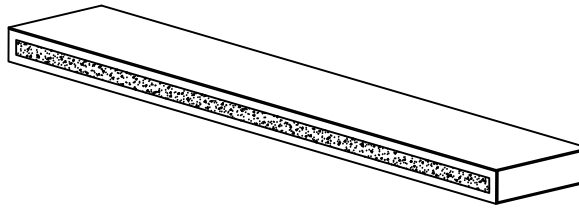


48" FIREPLACE MANTEL INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

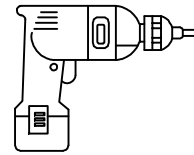


Step 1: Tools Needed for Installation

If you install the floating Mantel shelf to cement wall, following tools should be needed.

Power drills.
Philippines screwdriver.
Level
13/64" drill bit
Pencil
Hammer

If wooden wall, only level and Philippines screwdriver are needed.

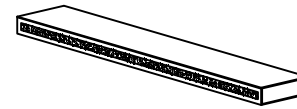

Step 2: Hardware Included in Packaging

When you buy a floating shelf, there should be following parts included in the packaging at least.

1. one shelf
2. one heavy duty bracket
3. 18 plastic anchors
4. 18 screws

1 heavy duty bracket



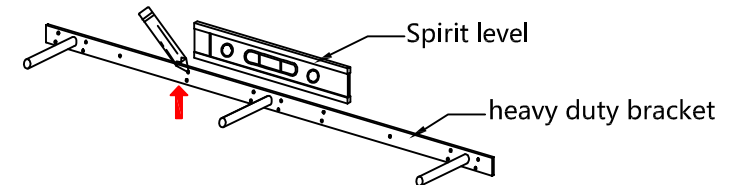
18 plastic anchors



18 screws

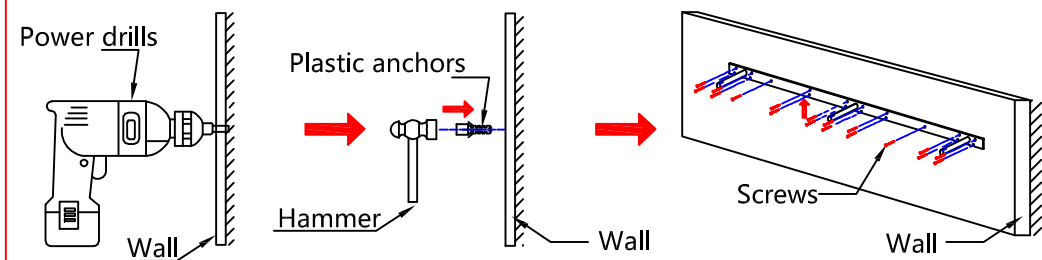
Step 3: Locate Install Space

Place bracket against wall in the desired position and mark holes with a pencil where holes in the bracket meet the wall. Level should be used to insure plate is horizontal.



Step 4: Install Metal Bracket to Wall

Using a power drill and 13/64" drill bit, drill a hole on the wall at the pencil mark insert the anchor into the hole tap the anchor flush with the wall. After all the anchors are secured in place position bracket to be mounted to the wall. Using a power drill with Phillips tip or Phillips screwdriver, place screws provided into each anchor and tighten until they are firm to the face of the bracket.



Step 5: Slide Shelf Onto Bracket

WARNING: The mantel shelf is made of fragile glass. Before sliding the shelf onto the bracket, make sure the bracket is securely mounted to prevent the shelf from falling and being damaged.
