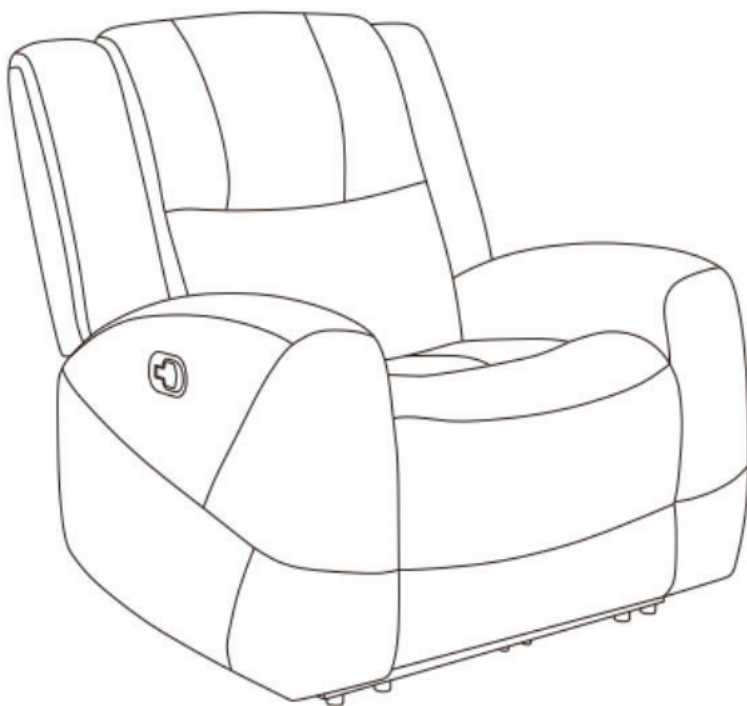

CHECK BEFORE STARTING

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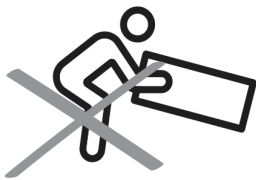
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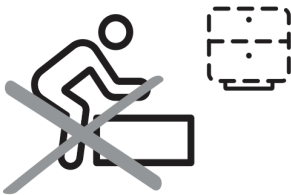
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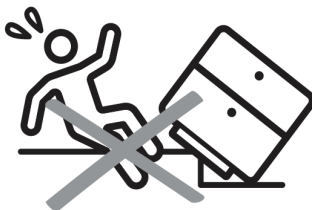
Sufficient Space

Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly.



Avoid Scratches

Use cardboard, blankets or a carpeted area while assembling furniture to prevent to prevent scratches and damages.



Flat Surface

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

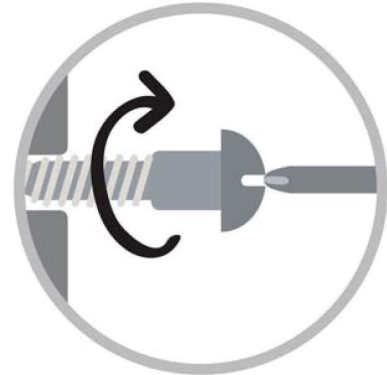

- 1 There are two wings under seat. Remove the LAF Wing and RAF Wing from under seat.

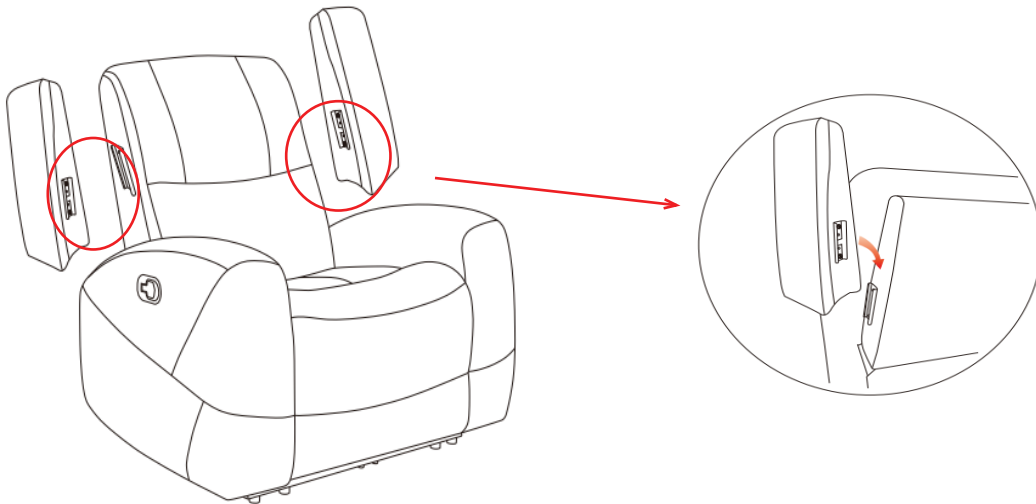

- 3** Install the LAF Wing and RAF Wing by inserting brackets.



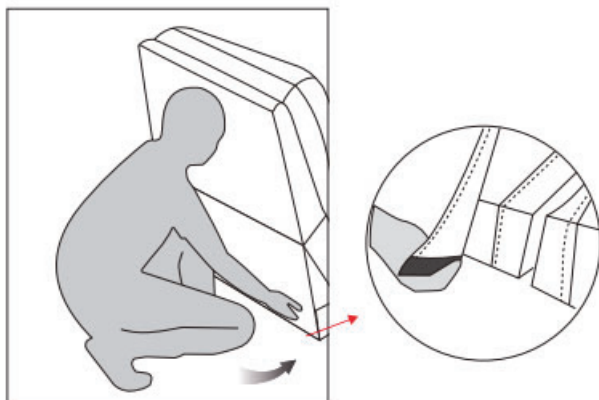
- 4** Take out the Middle Backrest from the bottom of the Console.
Install Middle Back Cushion by inserting 3 screws into pre-drilled holes on Console Body.
Screw up from bottom to attach the console back.
