Before starting the installation

Thank you for buying a Little Alexandra's Cottage. I'm sure the kids will love it. But before starting the installation please read below.

- Wear safety glasses and other safety equipment
- If you're working with children around, please use due diligence.

#### Step 1 The floor



Join both section together

The main floor is the base of the crate. Knock off the legs. The second floor section is inside the crate.

- Place the floors upside down where the playhouse will be built.
- The larger model will have 2 floors that need to be nailed together. After they're joined, flip the joined floor sections upside and make sure it's well supported underneath.
  - If you choose to install flooring, set it down and cut the excess off.

• The ground must be flat and levelled.

#### Step 2 The walls

- Get all your walls ready
- Lift them on the floor perimeter and nail them together



Identify the walls



Lift the walls on the floor perimeter and fasten them together



Wall assembly and front gable installed

#### Step 3 The roof



Join the rafters and set them evenly on the side walls



Set the roof panels. Make sure the top is exactly on the ridge so both panels will close tight



When both panels are in place, fasten them to the rafters using the finishing nails

- Assemble the trusses and set them on the side walls
- Lift the roof panels so the top edge is exactly at the ridge
- The roof should overhang in the front and in the back of the house about 2 1/2 in.
- Do both side of the roof and when they sit well, you may fasten the panels in place.

#### Step 4 Finishing your playhouse

You are now ready to finish the playhouse.

- Install the windows in the openings
- Set the door in place
- Do the facias boards starting with the front angled pieces
- Set the straight facias boards. Nail them at the end of the trusses. Set the back angled facias in place.
- Do your corners and the joining stips
- Complete the project with the ridge cap and flower boxes.

Start with the angled pieces setting them or the edge of the roof panels.



Complete your playhouse by adding the corners flower boxes and ridge cap.
