

Curtain Hanging Instructions.

A. Unpack it

Open the plastic packaging zipper carefully

1. Take out the curtain and avoid the fabric from touching the zipper while pulling it out of the bag.

2. Remove any cardboard inserts.

3. Gently unfold the curtain and shake it out.

4. IF Ironing is needed,

Set the iron to the lowest/synthetic setting (usually labeled Polyester or Low).

Turn the curtain inside out to protect the visible side.

Place a thin cotton cloth between the iron and curtain as a pressing cloth.

Iron gently and keep the iron moving. Don't leave it sitting in one spot.

Use light steam and avoid soaking the fabric.

Hang the curtain immediately after ironing so gravity can help remove remaining wrinkles.

5. Also recommended hanging the curtain and using a garment steamer from a few inches away is often safer than direct ironing.

B. Prepare the curtain for hanging.

1. Insert the Rod pocket: Slide the curtain rod directly through the sewn-in pocket. (The rod pocket is the second pocket opening from the top of the curtain).

2. Hang the rod and the curtain on the window brackets.

3. spread the fabric evenly across the window and bunch the curtain evenly so it covers the window the way you want.

Tip: choose a slim curtain Rod (often around ½–¾ inch in diameter), in order to fit through the curtain pocket opening.
