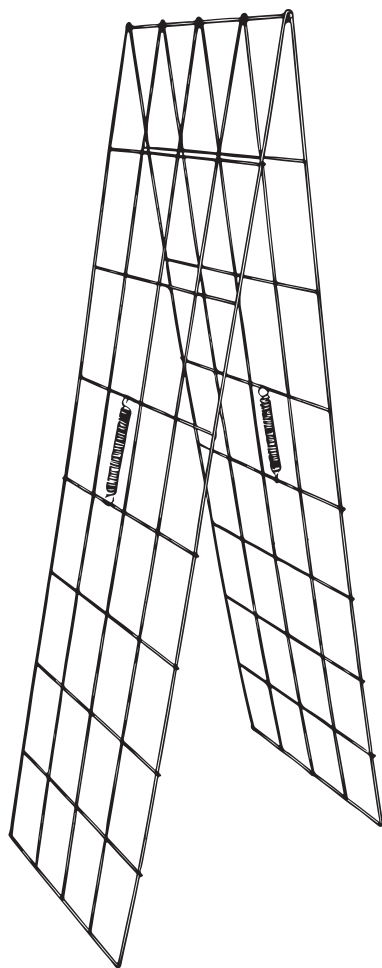


Cucumber Trellis Assembly

SAFETY & USAGE WARNINGS

Alignment Requirement: Before installation, ensure the upper and lower parts of the trellis are perfectly aligned. Misalignment may cause unstable structure or difficulty in assembly.

Protrusion Hazard: Note that both sides of the trellis have 5mm protruding parts. These edges are sharp and may scratch hands during handling or assembly—always wear protective gloves to avoid cuts or abrasions.

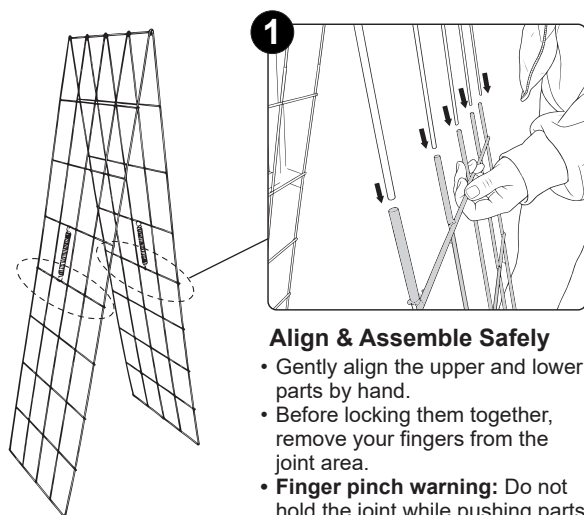
Handling Caution: When moving the trellis (either before or after assembly), grip it by the smooth frame parts (avoid touching the protruding edges) to prevent accidental scratches.

Assembly Safety: During the insertion/connection step, keep fingers away from the joint areas—pinching or squeezing risks injury from the protruding components.

Post-Assembly Check: After finishing assembly, double-check that all protruding parts are securely fastened; loose components may pose a greater scratch risk during use.

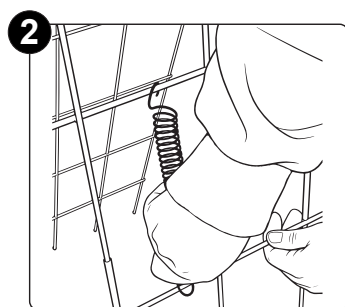
Keep Away from Children: This trellis contains small, sharp protruding parts. Store it out of reach of kids to prevent accidental injury.

INSTALLATION STEPS



Align & Assemble Safely

- Gently align the upper and lower parts by hand.
- Before locking them together, remove your fingers from the joint area.
- **Finger pinch warning:** Do not hold the joint while pushing parts together.



Reinforce With Spring Hooks

- After attaching the mesh panels, lock the connections with the included spring hooks.
- This keeps the trellis stable and prevents parts from falling off during use.
