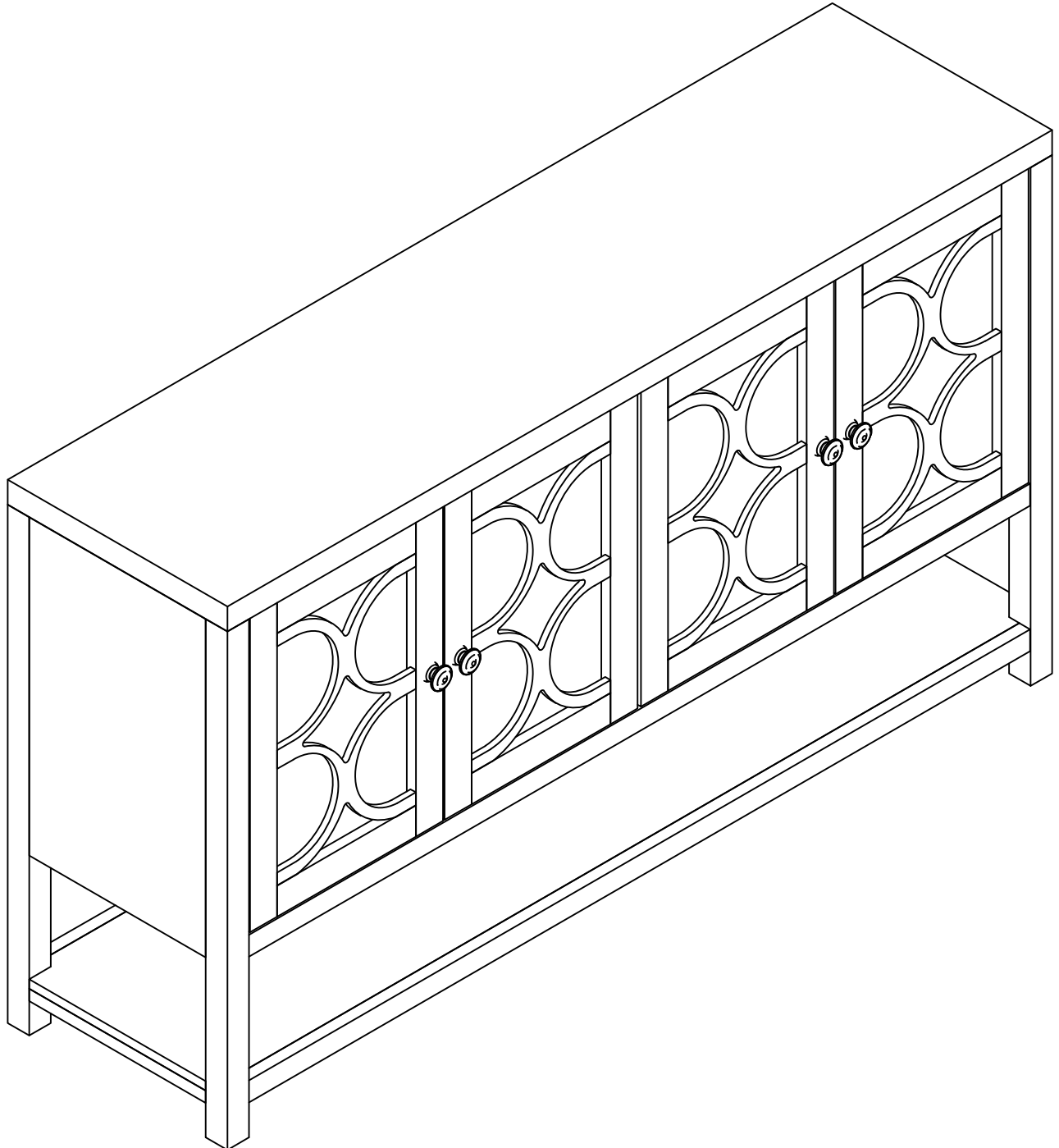


# ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION

**DO NOT RETURN TO THE STORE!** Skip the process of returning your product and contact us directly for a replacement

### Recommendations Before Beginning Assembly

Read instructions, cover to cover

-  • Have 2-4 adults on hand for assembly depending on product size
-  • Do not assemble directly on flooring or carpet
-  • Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (example: packing foam)
-  • Save all packaging until finished

### 3. Assembly Notice:

- If you encounter any problems during assembly and find that you cannot continue, rest assured we will help you solve the situation as soon as possible. Simply keep all of the parts of the product stored in a safe place and contact us immediately so we may assist you further.
- Once you have opened your package, remove all inner hardware packages and take the parts out. One by one, Place the parts out neatly in front of you, then refer to the instructions to ensure no parts are missing. If any pieces are found missing, please carefully look in the box first, as the hardware packaging might have torn making the hardware spill in the box.
- Some key parts of your product may be stored and hidden inside of other parts. Please open any zippered or hook & loop storage compartments to remove all parts. (example: cushions and legs being stored in the underside of a sofa)
- **IMPORTANT:** When setting up your product, **DO NOT INSTALL THE SCREWS ALL THE WAY IN THE BEGINNING.** Place each screw into their proper hole and use your hand to twist the screw halfway. Twist all the screws in halfway to ensure the holes will match up properly and the product is level on the ground. When everything seems fitted, then tighten the screws.
- When you have completed assembly, we suggest you have more than one person to assist you with lifting and placing the product.

## Care & Maintenance



Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface



Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish



Do not place furniture under direct sunlight



Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents



Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface



Do not place furniture outside. For indoor use only

Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth



Children should not climb or jump on the furniture

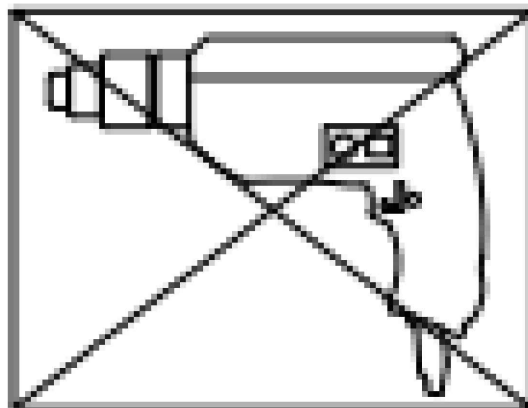

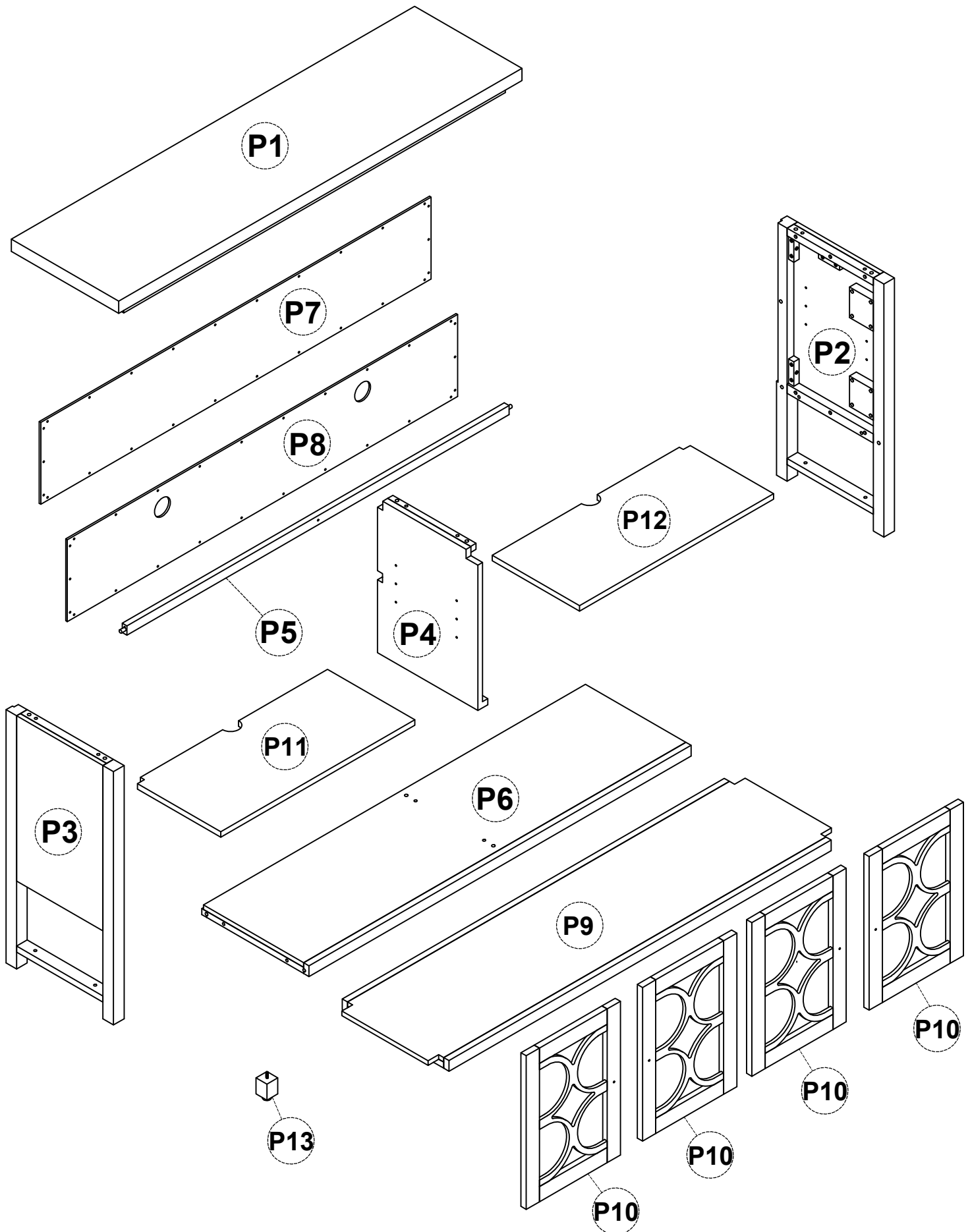

**Important - Please read instructions fully before starting assembly**

. Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages

. Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.

. Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.

. Make sure you have enough space to layout the before starting.

. During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product this could cause damage.

. Assembly the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.

. Assembly on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.

. Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



. To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your power drill is set on a low torque setting.

power drill is set on a low torque setting.

### Care and maintenance

. Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.

. From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.

. This product not be discarded with household waste Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.

### Handy Hints

. Assembly all parts and bolts loosely during assembly only once the product is complete should fully tighten the bolts.

. Regularly check and ensure that all bolts and fittings are tightened properly.

**In order to help prevent overturning - please follow these instructions**

To help prevent product toppling over please follow the below steps.

Use the anti tip strap or wall fixing method provided (if applicable)

Do not allow children to climb or hang on the furniture

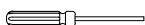
Do not open more than one drawer at a time

Do not place heavy items in the top drawers

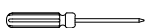
Do not place heavy items on top of the furniture, unless the furniture has been designed for this purpose

**Ruler - Use this ruler to help correctly identify the screws**







