

GENERAL USAGE INSTRUCTIONS

If you are not familiar with construction, hardware, and the use of tools, please seek assistance from a professional. Improper installation may lead to injuries.

Safety First:

Before using the hammock, inspect all components such as hardware, installation points, and hanging supports for any weaknesses.

Carefully sit down and rise from the hammock, as improper weight distribution can cause tipping.

This product is not designed for rough play or as a trampoline.

Excessive swinging or harsh movements can lead to tipping over and could prematurely wear out the product and its components.

Young children should not be left unsupervised with this product.

Care and Maintenance:

To prevent mold and extend the life of this product, store it in a dry place during seasons or periods of non-use. Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight and rain, as discoloration may occur.

Cleaning:

This product is hand-washable with cold water and a mild detergent or soap.

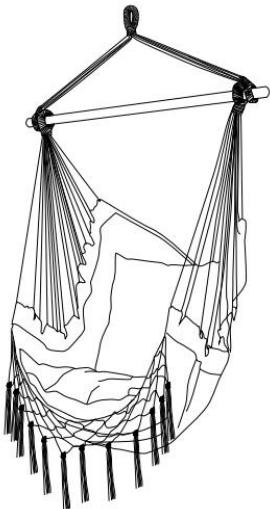
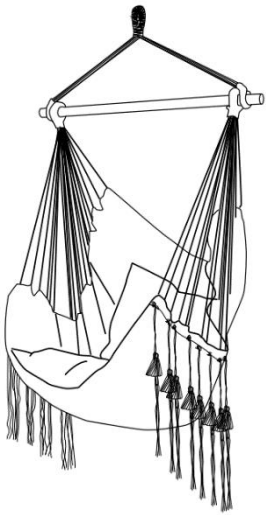
Do not use harsh chemical cleaners or bleach. Rinse thoroughly and let it dry completely before storage. Keep ropes and loops away from the fabric during cleaning.

Storage:

Ensure the product is completely dry before storing it in a dry place.

Optimal Hanging Instructions:

As most products of this type are handmade, measure the total length of the chair-type hammock to determine the best hanging option.



Hanging from a Tree Branch: You will need suitable hardware such as screw hooks, tree straps, and S-hooks.

Hanging from a Hammock Stand:

If a tree or beam is not available for hanging the hammock, using a freestanding stand is the simplest method. The total height of the stand should be about 30-50 cm higher than the total height of the hammock. To ensure the hammock fits the stand, hang it and adjust the height as needed.

Hanging from a Ceiling/Beam: Additional hardware is intended for ceiling hanging. If you are unfamiliar with construction, hardware, and the use of tools, please seek professional help.
