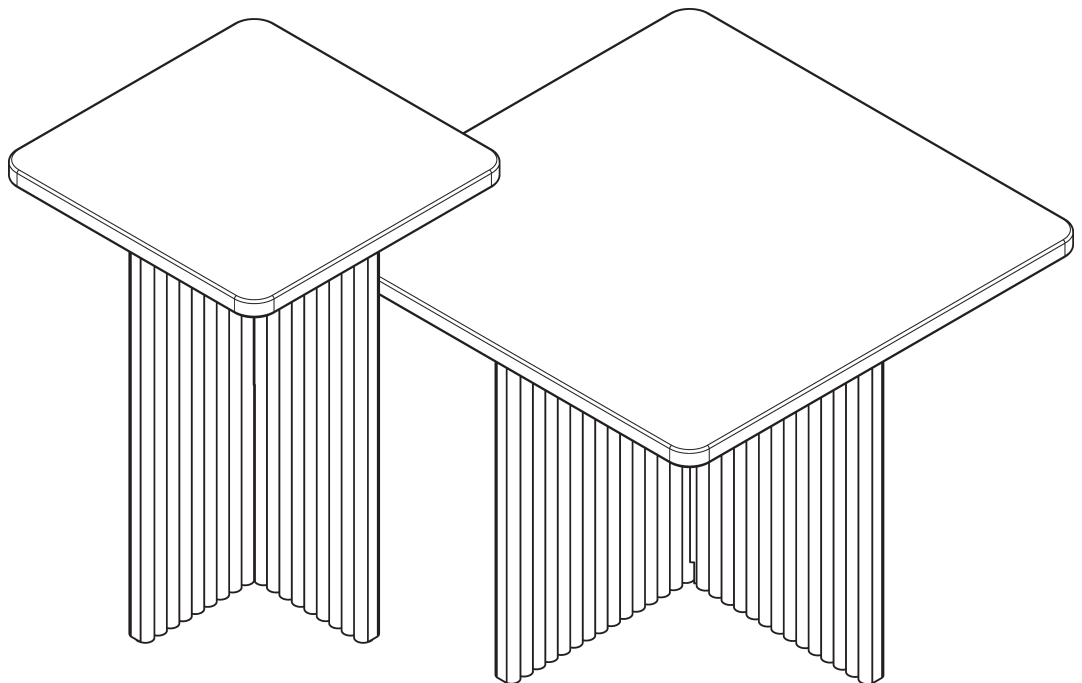
## Tall Table Finished
