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Daily Care



Ⓐ **Vacuuming:** Use a household vacuum cleaner with a soft brush attachment on low to medium suction to avoid damaging the pile. Gently vacuum in the direction of the pile, moving slowly.



Ⓑ **Pile Maintenance:** After daily use, lightly smooth the pile with your hand in the direction of the pile.

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Spot Cleaning



Step 1: Scrape Off

For solid stains (e.g., food, mud spots), gently scrape off surface solids using the edge of a blunt knife (e.g., butter knife). Do not rub back and forth.



Step 2: Blotting

For liquid spills, immediately press a clean, white, highly absorbent cloth (e.g., cotton, paper towel) onto the stain to soak up the liquid. Again, do not rub to prevent spreading the stain.



Step 3: Cleaning

1. Dilute a small amount of neutral detergent in cold water. Dip another clean white cloth into the cleaning solution. Test on an inconspicuous area of the sofa (e.g., under the seat, behind the backrest) first to ensure no color fading occurs before proceeding.

2. Using the dampened cloth, gently dab from the outer edge of the stain toward the center to prevent spreading.



⚠ Important!

Cleaning Solution: Always use a neutral detergent (e.g., diluted dishwashing liquid or specialized sofa cleaner). Never use strong acids, strong alkalis, bleach, or solvent-based cleaners.
Water Temperature: Use only cold or room-temperature water. Hot water may cause fabric shrinkage or set certain stains (e.g., protein-based).

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Step 4: Rinsing

This crucial step removes any remaining cleaning solution. Use a clean cloth dampened only with cold water, and gently dab the area. Replace the water and cloth multiple times until no residue remains.



Step 5: Blot Dry

Absorb excess moisture with a dry cloth, then allow the item to air dry naturally. Never use hair dryers, hot air, or direct sunlight, as these can cause the fabric to stiffen or discolor.



Step 6: Brush

Once completely dry, if the suede appears disheveled, gently brush it with a soft-bristled brush in the direction of the nap to restore its original appearance.

Deep Cleaning

A: Professional Sofa Service (We recommend hiring a professional sofa cleaning service.)

B: DIY Cleaning (Use a household sofa cleaner with cold water and a neutral detergent.)

C: Air Dry Naturally (After cleaning, air dry in a well-ventilated indoor area away from direct sunlight.)

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⚠ Regarding Ironing (Highly Not Recommended)

Generally, avoid ironing. High-temperature ironing can easily cause fabric shrinkage, hardening, or loss of sheen. If unacceptable wrinkles appear after cleaning and ironing is necessary, strictly adhere to:

- * Use the lowest steam setting.
- * Never allow the iron to directly contact the fabric!
- * Always use two layers of fabric protection: one dry white cotton cloth (like an old sheet) and one damp cloth. Alternatively, use a professional vertical steam iron, maintaining a distance of at least 20–30 cm from the fabric while steaming.
- * Iron quickly and always in the direction of the pile.

Important Recommendations

A. Avoid Direct Sunlight: Prolonged exposure to sunlight can cause the fabric to fade and age, and the foam is more prone to yellowing. Use curtains or blinds to block strong light.

B. Regularly Flip and Fluff the Cushions: Periodically turning and swapping the positions of seat and back cushions can ensure more even wear, extend their lifespan, and maintain a plump appearance. Fluffing helps restore the elasticity of the inner filling.

C. Keep Pets Away: Pet claws can easily snag and damage the fabric.
